On June 10, the Bellingham Business Association (BBA) hosted its annual Awards Night, where they introduced the winner of Bellingham's Unsung Hero Award and presented two exceptional Bellingham students with \$1,500 scholarships. BBA President John Orthman commenced the evening's program by honoring Bellingham's Unsung Hero, Officer Len Gosselin of the Bellingham Police Department. Gosselin earned this award for his years of service and community involvement. Gosselin lectures classes for the DARE Program and has contributed to its continuing success using his own personal funds and the donations acquired through his several organized fundraisers. He played a major role in establishing the town's K-9 unit, petitioning for grants and seeking donations, helping to procure specially trained dogs, specialized K-9 unit equipment, and day-to-day dog supplies. He and his family have contributed countless hours of personal time to help train the dogs and perform K-9 demonstrations for school and community events. Gosselin has also worked vigorously to establish the Bellingham Police Dept. Youth Center. By raising funds, deciding on a location, and recruiting volunteers, he has been responsible for providing innumerable extracurricular activities for the children and youth of Bellingham.

The first scholarship recipient announced was Suzanne Wright, who graduated as a member of the National Technical Honor Society from Blackstone Valley Regional Technical Vocational High School and is a two-time District V Gold Medalist in the Technical Computer Applications Contest. Her credentials further include Outstanding Achievement Awards in English, biology, and business technology. She has taken on numerous volunteer responsibilities within the community and graduated second in her class. She is attending Framingham State University.

The second scholarship recipient was Bellingham High School graduate Ryan Gonthier, a member of the National Honor Society. He has been awarded both the Coach's Award for Soccer and the Scholar Athlete Awards recognition for his adept athleticism, practiced sportsmanship, and outstanding academic performance. Gonthier is also an Eagle Scout and actively participates in volunteer work for the community. He will attend Westfield State University to major in criminal justice.
