

Free County Flu Clinics Going on Now

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - With flu season approaching, Sacramento County Public Health urges everyone to get a flu shot to protect themselves and their families from influenza. From Sept. 28 – Nov. 13, the Sacramento County Immunization Assistance Program will host free Adult and Family Flu Clinics throughout Sacramento County.

This year it is especially important to get a flu shot as COVID-19 continues to spread. In an effort to fight both viruses, all Public Health clinics will offer flu and COVID-19 vaccines, including at existing COVID-19 vaccine clinics. It is safe to receive flu and COVID-19 vaccines at the same time, according to the CDC.

'Vaccines are proven to reduce the risk of severe illness, hospitalization and death," said Sacramento County Public Health Officer Dr. Olivia Kasirye. "Those who cannot receive the vaccine, including infants and individuals with a compromised immune system such as those going through chemotherapy, rely on others being vaccinated to help protect them." All clinics take walkins, without the need for appointments.



As with COVID-19, it's crucial to practice good health habits:

If you feel flu-like symptoms, limit contact with others to keep from infecting them:

Stay home for at least 24 hours after you fever is gone, except to get medical care or for other necessities; Cover your coughs or sneezes and wash your hands; Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth; Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with flu germs.

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - September 9th marked the official opening of the new Heritage Oaks Patient Enrichment Center (HOPE Center), a standalone 16-bed psychiatric health facility located in Sacramento County and driven by the mission of providing mindful and caring services to our community members experiencing a behavioral health crisis. The new HOPE Center is located at 4378 Auburn Blvd.

"Our team of interdisciplinary doctors, nurses, clinicians and mental health technicians will collaborate in delivering recovery-oriented services and offer HOPE for a better tomorrow," said Mike Zauner, Group Director, Behavioral Health Division, Universal Health Services. "We HOPE to empower our patients with the skills needed to make choices that will reduce harm and enrich lives in a dignified and respectful environment where one can receive immediate, individualized care."

Dr. Ryan Quist, Director, Sacramento County Behavioral Health Services, stated, "We are excited to have the HOPE Center open in Sacramento County. This new facility will provide access to inpatient care for Medi-Cal beneficiaries experiencing significant psychiatric distress, who are often the most vulnerable, and it's important for them to have access to high-quality care. The Heritage Oaks Patient Enrichment Center

(HOPE Center) is an outgrowth of a well-established organization with a proven track record of serving the Sacramento region and helping countless people on their road to recovery."

Available 24/7, the new facility serves individuals 18 and older. Referrals to the HOPE Center are authorized through the Sacramento County Mental Health Treatment Center.

Several public figures and healthcare executives spoke at the event, including Rich Desmond, Sacramento County Supervisor, District-3, Dr. Ryan Quist, Director, Sacramento County Behavioral Health Services Division, Mike Zauner, Group Director, Universal Health Services, Melanie Nelson, Administrator, HOPE Center and Izzy DeLancy, Honorary Mayor of Carmichael, representing the Carmichael Chamber of Commerce. Cost-of-Living Crisis Continues to Drive Up California's Poverty Rate

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - According to data published by the U.S. Census Bureau, California continues to have the worst poverty rate among all states when adjusted to account for government programs designed to help low-income families and necessary expenses for critical goods and services.

"More people live in poverty in California than in any other state because of our high and rising costs of living. More than 16 percent of Americans living in poverty live in California, despite being home to just 12 percent of the population," said Rob Lapsley, president of the California Business Roundtable. "Driven by our housing and overall cost-of-living crisis, more Californians struggling to make ends meet are falling into poverty."

California's costadjusted poverty rate (2018-2020 average) was 15.4 percent, while 16.5 percent of all Americans living in poverty live in California. Rates among the other states ranged from 5.9 percent in Minnesota to 14.5 percent in Mississippi (16.5 percent in DC), with the US average at 11.2 percent and the average among all states other than California at 10.6 percent. For the first time, California residents paid more for electricity in March 2021 than the average for all other states in the nation. They also

continue to pay the highest gas taxes and prices in the country and for the ongoing housing crisis through increased housing costs. As tracked by the Center for Jobs and the Economy's Affordability Index, nearly all necessity costs for the average California family continue to increase.

