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Projects are Revving Up

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) -Small boys are rejoicing at the sight of 49-ton bulldozers and rock-laden trucks roaring into the American River near Fair Oaks. But big fish will be the real beneficiaries.

Started this month, a \$2 million project continues Sacramento Water Forum efforts to restore breeding habitats for vulnerable fish species. More than 42,000 cubic yards of gravel are being added to Lower Sailor Bar and Nimbus Basin locations. The program is geared to help Chinook salmon and steelhead repopulation.

Human river alterations have threatened these species since the Gold Rush. More recently, dam construction blocked spawning paths and barred natural gravel movement. "The lower part of the American River is gravel-starved," explains Water Forum Habitat Manager Erica

Bishop. "Some salmon and steelhead return to home waters and can't find a place to spawn. "Though the Nimbus Hatchery has a role in juvenile fish production, the Water Forum's focus is to help adult salmonids complete life cycles naturally."

Current projects must be finished before salmon surge home in fall. After the Chinook giants, steelhead will nest in the same areas. "Our work is targeted over time frames least likely to affect migrating fish," says Bishop. "And although the ongoing drought can make their conditions challenging, we focus on long-term river improvement."

Steelhead and salmon once swam from the Pacific Ocean via 200 miles of breeding sites. More than 150 years of human development have reduced options to about 12 miles. "Fish can't build nests among boulders," notes Bishop. "They need moveable gravel." To this end, the program includes mechanical

selection of many tons of small-diameter stones. Nursery channels will also be built to shelter hatchlings before their Pacific migration.

Similar restorations above Sailor Bar accommodated 1000 new Chinook nests in 2019. New gravel beds at Ancil Hoffman Park last year supplied 30 percent of all American River steelhead breeding. "Results are immediate," notes Bishop. "We see salmon beginning to spawn as we finish our projects. We know our restored habitats work."

Sailor Bar and Nimbus projects will wrap by early October. Staging areas are fenced during construction but river access is not restricted. Work will pause to enable weekend and Labor Day recreation.

County's New **Inspector** General **Appointed**

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously today to approve Francine Tournour as the new Inspector General for Sacramento County. Tournour will begin serving in that role on Sept. 1, 2022.

"Following a nationwide recruitment, we're pleased to announce Francine Tournour was selected as the best and most qualified candidate," said Board Chair and District Five Supervisor Don Nottoli. "We look forward to welcoming Ms. Tournour and her work in providing independent review and accountability in her role as Inspector General."

Two collaborative interview panels were convened for the Inspector General search, whose members included the Chair of the board, the Sheriff, representatives from both the Enforcement Management Association and the Deputy Sheriff's Association, and members from the Community Review Commission.

Tournour began her career in law enforcement as a Deputy Sheriff in Contra Costa County, where she quickly gained an appreciation for the complex field of law enforcement. After working in law enforcement for a brief period, she began working for the City of Sacramento as a Deputy Director for the Office of Public Safety Accountability.

In 2008, she was promoted to the Director role of that office, where she was responsible for conducting all complex and sensitive investigations for the City's 1,300 employees.

Tournour has bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from Madonna University and a master's degree in **Emergency Management** from California State University, Long Beach.

The Office of Inspector General was created to facilitate the Board of Supervisors' responsibility to oversee without interfering with the Sheriff's investigative or personnel deployment functions.

The Inspector General ensures the integrity of the citizen complaint process and the thoroughness and fairness of related Sheriff's Office investigations, while fostering positive relations with the community. The Community Review Commission

Reducing Homeless Deaths in Sac County

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - In Sacramento County, 2021 was an unprecedented year for loss of life in this region. The Sacramento County Coroner had more overall deaths reported to their office than any other year in history -8,677 deaths reported. Sacramento County similarly saw an increase in the deaths of its unhoused population.

