Drive-Thru Dream

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - A new Manzanita Avenue coffee shop might mean beans for customers. For owner Danny Phung (46), the business realizes an American dream. "It's what every immigrant from my culture hopes for," he says. "With our French heritage, coffee's a big part of daily ritual. And for Vietnamese people, business is in our blood."

Born in Saigon, Phung was the fourth of six siblings. His mom gave up everything - including her marriage - to get her six kids to America as refugees in 1980. Arcade Baptist Church parishioners adopted them. "They gave us a place to live and helped us with our English and to learn American ways," recalls Phung. "Mom cleaned houses and baby-sat; she took any work and made any sacrifice for our education."

The Phung kids attended El Camino and Encino High Schools, then all worked their way through

college. Armed with business and science degrees, Phung went to work for AT&T and later achieved a career conducting clinical trials in the biotech industry. Part of him nevertheless hankered for business. "It's in my nature to be my own boss, even as a sideline," he explains.

He last year acquired the first California franchise for PJ's Coffee and chose a Carmichael location. "I grew up in this area and I feel at home here," he says. Opening to hectic trade this week, the café didn't just deliver coffee, pastries and sandwiches; it greatly improved the look of its neighborhood. "Our building (a shuttered Mexican restaurant) had been empty for more than 10 years and it was an eyesore," says the entrepreneur. "The roof had fallen in and everything inside was trashed."

A licensed builder and indefatigable handyman, Phung tackled much of the rebuild. "The only thing that didn't need replacing was the tile floor," he says. "We're on one of the busiest corners in Sacramento. We're close

to freeway on-ramps and surrounded mostly by mom and pop operations. I like that -- family businesses are part of my culture."

In tune with a COVID world, Phung's café is drive-through only. He plans a sit-down patio for pedestrian customers and is meantime one of few local vendors with a window for sidewalk purchases. "Lots of workers walk during their lunch hour," explains the entrepreneur. "Why shouldn't they get walk-through coffee?"

Fifteen high school and college-age kids are his helpmates. "I hired people with no previous experience, because I wanted to train them myself," says the boss. "Our coffee has to taste consistent, whoever makes it. I also chose people with friendly personalities. I feel a cup of coffee gets you in a good mood to start your morning. Coffee and a good barista can make your day."

COVID-19 Vaccination Status in Sac County

Press Release by Sacramento County Public Health

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Sacramento County Public Health (SCPH) continues to create and refine its vaccine rollout action plan as conditions evolve. Currently, SCPH is vaccinating identified worker groups, primary front-line healthcare and first responders, in the Phase 1a: Tiers 1 - 3 with the limited vaccine allocations coming weekly from the State.

Outside of the doses that the State has sent to Hospitals/Multi-County Entities (MCEs), to date, SCPH has been allocated 10,500 doses of Moderna and 5,850 doses of Pfizer vaccines. So far, all but 1,235 of those doses have been administered to doctors, nurses, healthcare staff, correctional health staff, firefighters, EMTs, paramedics, long-term care facilities or given to other providers.

While demand far exceeds allocation, we are hopeful that allocations will drastically increase in the near future and we can envelop those residents 65 years old and older who are approved for vaccination, as well as other Phase 1b groups.

SCPH has 975 doses allocated for the week of Jan. 18. MCEs such as hospitals have also been provided a small allocation. Due to the limited amount, Sacramento County will not be able to accommodate all requests for vaccination between the continued need in Phase 1a frontline workers, as well as the addition of those who are 65 years old and older. We are also coming quickly upon the timeframe for the second dose for all our original vaccine recipients, which further limits our availability to bring in new recipients.

"We request patience as we work to navigate the rapidly changing landscape of vaccination best practices and availability," said Sacramento County Public Health Officer Dr. Olivia Kasirye. "We are working closely with health care providers, frontline employers and dozens of other public and private entities to ensure that anyone eligible and interested in the vaccine can receive it as soon as possible. We are closer than ever to COVID-19 immunizations for everyone who wants them, but we are not there yet."

At this time, we request that residents who are 65

Help for the Most Vulnerable

Sacramento County Homeless Resources

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Sacramento County approaches the homeless crisis as an engagement on a multitude of fronts, constantly fortifying and resupplying, and employing an arsenal of proven tactics. But the issues are multilayered and deeply complex, with no "one size fits all" fix. "Pathways into homelessness are interrelated with issues such as mental health, poverty and the lack of affordable housing," said Cindy Cavanaugh, the County's Director of Homeless Initiatives.

