## CRPD's Measure G on Ballot

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - With high hopes and due diligence, the cash-strapped Carmichael Recreation and Park District got Measure G – a General Obligation Bond – on the November ballot. The initiative asks the community to approve a tax to fund parks and park facility improvement.

Voter-approval nevertheless provides no guaranty of success. Many recall a similar 2014 process. More than 50 percent of district constituents voted for a tax-payer assessment. Initial monies were already collected when a private lawsuit overturned the voters' choice. One of few Sacramento area park

districts without an improvement measure, CRPD has since struggled mightily. Many facilities are outdated or inadequate; renovations are desperately needed.

CRPD Advisory Board Chair Joyce Carroll champions the "Say yes on Measure G" initiative. Carroll considers this new funding critical to Carmichael's 13 parks. "Without it," she says, "Existing facilities will continue to deteriorate and park user experience will suffer."

The Carmichael Times asked the following questions:

**Q: Why does Measure G have a fighting chance for success where the previous effort was quashed?**

**Carroll:** "This time we have a broader base of support. Already, we have scores of community members,

neighborhood associations, elected officials, educators and businesspeople who publicly endorse Measure G."

**Q: Could voter approval again be overturned?**

**Carroll:** "There are no guarantees. However, Measure G committee members and our financial advisory consultant have met with the Sacramento Taxpayers Association. Its directors voted to not oppose Measure G. With their input, and with the establishment of a citizens' oversight committee, we're confident a voter decision would stand."

**Q: Over 26,500 voters live within CRPD borders. How would bond contributions be assessed?**

**Carroll:** "A tax is calculated on the assessed value of all properties

## SJUSD Begins Selection for Next Superintendent

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - The San Juan Unified School District Board of Education announced at its meeting on August 23, 2022, that the district will conduct an internal search for its next superintendent of schools. The process kicks off with an opportunity for students, families, community members and staff to share their hopes for the district's future. The board hopes to conclude the selection process and ask the chosen candidate to assume the superintendent's position as of Jan. 1, 2023. "Our schools and our district have a lot to take pride in," said Board of Education President Michael McKibbin. "As a board, we feel it is essential that our next superintendent be able to build upon our strengths to help us address our areas of opportunity. As we continue our journey toward more equitable education, deliver on more than \$100 million in specialized programs to address learning loss and the challenges of the pandemic, and continue to implement the work called out in our Local Control Accountability Plan, we must have a leader who understands where we are and has the ability to help us grow."

To help inform the board in its selection process, members of the district's community are invited to share input in two ways. The first is online via a Thoughtexchange which offers a chance for participants to share their own thinking but also see what others are sharing. The exchange will be open from Aug. 24 through Sept. 9. The second method is via community forums being held on Sept. 8 at four physical locations as well as one online session. Additional outreach will be conducted with district committees and student groups.

Applications will be open to any current San Juan Unified employee beginning Sept. 1 with a closing date of Sept. 15. The board anticipates interviews taking place the week of Sept. 19.

"In looking at the superintendent selection processes recently in other districts and the history of success for those hired it becomes clear that stability of leadership is vital. We've been through interim superintendents before and seen the paralysis it can cause," said Board of Education

But after more than two decades of service, the Saini family, a first-generation couple who immigrated to the U.S. from India, decided to run an independent business instead when their franchise renewal was due

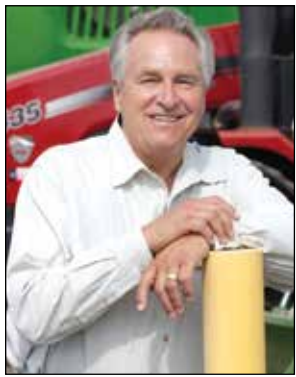
in early 2019.

# Senate Democrats Kill Proposal to Fund Critical Water Storage

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Senator Jim Nielsen, R-Red Bluff, issued the following statement in response to Senate Democrats killing his proposal on August 30, to fully fund and build Sites Reservoir:

“Here they go again. Senate Democrats need to get their heads screwed on straight. For the second time this year, they have killed critical funding to build Sites Reservoir. “California is in the third year of a devastating drought. The state budget is flush with money. Doesn’t it make sense to get large-scale, above-ground water storage funded and built?”

