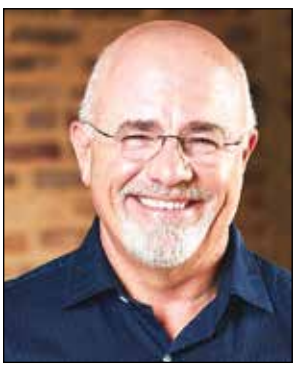

Kovar Named Person of the Year

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Carmichael Martial Arts entrepreneur Dave Kovar will be honored as Person of the Year at an April 1 gala. The Chamber of Commerce award recognizes not just business success but Kovar's zeal to motivate young people toward self-improvement.

His story is one of local legend. The main street block occupied by his business is locally called Kovar's Corner. "The County once gave me a sign to that effect," recalls the owner. "Unfortunately, it got stolen."

Heading one of the nation's biggest martial arts corporations, Kovar (62) has 13 studios, including eight in Sacramento. Kovar's Satori Academy instruction also packs a wallop in

New York and New Jersey.

One of a clergyman's three kids, young Dave aspired early to be tough. "With my red hair, I looked more like Danny Partridge than Rocky Balboa," he laughs. "At 11, I saw a poster of a guy doing a flying side-kick. I immediately started learning karate." After Sacramento Waldorf School, he graduated to house-painting and borrowed family money to begin a karate school in North Highlands. "With six students, I could barely pay the rent," he admits. "I sold out after four years. By day, I painted houses. By night, I went to business school and taught karate at other people's studios."

"One day I found a place for rent in Carmichael. I was covered in freckles and house paint and the landlord asked why I thought karate

might succeed in Carmichael. I'd just done a business class paper on how to start a karate school. I grabbed the assignment from my car and showed it to him. He gave me a one-year lease. The 'Karate Kid' movie had just come out. Talk about providence. Kids were suddenly lining up to learn."

His affinity with students has Kovar schools rated among top children's instruction resources worldwide. But teaching genius does not always extend to bottom lines. "If I hadn't brought my brother Tim on board in 1987, I'd still be painting houses," he reasons. "Tim balanced my weakness. He's the real reason we succeeded." (Tim Kovar has retired; current CEO Dave Chamberlain will introduce his boss

Kiley Responds to Newsom Extending School Mask Mandate

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Assemblyman Kevin Kiley (R-Rocklin) released the following statement in response to Governor Newsom's announcement that the statewide school mask mandate will continue until March 12, 2022:

"There is absolutely no basis for continuing the statewide school mask mandate another day. That's why almost every other state has moved on. Rather than finally acknowledge evidence and common sense, the Governor has chosen to give California kids another two weeks of pointless misery."

"This is the same Governor who kept schools closed longer than any state in the country. It's the same Governor who tried to stop students from enrolling in high-performing charter schools soon after COVID began. Young people in California will pay a lasting price for Gavin Newsom's indecent school policies."

"It's no wonder that dozens of school districts across the state have completely tuned the Governor out. They are doing what is right for their kids."

"The Governor is also refusing to give up his emergency powers and continuing the State of Emergency in violation of the plain text of the Emergency Services Act. The Legislature must act to stop this lawlessness, end the emergency, and let the people of California move on with their lives."

While California students wait until March 12, one day ago Gov. Kathy Hochel of New York announced that students would no longer need to mask starting Wednesday, March 2. ★

Grand Jury Calls for Independent Audit of Cares Act Spending

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento County Grand Jury is calling into question the use and distribution of more than \$181 million received in federal CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security) Act funding by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors. Following a nearly year-long secret investigation, the Grand Jury has learned that in the midst of a county-wide emergency, the Supervisors made questionable and opaque maneuvers that skirted

the intent of the CARES Act, to the benefit of County coffers and with scant regard for the needs of its citizens.

Enacted in March 2020, the CARES Act covered extraordinary and necessary pandemic related expenditures incurred by state and local government agencies. A fundamental CARES Act requirement was that funding utilized by government agencies had to be allocated for pandemic specific activities, and could not be applied toward already budgeted items. The Grand Jury's investigation revealed that the County of Sacramento made no CARES Act funding plan to support

countywide COVID-19 relief activities. Instead, the County Chief



Executive directed, and the Board of Supervisors approved, allocation of \$104 million of its \$181 million in CARES Act funding directly to the Sheriff's Office. That same amount of

Sherriff's Office funding was then transferred back into the County's

General Fund, a move the Grand Jury considers confusing at best and possibly illegal.

