During the hour, the SDSU Jazz Ensemble and Wind Symphony will perform contemporary and classic Latin music featuring <u>Jarabe Mexicano</u> in such Mexican favorites as *Granada* and *Querida* with a special tribute to the music of the late Juan Gabriel. During the concert, Carlos Amezcua will salute his father Don Oscar Amezcua and his legendry group *Mariachi Guadalajara* that performed throughout San Diego between the 1960s through the 1990's. The concert will also feature the City Heights Mariachi Ensemble.

"The annual Cinco de Mayo concert showcases the talent of our music students in a beautiful, public venue," notes Charles Friedrichs, Director of the SDSU School of Music and Dance, "and thanks to the Kiwanis Club of San Diego, the concert is free so the whole family can come enjoy good music together."