Conversely, escaping homelessness "requires collaborative contributions across government, and private and community partners," she said. It's this network of partnerships that helps "improve our overall system response."

One of the County's

partners is Sacramento Steps Forward (SSF), the federally designated lead agency for Sacramento Continuum of Care. SSF coordinates housing and services for the homeless in Sacramento.

"Sacramento Steps Forward partners with the community to achieve data-driven outcomes through collaborative

planning and coordinating the community's goal to end homelessness," said CEO Lisa Bates. "We help support the work of other agencies that have their boots on the ground. Collaboration requires us to honestly study our performance and build continuous learning, while being as adaptable and nimble as we can."

This approach is to connect those individuals and families to rehousing providers as quickly as possible, and to "provide additional support to programs and clients on their pathway to permanent housing" said Bates. "We play to our strengths and we're always stronger when we're united."

All Taxpayers Now Eligible for Identity Protection PINS

WASHINGTON, D.C. (MPG) - The Internal Revenue Service expanded the Identity Protection PIN Opt-In Program to all taxpayers who can verify their identities.

The Identity Protection PIN (IP PIN) is a six-digit code known only to the taxpayer and to the IRS. It helps prevent identity thieves from filing fraudulent tax returns using a taxpayer's personally identifiable information.

"This is a way to, in essence, lock your tax account, and the IP PIN serves as the key to opening that account," said IRS Commissioner Chuck Rettig. "Electronic returns that do not contain the correct IP PIN will be rejected, and paper returns will go through additional scrutiny for fraud."

The IRS launched the IP PIN program nearly a decade ago to protect confirmed identity theft victims from ongoing tax-related fraud. In recent years, the IRS expanded the program to specific states where taxpayers could voluntarily opt into the IP PIN program. Now, the voluntary program is going nationwide.

About the IP PIN Opt-In Program

Here are a few key things to know about the IP PIN Opt-In program: This is a voluntary program. You must pass a rigorous identity verification process. Spouses and dependents are eligible for an IP PIN if they can verify their identities. An IP PIN is valid for a calendar year. You must obtain a new IP PIN each filing season. The online IP PIN tool is offline between November and mid-January each year. Correct IP PINs must be entered on electronic and paper tax returns to avoid rejections and delays. Never share your IP PIN with anyone but your trusted tax provider. The IRS will never call, text or email requesting



your IP PIN. Beware of scams to steal your IP PIN. There currently is no opt-out option but the IRS is working on one for 2022.

How to get an IP PIN

Taxpayers who want an IP PIN for 2021 should go to IRS.gov/IPPIN and use the Get an IP PIN tool. This online process will require taxpayers to verify their identities using the Secure Access authentication process if they do not already have an IRS account. See IRS.gov/SecureAccess for what information you need to be successful. There is no need to file a Form 14039, an Identity Theft Affidavit, to opt into the program.

Once taxpayers have authenticated their identities, their 2021 IP PIN immediately will be revealed to them. Once in the program, this PIN must be used when prompted by electronic tax returns or entered by hand near the signature line on paper tax returns.

All taxpayers are encouraged to first use the online IP PIN tool to obtain their IP PIN. Taxpayers who cannot verify their identities online do have options.

Taxpayers whose adjusted gross income is \$72,000 or less may complete Form 15227, Application for an Identity Protection Personal Identification

Number, and mail or fax to the IRS. An IRS customer service representative will contact the taxpayer and verify their identities by phone. Taxpayers should have their prior year tax return at hand for the verification process.

Taxpayers who verify their identities through this process will have an IP PIN mailed to them the following tax year. This is for security reasons. Once in the program, the IP PIN will be mailed to these taxpayers each year.

Taxpayers who cannot verify their identities online or by phone and who are ineligible for file Form 15227 can contact the IRS and make an appointment at a Taxpayer Assistance Center to verify their identities in person. Taxpayers should bring two forms of identification, including one government-issued picture identification.

Taxpayers who verify their identities through the in-person process will have an IP PIN mailed to them within three weeks. Once in the program, the IP PIN will be mailed to these taxpayers each year.

No change for confirmed identity theft victims

Taxpayers who are confirmed identity theft victims or who have filed an identity theft affidavit because of suspected stolen identity refund fraud will automatically receive an IP PIN via mail once their cases are resolved. Current tax-related identity theft victims who have been receiving IP PINs via mail will experience no change.

