take place on Thursday, January 7, 2016 at 6:00-9:00p.m. in the MBPD Community Room. Classes will continue weekly and will culminate on March 10th with a graduation ceremony. Each session will highlight select divisions within the Police Department, to include: Patrol, K-9, Traffic, SWAT, CSI and more!! Participants will also tour the Manhattan Beach Police Department and Jail, the state-of-the-art 911 Center and go on a 4-hour ride along with a Manhattan Beach Police Officer.

To participate, an Academy application must be submitted for review to determine suitability for the program and applicants must meet the following criteria: be at least 18 years old, reside/work within the City of Manhattan Beach, not have felony convictions, not be wanted for any crime and submit to a limited background check (to include: warrants & criminal history).
