GENERAL INFO

Each manager will be responsible for informing his/her players of the content of this rules packet and will be responsible for the conduct of his/her teams player, and spectators.

INSURANCE

Players are responsible for providing their own insurance.

AWARDS

Champions in each division will receive numbered award jerseys as well as free entry into the next tournament.

<u>ROSTERS</u>

ROSTERS AND SCORESHEETS ARE DIFFERENT FROM EACH OTHER

1. Initial rosters must be turned in to staff by the first game. Players MUST print their first and last names legibly and sign the rosters for them to be considered valid. Rosters will be available at Sports Park before first game.

2. Rosters will have a maximum of 4 players. All changes to the roster must be made **PRIOR** to the first tournament game played.

3. It is FULLY the manager's responsibility to make sure all players on his/her team are officially signed onto the roster. If the Sports Park staff finds players who are not on the roster, those players may be ejected from the game.

5. All players must have a valid California ID, driver's license, current student ID, or military ID in case of "roster check"

6. You can play with 3, cannot play with 2, which may lead to a forfeit; if a player is late to a scheduled game, there is a 5 minute grace period. Any time over this grace period is considered a forfeit.

EJECTIONS

1. A player ejected from a game shall leave the court immediately. If a player is ejected for unsportsmanlike behavior, the player will be required to leave the gym and the park (out of sight and sound from the referee and scorekeeper), within 2 minutes. Failure to do so may cause the player's team to forfeit the game if your team has 4 players. If only 3 players, then it counts as an automatic forfeit. The referee should give a final warning at 1 minute, 30 seconds.

2. A player ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike behavior will be disqualified from the tournament weekend.

3. A player who is ejected from a game a second time for unsportsmanlike behavior will be ineligible from further participation for the remainder of the tournaments.

4. Any player or fan threatening staff, scorekeeper, or a referee will be banned from our league for a minimum of 1 year.

5. Any player involved in a fight before, during, or after one of our games may face a lifetime ban.

SCORESHEETS

1. Referees will keep track of score between the two teams. The referee does not keep track of stats, strictly scores and also calls the game as he see's it.

BRACKETS

We will have a staff member in charge of tournament bracket to keep track of teams who are still in, and who are eliminated. This is a double-elimination tournament in which the "bracket master" will be up to date with the winners and losers bracket.

<u>CLOTHING</u>

Please wear like colored clothing to tell who is on who's team. Also bring a color of opposite color in the case that you may play a team that has the same colors as you. A team that does not abide will either wear "shirts", or they may go "skins" (without a shirt). A female on the team is automatic "shirts" unless there is a situation where both teams facing each other have females. The males will determine who is "shirts" and "skins" (via coin toss) and females keep there shirts on and will have to know which team they are on.

GAME BALL

The home team is responsible for providing and/or determining the game ball.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The team manager is responsible for his/her own fans. If the team manager cannot control an unruly fan or player, the team could forfeit its game. The referee will warn the manager first before forfeiting the game.

<u>ALCOHOL</u>

1. Any player determined by the umpire to be drinking alcohol during the game will be ejected.

2. Any player determined by the umpire to be intoxicated will not be allowed to play. If the umpire makes the determination that a player is intoxicated during the course of the game, the player will be ejected from the game.

PARK REGULATIONS

1. NO GLASS CONTAINERS allowed in any City Park.

2. Smoking is prohibited in all City Parks. Players will be subject to ejection if caught smoking in the Park their game is played. This also includes parking lots and restrooms.

- 3. Children may not be left unattended in City Parks.
- 4. Pets may not be left unattended in City Parks.
- 5. Only players listed on the team roster should be on the team's bench.

GAME RULES

- 1. Winner of the coin toss will receive the ball
- 2. 1's and 2's
 - loser takes the ball after a made basket
- 3. Must check-ball prior to play after made basket or fouls that are on the ground
- 4. 1st to 20 points wins unless... it goes to 25 minutes without a team scoring 20.
 - Referee notifies the clock situation throughout
- 5. "Overtime"
- 6. Must win by 2 of the leading teams score
 - i.e.:
 - 19-18= first to 20 wins
 - 16-16= first to 18 wins
 - 8-7= first to 10 wins
 - 14-12= team with 14 won
- 7. Shooting fouls=1 free throw only unless a 2 point attempt, then you get 2 attempts
 - missed shot=live ball and clear out if rebounded by opposing team
 - If same team as shooter gets rebound, they don't need to clear
- 8. No stalling... meaning intentionally running out the clock- will result in technical
- 9. Taunting or trash talk is referee's discretion for technical
 - Technical= 1 free throw and the ball
 - Flagrant= 2 free throws and the ball
 - 2 flagrant fouls=ejection
- 10. Substitutions only on timeout or dead ball possessions
