

FedEx Smart Post

FedEx Smart Post announced in July 2014 that it will invest \$14 million in constructing a new 400,000-square foot distribution center located in the Phase III portion of the International Business Park in Concord. FedEx Smart Post plans to employ 59 full-time employees and 462 part-time employees at the Concord location by 2019.

Gordon Food Service

Gordon Food Service announced in October 2014 that it will invest \$58 million in constructing a new 300,000-square-foot distribution center that will lead to 275 jobs. The building is located in Afton Ridge Business Park on Glen Afton Boulevard off Kannapolis Parkway.

Alevo