The IRS also encourages tax professionals and employers to share information with taxpayers about the availability of the IP PIN. Tax professionals and employers can print or email Publication 5367 or share IRS social media/e-poster products. ★

The Sacramento County District Attorney's Office, Sacramento Police Department, Sacramento County Sheriff's Office, and Sacramento County Probation Department are proud to announce the 21st Annual Citizens Academy. The 2020 Citizens Academy was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, this year's program is being offered virtually.

The academy was created to improve communication, foster a better understanding and develop relationships between members of the criminal justice system and our citizens, including those from different ethnic, cultural and faith-based communities. In this time of social distancing, we felt it was important to offer the academy virtually this year so we can continue building and strengthening relationships with the community we serve."

There is NO cost to participants. The 10-week course is held Tuesday evenings starting April 6, 2021 to June 8, 2021, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. via Zoom.

Officer Involved Shooting at Cal Expo

K-9 Riley

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - At 10:07 p.m. on January 18, 2021, Sacramento County Sheriff's Office Deputies saw an occupied vehicle in a parking lot near Arden Way and Avondale Avenue that matched the description of a vehicle involved in a burglary series. Deputies initiated contact with the single occupant of the vehicle and were able to identify the subject as being on active parole. The subject became uncooperative and fled in his vehicle when deputies attempted to search the vehicle. A short pursuit ensued that terminated inside of the Cal Expo Complex located at 1600 Exposition Boulevard. The suspect vehicle became disabled after striking a curb and came to rest near a chain-link fence. Multiple patrol units gathered at the termination point to assist the initial deputies. Deputies gave several commands for the suspect to exit his vehicle and he refused.

Deputies deployed less-lethal "bean bag" rounds into the suspect vehicle's back window in an attempt to see inside. A K-9 handler deployed his K-9 into the back window of the vehicle at which time several shots were fired from within the vehicle. Two deputies and the canine were struck by the suspect's gunfire. Multiple deputies returned fire.

The wounded officers were transported by deputies in patrol units to an area hospital. Deputy Adam Gibson, a 31-year-old, 6 year veteran of the department, was pronounced deceased at the hospital. A second deputy was stabilized and transported to a trauma center for further treatment. K-9 Riley also died at the scene. K-9 Riley was 5 years old and had been in-service with our office for 3 years. Fire arrived and pronounced the sole occupant of the suspect vehicle deceased at the scene.

Homicide detectives and Crime Scene Investigators responded to the scene and began interviewing witnesses and processing evidence. This

investigation is still in its early stages and information is still developing. No further information is available at this time.

Deputy Gibson leaves behind his wife Rachel Gibson, 9-month-old child, his parents Doug and Sandee Gibson and several siblings. Deputy Gibson served in the United States Marine Corps and did two tours in Afghanistan. Since joining the department in 2014 he has worked in corrections, patrol and most recently a canine handler. Deputy Gibson received the Sheriff's Office Bronze Star for Bravery and a Major Incident Ribbon in 2018.

The wounded deputy is 43 years old, a 13 year veteran of the department and remains hospitalized in serious, but stable condition.

The Officer-Involved Shooting investigation will be conducted by the Sheriff's Professional Standards Division, which is standard practice for any officer-involved shooting. The Sacramento Police Department Homicide Division will investigate the remainder of the incident. Independent review of the officer-involved shooting will be conducted by the Sacramento County District Attorney's Office and the Inspector General.

Officer Involved Shooting Ranger Way and Rampart Drive

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - A little before 8:15 p.m. on January 15, 2021, members of the Sacramento County Sheriff's Gang Suppression Unit (GSU) were conducting a follow-up investigation regarding a possible gang-related shooting in the southern region of Sacramento County. During the investigation, evidence gathered led detectives to a location in Carmichael near Ranger Way and Rampart Drive.

Detectives located a vehicle connected to the investigation, occupied by at least two subjects. Gang Detectives attempted to contact the occupants of the vehicle. At some point during the contact, multiple shots were fired striking one detective and the suspect. Fire personnel responded; however, upon arrival, they pronounced the suspect deceased at the scene. The wounded detective was transported from the scene to an area hospital for treatment.

Multiple regional agencies assisted and established a perimeter of the surrounding area. Neighboring residents were advised to stay inside. After several hours of searching, the tactical teams were unable to locate any additional subjects involved in the incident.

Homicide detectives and Crime Scene Investigators responded to the scene and began interviewing witnesses and processing evidence. This investigation is still in its early stages and information

is still developing.