“What’s most frustrating is that voters overwhelming approved building water storage

via Proposition 1 back in 2014. Not one shovel has been turned. Not one drop of water has been stored. “That’s shamefully irresponsible and short-sighted of our state’s leaders. The future of our children and grandchildren depends on a reliable water supply.”

Nielsen offered amendments to Assembly Bill 2201, which would have established the Water Storage and Conveyance Fund to provide:

\$2.6 billion to fully fund Sites Reservoir; and \$685 million to repair the Friant-Kern/Delta-Mendota Canals and the San Luis Field/San Joaquin Divisions of the California Aqueduct.

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Proudly unincorporated, the community of Carmichael will mark its 113th anniversary on September 24. Live music, youth group performances, a car show and kids activities will bring a carnival atmosphere to Carmichael Park.

Founder’s Day commemorates a 1909 real estate venture by realtor Daniel Carmichael. The Georgian-born entrepreneur purchased chunks of the old San Juan and Del Paso land grants and carved these into 10-acre blocks. Settlers were offered mini farms for around \$1000 each. The lots have since been much subdivided and though few original homes remain, streets named for pioneers Van Alstine, Gibbons, Barrett, Clark, Kenneth, Stanley – and Dan Carmichael himself – are monuments to the colony’s early years.

History aside, the birthday provides much festivity. The area’s largest annual car show will fill part of Carmichael Park with classic motors. In the sound-shell area, youth performances will include martial arts, gymnastics and the award-winning Del Campo High School Cheer Team. A free kids zone will offer bounce houses and crafts. Food trucks will provide refreshments.

In advance of the dates, Carmichael Improvement District is rallying enthusiasm by encouraging

businesses to offer anniversary deals. “The 1909 date seems a good hook for Carmichael love,” explains PBID executive Rebekah Evans. “The T-SHIRT PRO is offering to custom print 24 tee shirts for \$190.09. That’s a real bargain. Cake, Cake and More Cake bakery is offering a two-layer cake

for \$19.09. It usually sells for \$40.”

Saini credits her children with much of the success the family-owned eatery has had – with her tech-savvy son, Kyle, and her supportive daughter, Gia.

Both of Sandeep's kids grew up locally with the 28-year-old Kyle graduating from Jesuit High School in Carmichael, and her 24-year-old daughter graduating from Saint Francis High School in Sacramento.

# Emergence of Monkeypox Underscores Need to Strengthen Public Health

**California Can't Wait News Release**

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - The California Can't Wait Coalition, including local public health officials, health equity advocates, county governments, and frontline workers, applauded the California State Senate's passage of AB 240, their sponsored bill with bipartisan support (39-0) to require a comprehensive assessment of our public health workforce and infrastructure.

"Californians now know that public health saves lives. Preparing for the next threat will require a clear assessment of workforce and infrastructure gaps that have emerged over decades of disinvestment," said Michelle

Gibbons, Executive Director of the County Health Executives Association of California. "AB 240 will provide a roadmap for California to ensure local health departments have the workforce and infrastructure to protect the state against public health threats and deliver and achieve health equity."

"SEIU members had a front-row seat to how quickly the COVID-19 pandemic overran our threadbare public infrastructure and how longstanding inequalities left communities of color predisposed for the worst outcomes," said Dr. Kelly Zhou, Nurse Anesthesiologist, LAC USC and member of SEIU Local 721. "We simply can't wait for the next crisis to invest in our public health system.

AB 240 is a simple bill to allow California to study the long-term needs of local public health agencies so that California never again experiences such suffering and inequity in sickness and death. SEIU members are proud to support this essential bill."

"Californians face an unprecedented series of overlapping public health crises - viruses such as COVID and monkeypox as well as societal conditions such as poverty and racism," said Harold Goldstein, Executive Director of Public Health Advocates. "The state senate has consistently supported legislation to help public health officers address multiple threats and they deserve our thanks." ★

(home, business and agricultural) within park district boundaries. The rate is \$19 per year, for each \$100,000 of assessed value. Remember, it's based on the County's assessment - not on market value. General Obligation Bonds are typically structured to be paid over 30 years."

**Q: If this Measure is critical, how is CRPD managing without it?**

**Carroll:** "Not easily. We prioritize improvements according to urgency. Our incredibly skilled staff has managed to complete critical projects in-house. They've accomplished roof repairs, HVAC replacements and retaining wall construction, saving many thousands of dollars in outside contractor costs. Community partners such as Carmichael Parks Foundation have fundraised energetically. Service Clubs, neighborhood groups and individual donors have been generous."