NOTE: The Coroner's Office does not receive a report of every county resident's death. For example, deaths signed off by a supervising doctor are not reported to the Coroner. Additionally, natural deaths occurring in a hospital or medical facility and/or under a hospice physician's care are not coroner cases which require a coroner death investigation.

The Coroner releases a report every year of the deaths, causes and some

demographics for people experiencing homelessness at the time of death. In 2021, 199 deaths were reported to the coroner's office that were investigated and determined to be people who were experiencing homeless. While this is an increase from the years prior, it is not the same incremental increase as the overall increase in the homeless population, based on the most recent point in time count.

The causes of death among the unhoused population vary, but overwhelmingly, the causes are unnatural - death by substance use, vehicular or homicide. Decedents were overwhelmingly male, and there was a disproportionate number of black and Hispanic deaths compared to the overall homeless population demographics.

Substance abuse continues to be the leader in untimely deaths of the unhoused population at nearly half of all deaths in

2021, as compared to just 3 percent of the overall county population. Sacramento County continues to invest in existing and new programs to help

meet the needs of the homeless population. The County is investing \$181 million annually on current and new programs, and services and to mitigate the impacts of homelessness. Not only does the County fund 1,300 indoor shelter beds on any given night, but continues to fund new and diversified programs such as:

Increasing the offerings in 2022/23 to those experiencing behavioral health, both mental health and substance abuse, crises:

\$10 million to procure an additional 156 beds for Substance Use Disorder residential treatment;

\$5 million for behavioral health crisis stabilization

units required in Medi-Cal; \$7.5 million in Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funds and federal

match for additional Full

Service Partnerships;

The County has approved two new-concept locations for Safe Stay Communities, adding another 165 indoor beds that provide privacy, dignity and a place for people to receive services to end their homelessness;

The County added 11 new behavioral health staff to the Encampment Service Teams to connect people to mental health and substance abuse services; Allocated \$1 million in the 2022/23 budget to expand the scattered site sheltering program;

Allocated \$10 million in ARPA funding for a Landlord Engagement and Assistance Program (LEAP), which will fund re-housing of 300+ households from shelters and encampments;

Allocated \$28 million in MHSA funding since 2017 through the MHSA Housing Program and No Place Like Home Program;

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El Camino Dominates Cordova in Shutout Win

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The first two weeks of the 2022 high school sports season have not been kind to the Cordova varsity football team.

The Lancers (0-2) lost their first game of the season by 34 points at home to Bella Vista on August 19. Given the lopsided loss, one would think there's nowhere to go but up for Cordova, right? Wrong!

Even with an extra day of rest before their next game, things somehow got worse for the Lancers. Cordova lost on the road at El Camino (2-0) by a score of 41-0 on Saturday night. Through two games under interim head coach and alumnus Kyle Williams, the Lancers have

been outscored 89-14.

Cordova senior quarterback Kevin Lewis completed only 1-of-5 passing attempts for seven yards. His one completion went to junior Ruvim Kravchuk. Lewis, who is a dual-threat QB, had much more success on the ground, rushing 15 times for 114 yards (7.6 average).

Lewis has been the one bright spot for the Lancers so far this season. The 5-foot-10 senior also plays defensive back and was tied for a team-high in tackles with seven. Junior Aleksey Medvedeva also had seven total tackles. Four other Cordova players had five tackles each.

One of those four is defensive end, Michael Brown. The 6-foot-4, 188-pound junior also had two quarterback hurries. Stats from the Eagles' offensive explosion were not made available by press time.

The Lancers will attempt to rebound from the back-to-back losses when they play at Rio Linda (1-1) on Friday. El Camino will go on the road for the first time this season and play at Foothill. Kickoff for both games is scheduled for 7 p.m. ★



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


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Final Recommended Budget **Hearings Begin September 7**

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors will begin Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 Revised Recommended Budget hearings on Wednesday, Sept. 7, at 9:30 a.m. in the Sacramento County Administration Building located at 700 H Street, Sacramento, 95814. If necessary, hearings will continue on Sept. 8 and 9 at the same time and location.

