## Bill Signed to Crack Down on Street Racing and Illegal Sideshows

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - On Monday, September 19, Gov. Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill (AB) 2000, which will prohibit street racing and sideshows from occurring in parking lots across the state.

The bipartisan measure, authored by Assemblymember Jesse Gabriel (D - Woodland Hills), aims to crack down on dangerous driving – including street racing, "sideshows," and street takeovers – which continue to cause injuries and fatalities across California.

"Far too frequently, street racing and illegal sideshows devastate families, harm innocent bystanders, and cut short young lives," said Assemblymember Jesse Gabriel. "Communities in the San Fernando Valley and across California are sick and tired of this reckless behavior. I'm grateful for Governor Newsom's leadership on cracking down on this dangerous activity and signing this commonsense measure that will save lives across our state."

"AB 2000 will help us save lives and prevent further crashes and drivers going to prison for manslaughter," said Lili Trujillo, Founder and Executive Director of Street Racing Kills, a non-profit created in 2014 after Trujillo's 16-year-old daughter, Valentina, was killed in a street racing incident. "An exhibition of speed in a parking lot is way too common now and people are being hurt and killed, AB 2000 is definitely a great tool to help us save lives."

"There are countless stories every week throughout California about illegal street races and dangerous sideshows shutting down streets, causing accidents, damaging neighborhoods, and endangering lives," said Assemblymember Vince Fong (R - Kern County), a joint author of the measure. "They are unpredictable, destructive, and can lead to senseless deaths that devastate families. AB 2000 is an important and needed step in cracking down on illegal sideshows to make our communities safer."

Across the state, COVID-19 has caused a sharp rise in illegal street racing activity as drivers took advantage of roads emptied by stay-at-home

## Training Residents to Help in Emergencies

### Rotary Club of Rancho Cordova

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - Recently, the Rotary Club of Rancho Cordova in partnership with UC Davis Medical Center hosted two free "Stop the Bleed, Save a Life" training courses in the City of Rancho Cordova.

The American College of Surgeons Stop the Bleed is a grassroots national awareness campaign and call-to-action to encourage bystanders to become trained, equipped and empowered to help in an emergency before professional help arrives. Over 2.1 million people worldwide have been trained through the program on how to stop bleeding in a severely injured person.

Rotarian Walt Little heard about the Stop the Bleed campaign and brought it to the Rotary Club as a suggestion of how to serve the Rancho Cordova community. He worked with Dr.

David Shatz to arrange the training logistics, materials and aids.

"With a background

that includes medical and trauma response training, I discovered that 'panic' plays a significant role in

most major medical emergencies. Even the simplest task can be overwhelming if you don't know what to do," said Little. "Soon after the Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting, I was introduced to the Stop the Bleed program and realized the value in its simplicity. Opportunity has led me to the decision to promote and train anyone who will listen. The ability to overcome panic and stop the bleeding to potentially save someone's life is invaluable."

The first training course was a train-the-trainer for individuals to become certified to teach the community. Fourteen representatives from the Rancho Cordova Police Department, Sacramento Police Department, Sacramento VA Medical Center, Emergency Medical Services Authority, American River Bike Patrol, and Rotary Club became certified trainers.

# 2022 Election Candidates Speak at Forum

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - The Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce gave 2022 Election candidates a platform to address community members and leaders at the monthly luncheon on September 16, 2022.

Rancho Cordova City Councilmembers Garrett Gatewood and Vice Mayor Linda Budge are sitting councilmembers, and Sheikh Zulkader, a California Independent Systems Operator IT specialist, is also vying for a seat in the Council.

Speaking for the Sacramento County Supervisor race in District 5 is Elk Grove Councilmember Pat Hume, a native of Elk Grove who graduated from Jesuit High School and has been serving the community in various functions and diverse nonprofits for 16 years. Also running in this race is Jaclyn Moreno, who is in the Cosumnes Community Services Division 2 District Board of Directors, and also the business owner of CARE Educational Services.