**Q: Nobody likes new taxes. Why should we vote for this one?**

**Carroll:** "Parks are good for everyone. They improve our wellbeing. They

increase the value of homes. General Obligation Bonds have safeguards. Money must be spent locally. A citizen's oversight committee ensures these taxpayer dollars are spent appropriately."

**Q: How are you campaigning for community approval?**

**Carroll:** Measure G committee members reach out at every opportunity. We're at food truck events and concerts. We meet with business groups; service clubs; veterans; neighborhood meetings - we'll talk to anyone who's interested - just ask us. We use social media, fliers, mailers and word of mouth. At a recent farmers market, 67 people offered names to publicly endorse Measure G. Another seven volunteered to help us promote it.

"We feel the community wants parks improved for future generations to enjoy. Our initiative is one of the last on the November ballot - we urge people to look for Measure G and vote yes."

# Health Care and Hospice Owner Sentenced for Conspiring to Defraud Medicare

**U.S. Attorney's Office, Eastern District of California**

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - U.S. District Judge Troy L. Nunley sentenced Liana Karapetyan, 42, of El Dorado Hills, on July 21, 2022 to 18 months in prison for one count of conspiracy to commit health care fraud and one count of conspiracy to pay and receive health care kickbacks, U.S. Attorney Phillip A. Talbert announced.

According to court documents, Karapetyan and her husband, Akop Atoyan, owned and controlled home health care and hospice agencies in the greater Sacramento area: ANG Health Care Inc., Excel Home Healthcare Inc., and Excel Hospice Inc. On behalf of the agencies, Karapetyan and Atoyan certified to Medicare that they would not pay kickbacks in exchange for Medicare beneficiary referrals to the agencies.

Despite their certifications, from at least July 2015 through April 2019, Karapetyan and Atoyan paid and directed others to pay kickbacks to multiple individuals for beneficiary referrals, including employees of health care facilities, as well as employees' spouses. The kickback recipients included John Eby, a registered nurse who worked for a hospital in Sacramento; Anita Vijay, the director of social services at a skilled nursing and assisted living facility in Sacramento; Jai Vijay, Anita Vijay's husband; and Mariela Panganiban, the director of social services at a skilled nursing facility in Roseville.

In total, Karapetyan, Atoyan, and others caused the agencies to submit over 8,000 claims to Medicare for the cost of home health care and hospice services. Based on those claims, Medicare paid the agencies approximately \$31 million. Of that amount, Medicare paid the agencies at least

\$2 million for services purportedly provided to beneficiaries referred in exchange for kickbacks paid to, among others, Eby, Anita Vijay, Jai Vijay, and Panganiban. Because the agencies obtained the beneficiary referrals by paying kickbacks, the agencies should not have received any Medicare reimbursement.

This case was the product of an

investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Department of Health and Human Services' Office of Inspector General. Assistant U.S. Attorney Matthew Thuesen prosecuted the case.

In separate cases, Atoyan, Eby, Jai Vijay, Anita Vijay, and Panganiban pleaded guilty for their roles in the kickback scheme. They await sentencing. ★

the lawyer? I'm guessing the reason you haven't gotten a real answer to your question is because you've actually been talking to some low-level staffer or paralegal. If you have been talking to the lawyer, there's a pretty good chance he's running a small debt collections or debt lawsuit machine. If this is the case, he probably gets a piece of whatever he collects. That means he's out to collect as much as possible, as quickly as he can.

You might consider changing tactics, and see if you can talk to the hospital administrator. Propose giving them \$2,000, or whatever reasonable amount you can afford, on the agreement that the hospital accept it as payment in full. Hospitals and doctor's offices are often some of the easiest folks to work with when it comes to paying off debt, but

people have to be proactive and make an honest, good faith effort to make it happen.

There's a moral, as well as legal, responsibility involved when it comes to paying off bills or debt, Ronnie. You should always pay what you owe if at all possible.

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - A veteran coach with a quarter century of experience mentoring student-athletes at all levels, Jon Wentte has been named as the pitching coach for the Sacramento State baseball program on August 9, Head Coach Reggie Christiansen announced.

“We are excited to have Jon join us as our new pitching coach,” Christiansen said. “Jon has a tremendous track record and has won at every step of his career. Our players and staff are excited to welcome him to Sacramento.”