The hearing schedule, in order:

IHSS Public Authority Budget Deliberation and Approval; Introduction by the County Executive to the FY 2022-23 Revised Recommended Budget; Public Comment; Board Deliberation and Approval to Revisions of the Approved Recommended Budget

The numbers in the recommended budget change between June and September when the County receives new information, including the impact of the State Budget and updated revenue totals. Because of that new information, the Revised Recommended Budget comes back to the Board for review and adoption in September.

The Board of Supervisors approved the FY 2022-23 Recommended Budget on June 9. The \$7.3 billion spending plan reflected substantial investments in new and enhanced programs based on the Board's priorities and a survey of Sacramento residents. The budget included annual commitments of an additional \$6.5 million to fund new programs and services addressing homelessness in the County; \$10 million to procure an additional 156 beds annually for substance use disorder residential treatment; \$7.5 million in Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) and Federal matching funds to fulfill permanent supportive housing commitments; and \$20 million in one-time costs to fund pavement maintenance and road rehabilitation in the unincorporated County, among others.

Members of the public may attend the hearings and be heard on any item in the budget, either publicly, over the phone or through written comments. The budget hearings will also be telecast live on Metro Cable 14 and on sccob.saccounty.gov/ Pages/BOSPublicMeetings.aspx.

Art Going to the Dogs

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - It takes more than a year to prepare a dog to partner a veteran with post-traumatic stress or to work with an autistic child.

Carmichael breeder and trainer Jan Lopez – who began the nonprofit Breeding Education Service and Training for service dogs six years ago – estimates \$25,000 is needed for the process. Expenses mount beyond the cost of the puppy itself: specialized training, food, vet bills and health clearances add up.

A September 25 fundraiser will support Lopez's operation. Guests at her open house will meet canines in training and be offered a chance to bid on art. Paintings by famed Carmichael painter Earl Boley are among auction items. Other artists include Helen Plenert, S.R. Jones, Susan Leith, Grey Lux, Euan Rannachan and Gabriel Teague. The event will be staged on Lopez's ranch-style Carmichael property.

Lopez's Labrador Retrievers (a favored breed for service training) have been placed with national agencies like Paws for Purple Hearts, Joyful Paws Service Dogs and Good Dog Service Canines. "You can't have service dogs without puppies," she says. "My puppies go to

experienced groups that provide dogs for people who desperately need them.

"One of my dogs is in Connecticut; others are in Detroit, San Antonio, Nebraska and New York. These are all good Carmichael dogs – but they go to work where they are needed."

Training starts with basic obedience skills and works towards public access. "This includes trips to stores, restaurants, parks," she says. "They train anywhere where their eventual partners might want to take them."

When dog-lovers see a trainer and student out shopping, they are gently reminded that a working team should not be distracted. "It's understandable people want to approach them," says the trainer. "But they need to do their work. Service dogs will eventually be paired with people who want to lead normal lives."

Her breeding operation produces one or two litters per year and puppies are placed with service agencies at about nine weeks old. "It's tough to part with a puppy you've raised with love," says Lopez. But it's my philosophy to be happy. They're going somewhere they'll be loved. They'll change someone's life for the better."

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Sushi Spot Celebrates 20th

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - With high hopes, Camon Lee opened a sushi restaurant 20 years ago.

The son of Chinese immigrants saw a hot trend and decided Japanese cuisine was a cool way to go. "Californians are health conscious and aware of how they look," Camon explains. "People don't always want to fill their stomachs up. Something told me sushi would succeed."

It did. After several years learning the ropes in other sushi establishments, Lee located his Silver Sake restaurant in the Marconi & Walnut Center, Carmichael. Several busy years later, the entrepreneur expanded from one rented space to two. Customers became regulars. Regulars came to claim the same seats for each visit; sitting shoulder-to-shoulder and greeting fellow diners by name. "It's like 'Cheers' in here, every night," beams the owner.