In the FCUSD Board of Education race were incumbent District 5 Board Member Ed Short and candidate Jennifer Laret, a Volunteer of the Year Award recipient who is currently the Vice President of A4 Promotions & Incentives.

FCUSD Board Member Ed Short said, "I have been holding office since the time Rancho Cordova underwent the cityhood process in 2003. And, at that time many encouraged me to run for office. I have since then been FCUSD Board of Education president 3 times. And in my time on the FCUSD Board of Education we've constructed a new theater, upgraded the football facilities and promoted a STEM curriculum among many other projects."

"I don't have a political bone to pick," said Short, "I just want FCUSD students to have the best education."

FCUSD Board candidate Jennifer Laret said, "I have lived in Rancho Cordova for 20 years, and it's been an amazing place to live with my family of 4 children. But I would not agree that to learn in Rancho Cordova is very amazing," she said.

"The bonds are not working because Rancho Cordova is not a priority at FCUSD. Instead, our schools have deteriorating facilities, and our student test scores are declining," Laret said.

She finished saying, "Our students see that their peers in Folsom have access to brand new school facilities. I want to be the voice for them and their parents."

The Sacramento County Supervisor race was launched after Supervisor Don Nottoli announced that he would not run for re-election in District 5 after seven terms.

Jaclyn Moreno is one of the Sacramento County Supervisor candidates for District 5. She is the Cosumnes Community Services Division 2 District Board of Director and the

businessowner of CARE Educational Services.

As an Elk Grove resident, Moreno said, "This race is really about two things: values and experience. I am the Pro-Choice candidate in this race, which is significant in the wake of the recent Dobbs decision; and I am a climate champion." Moreno helped in the creation of her district's first Climate Action Plan.

The other important aspect in this election, according to Moreno, is experience.

Moreno opened a small business 9 years ago in the field of mental health which now employs 25 workers. As a small business owner, she said she understands the day to day needs of the business community. Along with that, she said her professional expertise as a school psychologist has given her a unique perspective relevant to the growing homelessness in the County.

Also running for the vacant Supervisor seat left by the retiring Nottoli is Elk Grove

Councilmember Pat Hume.

The councilmember said he has a broad coalition of supporters from nonprofits, local organizations, service clubs, government agencies, the business community and law organizations.

Hume said, "It is atrocious that crimes are going unpunished by authorities and leaders who turn a blind eye to it." His approach is to take back the streets from lawlessness and get back to the basics of serving constituents.

The County's priority should be to ask you: "How can I help you get what you need?"

After being overwhelmingly re-elected to City Council four times since 2006, he said, "I still have a little gas in the tank, and I hope you vote for me."

Current Vice Mayor, Linda Budge, runs this year to retain her seat in the City Council. She has been involved in many aspects of Rancho Cordova life for more than 40 years, including the Chamber of Commerce and as a Volunteer of the Year. She

has since incorporation in 2003 served in the City Council and wishes to continue working for Rancho Cordova.

She was proud to report, "We are building homes for everyone who wants to live here. Three new shopping centers are underway, bringing new retail and a grocery store. A senior residence and low-income housing are underway, and we intend to expand Mather Veterans Village."

Councilmember Garrett Gatewood is also running to retain his seat in the City Council. He projected the City's current trends and stated:

"Over the next four years," he said, "I hope to bring a new high school to Rancho Cordova to meet the demand of our growing community. I want to spur job growth and economic development through investing in technology and infrastructure and attract new businesses. We must continue to build homes and remain the most business-friendly city in Sacramento County."

New to the City Council race this November is Sheikh Zulkader, who has degrees in the field of Electrical and Computer Engineering, an MBA and is currently earning his Ph.D. in Leadership Studies. He has been living in Rancho Cordova with his family for 17 years.

Zulkader said education is the chief way to improve the lives of residents and places a very high value on schools and their ratings. Many parents and students in Rancho Cordova, including his family, have had to confront the tough reality that Folsom schools provide better education and have better ratings.