"The County Chief Executive has argued that the budget move was legal, however the

Grand Jury has not been able to make that determination," says Grand Jury Foreperson Deanna Hanson. "We are calling for an independent audit, because Sacramento County residents deserve answers."

While the CARES Act permitted its funding to support public safety, the County's maneuver was inconsistent with the widely publicized intent that funds be directed to meet community challenges triggered by the COVID-19 pandemic. Neither the County Executive nor the Board presented any statutory or regulatory language, or a legal opinion, to verify this assertion. "At a minimum, these elected

representatives, had an obligation to notify its constituents of the fund allocation and transfer," Hanson explains.

In its report, the Grand Jury points out that in sharp contrast to the County, the Sacramento City Council allocated nearly all of its CARES Act funding directly to community agencies and businesses to help alleviate impacts of the pandemic. Formal responses to the report are required from both the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors and Sacramento County Sheriff Scott Jones. Mel Closes Copy Shop

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - A mainstay of Fair Oaks Boulevard services for 20 years, Mel's Copy Plus has closed its doors.

Owner Mel Piercey farewelled customers last week and will spend most of March selling equipment, furniture and supplies. He opened shop at Landis Avenue in 2000 and later claimed premises near Stanley Avenue. Friendly and capable, the merchant prospered. "Business was good," he reflects. "My location suited people who didn't want to drive across town. I went the extra mile to make them happy."

Closure follows two tough years. Fair Oaks Boulevard reconstruction curbed access to his shop for many months. Carmichael's homeless crisis obliged him to clear camper trash (including human waste) from his doorstep most days. "Then COVID came," sighs Piercey. "My landlord and I came to an understanding. I opened for two hours a day. But customers tended to stay home. When things started improving, I expected to recover."

Supply shortages hit next. "Specialty paper I use for the majority of my business is not available," he explains. "I hear it's stuck on ships in Los Angeles. An order I placed in August arrived mid-February. Now there's hardly any paper on the entire West Coast. I own my equipment; I do my repairs and I've limped along. But the final straw was when I couldn't find machine

parts. I managed to get the last return unit for my main copier in the entire United States. Without parts, there's nothing I can do. So I'm closing."

South African Piercey immigrated with his parents and sister in 1976. "We had two suitcases each," he recalls. "America's been spectacularly good to us." Following a 20-year career in corporate health administration, his print shop allowed hands-on customer connection. Piercey's parents, nephews and nieces helped at counter. A gray parrot called Storm often accompanied the boss to work.

Customers appreciated Piercey's patience: immigrants trusted him with confidential papers; he faxed benefit forms for veterans; death certificates for tearful widows. He helped

fledgling entrepreneurs put flyers together. He spotted typos and tweaked design. An unerring taste was part of the service.

Non-profits achieved special rates. "Helping the community always pays off," reasons the merchant. "Service club members usually come back as regular customers. People like working with someone who knows what they're doing. That doesn't always happen in big stores. I've had guys leave credit cards or wallets on my counter. They knew they'd get them back. One customer regularly drove here from Elk Grove. She cried when I said I was closing."

Orangevale resident Piercey plans travels with his ageing parents and might eventually channel his skills back to the

McVay considers her studio's success has to do with the special type of learning environment she has fostered since the studio's beginning.

"Our students are provided a supportive non-competitive environment where they can best discover, explore, then test, and further develop their skills in the arts of ballet, tap, jazz, and in the sport of gymnastics," she said.

McVay began her own professional dance career at the age of five in New York with training at the Royal Academy in London, England.

"There is a place for everyone with Joanna's Kids...even "big" kids 40 and up," she said.

"I feel that success and achievement is best accomplished individually, based on everyone's own abilities and effort, regardless of body type, or the set standards of the competitive, or professional, community."

"That's the difference between our approach and that of other studios," she said.

Joanna's Kids "R" It offers younger students combination dance classes in ballet, tap and jazz and in floor exercise gymnastics. Adult classes are offered in jazz and tap dance. Classes in advanced ballet are also available.

For younger students, ages 2 years and up, small classes, emphasizing individual ability are now open.

"We have a variety

of affordable dance and gymnastics classes and programs to fit the needs of almost every student," she said. Discounts are available for multiple enrollments.

"Our success through the years is based on our teaching style," McVay explains. No "free" or "introductory" classes are offered. Parents may observe any program, at anytime, without notice.

Kids "R" It dance and gymnastics programs are not "entertainment based," in McVay's words, "but require a positive and established relationship with the teacher, and fellow classmates, in order for each student to feel comfortable and to begin to enjoy learning."

For many years, her school, Kids "R" It, offered off-site and after school programs to private and public schools, pre-schools and day care centers, and individual parks and recreation districts throughout

the Sacramento Area, she said.

