Nothing declares "summer" better than time to relax in the sun, or shade, with a good book. Here are some great options to

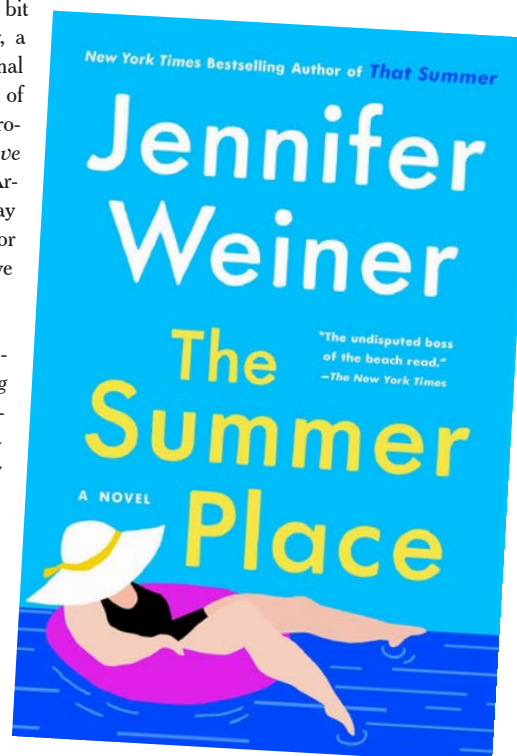
consider, all available at your local bookstore or library.

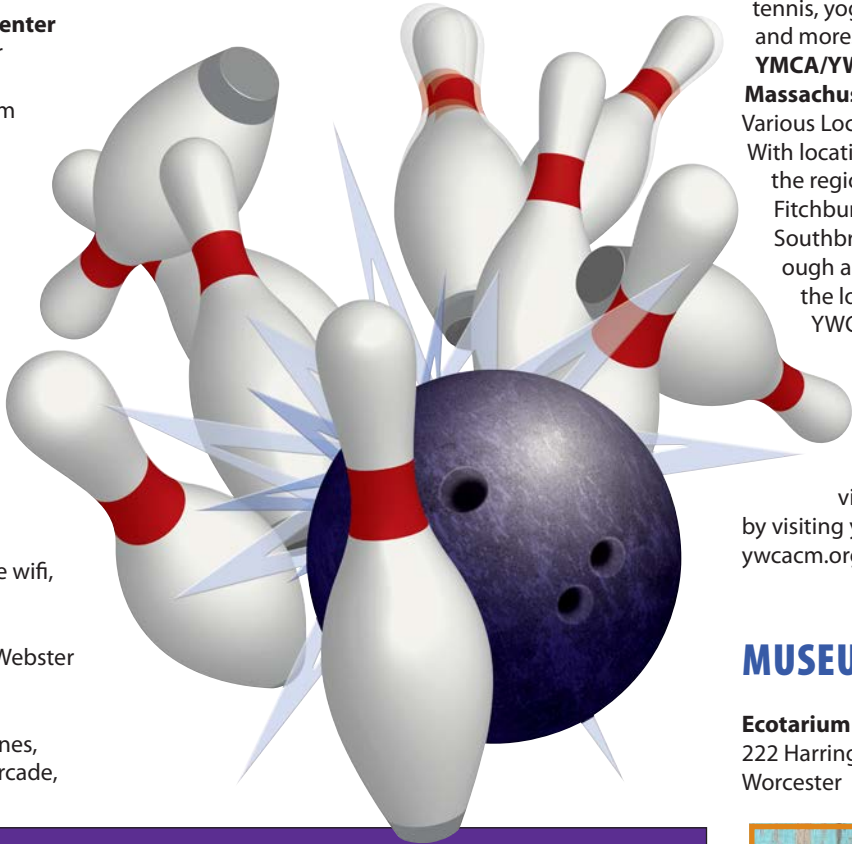