He said, "[He] would like to make his first task at City Council the establishment of middle and high schools in the south side of Highway 50 and improve the ratings of existing schools in Rancho Cordova." ★

## Re-Elect Assemblyman Ken Cooley



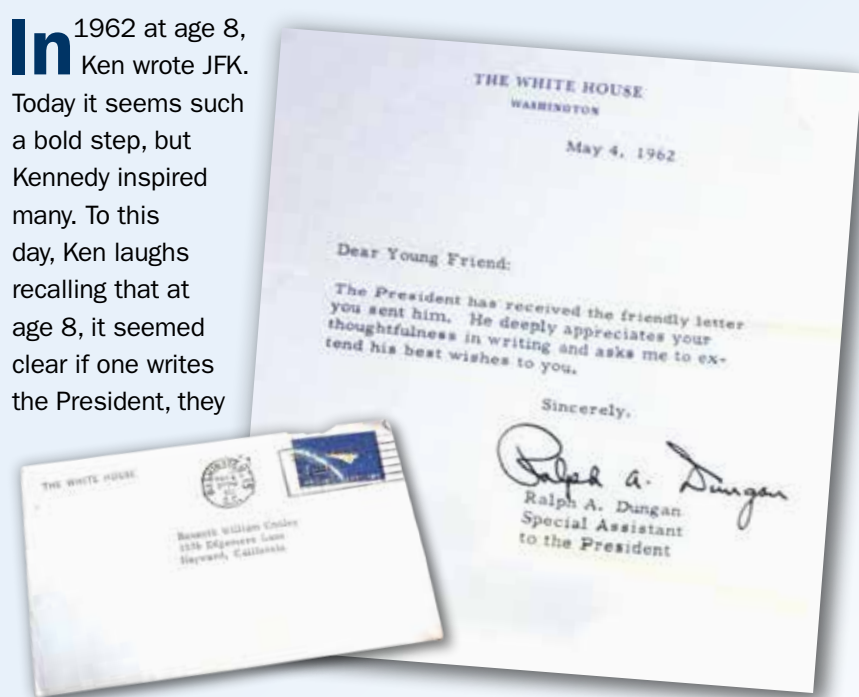
**Assemblyman Ken Cooley** and his wife of 47 years, Sydney, have made their home in eastern Sacramento County since 1977. They raised their sons here and passed their love of camping and hiking in California's mountains, rivers and lakes. As a young man, Ken worked in the Legislature and today he is the only sitting lawmaker who has run a multi-year program of active executive branch

oversight and also supported a successful veto override. Both are vital to fulfilling the Legislature's role as a co-equal branch of government.

Ken's experience and skill have earned him leadership duties in the State Capitol as Chair to both the Assembly Rules Committee and the Joint Senate and Assembly Rules Committee. As a strong advocate for the communities he represents, in recent budgets he helped local projects access about \$50 million dollars in state funds.

Ken believes the most uniquely "American method" in problem-solving – seen in churches, service clubs and PTA's – is based on listening, so that all are encouraged to speak up so a sense of the group can emerge, often reflecting parts of all the ideas shared. Ken thinks this "American method" is how all governments should make decisions.

In 1962 at age 8, Ken wrote JFK. Today it seems such a bold step, but Kennedy inspired many. To this day, Ken laughs recalling that at age 8, it seemed clear if one writes the President, they



must of course use their whole name – JFK's White House reply was sent to "Kenneth William Cooley."

The inspiration stuck so that at age 11, he shadowed the City Manager of Las Vegas, Nevada for a day. Ken went on to study government at U.C. Berkeley. Graduating from Cal in 1977, Ken and his wife made Rancho Cordova their home that year. Today, Ken and Sydney's grandchildren are at these same tender ages when his own respect for public service was becoming established.