"We lost quite a bit of ground during the pandemic closure," she said.

The studio offers dance programs at the Rio Linda Community Center which recently recognized McVay and her staff for their ongoing support of the local community.

"As an independent contractor, we can, and have provided affordable quality dance and gymnastics programs that are conducted by professional and well-qualified staff."

"We're hoping in this year to add instructional staff and market our short-term (2-6 months) or on-going year-round programs to local community centers and or parks and recreational districts which may want to work with us," McVay said.

How California Mistreated its Working Families

Democratic politicians frequently and vehemently express their admiration for and support of what they call “working families,” while contending that rival Republicans lack such empathy.

Despite that political posture, the Democratic governor of California, with the implicit support of a Democrat-dominated Legislature, has imposed unnecessary misery on those they purport to value, as a new report from the Legislature’s budget analyst confirms.

When COVID-19 struck California two years ago, Gov. Gavin Newsom declared a state of emergency and ordered closure of large segments of the state’s economy to battle its spread. Almost immediately, more than two million workers were laid off as their employers complied with the orders and most applied for unemployment insurance benefits to keep themselves and their families housed and fed.

Whether the closures and resulting layoffs were justified, in terms of their pandemic-fighting effects, will be endlessly debated. Regardless, they happened and having lost their jobs by executive decree, the suddenly idled workers’ claims for benefits deserved rapid and accurate processing by

Newsom’s Employment Development Department.

Instead, EDD’s pandemic operations rapidly devolved into a bureaucratic Chernobyl with immense and prolonged backlogs of claims, unresponsive handling of claimants’ inquiries, rampant fraud and, as the new report details, botched anti-fraud practices that blocked payments to those with legitimate claims.

The state’s oversight agencies, particularly the state auditor’s office, have steadfastly catalogued EDD’s shortcomings and the latest report, focusing on about \$20 billion in fraudulent payments and EDD’s measures to battle it, comes from the Legislative Analyst’s Office.

What emerges is a tale of an agency repeatedly failing to act when necessary and then overreacting as it tries to correct its previous errors.

Embarrassed by the revelations of fraud, mostly involving special federal jobless benefits, EDD’s managers went overboard in adopting anti-fraud policies, thus denying benefits to many legitimate and qualified claimants, the LAO report declares.

At one point, it says, “EDD and (and an outside contractor) identified 1.1 million claims as potentially fraudulent. EDD stopped payments for these claims. Workers were not notified ahead of time. To reopen their accounts, workers had to verify their identity using ID.me or their accounts would be closed permanently. Ultimately, more than half of the claims (600,000) flagged as fraudulent were confirmed as legitimate.”

Thus, the “working families” that Democrats profess to treasure have been doubly

and triply mistreated.

Newsom’s proposed 2022-23 budget contains funds for six contracts by outside vendors to prevent future fraud, in addition to 13 other fraud-related contracts and the LAO report questions “whether additional anti-fraud efforts are warranted at this time.”

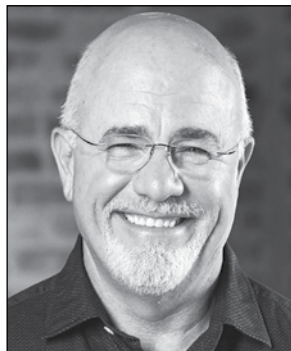
“Moving forward at this time with new, additional layers of fraud protection also would move the department further out of balance by again prioritizing fraud elimination at the expense of prompt and straightforward payments,” the report states.

One of the most irritating things about the EDD’s incredibly bad performance over the last two years is that its political overseers had plenty of warning. During the previous recession that began in 2007, the department experienced great difficulty in handling a surge of unemployment insurance claims because of antiquated tools and procedures.

However, once that recession ended, the agency reverted to its customary ministerial role and no one — in particular Newsom’s predecessor, Jerry Brown — took the proactive step of improving EDD’s capabilities before the next recession hit.

Thus, when it did hit in 2020 by Newsom’s decree, the department was overwhelmed and the shortcomings revealed in the previous recession were magnified. It’s another reminder of government’s endemic inability to look ahead and plan ahead.

This person also needs to be mature, capable of handling life events with a level head and have an honest heart. You need to think about where your potential executor lives, too, because they could end up spending a lot of time working with the courts in your area. If you already have someone in mind who has all the right personal qualities, but lives out of state, research your state’s requirements for an executor’s location. Virtual meetings could be a possibility.