The wounded detective remains hospitalized in serious, but stable condition and is expected to survive. The detective is 47 years old and a 15-year veteran of the Sheriff's Office. The detective has held several assignments within the Sheriff's Office including his current assignment in the Gang Suppression Unit.

The other occupant of the vehicle during the time of the incident was arrested and later booked at Sacramento County Main Jail on felony charges unrelated to this incident.

The investigation into the incident will be conducted by the Sheriff's Homicide Bureau and Professional Standards Division, which is standard practice for any officer-involved shooting that occurs in the Sheriff's Office's jurisdiction. Independent review of the officer-involved shooting will be conducted by the Sacramento County District Attorney's Office and the Inspector General. In accordance with the Sheriff's Office's policies and procedures, the other detective involved in the shooting will be placed on paid administrative leave pending the investigation.

Scrambling for Shots

California Vaccine Chaos Amid Mixed Messaging

The chaos and confusion many Californians experienced this week in their search for a COVID-19 vaccine only intensified as Gov. Gavin Newsom revealed that the state would not receive an additional supply of doses it was counting on to accelerate vaccination.

Newsom said he, like other governors, expected about 50 million doses to be released from storage by the feds in the next few days. “And then we read, as everybody else, that they have reneged or ... are unable to deliver on that,” he said at a news conference unveiling a new mass vaccination site at Dodger Stadium.

The governor said he does expect there to be enough vaccine for Californians who already have received their first shot and need the required second dose. But the state needs to verify the supply it will be given, he said.

Federal officials had promised states an expanded supply of vaccine and demanded they start vaccinating people 65 and older and those with documented preexisting conditions to speed the slow pace of immunizations nationwide.

But a national stockpile of vaccines held back for necessary second doses appears to have been depleted, meaning that states won't get the amount of vaccine they were counting on to dramatically ramp up mass vaccination campaigns,

according to a Washington Post report Friday.

Newsom last week announced an audacious goal of immunizing 1 million people in 10 days, under mounting political pressure over the state's slow vaccine rollout. But at least 450,000 people would need to receive shots today to fulfill that goal. The state is on pace to achieve it, Newsom said, adding that there is a lag in the state's data reporting.

California has used about 30% of the doses it has been allocated from the federal government while Texas has

used about 55%, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. California ranks 43rd among states in the proportion of people it has immunized.

On Wednesday, following hastily-announced federal guidance, Newsom said that anyone 65 and older could now be immunized — broadening a complicated priority system that previously reserved doses for health workers and nursing home residents.

Local public health officials and health systems weren't at all ready for an

onslaught of potentially 6 million seniors. Not all adopted the state's recommendation, creating a patchwork of access that Californians are now trying to decipher.

Reports of glitches mounted as counties launched dozens of different online platforms for appointment sign-ups and waiting lists. Tiny Inyo County, with about 18,000 residents, had to ask people to sign up with just a Google form.

Californians across the state reported finding every appointment taken online and voiced their outrage on

social media. They held on phone lines for hours. Their bewilderment and frustration only grew as they learned that some vaccination sites would only accept people 75 and older, while some would accept those 65 and above. And some still would only immunize health workers because they didn't have enough doses for everyone.

“Any rollout like this is bound to run into snags, but this level of problems is concerning,” said Dorit Rubinstein Reiss, professor and vaccine expert at UC Hastings College of Law.

“Every day we wait, thousands of people are at risk of dying.”

The state's public health agency reported 42,655 new cases and 637 deaths as a more infectious “U.K.” coronavirus variant spreads across California and nationwide. About 32 cases of the variant have been reported in California, more than any other state, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

California continues its winter surge — the worst since the pandemic started. About 13% of tests are coming back positive, although hospitalizations are beginning to decrease slightly, according to the latest state data.

Leah Russin, co-founder of the advocacy group Vaccinate California, empathized with local public health officials who, she said, have been asked to roll out mass vaccination campaigns at the same time as they're battling the worst surge of the pandemic. But Californians deserve better, she said.

“It feels like some decisions have been made that haven't been thoroughly explained and they may increase inequity or confusion. Neither of those things are good at a time when we're fighting against extraordinary mistrust of government,” said Leah Russin, co-founder of Vaccinate California.

“We have to be exceedingly transparent and do it fast, without mistakes. I know I'm asking us to be amazing, but we have to be.”