"Unfortunately, it is likely that our poverty crisis will continue to get worse," Mr. Lapsley continued. "We are seeing a significant increase in inflation, which will drive costs up even higher. At the same time, a series of new and expensive energy mandates are being implemented, which will drive up the cost on home electricity, gasoline, goods and services, and housing. And let's not forget the more than \$200 billion in new and higher taxes introduced by the California Legislature in 2021 alone. Without prioritizing focus on affordability and honest discussion of the price Californians are paying for new and expensive regulations, fees and mandates, we will never address the growing poverty crisis in our state."

Continued from page 1 ran both ways. This last It states on the contract, February, during the horrible storm, the horse boarding shed's roof was blown off. Word got around and within a month a group of trucks pulled up with hammers, wood, drills and all things to replace that roof... FREE. "Just paying back the riding they'd received and still received", they told Zach. Now all that is over. Zach is still trying to come to grips with the sudden notice.

What happened to bring all this on you ask. Several weekends ago, a trail ride was going on when one of the horses spooked and jumped, the young girl fell off. Yes, she was hurt, thank God she had her helmet on,

a MUST when you ride. EVERYONE must sign before riding, saying you are riding a horse, an animal. There are six dotted paragraphs that state what you need to be specifically aware of. As Zach told me, "we have to carry a very large insurance policy to even operate the horseback riding we offer."

I am not here to say one way or the other, but there are many examples of private horse owners telling true tales of horse ownership and a horse's unpredictability. They tell of broken arms, of being thrown off their 'favorite horse', and always having to remember you are on a prey animal. When they

scare, they run, it is in their DNA. Everyone wishes a speedy recovery to the young birthday girl.

Everyone is still trying to understand, "why" the County was so fast to slap the Trail Brothers with an eviction notice. Zach told me his lawyer, Jonathan Saul and Associates are working hard to get a stay or hearing. "No one came out and talked to our veterinarian, just a call away, or our shoer, or to the veterans and their families that are really dreading this loss to the Elverta, Rio Linda, North Highlands and Antelope areas," Zach told me.

Lastly, I will be able to help the Trail Brothers out personally. I have an extra acre and offered it up to them should they need to have an emergency, temporary home. I was told they will be taking me up on the offer and bringing 10 horses they have to sell off, sooner than later. They would be over Monday to put up fences, water troughs and of course hay. It will only be for a short time. They are still hoping to take them back to Gibson Ranch and stay open for the community to enjoy. I will let you know how this turns out.

November. Fish that reach Nimbus unfulfilled will be lured by churning water. Piped from Lake Natoma, this torrent will fill a 150-yard flume that precedes the final climb. The channel is entirely caged to protect salmonids from poaching and debris; nearby riverbanks are permanently closed to anglers. The new ladder parallels a realigned bike trail that runs between Nimbus and Lake Natoma.

Hell-bent on reproduction, fish will encounter submerged barriers, a 10-foot deep pond and concrete steps. Visitor lookouts are positioned to enhance viewing. "We've wanted submerged windows for ages," says Nimbus interpretive specialist Stephanie Ambrosia. "It's a great way to show how fish group; how they rest between steps and the physiological changes that occur during their long journey from the ocean. Some have bones exposed and fins hanging off. These changes are more visible from underwater."

Some nature lovers might miss the autumn spectacle of massive Chinooks challenging the old hatchery weir. The barrier will nevertheless not be scrapped; its metal sections will remain in storage for emergency service. Heralding a new age of California State Hatchery efficiency, a 60-foot mural was last week completed on the facility grounds. San Francisco-based artist Max Erhman's canvas spans the walls of silos that store fish food near the visitor center. The work was funded by Wide Open Walls, a street art nonprofit supported Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission. Central to Erhman's design, a steelhead bursts from the river to symbolize nature's leap of faith to the future.

Nimbus Hatchery is located at 2001 Nimbus Rd, Gold River. Facility parking is open and the completed fish ladder may be viewed from walking trails. The Salmon and steelhead spawning season runs from November to March. For more information, visit: www.wildlife.ca.gov/ fishing/hatcheries/nimbus. *



Biden Proposal Could Benefit Free County Flu Clinics Going on Now **High-income Californians**

Congress is tied up in knots over the scope and financing of President Joe Biden's \$3.5 trillion basket of enhanced social, educational and medical benefits.

