"Lest We Forget"

"We have come to dedicate a portion of that field, as a final resting place for those who here gave their lives that that nation might live." – President Abraham Lincoln's Gettysburg Address, November 1863.

CHATTANOOGA, TN (MPG) - I cannot adequately describe my feelings as I entered the Chattanooga National Cemetery where I had come to pay my respects and dedicate this story to these veterans. It is located not too far from the heart of the city of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Visiting this cemetery, even if you had little or no understanding about the Civil War, you would come away with a new perspective on our nation's history, and aren't we supposed to have a grasp of history (both good and bad), before we are doomed to repeat it?

In 1863, General Order No. 296 was issued to create a national cemetery to commemorate the Battles of Chattanooga in November 1863. Major General George H. Thomas, known as "The Rock of Chickamauga," issued this order, but it was not until 1867 that the cemetery gained a national designation. In all, there are 155 national cemeteries in 42 states and Puerto Rico; to find out where they are in your travels, go to www.cem.va.gov, for more information.

Why should you visit the Chattanooga National Cemetery? When you arrive at the cemetery and proceed to the administrative building for information, you may talk with Kevin Ritchey of Facilities Maintenance, who has a wealth of knowledge about the park. Kevin is also a U.S. Army combat veteran. The cemetery has many qualified volunteers to answer your questions and offer directions (all the volunteers are veterans), so if you want to visit the grave of Desmond Doss (the subject of the movie *Hacksaw Ridge*), they can get you there. You can visit the grave of an individual who has the unique distinction of being the only person buried here from the American Revolution.

The Chattanooga National Cemetery is 120 acres in size, and there are more than 41,000 veterans and their dependents resting here. Some of the highlights of cemetery include the Memorial Circle of Honor that was established in 1992. You can easily recognize the location by the American flag sitting atop the hill where it is said that

General Ulysses S. Grant had his headquarters while the Battle of Chattanooga was fought nearby. The Circle honors those from our nation's conflicts, and organizations have erected memorials in recognition of the sacrifices that were made during the Vietnam War, Korean War, World War II

The first thing you see when you arrive is the Andrew's Raiders Monument. This monument is in honor of those individuals who aided the Union in the Civil War. The individuals honored here are among the first recipients of the Medal of Honor, our nation's highest military tribute "for conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity at the risk of life above and beyond the call of duty."

In addition to the individuals buried here from the Civil War, the cemetery also is the final resting place for German soldiers who were prisoners of war from World War I and World War II. Each November, the German government honors these soldiers with a laying of the wreath at the German monument.

The Chattanooga National Cemetery was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1996. As with historic places, one must take time to observe and "feel" the surroundings. For instance, every monument or memorial arch has a story, and usually there is an inscription, or plaque or headstone that tells why that warranted being placed in this cemetery of honor.

The Chattanooga National Cemetery is an inspirational place to visit. I found that there is so much more to discover through the veterans buried here. Charles H. Coolidge, who was one of the last surviving Medal of Honor recipients from World Warr II, is buried here. In fact, if you want to study up on Medal of Honor recipients, you can visit the Charles H. Coolidge National Medal of Honor Heritage Center right here in Chattanooga.

As I said, a visit to this cemetery is very enlightening and truly educational! The closest national cemetery we have to Sacramento is in Dixon at the Sacramento Valley National Cemetery. It is the seventh national cemetery built in California and the 124th in the national cemetery system. It's a visit worth the time. Thank you, veterans! ★

The CHP uses its canines to perform a variety of functions, including detecting human scent. contraband, and explosives. A canine team can improve the safety and effectiveness of officers as well as saving time and money. The CHP canines are also used to assist allied agencies in apprehending criminals, detecting explosives or drugs, and in locating "atrisk" missing persons.

This is the only graduation in 2021 for CHP canine teams trained in handler protection and narcotics detection or handler protection and explosive detection. The canine teams completed between 11 and 15 weeks of intensive training at the CHP Academy, depending on their specialty.



Beat a Cyberbully: Here's How Parents Can Help

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - While remote learning during the COVID-19 pandemic lowered reported instances of bullying, parents fear that, for some students, going back to school will mean going back to being bullied.

"Bullying is something we worry about, especially with the beginning of each new school year," said Zury Bourque of her family of four in Cypress, Texas.

Now 15 years after the inception of National **Bullying Prevention Month** in October, technology's ever-greater presence in children's lives has given bullying a new outlet. With just a click, cyberbullies can taunt, harass and threaten relentlessly, even reaching into the home via cellphone or computer. As a result, victims report feeling hopeless, isolated and even suicidal.