The amount of time needed for an executor to handle your affairs when you’re gone could

be enormous. Depending on the complexity of your estate, it could take months—or even years. Once you settle on someone as executor, be honest with them about all the responsibilities that come with the job. And if you’re unable to find someone appropriate, you can always hire a professional executor.

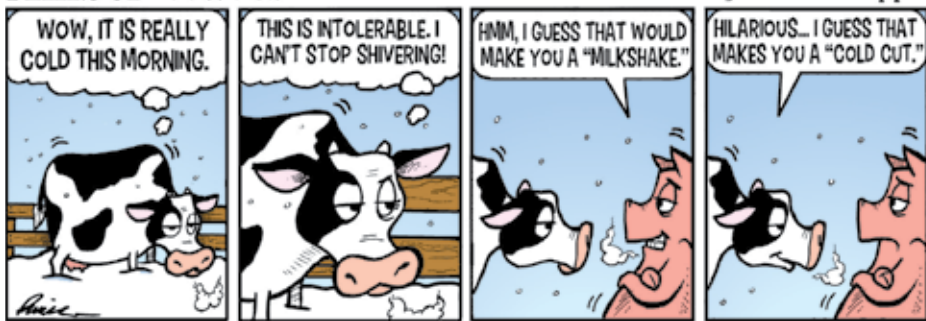

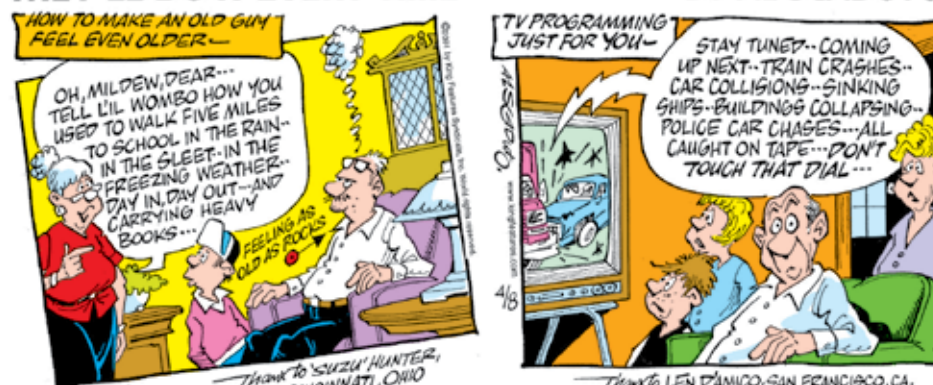

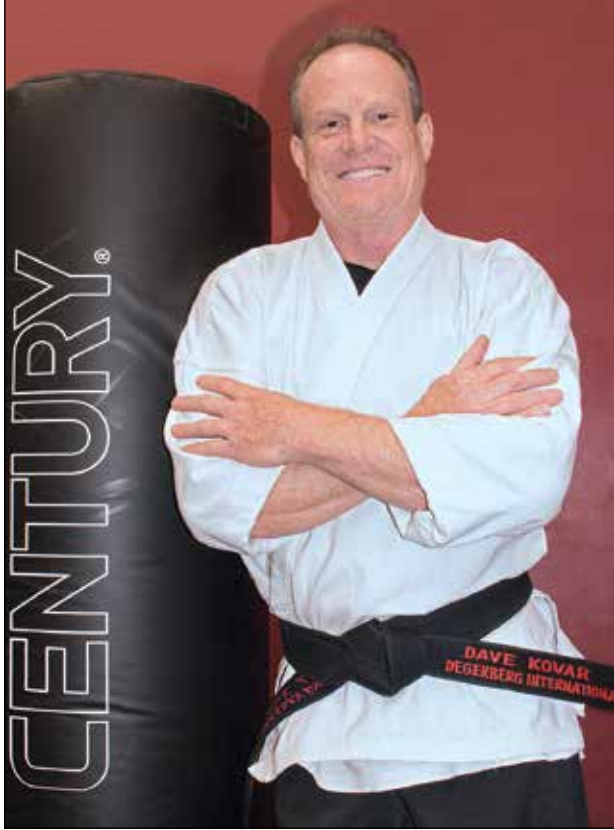

at the awards banquet). “My CEO does an amazing job leading our company,” notes Kovar. “I just hope he’ll find something nice to say about me.”

Few careers avoid hiccups. Rebranded “Kovar’s Satori Academy,” his corporation invested big in 2004 and aimed for nationwide dominance. The move proved over-ambitious. Undaunted, the company licked its wounds, paid off big debts and consolidated its base. Kovar also channeled skills into instructing other martial art teachers. He is now internationally sought as a business and youth motivational speaker.

