CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG) - The votes have been tallied, and the results are in. Congratulations to this year's 2022 'Best of Citrus Heights' winners voted by the Citrus Heights Chamber of Commerce.

New Highland Avenue Well Planned

CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG)

- A potential "sweet spot" in Citrus Heights will soon be tapped to provide an additional, reliable water supply source for customers in the Citrus Heights Water District.

Representative Ami Bera, M.D. (CA-07) and representatives of the Citrus Heights Water District celebrated the \$1.5 million recently secured for construction with a tour of the project site at 7725 Highland Avenue on August 1.

The new Highland well will be built on a oneacre lot recently sold to the CHWD by the First Apostolic Church-Faith Christian School. The location is bordered by Beam Lane, a private road and by Highland Avenue.

Pending construction of a groundwater aquifer at 7725 Highland Avenue will allow the district to forego up to 1,500-acre-feet per year (AFY) of its surface supplies and allow the injection of surface water into storage.

"The goal is not just to be able to tap into more underground water, but in a good year, the new Highland well will be designed to take water from the surface and inject it back into the underground aquifer," said CHWD general manager Hilary Straus.

The new aquifer will help preserve water resources for the Sacramento region through aquifer storage and recovery (ASR) technology, Straus said.

ASR is a water resources

actively storing water underground during wet periods for recovery when needed, usually during dry periods. Artificial Recharge (AR) is focused on actively moving water from the surface into ground water systems, according to the California Water Science Center.

While CHWD receives the bulk of its water from Folsom Lake, it has four active wells and two standby wells that are used to supplement surface water. With Folsom Lake looking more like a pond, and no way of knowing if the next rainy season will deliver, local water agencies, including CHWD, are finding they have to dig deep.

"Our region relies a lot on Folsom Lake and

management technique for Folsom Reservoir. We need projects like this where, in the rainy months, we can capture that water, and pump it down into the aquifer," Representative Bera said.

> "Highland Avenue is a location we've had our eye on for quite some time," Straus said. According to its own studies, the Highland well location offered ideal geological characteristics for such water storage.

Wells in Citrus Heights

tap into a water source inside a vast deep aquifer called the Mehrten Formation that is pressurized and less susceptible to the variations that come with extreme weather changes, according to CHWD.

With its additional new Highland Avenue storage, CHWD will have the opportunity to better be able to work with regional entities such as the Sacramento Groundwater Authority to increase regional supply reliability and implement the overall goals of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA).

Straus applauded the partnership between CHWD and the office of Rep. Bera to secure project funding for the Highland well.

District officials say the federal dollars, on top of local funding, will soon help get the shovels in the ground. Funding will support the design, drilling, and testing of Highland Avenue Well within the service area of the Citrus Heights Water District.

The congressional bill to provide project funding awaits an approval vote in the U.S. Senate, and signature by President Biden.

Rep. Bera secured the funding as a community-funded project request through the House Energy and Water Development, and Interior-Environment fiscal year 2023 Appropriations bills, which passed the U.S. House of Representatives on July 20, 2022.

The congressman has secured more than \$32 million to support 15 different community funding project requests for the Sacramento-region in the House fiscal year (FY) 2023 appropriations bills.

Citrus Heights Water District (CHWD) has served the community since 1920. Its service area consists of 12.8 square-miles of service line which provides drinking water to an estimated service area population of 67,000 customers via approximately 19.600 water service connections in Sacramento and Placer counties, including about 60 percent of the area within the boundaries of the City of Citrus Heights.

To celebrate the openings, all Macy's stores, including Citrus Heights, will host nine days of in-store events beginning October 15 through October 23, which will include family-friendly activities and daily giveaways from brands like Barbie, LEGO, Play-Doh and more, Edheimer said.

The once-storied toy store went bankrupt and closed all its stores in 2018. Its former location on Greenback Lane has since re-opened as a Hobby Lobby arts and crafts store.

Toys 'R' Us has since established its own designated e-commerce section on Macys.com which customers can access now in addition to its own dedicated ToysRUs.com site.

"As a Toys 'R' Us kid, I could not be more excited to bring this beloved brand that so many of our customers know and love into Macy's online and to our stores across America," said Macy's chief merchandising officer, Nata Dvir, in a press statement.

Seeks New Tenant



Starbucks thanks its patrons for their support of the coffee shop which was located at 6121

CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA (MPG) - The site of a former popular Starbucks coffee shop at 6121 Sunrise Boulevard in Citrus Heights between Barnes & Noble Booksellers and Noodles and Company remains vacant, as the Gerrity Group, LLC, an asset management group in Solano Beach which manages the plaza seeks a new tenant.