What can parents do to protect their kids? Taking an interest in their children's online world can make a difference, says the National Parent Teacher Association.

This interest does not necessarily require parents

to become tech experts. Instead, the federal stopbullying.gov site advises parents to watch for subtle clues that something is wrong, such as their child becoming withdrawn, hiding their screen when others are nearby or reacting emotionally to what is happening on their device.


For Zury Bourque and her husband Chris, that has meant being keenly aware of what "normal" looks like for their two boys, ages 12

"Knowing my children's moods is very important because I can then detect shifts or changes in their personalities that might signal something is going on," Chris said.

Talking with kids openly and often – helps too. "The more you talk to your children about bullying, the more comfortable they will be telling you if they see or experience it," UNICEF says in its online tips for parents.

As their two daughters enter their teens, Houston parents Thiago and Auboni Cordolino have found that talking less and listening more works best. "We try to focus on being approachable and listening actively without reaction," Thiago said.

Beyond talking, listening and observing their kids, parents should not be afraid to make and enforce rules for online activities, experts say.













Los Rios Colleges Awarded Major Federal Child Care Grants

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Three of the Los Rios colleges - American River College, Cosumnes River College and Sacramento City College - have been awarded federal grants to support child care and family services on campus. The multi-year grants will support a variety development centers.


The Cosumnes River College grant is \$150,000 a year for the next four years and will fund the development of the college's family resource and engagement center, the Nest. This program will support families so that:

Gavin's Gas Lawn Equipment Ban Hits the Little Guys

Gov. Gavin Newsom's signature on Assembly Bill 1346 makes one wonder whether California politicians ever fully understand – or even want to understand - the ramifications of their decisions.

The measure aims to eliminate the sales of gasoline-powered lawn equipment, such as mowers, string trimmers, leaf blowers and other devices, within a few years.

The purpose, it's said, is to eliminate the exhaust emissions from small engines that create smog and contribute to global warming.

The bill's author, Assemblyman Marc Berman, a Menlo Park Democrat, contends that "operating the best-selling, gas-powered commercial leaf blower for one hour emits air pollutants comparable to driving a 2017 Toyota Camry from Los Angeles to Denver. Smogforming emissions from small engines will surpass those from passenger vehicles this year."

One could add that the gas-powered lawn machines also emit jarring levels of

California Air Resources Board will decide how and devices will be prohibited three-person landscaping and it could be as early as 2024. A shift to battery-powered machines presumably would occur as older devices need replacement.

Tools powered by rechargeable batteries are fit their entire workshops to convenient, quiet and relatively inexpensive to operate sive change in voltage so and make perfect sense for the homeowner. Personally, I've used them almost exclusively for the past quarter century and wouldn't have it any other way.

That said, what's practical for personal use is not necessarily so for lawn care professionals, most of them single persons or small crews, and often immigrants. It's estimated that California has at least 50,000 such microbusinesses.

Mowing a lawn once a week is one thing, but pros do it a dozen or more times a day to keep their families housed and fed. They would have to not only buy the equipment but dozens of batteries and chargers and have the facilities, including sufficient electric power supplies, to recharge those batteries.

Backers of the legislation, a coalition of public health and environmental groups, would let the Air Resources Board figure out the details. There's the possibility of a \$30 million fund to help buy new equipment.

The arithmetic, however, indicates that the proposed conversion would cost much more than that, either borne by the lawn services or taxpayers.

The larger landscape companies that Bray represents could make the switch and adjust their fees accordingly. But how about the little guys?

A basic array of highquality, battery-powered lawn tools - a mower, a trimmer and a blower would cost at least \$1,000. Enough spare batteries and chargers would at least double the initial cost. So at a minimum, with 50,000 lawn services, the total cost would be \$100 million. The real world cost would likely be a quarter-billion dollars or

Even were the state willing to cover replacements, how about the infrastructure that small landscapers, operating out of their homes, would need to recharge their batteries? Would we be putting them through a daunting application process? Would the many undocumented landscapers submit the paperwork?

Newsom and the legislators who voted for this bill may think they are doing the right thing, but did they ever consider that they are messing with people's livelihoods and lives? Nothing in the bill indicates they did.

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Honorable Ernest Sawtelle sentenced Patricia Lane to 60 years to life in state prison. On August 19, 2021, a jury convicted Lane of four counts of child sexual assault and found true a multiple victim enhancement.