# Final Farewell for Queen Elizabeth II

It was a spectacle few will see again. A Queen – perhaps the greatest monarch in history – borne to rest with pageantry beyond Cecil B. De Mille. Monday’s funeral

The nonagenarian bore the yoke of duty until death.

Service came at a price. Her babies lacked a mum’s hands-on guidance and later blundered into mistakes she so deftly avoided. But three Windsor generations’ heartfelt mourning

was a masterpiece only the Queen’s horses and men could achieve; meticulously choreographed by the lady herself.

The massed pipers, gun carriage and swaying naval phalanx was not just pomp. Pragmatic to the last, Elizabeth II knew great pageantry stirs sentiment. What better tonic for royal continuance? What better kick-start for her heir’s succession?

Ten thousand military officers and the tears of a grateful nation accompanied an Empress into legend. Elizabeth was not born to her role, yet this accidental monarch managed sovereignty so peerlessly that her death was – for millions – like the loss of a mother, a grandmother or great grandmother.

The Queen encapsulated the Greatest Generation. Her radio voice comforted Londoners during Hitler’s blitzkrieg. Her wedding dress was purchased with clothing ration coupons. The Navy bride followed her husband’s deployments, and she paraded children at her coronation. As a Commonwealth leader, she walked a steel tightrope through 70 years of diplomacy. During pandemic, she reassured locked-down subjects, “We will meet again.”

demonstrated the brood’s profound love.

When I was a little girl, I waved to the Queen from a street crowd. In pale flesh, I beheld the icon from New Zealand’s stamps and pound notes. When I met her many years later, I was told to address her as her ma’am. Through nerves, I called her “mum.” She looked at me askance, but the irony was surely not lost on the mother of the Commonwealth.

I was then a court correspondent in London. Palace press corps members saw her frequently, but the jokey banter of Charles and Diana’s entourage was absent with the Queen. Some people called her shy; I found her reserved. I recall aching polite conversations about the weather. Her sapphire gaze was beguiling. But in disapproval, what she called “the look” could silence cannon fire.

Stoicism is not the same as snobbery. As much as her 15 prime ministers, the Monarch knew adaptability was key to survival. In tune with her times, she knighted rock stars, agreed to pay taxes, shelved her minks, mothballed her yacht and shook hands with activists.

She bent only as far as her principles allowed. The Queen gave no

interviews; nor did she pander to the press. She believed a monarch should be seen – hence her bright ensembles – but heard as little as possible. In an age of celebrity narcissism, the world’s greatest celebrity eschewed exposure of emotions or private life. Her children divorced; a son was disgraced; a grandson defected. The matriarch seethed or grieved in private. Her

husband died; she soon donned lavender ensembles and returned to work. Her policy to neither explain, complain or comment served her well.

The Queen nevertheless knew the age when few questioned colonialism – or Britain’s right to the Koh-in-Nor diamond – were over. Abdicating from dynastic problems on September 8, her final coup was to

unite stewing elements of the Commonwealth in mourning.

Elizabeth II’s most crucial legacy is the king she groomed. What Charles missed in motherly cuddles was not stunted in his training. The mentor likely hammered in responsibility to a changing society over tea and scones.

When Elizabeth ascended, her realms were emerging from war years

with adoration for Queen and Country. Charles III inherits national crises and a complaining Commonwealth. But as passionately as one Sovereign believed in contending monarchy for the times, so will her heir.

Elizabeth II was the right Queen for her era. Thanks to her unflinching example, I believe Charles III will be the right King, for his. ★

## Bill Signed to Crack Down on Street Racing and Illegal Sideshows

orders. In 2020, the California Highway Patrol responded to more than 25,000 calls involving illegal street racing activity statewide, an alarming increase of more than 3,500 calls from the year before.

In Southern California, street racing and sideshows have become extremely popular. In August and October of 2021, respectively, a Calabasas teen was among three people killed by apparent street racers in a three-vehicle collision in Burbank caused by street racing, and a Woodland Hills woman was killed and seven others were injured after a driver lost control while racing. Just last week, police arrested three dozen people at several illegal street takeovers

in and around Los Angeles and the San Fernando Valley.