Starbucks abruptly closed on October 3, 2021, where a notice posted by district manager Jackie Paduveris thanking past customers remains posted on its front door.

In a 2021 interview, Paduveris said that the store's closure in Birdcage was related to "its business model." Calls to both Starbucks corporate public relations team and to Paduveris were not returned.

News of the closure in 2021 came as a surprise to The Gerrity Group, in an earlier press

"It was a surprise to learn of the tenant's intent to close the business as of October 3, 2021, particularly because the store appeared to perform well, and there is considerable amount of term remaining on the lease," said Colby Young, Gerrity Group vice president. Starbucks had been a tenant in Marketplace-Birdcage in Citrus Heights for 24 years.

Does Starbucks still have an option to return and reopen?

"Starbucks has the right to operate for the remainder of their lease term," Young said.

Young said The Gerrity Group is actively searching for businesses to add to the diverse mix of restaurants, goods, and services which Marketplace at Birdcage offers.

"I think a coffee shop or restaurant would be a great use for this space," he said.

Young said the Gerrity Group is "engaging and pursuing potential new tenants for this space and others daily. The opportunity to lease space at Birdcage fronting Sunrise Boulevard has drawn strong interest."

"The Gerrity team continues to work with interested businesses to ensure we provide the best shopping experience for our Citrus Heights community. I encourage anyone interested in opening their business at Birdcage to contact Chris Campbell with CBRE at (916) 446-6800," Young said.

Today, a black floor-to-ceiling metal mesh fence and curtain separates the closed Starbucks from the Barnes & Noble bookstore.

"When asked to show the former Starbucks, we can do so by appointment," said Sophia Garman, store manager for Barnes & Noble which adjoins the former coffee shop.

Garman said she has shown it to interested parties on behalf of the Gerrity Group from as far south as San Francisco. She remains optimistic that a new tenant will be found

"Our customers periodically ask us whether we've heard any news whether or not Starbucks will return, or if another business may move in," she said.

"There's not much I can tell them or the general public at this time," Garman said. "I'm still hopeful the space won't be vacant too much longer before the upcoming holiday season."

Keep Pets Safe During Hot Weather

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Every vear. Sacramento County residents do their best to keep cool during the summer heat. Failing to keep cool in extreme temperatures can cause adverse health effects for residents – both humans and animals.

Unlike humans, cats and dogs cannot sweat to keep cool; they cool their bodies off through panting and the pads of their feet. As a pet owner, it's important to take measures to keep them cool during high temperatures.

Here are some tips for keeping your pet safe from the heat:

Never leave your pet in a parked car: Even cracking a window won't protect your pets. It is against the law in California and could be punishable by a fine or imprisonment. A car can reach 120 degrees in just minutes; even if the windows are slightly open the car can still reach 102 degrees. A dog's normal temperature is 101.5 degrees; at 120 degrees your pet can suffer from heat exhaustion and die and at 107 degrees brain damage occurs. Check out this video on how hot it

gets in cars. Avoid extreme heat: When temperatures get above the 90s, take your pet inside. For outdoor pets, be sure to provide them with plenty of fresh, cold water in a tip-proof water dish and shade for them to cool down.

Don't exercise with your pets when it is too hot: Older and certain long-haired dogs can be particularly susceptible to heat, and hot asphalt can burn their paws. Exercise in the early morning or cool evenings and make sure both of you have plenty of water.

Use sunscreen: Pets get sunburned just like people, and if your pet has light skin or fur, they can be particularly susceptible to a painful burn, and even skin cancer. Use sunscreen on sensitive areas, such as ears or nose to make sure your pets are protected.

Secure your dog during transport: Make sure your dog is secured safely in your vehicle. Cross-tethering your dog with a rope or containing them via a kennel in the bed of your truck will help prevent the dog from falling or jumping from the vehicle. Also, please note that truck beds can get hot when exposed to

the sun and that can severely burn dog footpads. Transporting animals on a public highway or public roadway without properly securing them could be punishable by a fine.

Be your pet's lifeguard: While swimming can help pets get exercise without overheating, always supervise pets when swimming either in a pool or in waterways. Dogs can get tired swimming, particularly in rivers where they have to fight against currents. To avoid drowning, make sure they wear life jackets and keep them out of the water when flows are high.

If pets have been exposed to high temperatures...