Lane sexually assaulted four young boys when they were between the ages of 4 and 11 years old. The victims were adults when they disclosed the sexual abuse. Their testimony was heart wrenching as were the victim impact statements made at sentencing.



Families Now Receiving October Child Tax Credit Payments

IRS Media Relations

WASHINGTON, D.C. (MPG) - The Internal Revenue Service and the Treasury Department announced that millions of American families are now receiving their advance Child Tax Credit (CTC) payment for the month of October.

This fourth batch of advance monthly payments, totaling about \$15 billion, is reaching about 36 million families today across the country. The majority of payments will be issued by direct deposit.

Under the American Rescue Plan, most eligible families received payments dated July 15, Aug. 13 and Sept. 15. Future payments are scheduled for Nov. 15 and Dec. 15. For these families, each payment is up to \$300 per month for each child under age 6 and up to \$250 per month for each child ages 6 through 17. The vast majority will be issued by direct

Here are more details on those payments:

- Families will see the direct deposit payments in their accounts starting Oct. 15. Like the prior payments, the vast majority of families will receive them by direct deposit.
- For those receiving payments by paper check, be sure to allow extra time. through the end of October, for delivery by mail. Those wishing to receive future payments by direct deposit can make

this change using the Child Tax Credit Update Portal, available only on IRS. gov. To access the portal or to get a new step-by-step guide for using it, visit IRS. gov/childtaxcredit2021.

- Payments went to eligible families who filed a 2019 or 2020 income tax return. Returns processed by Oct. 4 are reflected in these payments. This includes people who don't typically file a return but during 2020 successfully registered for Economic Impact Payments using the IRS Non-Filers tool on IRS.gov or in 2021 successfully used the Nonfiler Sign-up Tool for advance CTC, also available only on IRS.gov.
- Payments are automatic. Aside from filing a tax return, including a simplified return from the Non-filer Sign-up Tool, families don't have to do anything if they are eligible to receive monthly payments.
- Families who did not get a July, August or September payment and are getting their first monthly payment this month will still receive their total advance payment for the year. This means that the total payment will be spread over three months, rather than six, making each monthly payment larger.

The IRS is currently sending letters to some Americans reminding them it is not too late for families who haven't filed a 2020 income tax return - including those who are not normally required to file because their incomes are too low

- to sign up for advance CTC payments. new account or address). Most low-income families can get these monthly payments. The IRS urges families who normally aren't required to file a tax return to visit IRS.gov for more information on how to file a return and receive their credit.

Update on Sept. advance Child Tax Credit payments

In September, the IRS successfully delivered a third monthly round of approximately 36 million Child Tax Credit payments, totaling more than \$15 billion. Given the new components of this program, the IRS continues to work hard to make improvements and deliver payments timely.

After the September payment was issued, the IRS resolved a technical issue, which the agency estimates caused fewer than 2% of CTC recipients not to receive their September payment on the scheduled payment date. Payments have since gone out to affected individuals.

The impacted group primarily included taxpayers who recently made an update to their bank account or address information using the IRS Child Tax Credit Update Portal. In particular, the issue affected payments to married taxpayers filing jointly where only one spouse made a bank account or address change, which usually results in payments being split into two (between the existing account or address and the

In some of these cases, the split payment caused a delay in making payments, and further caused individuals to receive slightly more than the correct payment in September. To address this, the payment that each spouse receives in October, November and December will be reduced slightly to adjust for the overpayment. For each taxpayer receiving a payment, the typical overpayment was \$31.25 per child between 6 and 17 years old and \$37.50 per child under 6 years old. This will result in about a \$10 to \$13 reduction per child in the three remaining monthly payments.

The IRS will send letters to affected individuals with this information. The IRS continues to closely monitor this program and the agency appreciates the patience of those whose payments were

The IRS encourages partners and community groups to share information and use available online tools and toolkits to help non-filers, low-income families and other underserved groups sign up to receive these benefits.





SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) -On October 6, 2021, the California State Parks director Armando Quintero designated Francis Drake's 1579 California landing, Site of New Albion, as a California Historical Landmark, number 1061. This finalized the unanimous approval given by the seven-member State Historical Resources Commission in August 2020. Nominated by the Drake Navigators Guild, it had been presented to the Commission by historian State Historian William Burg and the State Historic Preservation Officer Drake Navigators Guild, a history research organization, is headquartered in Orangevale, California, with Steve Wright as

president. The landmark, located within the boundaries of Point Reves National Seashore at Drake's Cove, their journey to California in 1579. 