Statewide law enforcement groups have identified driver's license suspensions as an effective tool for the deterrence of illegal street racing activity. Expanding on AB 3, which was signed into law last year, AB 2000 allows courts to issue a driver's license suspension for the exhibition of motor vehicle speed during a sideshow taking place in a parking lot – an area not currently covered under the law – and thereby helps to further deter individuals from engaging in these dangerous activities.

# Lancers Lose 4th Straight Game by Wide Margin

**NICOLAUS, CA (MPG)** - A tough 2022 campaign continued for the Cordova High School varsity football team Friday night, September 16, with a 45-6 loss at the East Nicolaus Spartans.

The Lancers (0-4) have allowed at least 41 points in each game this season. Cordova's fourth game of the year against regional rival Rosemont (3-1) was canceled due to the poor air quality and heat in the Sacramento region on September 9.

The Spartans (2-1) started quickly Friday against the Lancers and never looked back. East Nicolaus scored 31 points in the first quarter and led 31-0 at halftime. The Spartans first points of the night came on a five-yard rushing touchdown from senior wide receiver Dalton Novak.

Senior running back Sonny Pina followed it up by rushing into the end zone for the successful two-point conversion attempt. Senior RB Rhett Risse scored the next touchdown on an eight-yard dash followed by senior offensive lineman Taco Mallow scoring the two-point try on the ground.

East Nicolaus quickly got the ball back by recovering an onside kick attempt. Senior WR Isaac Rocucci rushed in for the next score, this time from 10 yards out. Pina converted another two-point conversion with his legs. The Spartans continued to pour it on in the opening quarter, recovering another onside kick following a score.

Risse then rushed in for the touchdown from 12 yards out, followed by a successful point after try, making the score 31-0 after 24 minutes of play. Senior WR Easton Lunsford returned the opening-half kickoff 85 yards for the score and Rocucci nailed the PAT kick.

Cordova scored its first and only touchdown of the night on the ensuing kickoff as do-it-all senior quarterback Kevin Lewis rushed 75 yards for the touchdown. The PAT was missed. Lewis nearly had another long touchdown run Friday night, but the play was negated due to a block in the back penalty.

East Nicolaus had great field position to start their final scoring drive at their own 48-yard line following a failed inside kick attempt from the Lancers. Senior QB Ty Grigsby threw his only touchdown pass of the night on a 12-yard strike to senior tight end Ryan Engler midway through the third quarter. Rocucci converted the PAT. The Spartans ultimately won 45-6.

To replace the canceled contest against Rosemont, the Lancers played versus Union Mine (1-2) on Thursday evening, September 22.

Thursday's game was Cordova's final preseason game before beginning league play against Foothill (2-2) on September 30. Kickoff for junior varsity was scheduled for 5 p.m. while varsity kicked off at 7:15 p.m. ★

The second training course was for the Rancho Cordova community. Thirty-seven people signed up for the program through the City of Rancho Cordova's Volunteer Central, a new one-stop-shop for those who are interested in volunteering and for organizations and businesses who are seeking volunteers.

The participants were presented with a certificate of completion and their own tourniquet at the end of the training course. They learned five steps to stop the bleed and help save a life:

Take care of yourself to be safe and not become another victim; Call 911 for help; Use pressure with hands, if possible; Pack the wound and press; Apply a tourniquet.

"My wife and I were thrilled to have this

opportunity to enhance our first aid skills with the Stop the Bleed course," said Rancho Cordova resident Jim Garcia. "With an easy-to-follow slide show and presentation by Walt Little, it was terrific to also have a hands-on application of our newly acquired skills on ourselves and other participants. The certified trainers helped the audience better understand the techniques and guide us as necessary during the hands-on demonstration. You never know when you may need to Stop the Bleed!"
