Tips for Sand Sculpting Kids n Kastles 2019

Have an idea or design before starting

Use only biodegradable items as props

Use water and sand together to pack and harden sand to make sculpting easier.

Square, round, rectangular (or any shape really) small forms help create base from which to sculpt

Examples: Round 5 gal buckets, small square boxes, square or rectangular buckets or boxes. Simple boxes made of scrap wood are preferable and awesome to create forms. TupperWare or similar kitchen ware works well (keep in mind teams will either have to remove or dispose of any materials they bring---this can be done thru Club if necessary)

Tools. Such as trowels, small butter knives, paint brushes etc.... make carving and sculpting easier.

Note: best to bring unassembled if using wood and kids must use or put forms together NOT ADULTS. As rules states Adults must leave plots once contest begins and can only assist in bringing water. Cooperation from adults is a must on this one. Thank You.