“Satori is a Japanese term for being at your best in any specific moment,” explains the mentor. “Martial arts is not about being tough. It’s about personal development. It teaches self-control, responsibility and doing what is right. Kicking tail is a just a side effect. I’m totally against fighting—unless you have to defend yourself—then I’m totally for it.”

Kovar has been wed 35 years to fellow black-belter Angelina Kovar; the couple has two black-belt karate kids. Their dad has also been a parental figure to many thousands of students. “My studio’s taught one in ten Carmichael kids,” he estimates. “When I speak at school assemblies, teachers always greet me. They tell me how my studio changed

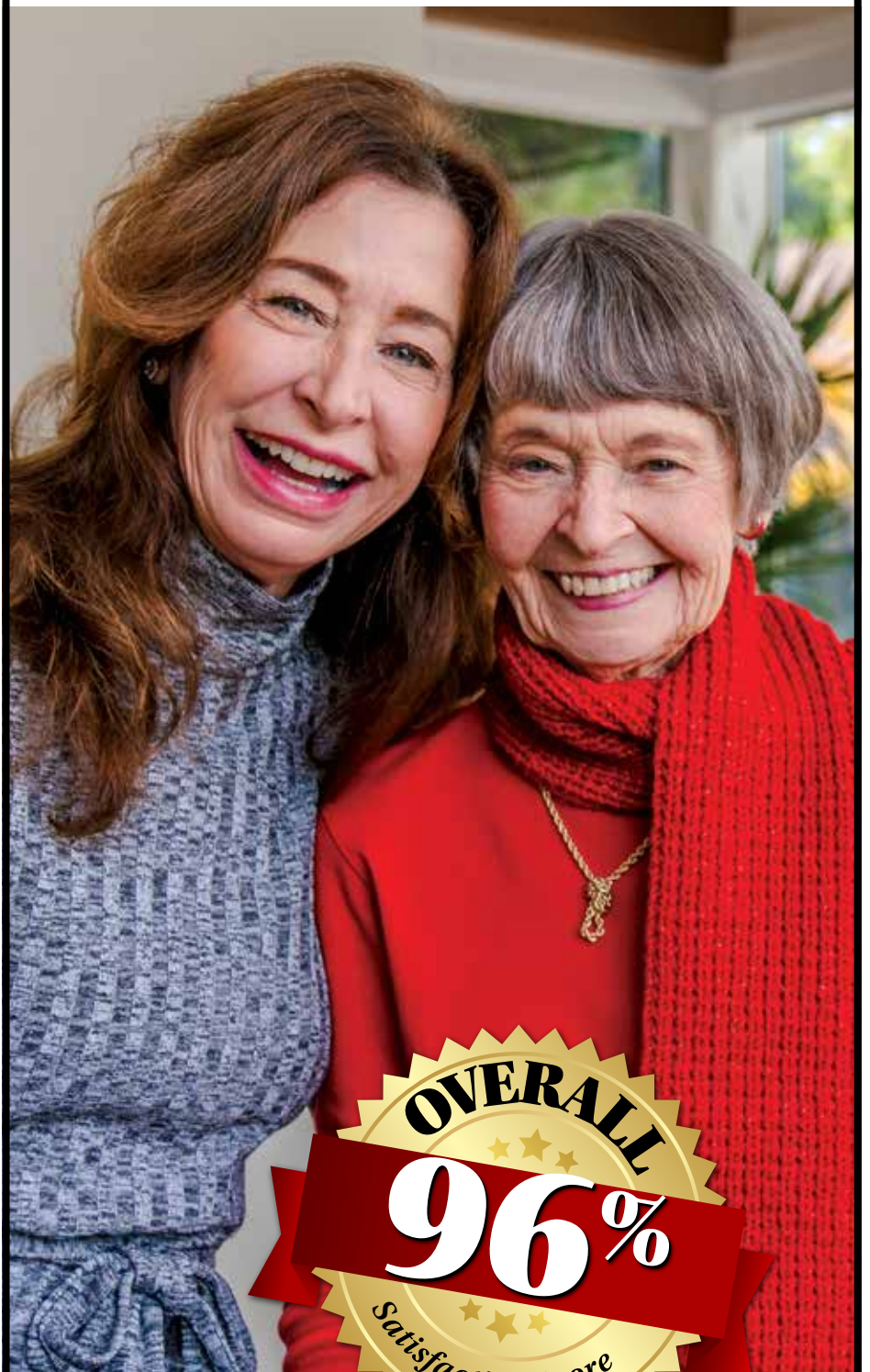

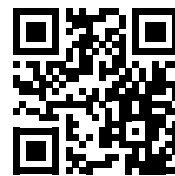