Be alert for signs of heat stress including heavy panting, glazed eyes, a rapid pulse, unsteadiness, staggering gait, vomiting, or a deep red or purple tongue.

Immediately move your pet to the shade to gradually lower their temperature. Apply cool (not cold) water to the pet, and provide lukewarm or cool water to drink. Take your pet to a veterinary hospital immediately. It could save their life.

SacRT Takes You Back to School for FREE

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) -

The Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) is reminding students and families that with the RydeFreeRT program, students in transitional kindergarten through 12th grade can ride the entire SacRT transit network for free. The program includes SacRT buses, light rail and SmaRT Ride on demand microtransit services.

The RydeFreeRT program is available for any youth that live or go to school within SacRT's service area, which includes the cities of Sacramento, Elk Grove, Folsom, Citrus Heights, Rancho Cordova and parts of Sacramento County. Approximately 220,000 students in grades TK – 12th, home-schooled students, and foster and homeless youth are all eligible.

SacRT launched the RydeFreeRT program in October 2019, at that time, SacRT experienced a 127% increase in student ridership (pre-COVID-19). Over the last year, SacRT provided over 2.4 million free rides to youth across the region.

New RydeFreeRT cards for the 2022-2023 school year are distributed by schools and have a valid date from June 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. For students that still need a RydeFreeRT card, visit SacRT's Customer Service and Sales Center located at 1225 R Street (adjacent to the 13th Street Light Rail Station) or Sacramento Public Libraries.

That's going to make family dinners taste different, because you'll be eating with your lender instead of just good old dad. Money has a way of changing the family dynamic, and it's almost never for the good. Suddenly, you're getting raised eyebrows if you buy something for yourself, because even the nicest, most generous folks have opinions.

If it were me, I'd say thanks, but no thanks. There's no way I'd be in financial debt to my dad.



Correctional Officer Pleads Guilty to Civil Rights Violations for Assaults on Inmates and Cover Up

U.S. Attorney's Office, Eastern District of California

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Arturo Pacheco, 40, of Elk Grove, pleaded guilty on July 25, 2022, to criminal civil rights violations for the on duty assault of two inmates entrusted to his care and to submitting false reports about those incidents in an attempt to cover them up, U.S. Attorney Phillip A. Talbert announced.

According to court documents, Pacheco was a correctional officer at California State Prison, Sacramento (CSP-Sacramento). On September 15, 2016, while escorting an inmate, Pacheco grabbed the legs of the inmate, pulling the legs out from under him. The inmate, whose hands were handcuffed behind his back, fell forward onto the concrete floor, breaking his jaw, several teeth, and suffering other injuries. That inmate was transported to UC Davis Medical Center where he received treatment for his injuries. Approximately two days later, the inmate suffered a pulmonary embolism and died. While the inmate was receiving treatment, Pacheco, a sergeant, and other correctional officers began falsifying reports to cover up the incident.

Following the death of the inmate, investigators uncovered a second incident involving Pacheco. In that incident, on May 19, 2016, Pacheco had, unprovoked, discharged a canister of pepper spray at short range

into the eyes of an inmate who was inside of a prison cell. Pacheco falsified his report in that case to make it appear as though his actions were justified in order to save the life of the inmate. In reality, the inmate was fully complying with commands, and any use of force at that time was unlawful.

As outlined in the factual basis to his plea agreement, Pacheco sent text messages to a friend after the May 2016 incident, commenting how "funny" the incident was and "[i] t's all about how u write ur report". "plus ur partners have ur back." As Pacheco said, "[b]lood, broken glass, n just u n ur partners. ... Green light!"

"Pacheco deprived inmates of their civil rights, abusing his position of authority as a correctional officer to harm them," said U.S. Attorney Talbert. "While Pacheco thought a 'green wall' or code of silence would protect him, he was wrong. His crimes have come to light and now he has admitted to his assaults and cover up. Those who violate the public's trust by harming inmates 'under the color of law' or by covering up wrongdoing must and will be held accountable."

"The FBI is deeply committed to protecting the rights of all Americans, and those rights do not stop behind the walls of our prisons," said Acting Special Agent in Charge Dennis Guertin. "Today's guilty plea is the result of an intensive investigation conducted by the FBI and our partners at the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and the United States Attorney's Office. Corruption and civil rights violations within our prisons are some of the most difficult to detect and investigate, and we encourage anyone who has knowledge of similar crimes to reach out to any FBI field office or submit information to tips.fbi.gov."

