Theme: *I found my hero and my hero is me!*

Speech Details:

Expo Presentation Length: 5 minutes

Grade levels: 5-8th

TOPIC:

Option 1:

Tell the story of a moment when you realized:

You inspired yourself;

OR

You inspired someone else.

Option 2:

Tell the story of an innovation you've developed which made you a hero to others.

Auditions will be in the form of video submissions ONLY! Send to Learning and Innovation, SBUSD Ed Center by: 1) email (joliveira@sbUSD.org), 2) link (Google drive or YouTube link sent to email listed), or 3) video upload below by April 6th.

For your audition, please introduce yourself and which school you attend along with a short summary of your topic. You might also include: a) telling a joke; b) reciting your favorite poem; or c) telling a short story so that your personality shines through. Video submissions are to be approximately one minute in length. Videos will be reviewed and selections will be made based on topic variety, speaking ability, and engagement.
