The OFPD would like to honor *Retired Chief Rick Neitzer* by awarding two \$500.00 scholarships in his name to two 2016 graduates that will be pursuing a higher education in the fall of 2016.

Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a degree in Fire Science or a related field
- 2. Those applicants pursuing a career in Public Safety will also be given preference, but weighted less than those in the Fire Science field
- 3. Applicants must reside within the Oswego Fire Protection District boundries and be graduating in the spring of 2016
- 4. Applicants must be attending an institution of higher learning in the fall semester of 2016
- 5. Students may receive the scholarship only once
- 6. Applications will be screened and scholarships awarded by the OFPD scholarship committee (The *OFPD* reserves the right to choose the students that best meet the criteria for the award)
- 7. Contingent upon availability of qualified applicants, the scholarship may not be awarded annually
- 8. Only applicants that include the one page essay and transcript shall be considered.
- 9. Applications are due no later than April 30th, 2016 and must be returned to Oswego Fire Station #1 located at 3511 Woolley Rd. Oswego, IL, 60543. (*Care of Capt. John Cornish*)
