What is beach nourishment?

It is defined as *the artificial addition of sand on a beach* and is a common shore protection measure. At Imperial Beach, a beach nourishment project in 2012 helped prevent wave-driven flooding, but it also contributed to groundwater flooding and the closure of the Tijuana River Mouth.
