**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - The Sacramento Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution laid a wreath on the Sacramento Historic City Cemetery grave of William S. Hamilton, son of Founding Father Alexander Hamilton, on December 9, 2019. William S. Hamilton came to California for the Gold Rush and died in 1850 of cholera.

"It isn't commonly known that the son of one of our Founding Fathers is buried in Sacramento," stated Emily Browne, Chapter Regent, of Carmichael. "The musical, Hamilton, introduced a new generation to

Alexander Hamilton. We hope that introduction creates interest in learning more about the men and women who sacrificed everything for the promise offered by the United States of America," she continued. Janet Fulton, Sacramento Chapter Historic Preservation Committee Chair, of Davis, added, "The Sacramento Chapter has maintained William S. Hamilton's grave for almost 100 years. It is located in a beautiful cemetery, surrounded by the graves of California and Sacramento pioneers. A visit to honor William S. Hamilton can be a fascinating adventure."

The grave of William S. Hamilton is found in Hamilton Square within the Sacramento Historic City Cemetery,

1000 Broadway, Sacramento.

## Challenges During the Holiday Season

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - There is a lot going on around the holidays! Whether it's the parties, shopping, buying gifts or participating in family get-togethers, there is immense pressure to partake in the holiday cheer.

For those living with mental illness, the stress and pressure of the holidays can often cause increased anxiety, depression or worsen other mental health symptoms. According to the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), 64% of people with mental illness report holidays make their conditions worse. In addition, many holiday events include and even focus on alcohol consumption, which can be a particularly challenging time for sobriety for people in recovery.

In Sacramento County alone, it is estimated that nearly 300,000 residents are living with a mental illness, which means we all need to bring understanding and kindness to each other and ourselves as we greet this holiday season.

Laura Bemis, a member of the Stop Stigma Sacramento Speaker's Bureau, on behalf of the Sacramento County "Mental Illness: It's not always what you think" project shares her coping strategies. "The holiday season can be very stressful and depressing for me and for others like me who are living with mental illness. Even though I have a fulfilling life, the holidays make me think of my family and how much I miss them. I lost both my parents to cancer and both my sisters took their lives. To cope, I have made a 'new' family with close friends, who now ARE my family and help me feel connected during the holiday season. By keeping active, giving back to the community, and spending time with my 'homemade' family, these are some of the coping strategies that help me get through the season - and not just making it bearable, but enjoyable. I will always miss my immediate family, but through my friends, taking care of myself and using my coping skills, I am able to see just how blessed I am."

It's also important to remember that for people in recovery, the holidays can be a particularly challenging time for their sobriety. You can help those in recovery during the holiday season by demonstrating understanding and support - and even consider planning a sober holiday event or one where overindulgence is limited.

## Adoption Event Joy, But More Youth Need Families

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - Sacramento Superior Court and Sacramento County collaborated to host a National Adoption Day event at the William R. Ridgeway Family Relations Courthouse on Saturday, Nov. 23, 2019. By the end of this special day, 54 children from foster care finalized their adoptions into 42 families - each finding their forever home.

"This has been a joyous event for every child and family. However, right now, roughly 350 foster children still need forever homes," said, Michelle Callejas, director of the Sacramento County Department of Child, Family and Adult Services. "This day is a great reminder to community members that they can become a resource or adoptive parent and open their homes and hearts to foster

On the day of the event, the courthouse, normally serious, instead buzzed with excitement and jubilation of children excited to embrace their new families. Suzzanne Goldwire, a Resource Parent many times, who after fostering Jessi and Tianna for

10 months, celebrated at the Adoption Day event with hugs and poignant tears as she took the final step to welcome Jessi and Tianna into their forever family with the rest of her family and grandchildren present in support.

"Today is the day I

adopted Tianna and Jessi. I've been fostering them for 10 months... and now we just made it official and they fit right in with my nine grandkids. It's important that the kids know that they can be loved even though they are not your biological child,"

# New NASA Hubble Exhibit Launches at the Aerospace Museum

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - The air is cool and still. Lights from illuminated panels give off an unearthly glow as the soft whine of computers suspend the passing of time. Hushed voices can be heard discussing stardust and light waves and the edge of charted space. Have you stumbled upon a secret governmental lab? A starship pulled from science-fiction? No, you're at the Aerospace Museum of California, in the midst of the official NASA Hubble Space Telescope Traveling Exhibit!

Blast off to the Aerospace Museum this holiday season and be a part of history as the NASA Hubble Space Telescope Traveling Exhibit debuts for the first time in California! Experience the magnificence and mystery of the Hubble Space Telescope and its unique mission through interactive stations, guided tours and engaging activities for explorers of all ages! Visitors are invited to explore the vast reaches of space through Hubble's iconic images, learn the history and purpose of this technological marvel in a space station environment, and look to the future of space exploration with the James Webb Telescope.