Budget Priorities: Reopen Schools, Help Small Businesses and Fix EDD

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Governor Gavin Newsom unveiled his \$ 227.2 billion budget proposal. The state is unexpectedly receiving between \$15* billion to \$26** billion in additional one-time revenue. Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama), Vice Chair of the Senate Budget & Fiscal Review Committee, issued the following statement:

“This one-time money must be spent on one-time expenses to help those most harmed by COVID-19 – children, mom-and-pop shops and those struggling with joblessness. The state continues to face ongoing budget deficits despite the current unexpected revenue.

“Children are not learning. They have not seen the inside of a classroom for eight months. Many are failing and facing mental health challenges. Parents are at their wit’s end trying to work and provide for their children’s instruction.

come first. Schools must open safely regardless of the demands of the adults involved. There is no equity when private schools are open, and public schools are not. The vast majority of families cannot afford to have independent child care or arrange for pods with private tutors.

“Millions of Californians are jobless. Countless small businesses have permanently closed including 40,000 restaurants, and many more are on the brink of closing.

“EDD must be fixed to ensure that Californians receive the help they need.

“California must be a state that enables entrepreneurs and businesses to create jobs for our people.”

What’s Next?

Cindy Cavanaugh, Sacramento County’s Director of Homeless Initiatives, points out that

while the pandemic has brought extraordinary challenges to delivering homeless services, it has resulted in “an unprecedented collaborative response that scaled new interventions in outreach and rehousing services.”

For instance, the Sacramento COVID-19 Response Team provided services to more than 1,000 individuals, more than half over age 55 and a quarter of whom had never before received services from the homeless system.

While the Response Team’s first phase “was about saving lives and ensuring safety, we have now shifted the focus from temporary to permanent solutions,” Cavanaugh says. That includes housing.

Sacramento County and its partners will continue to work with rehousing providers “to resolve barriers, improve connections with property owners, and find new ways to connect people to permanent housing and stabilizing services.”

Draft Climate Action Plan Available in February

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - County staff is hard at work on a Communitywide Climate Action Plan (CAP) that aims to significantly reduce greenhouse gas emissions and prepare the county for climate-related impacts for decades to come.

The Sacramento County Office of Planning and Environmental Review expects the draft CAP will be available for public review sometime in February. A virtual public meeting is also in the works. You can be among the first to see it by signing up for email or text alerts.

Climate change is expected to affect the region in a variety of ways: Hotter temperatures and more extreme heat events; increased wildfire risks; unpredictable rainfall and flood; reduced snowpack and impacts to the water supply, among others.

As proposed, the Communitywide Climate Action Plan will serve as a policy and technical document that determines greenhouse gas reduction targets and proposes measures to reach those reductions.

“Our goal is to have an implementable community-wide plan that provides meaningful and equitable climate action, enhances resiliency and provides a transparent and public path for future plan performance and adaptive management,” said Principal Planner Todd Smith.

Following public review, staff hopes to get the revised plan before the Board of Supervisors by the summer of 2021.

The Board of Supervisors adopted the Climate Action Plan – Government Operations in 2012. This plan covered Sacramento County measures to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, including converting the county’s light-duty vehicles fleet to hydrogen or hybrid fuel cell (electric) vehicles.

Presentations from past public workshops and Board of Supervisors meetings that give examples of some of the concepts under consideration are available on the Planning and Environmental Review website.

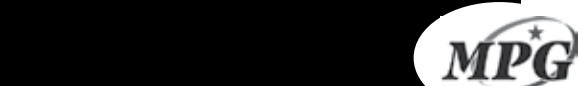

U.S. forces choppered into Syria 24 hours after new commander-in-chief takes power | 22 Jan 2021 | A large convoy of U.S. military personnel headed into Syria on Thursday along with hundreds of troops some 24 hours after President [sic] Joe Biden took office and took on his commander-in-chief role, foreign media reported. Citing Syrian state news agency SANA, i24 News reported that a convoy of about 40 trucks and armored vehicles "entered northeastern Syria" on Thursday supported by helicopters. The convoy entered the country from Iraq via the al-Waleed crossing "to bring arms and logistical equipment to bases in Hasakeh and Deir Ezzor provinces," i23 News stated. And while "other local media" noted that such resupply convoys are not uncommon, SANA's report added that an additional 200 U.S. troops were choppered into the Hasakeh province as well.

