**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Marcy Friedman began 2020 with new honors and new love. One of Carmichael's most famous residents, the artist/philanthropist married high school sweetheart Paul Kaufmann on New Year's Eve. To cap her happiness, she will be honored as

Carmichael's Person of the Year on March 20.

The event is a fundraiser for the Carmichael Chamber of Commerce. Friedman is the surviving half of a partnership synonymous with philanthropy. She was married for 58 years to business and legal legend, Mort Friedman, who died in 2012. In the late 1980s, he transformed Arden Fair Mall into a commercial

landmark, remaining a monument to the Friedman family vision.

Arts, education and human causes were Mort and Marcy's philanthropic passions. Their \$10 million donation to the Crocker Art Museum enabled expansion that improved the institution for perpetuity. Arcade's Shalom School would not exist in its present state

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## State Health Officials Ramp Up Response

**California Department of Public Health Press Release**

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - As the spread of COVID-19, the disease caused by novel coronavirus, continues worldwide, the State of California announced a broad series of new actions designed to protect public health and safety.

Governor Gavin Newsom is requesting the Legislature make up to \$20 million available from the Disaster Response Emergency Operations Account, which will allow state government to respond to the spread of COVID-19. This will be an early action item for the 2020-2021 budget.

Additionally, Governor Newsom has activated the State Operations Center (SOC) in Mather, California, to its second highest level to support state, federal and local emergency managers, public health officials and first responders. The SOC will provide operational and logistical support to the California Department of Public Health's Medical and Health Coordination Center (MHCC). The MHCC has been activated since January to coordinate California's public health response to COVID-19.

Also, California received additional COVID-19 test kits from the CDC, allowing California to test thousands of specimens. These resources, which were requested by the governor last week, will help California medical experts get test results sooner, so they can identify and treat cases, trace potential exposures and better protect public health.

Receiving these new test kits has significantly increased the state's capacity to process specimens and quickly identify new positive cases so affected individuals can be isolated.

Ten California public health labs have already received CDC test kits and have begun testing. These labs include CDPH's Laboratory in Richmond, Alameda, Contra Costa, Sacramento, Santa Clara, Tulare, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego County labs. The CDPH Laboratory will provide diagnostic testing within a 48-hour turnaround time. More public health labs will soon be able to test, ramping up to a total of 20 public health labs in California in the coming weeks.

While additional positive tests continue to be reported by county health officers, state officials emphasized that these reports show swift and robust action is being taken to detect cases early, isolate and care for patients, and trace contacts.

**CHP Investigation Leads to Multiple Arrests**

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The California Highway Patrol (CHP) Valley Division Investigative Services Unit (ISU) announced their investigators have made arrests in a felony hit and run collision that occurred on January 12, 2020, in Orangevale, CA, resulting in the death of one of the passengers.



was transported to Mercy San Juan Medical Center for treatment. The left rear passenger sustained injuries to his upper body and was transported to Sutter Roseville Medical Center for treatment of his injuries.

The investigation into the cause of the collision determined that for unknown reasons, the right front passenger Morrison grabbed the steering wheel turning the vehicle to the right causing the collision.

At approximately 1:30 a.m., Brandon D. Reyes-Langsjoen was driving a 2016 Volkswagen Passat westbound Madison Avenue, east of Main Avenue with Cayleh A. Morrison seated in the right front seat. Three passengers were in the rear seat of the Passat at the time of the collision. The vehicle was traveling at approximately 80 miles per hour when the Passat turned sharply to the right, struck two metal poles and a fire hydrant before it came to rest.

Immediately following the collision, Reyes-Langsjoen fled from the scene on foot. As a result of this collision, Cayleh A. Morrison sustained major injuries and was transported to Mercy San Juan Medical Center. The right rear passenger was ejected from the vehicle and sustained fatal injuries to his upper body and

Reyes-Langsjoen (24 years old out of Sacramento, CA) presented himself to authorities and was arrested and booked at the Sacramento County Jail for CA Vehicle Code Section 20001 (a) - Felony Hit and Run Involving Death. The right front passenger Morrison (22 years old out of Sacramento, CA) was charged and booked at the El Dorado County Jail for CA Penal Code Section 191.5 (a) - Gross Vehicular Manslaughter and CA Vehicle Code Section 23153 (a) - Felony Driving Under the Influence Causing Injury.