Surviving the pandemic without laying off staff, the father of two considers himself "fortunate to still have a business." Loyal customers adopted

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
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
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Time to **Get Serious**


the wants from the needs.





California has a lot of problems and not all of them are directly taxpayer related. But, as noted in last week's column, they all interconnect in one important way: Control. Our state's government and its boosters think they know better than you. They know better how to spend your money. They know better how to use your land. They know what's best for you. And, if you disagree, the nanny state

will just make it illegal. Look no further than Proposition 31 on this November's ballot. It's a referendum on Senate Bill 793, the state's total ban on the sale of flavored tobacco products. SB 793 was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the governor in 2020. It prohibits "a tobacco retailer, or any of the tobacco retailer's agents or employees, from selling, offering for sale, or possessing with the intent to sell or offer for sale, a flavored tobacco product or a tobacco product flavor enhancer" and

imposes a fine of \$250 for on smoking. Only the fear each violation of the ban.

Although the law bans the sale of flavored tobacco products to all customers regardless of age, lawmakers named it the "Stop Tobacco Access to Kids Enforcement Act." They claimed it was needed to stop underage tobacco use because only kids, apparently, like flavor. To be sure, no one wants children smoking or vaping, but it's already illegal in California to sell or give tobacco and vapor products to anyone under the age of 21. If prohibition worked, then we wouldn't have a problem.

It's also immensely hypocritical. At the same time California is lowering taxes on marijuana and debating bills in the Legislature to decriminalize psychedelic drugs, it is placing bans on menthol cigarettes, flavored smokeless tobacco, and other flavored nicotine vaping products that don't even contain tobacco. Those non-tobacco vaping products, mind you, were determined by an "expert independent evidence review" published by England's public health agency to be "95% safer" than smoking.

Plus, Californians are smart enough to make this decision for themselves. Our state already has one of the lowest smoking rates in the country. In fact, California has lower cigarette use among adults than any state other than Utah - where the state's predominant religion frowns

of God can get you to smoke less than we do in California.

Youth vaping was down 59% before the ban and youth smoking rates are at 1.9% – an all-time low.

Also, while the issue, as I stated, isn't directly taxpayer related (and why HJTA hasn't taken a formal position on the proposition), a legislative analysis of a ban on these products found that it would lead to "significant revenue losses" (revenue is government-speak for tax money) that will exceed \$1 billion in the next four years. I'm sure the Legislature won't take that sitting down and will try to find more "revenue" in higher taxes elsewhere.

It's all about control and it's why voters should just say no to Proposition 31.

Why no? Because this measure is a referendum. which is one of the direct democracy powers that Californians have had since 1911, along with the power of initiative and recall. A referendum empowers voters to approve or reject at the polls any act or section or part of any act of the Legislature.

On Proposition 31, California voters will be deciding whether to approve ("yes") or reject ("no") the law that bans flavored tobacco products.

I'll be voting no – and I don't even smoke.

"We're a disciplined bunch, we showed up and we got after it from the beginning," Indians coach Will Claggett told MPG after the win. "We had a point to prove, we wanted to be 2-0 and we came out and we played like it."

Rio's first drive of the game was productive, marching down into Marysville territory. However, a costly interception by freshman quarterback Frankie Cervantes ended the Raiders' first offensive possession.

The Indians capitalized almost immediately, as senior running back Danny Lanini broke away for an 86-yard rush down the left sideline to reach the red zone. Marysville finished off the drive on the ground from four yards out, but missed the PAT, leaving the score 6-0 early.

Another timely turnover concluded Rio's second drive. Junior running back Charles Hausman fumbled and had it scooped up by Indians senior linebacker Maddox Marino.