Biden Nullifies Trump Executive Order Issued to Reduce Prices of Insulin and Epinephrine | 22 Jan 2021 | The Biden government has nullified an executive order signed by President Trump reducing the prices of insulin and epinephrine for American consumers, in a move that will be cheered on by Biden's many Big Pharma donors. Biden's Health and Human Service (DHHS) announced they are freezing the order until at least March on Thursday. The Trump order mandated for community health centers to pass all discount savings down to the consumers, but this crucial reform is no longer in effect. "On January 20, Donald Trump will become the Commander-in-Chief of a different army," the slightly over two-minute clip begins. The words "This army" are then displayed as Trump supporters in Washington, DC, flash on the screen. The threat addressed is described as emanating from "radical" conservatives who live among us. The clip continues: "The greatest threat facing America today comes from within: radical extreme conservatives, also known as domestic terrorists. They're hidden among us, disguised behind regular jobs. They are your children's teachers. They work at supermarkets, malls, doctor's offices, and many are police officers and soldiers." The video, which has received over 3.5 million views since, then claims that the president will begin a civil war once out of office and that ordinary citizens must "fight back." ... "We have to fight back," the clip continues. "In this new war, the battlefield has changes. Computers can be more valuable than guns. And this is what we need now more than ever: an army of citizen detectives."

President Trump Gives Permission for US Troops to Stay at Trump Hotel in Washington, DC | 22 Jan 2021 | As reported earlier, A military source in DC told TPUSA Chief Creative Officer Benny Johnson that for the last week his battalion had been sleeping on the floor in the Senate cafeteria in preparation for Biden's sham inauguration. One day after Biden's inauguration, 5,000 soldiers were moved to a cold parking garage. There is one power outlet and one bathroom for 5,000 soldiers. ★

After Covid-19, Drought Threat Still Looms

California is enveloped in balmy weather that's more like spring than mid-winter – and that's not a good thing.

We have seen only scant rain and snow this winter, indicating that the state may be experiencing one of its periodic droughts and adding another layer of crisis to the COVID-19 pandemic and economic recession.

The all-important Sierra snowpack, California's primary source of water, is scarcely half of what is deemed a normal depth.

"The snow survey results reflect California's dry start to the water year and provide an important reminder that our state's variable weather conditions are made more extreme by climate change," the state director of water resources, Karla Nemeth, said after the disappointing Dec. 30 snowpack survey. State Water Project customers have been told to expect only 10% of their requested allotments in 2021.

The state is so dry that this week Southern California Edison and Pacific Gas and Electric temporarily interrupted power to thousands of customers, fearing that high winds could down power lines and spark devastating fires.

Gov. Gavin Newsom's new budget, unveiled this month, warns that California, already hit by devastating wildfires in recent years, is in grave danger.

"In 2020, 9,000 wildfires burned over 4 million acres across the state, more than the 2017 and 2018 fire seasons combined and significantly higher than the most recent five-year average of acres burned," the budget says in proposing new firefighting expenditures. "Hotter, drier conditions in the state's forests, driven by climate change and the consequences of a century-old legacy of fire suppression, have generated unparalleled fuel conditions that result in significant wildfire risk."

The situation is a reminder that although pandemic and recession dominate Californians' consciousness now, with good reason, older threats still must be confronted.

Clearing fuel, "hardening" communities against wildfires and expanding firefighting capabilities are all expensive necessities, as the budget proposes. At the same time, we must also build more resilience into a water supply dangerously dependent on an assumption that winter storms will always refill the natural reservoirs of mountain snowpacks.

With climate change, even normal levels of precipitation will be more in the form of rain and less in the form of snow, thus reducing that natural reservoir. Therefore, we must, in addition to pursuing water-saving and reuse strategies, create more storage.

Traditionally, storage has meant building dams to hold back and store river flows, such as Shasta Dam on the Sacramento River and Oroville Dam on the Feather River. There are proposals to continue that approach, such as raising Shasta to increase storage capacity or building Temperance Flat on the San Joaquin River.

However, such projects generate so much opposition due to their effects on river flows and wildlife habitat that they have only tiny chances of becoming reality.

Restoring much-depleted aquifers in the San Joaquin Valley is a more politically acceptable option, as is constructing more off-stream storage like the 63-year-old San Luis Reservoir in the Pacheco Pass. A San Luis-like project called Sites Reservoir seems to be gaining traction after sitting on the shelf for decades.

Sites, on the west side of Glenn and Colusa counties, would store excess flows on the Sacramento River from winter rains and then release water back into the Sacramento as needed. Recently reduced in scope and cost, it has received planning funds in the most recent pandemic relief and economic stimulus packages passed by Congress.

Once COVID-19 is behind us, if it ever is, we need to move quickly to prevent the ecological, economic and human disasters that prolonged drought would wrought.