Valley Division would like to express their heartfelt condolences to the victim's family and friends and would like to thank the public for their support and assistance with the apprehension of the two subjects.

dition of benevolence; she also channeled her formidable energy into painting. Romance beckoned in her eighth year of widowhood.

A lifetime before, Marcy (Lichter) and Paul Kaufmann dated as seniors at Punahou High School, Honolulu. After graduation, they said Aloha nui loa. She headed for Stanford University and he entered the US Coastguard Academy in Connecticut. Kaufmann later began a company that pioneered oil-spill cleanup. Like his teenage sweetheart, he had married, raised a family and eventually lost his spouse to illness by the time the two widows reconnected last year. Old flames soon rekindled.

Celebrated at Marcy's riverside home, their wedding was a tropical interlude in midwinter. The newlyweds sported

Hawaiian leis. The petite bride bespoke a gown of hibiscus-red appliqued lace. Glasses were raised on New Year's Eve and set down in the decade that followed. Previously a Bay Area man, the groom now has a Carmichael address. "It's one thing to wake up every morning to the joy of a sunrise over the river," says his bride. 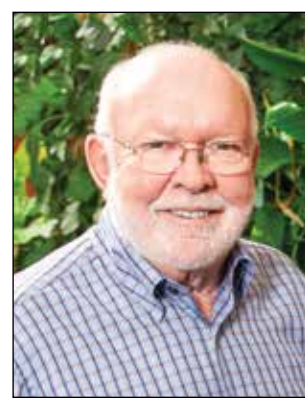

# State Health Officials Ramp Up Response

"These new cases were quickly identified and isolated thanks to the increased testing capacity and aggressive contact tracing deployed by state and local public health departments in partnership with the CDC," said California Health and Human Services Secretary Dr. Mark Ghaly. "Quickly identifying and tracing positive cases is helping us better understand and slow the spread of the virus. As testing and contact tracing continues in the coming days, CDPH expects there will be more California cases identified."

Dr. Ghaly also underscored that there are

simple steps we can all take to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Wash your hands with soap and warm water. Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands. Stay home from work or school if you become sick with respiratory symptoms like a fever and cough. Avoid close contact with people who are sick. Follow guidance from public health officials.

It is also important that anyone experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, call their health care provider first before seeking medical care so that appropriate precautions can be taken. ★

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The initial Annual Percentage Rate (APR) is currently 4.25% for a new Home Equity Line of Credit (HELOC), and is fixed for the first 5 years of the loan which is called the draw period. After the initial 5 year period, the APR can change once based on the value of an Index and Margin. The Index is the weekly average yield on U.S. Treasury Securities adjusted to a constant maturity of 10 years and the margin is 3.50%. The current APR for the repayment period is 5.00%. 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# Stabbing in Carmichael, 2 Killed and 2 Wounded

By Sergeant Tess Deterding, Sacramento County Sheriff's Office

**CARMICHAEL CA, (MPG)** - At approximately 4 p.m. on February 28, 2020, the Sheriff's Communication Center received a call from the 3600 block of Mission Avenue in North Sacramento. The caller stated a client was stabbing people.

Deputies arrived and observed multiple people running from the Wellness and Recovery Center business yelling that people had been stabbed. Upon entering the business, they located several victims suffering from multiple stab wounds. Two people, one adult male and one adult female, were pronounced deceased at the scene. An adult male suffering from at least one stab wound to his upper body and an adult female with multiple stab wounds to her upper body were transported to area hospitals. They are expected to survive.

The suspect, who has been identified as 39 year-old Martin Raymond Lackey-Garcia, was taken into custody without incident. He has been booked into the Sacramento County Main Jail on charges related to this investigation.

The exact motive is unknown at this time.