"That's one thing that this group does a really good job of, we're very opportunistic," Claggett said about his team capitalizing on the Raiders' early turnovers. "When we have the chance to score, we usually do it. If we can keep playing like that, we got a chance to be pretty special this year."

Marysville scored its second touchdown of the night on a six-yard rush from Lanini. The Raiders then responded with their first score of the night, as

Hausman scored the five-yard rushing TD. The junior also successfully converted the extra point attempt with his leg, making the score 13-7 in the second quarter.

That's where things got rough for Rio, as the Indians scored three unanswered touchdowns to take a 27-point lead early in the second half. The first score came through the air, as senior wide receiver Trishton Henderson made an over-the-shoulder 16-yard catch in the right corner of the end zone.

The next score came via the defense, as senior Kayden Ellyson made an interception and ran it back 34-yards into the end zone. The third and final score came on the ground, as senior running back Joseph Endicott ran it in. The Raiders would not go away quietly though.

Hausman continued to redeem himself from the early fumble, scoring his second rushing TD of the night after dashing 30-yards down the left sideline in front of the Raiders faithful. Hausman's extra point kick was blocked, leaving the score 34-13 just over two minutes in the third quarter.

The Indians' first turnover of the game proved to be un-costly. Marysville fumbled deep in their own territory, but Rio was unable to capitalize, turning the ball over on downs. The third period ended with another Indians rushing TD as Endicott scampered in for another score.

"Endicott got rocked early in the game, was out for about a quarter, and came back and just ran all over the field," Claggett said. "He just showed a lot of toughness and competed his butt off."

Raiders freshman wideout Robert Hamel scored a 43-yard touchdown with 9:41 remaining to make the score more respectable. Lanini scored Marysville's final points of the night with a pick six in the fourth, returning it 53 yards for the TD.

Rio's final score came on another long TD reception from Hamel, this time from 35 yards out. The Raiders also success-

conversion attempt.

Things got chippy down the stretch, as a Rio player blindsided Lanini on one play late in the game once the outcome was decided. However, tempers quickly settled, and the Indians prevailed in dominant fashion, winning 48-27.

Lanini and Endicott were a dynamic duo on the ground, running all over the Raiders. Lanini carried the ball eight times for 156 yards (19.5 average) and one TD. Endicott rushed 17 times for 167 yards (9.8 AVG) and two scores.

"Joseph Endicott got hurt very early and it kind of messed me up, I was like, 'noooo' (because) he's one of my boys," Lanini said. "Seeing him get hurt, (I thought) I gotta ball out for him. And then he came back, and I was like, 'Oh we're both balling out together!'"

Ellyson was perfect under center, completing all three of his pass attempts for 44 yards and a TD. Lanini and Marino each had a strong night defensively, as Marino had a game-high nine tackles and Lanini had eight. Both players also had at least one tackle for loss and a forced turnover.

"I think my performance was pretty good," Lanini said. "I came out here and balled out. Last week I had a lot of good runs, but they got flagged and stuff, so I was like, 'Dude, I'm just going to go out here and run the ball as hard as I can and hopefully it's a good run.' A lot of my boys got a lot of hit stickers on their helmet and I only had a couple, so I wanted to get some hit stickers, so that was a motivator for me."

For Rio, Hausman ran the ball 17 times for 67 yards and two scores. Cervantes was 27-of-42 passing for 265 yards, one TD and three interceptions.

"It is interesting. We wanted to see where we were gonna be at after these first two games. So, sitting at 2-0 is a great spot," Claggett explained. "We have a gauntlet of a schedule these next three to four games. We came out of the first two games relatively unscathed and pretty healthy.

"These next few weeks are going to do a lot to determine what kind of football team we have and what kind of season we have. These next few weeks it's on, we have some really good competition. We're pretty sharp right now, we got areas to improve on and these next few weeks are pivotal for us as a team this year."

Marysville hosts East Nicolaus on Friday for their home opener. Rio will remain at home and play winless Woodland. ★