This case is the product of an investigation by the Federal Bureau of Investigation with the cooperation of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Office of Internal Affairs. Assistant U.S. Attorneys Michael D. Anderson and Rosanne L. Rust are prosecuting the case.

Pacheco remains out of custody pending sentencing. Fellow former California State Prison, Sacramento correctional officer, Ashley M. Aurich, charged separately, is pending sentencing as well.

Pacheco is scheduled to be sentenced by U.S. District Judge William B. Shubb on October 17, 2022. Pacheco faces a maximum statutory penalty of 20 years in prison on each of the false reporting counts and 10 years in prison on each of the assault counts and a \$250,000 fine per count. The actual sentence, however, will be determined at the discretion of the court after consideration of any applicable statutory factors and the Federal Sentencing Guidelines, which take into account a number of variables.

Arrest Made in Homicide Attempt at Alta Arden and Glendale Lane

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Bureau arrested Chad Jones (36) of Sacramento County for the attempted murder (shooting) of an adult male subject on July 28, 2022, near Glendale Lane and Alta Arden. Major Crimes Detectives tracked Jones to the City of Sacramento and took him into custody at approximately 5 AM. The Sheriff's Office thanks the Sacramento Police Department's SWAT for

their assistance in apprehending Mr. Jones. Jones is well known to local law enforcement and was on Formal Searchable Probation (Until 2024) stemming from felony cases dating back to 2019; he was prohibited from possessing firearms.

Jones was booked into the Sacramento County Main Jail on a single count of attempted murder and is being held without bail. He will be in court (Department 62) on Tuesday August 2, 2022, at 3pm. No suspects are outstanding in this case. No further information is available at this time.





San Francisco's Shortstop Stops by SacTown

WEST SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - It's not often that you have a three-time All-Star and four-time Gold Glove Award winner rolling through Sacramento and suiting up for the River Cats.


However, the uncommon occurred last week as San Francisco Giants shortstop Brandon Crawford played for the Giants' Triple-A affiliate, the Sacramento River Cats. Crawford was in town for multiple days to get in some game-action before returning to San Francisco following a stint on the injured list with a knee injury.

"The past week's been pretty good," Crawford told the media before taking the field on Tuesday, August 2. "I had three or four days where I wasn't really feeling anything in the knee. I'm hoping to continue that."

The Mountain View native had been on the IL since July 16 after aggravating the knee that had previously sidelined him once before this season. Crawford aggravated the injury on June 21 during a 12-10 victory over the reigning World Series champions, the Atlanta Braves. He spent the minimum 10 days on the IL before returning on July 5.

Crawford may have rushed his return coming back after 10 days, because 11 days later, he was right back on the IL as the Giants continue to fight to keep their record above .500 following a National League West division title last season.

"I have to make sure the knee is feeling good before I come off the IL," Crawford said. "Last time I came off the IL and felt

good for a game, but the in 72 games for San next week after that I wasn't feeling great. I feel like the only way to test it in a game like situation is to actually play a game. That's kind of what we decided would be best. Hopefully going forward the next couple months it feels pretty good."

Before his return from the IL, the 35-year-old recorded a .215 batting average with five home runs, 33 RBI, 29 runs scored and 10 doubles

Francisco this season.

"We're not far out of the playoff race right now," Crawford explained. "Hopefully I can come back healthy, and Evan Longoria can come back healthy, and we can be at full strength for a little while. I think with the guys that we have, and we kept, we can make a push for the playoffs."

As for his time spent in Sacramento, this wasn't the

veteran's first time experiencing the Capitol of California.


"It's definitely convenient," Crawford said about Sutter Health Park being within driving distance of Oracle Park. "I've always enjoyed Sacramento. I've had family that's lived up here. I have definitely played one exhibition here. I can't remember if I've played two. It's nice to come back out."

Crawford returned to

the majors on Saturday, August 6. The timing couldn't have been any better for the man who was once a boy born in the Bay Area, as the Giants swept a two-game set on the road from their regional rivals, the Oakland Athletics, in the Battle of the Bay.

In eight at bats over the weekend, Crawford had three hits, two runs scored, one run batted in and one walk with three strikeouts. The Giants won Saturday 7-3 and Sunday 6-4.

As of Monday morning, August 8, San Francisco (53-55) was 6.5 games back of their rival, the San Diego Padres (61-50), who currently hold the third and final Wild Card spot. Both teams will need a WC berth to get into the playoffs as the Los Angeles Dodgers (75-33) are currently running away with the NL West crown.
