



Are you ready for some great summertime reading? It's almost time to while away an hour or two at the beach, backyard or reading nook with a good book and cool beverage. Here are some great options to consider, now available in paperback.

You know it's summer with these new releases by perennial favorite authors. **The Seaside Library** by Brenda Novak takes you to tiny Mariners Island with its pristine beaches and an iconic lighthouse that is also harboring a tragedy leaving a scar on the community. Twenty years later, new evidence emerges on the case, calling into question everything three friends thought they knew. **The Summer Place** by Jennifer Weiner, "the undisputed boss of

the beach read" according to The New York Times, centers around a family beach house on Cape Cod where a wedding is soon to take place. Unbeknownst to everyone but the matriarch of the family, this is to be the last gathering before putting the house on the market. As we hear from various family members about the upcoming nuptials, family secrets threaten to reveal themselves and the house itself adds opinions and feelings too. Staying on Cape Cod, Nancy Thayer brings us back to Nantucket with **Summer Love**, where four strangers rent bargain-basement rooms in an old hotel near the beach and embark on the summer of their lives.

For a jaunt across the pond, try **One Italian Summer** by Rebecca Serle, bestselling author of *In Five Years*, for a magical trip about love, loss while realizing parents are human too and not always perfect. What would happen if you were able to meet your mother as she was at thirty years old? **Meant to Be** by master storyteller of contemporary fiction Emily Giffin, is impossible to put down. The Kingsley family is American royalty. After the father is tragically killed in an accident, his free-spirited son inherits the weight of their legacy but has trouble meeting all that's expected of him. When he gets involved with another woman in

the spotlight, can their relationship survive? **The Comeback Summer** by Ali Brady, author of *The Beach Trap*, follows two sisters who have one summer to crush their comfort zones and save their grandmother's PR agency in this sweet, uplifting novel and ultimate vacation read.

Yours Truly by Abby Jimenez, founder of Nadia Cakes bakeries and a Food Network winner, pens a novel about terrible first impressions, hilarious second chances and the joy of finding your perfect match. Local author Jean Grant has written several contemporary and historical romance novels and her latest is **Seeker** that includes a little touch of magic. Aileana Montgomerie is descended from the mystical isles' folk of the Scottish Ancients and wonders if she belongs. Wishing to find her purpose, she discovers with each honor comes a curse. When she falls in love with a future chieftain of another clan, will their love foster an alliance or be a step toward war?





Over the past three years, Massachusetts has seen a lot of dispensaries open their doors, however, none as unique as Green N Go, located in Uxbridge, MA. Green N Go has been making headlines in recent months as it hopes to become the first drive-thru dispensary in the state. The dispensary applied for and was awarded a retail license by the Massachusetts Cannabis Control Commission, however, they were met with opposition from the State when requesting to open the drive-thru portion of

the facility.

The concept of a drive-thru dispensary may seem unusual to some, but it is now without precedent. Several states including Colorado, Oregon, and Michigan have already approved Drive-Thru dispensaries, and they have proven to be a convenient and safe option for customers who have mobility issues or are concerned with exposure to Covid-19.


Green N Go has outlined several benefits of a drive thru dispensary, including increased

convenience for customers, reduced wait times, and improved traffic flow. The dispensary has also emphasized its commitment to safety and security, stating that it will implement strict age verification and ID checks, as well as security cameras and personnel, to ensure that the drive-thru operation is conducted in a responsible and lawful manner. Green N Go is now working with state regulators to rewrite the language of the current law to allow such drive-thru dispensaries.