A native of Cave Creek, Ariz., Wentte spent the last eight seasons as the pitching coach at a pair of Western Athletic Conference rivals, the last two at Grand Canyon following six years as the associate head coach, recruiting coordinator, and pitching coach at UT Arlington.

He also has experience as a head coach at Hutchison Community College in Kansas (2003-04), Odessa College in Texas (2005), and a nine-year run at Central Arizona College (2006-14), while also serving as an assistant for the Vaqueros following his

collegiate playing career.

“My family and I are grateful for this tremendous opportunity to coach at Sacramento State,” Wentte said. “Coach Christiansen and Coach (David) Flores have been great to work with throughout the entire process and I am very excited for the chance to work with and learn from some great pitchers.”

During his time as an assistant with the ‘Lopes and Mavericks, Wentte saw 11 of his student-athletes selected in the Major League Baseball first-year player draft - five of those at GCU and six more during his time on the staff at UTA - including five of those in the top 15 rounds.

Over the last two seasons, Wentte helped lead Grand Canyon to a combined 80-42-1 overall record and a 54-12 mark in Western Athletic Conference play, capturing the league tournament title in 2021 and lifting the ‘Lopes to a pair of NCAA regional berths. Last year, GCU broke into the top 25 for the final three weeks of the regular season and set a new program Division I record with 41 victories, while the pitching staff ranked No. 10 in the nation in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.00), No. 19 in walks allowed per nine innings (3.31), No. 27 in strikeouts per nine innings (9.9), and No. 36 in WHIP (1.38).

Individually, closer Vince Reilly was fifth in the NCAA with 14 saves while conference pitcher and freshman of the year Daniel Avitia ranked among the top 30 in both strikeouts (No. 28 with 111) and strikeouts per nine innings (No. 29 with 5.84).

In 2021, Wentte helped mentor a ‘Lopes pitching staff to a 3.98 ERA - the second-best mark in the program’s Division I history - and a 2.98 ERA in league games. For the year, Grand Canyon’s staff set program bests in saves (15), shutouts (seven), and opponent batting average (.247), while staff ace Pierson Ohl was named the program’s first Division I All-American and first WAC Pitcher of the Year.

Prior to his arrival in Phoenix, Wentte built a strong staff at UT Arlington, including a combined 2.42 team ERA in 2020 - a mark that ranked No. 18 nationally. The Mavericks also ranked No. 14 in the nation with 6.33 hits per nine innings that year and claimed a Sun Belt Conference Western Division title in 2017 with a staff that led the league in saves (18) and finished second in ERA (3.27).

After earning his first head coaching positions at Hutchinson CC and Odessa College, Wentte built an impressive resume at Central Arizona College as its head coach, leading the Vaqueros to six consecutive Region I championships, including 56 wins and a runner-up finish at the 2011 World Series and a third-place World Series finish in 2008.

In nine seasons with the Vaqueros, Wentte posted a 402-165 (.709) record and saw 28 of his players drafted by Major League clubs - including major leaguers Ian Kinsler, Scott Hairston, and Josh Spence - and holds a 513-226 (.696) mark overall in 11 seasons as a head coach. ★

# Taking Steps to Accelerate Home Construction

**Sac County News Release**

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors, at its Aug. 9 meeting, voted to approve amendments to the Sacramento County Zoning Code and Countywide Design Guidelines, in an effort to streamline housing approval and speed up building in specific areas of the Unincorporated County.

These amended Zoning Codes and Design Guidelines will make it easier for developers to build more multifamily homes, like apartments and duplexes, in areas of the Unincorporated County that could include south Sacramento, Fair Oaks, Arden Arcade, Foothill Farms, Vineyard, North Highlands, Rio Linda, Elverta and Antelope.

Additionally, the amendments also aim to cut down on the costs and amount of time it takes to have minor deviations from the county's development standard approved for

certain projects.

"We hope that these changes will especially help some of the Unincorporated County's lower-income, diverse communities," said Wendy Hartman, Principal Planner. "In some cases these changes could cut the cost to process a request from approximately \$14,000 to \$4,300 for a multifamily project, and cut the amount of time from ten months to three months."

Among the more substantial changes included in the amendment are: Reducing how far smaller multifamily projects have to be set back from an abutting single-family home with a minor special development permit; and Allowing builders to construct more duplexes on small infill lots without needing additional approval.

# Investigation Underway for Homicide at Trade Wind and Fulton Avenues