Although Democrats control – on paper – both houses, their majorities are paper-thin and their leaders are being buffeted by competing demands from the White House, their party's left wing and moderates whose votes are needed for any final product.

As the nation's most populous state, California obviously has a major stake in what the ultimate package will contain, if there is one. But the state has the most affected states another, less obvious stake howled, claiming that in how it's financed because of something called SALT.

It stands for "state and local taxes" and four years ago, a Republicancontrolled Congress and GOP President Donald Trump, as part of a major tax overhaul, imposed a \$10,000 limit on how much SALT could be deducted on personal income tax forms.

In a tradeoff, the 2017 tax legislation doubled the standard deduction. The two actions had the effect of increasing federal taxes on high-income residents of high-tax states such as California while lowering Majority Leader Charles California newspapers. *

the federal bite on low- and Schumer of New York middle-income taxpayers. A 2018 state study found that it cost high-income Californians an extra \$12 billion a year in federal taxes.

Tax Foundation, which analyzed federal income tax data from 2018 returns county-by-county, reported recently that the SALT limitation had its greatest impact on taxpayers in highincome counties in high-tax states such as California, New York, Maryland and Virginia.

In California, that meant San Francisco and other Bay Area communities such as Marin, San Mateo and Santa Clara counties. In Santa Clara, for instance, the average tax return with itemized deductions reported outlays of \$46,817.53 in state and local taxes, but could deduct just \$8,931.28 due to the SALT limit.

When the SALT limit was enacted, leaders of Republicans were punishing them because of their Democrat-leaning politics. New York Gov. Andrew Cuomo complained the loudest, worrying aloud that the SALT limit would encourage the rich to relocate to low-tax states such as Florida and Texas.

There's no evidence, at least yet, of a massive outmigration of high-income Californians, although there have been specific moves, such as Tesla's Elon Musk to Texas, which has no journalist for nearly 60 income tax.

and House Speaker Nancy Pelosi of California have been trying ever since 2017 to undo the SALT limit, and California Gov. Gavin Newsom has publicly sup-The Washington-based ported repeal. That's why California has a big stake in how Biden's "human infrastructure" package would be financed.

> The White House wants an array of tax increases on corporations and highincome taxpayers and SALT ceiling foes see it has an opportunity to undo it.

> But how? Politically, it's a tricky issue for Democrats, who want to change the limit without appearing to provide a windfall to the wealthy.

> Wealth Putnam Management has published a monologue on the potential ways the SALT limit could be modified or repealed, one of which would place an income limit on restoring deductibility so that those with the highest incomes would not benefit. Other alternatives include doubling or tripling the limit or changing the Alternative Minimum Tax.

The situation is another reminder that there is no right or wrong when it comes to tax policy at any level of government. What is taxed – whether income, sales or property - and at what level are purely arbitrary decisions that reflect the politics of the moment, not the higher moral purpose that politicians often claim.

Society for the Blind in Sac Receives \$10K to Teach Braille

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Society for the Blind recently received \$10,000 from Golden 1 Credit Union to provide Braille literacy for children in Sacramento and across Northern California who are blind or have vision loss.

"Today, less than 10 percent of children with vision loss are literate," said Shari Roeseler, executive director, Society for the Blind. "They are not learning Braille and are unable to read, write and comprehend. By third grade they are significantly behind their sighted peers, and 50 percent of high school students who are blind drop out before graduating. Literacy is key to improving academic outcomes and pointing these children toward college and careers. We are grateful to Golden 1 Credit Union for helping us fill this gap so children with vision loss can be successful and independent when they grow up."

The grant will allow Society for the Blind to provide Braille literacy classes, instruction materials and training in assistive devices for up to 100 new children who are blind or have low vision in elementary through high schools across the region. Through Society for the Blind's After-School Academy for children from first grade through high school, students will learn Grade 1 Braille, including the alphabet, spelling, numbers, reading and writing. 