The Exhibit features a 1:15 scale model of the Hubble Space Telescope, a real-time GeoSphere that displays earthly phenomena and a collection of tools that have actually flown into space to serve one of five servicing missions Hubble has required since its launch in 1990. Visitors will experience a deeper appreciation for Hubble's mission and a sense of child-like wonder at the sheer size

To promote STEM Education in the local community, the Aerospace Museum has partnered with SMUD to contribute \$25,000 in sponsorships, transportation funding, teacher memberships and educational resources for local students in underserved communities to experience this once-in-a-lifetime STEM education opportunity.

The Aerospace Museum of California is a private 501(c)(3) nonprofit foundation located in McClellan, CA. Visitors experience aviation history and aerospace science in an interactive setting. With a 4-acre airpark and rotating exhibits, families engage with STEM activities for all ages and let their imaginations soar. # Board Approves Inspector General Candidate

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to approve the selection of a new Inspector General for Sacramento County and for the County Executive to begin contract negotiations for Mark Evenson to serve in that position.

"Following a nationwide search,

I'm pleased to say that we have identified a qualified candidate," said Board Chair and District Two Supervisor Patrick Kennedy. "We look forward to welcoming Mark Evenson in his role as Inspector General and his work in providing good oversight and accountability."

The Office of Inspector General was created to facilitate the Board of Supervisors' responsibility to oversee without interfering with the Sheriff's investigative or personnel

deployment functions.

The Inspector General ensures the integrity of the citizen complaint process and the thoroughness and fairness of related Sheriff's Department investigations, while fostering positive relations with the community. The Inspector General works independently on items detailed in the scope of services. In addition, the Inspector General may investigate other non-personnel matters as requested by the County

Executive or a majority of the Board of Supervisors. The Inspector General will present recommendations relating to these examinations to the Board of Supervisors, County Executive and the Sheriff.

Evenson is an experienced police executive with 32 years of law enforcement experience. Of those years, 20 were in middle and senior management levels, and 10 years were as Chief of Police for the City of Brentwood.

Additionally, Evenson has extensive experience as an Internal Affairs investigator, a commander and has demonstrated leadership success in police accountability, citizen complaint investigations and community/police relations.

The Office of the Inspector General is a contract position. A start date for the Inspector General will be announced when contract negotiations are complete and there is a signed contract. ★

# Bard's Birthday Celebrated with Scottish Supper

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - Sacramento Scotophiles will kick up their heels on Saturday, January 18. Hosted by the St Andrews Society, an annual Robbie Burns Supper will gather clans at the Northridge Country Club (Fair Oaks).

Robbie Burns (aka the Bard of Scotland) lived a short but glorious life that began on January 25, 1759. Scots all over the world annually celebrate his birthday as close to the auspicious date as possible and Burns Suppers have become a proud institution of Scottish life. St Andrews Society members will celebrate their hero's legacy with solemn adherence to tradition. Their formal supper (kilts and sporrans will be worn) is open to the public. However, a high tolerance for bagpipes is suggested.

Under the Scottish hosts' supervision, Northridge chefs will prepare roast beef with tatties and neeps (potatoes mashed with turnip). The arrival of the haggis is a ceremonial high point. This concoction of sheep innards and

oatmeal, stitched up in a sheep's stomach, is fanfared by bagpipes. Whisky toasts are offered and Burns' "Address to a Haggis" (in which poet Burns hails Scotland's famous delicacy as the "great chieftain o' the puddin' race"), is recited. The event's puddin' is imported from an Oregon sheep meat specialist.

"We've used this haggis-maker before and he does a beautiful job," says St Andrew's Society president Bruce Locken. "We put two pounds of the pudding on every table and we don't have leftovers - in fact, people fight for the last bite."

Bagpipers, Highland dancers and a choir will further entertain the gathering. Celebrations begin with a social hour at 4 pm. Tickets are \$65 per person and proceeds benefit Celtic arts scholarships offered by the St Andrews Society. Northridge Country Club is located at 7600 Madison Avenue, Fair Oaks. said Suzanne. When asked about the upcoming holidays, Suzanne said, "I'm excited about expanding the family and having everybody get together... this Thanksgiving will be extra special because I've added two kids to our family - and now they are official with us - I'm thankful for that."

At the event when asked about the process to foster/adopt, Suzanne shared that the process was easy and the agency will walk people through the process. Data shows that outcomes for foster youth improve greatly with the permanency of a family. Resource parents and their families make a vital

and positive difference in the lives of foster children by providing love, parental care, guidance and stability to children until they can either return to their parents or provide a permanent home through adoption or legal guardianship. Anyone able to provide a loving and affirming home can become a resource parent - and there is a tremendous need for resource families for teens, LGBTQ youth, African-American children, sibling sets, children with medical needs, and emergency, short-term placements and homes.

While reuniting children with their biological families is the primary goal, when reunification is

not possible, Sacramento County staff can help resource parents to adopt or to provide legal guardianship. Sacramento County supports, trains and offers guidance, resources and assistance to resource families to make sure the journey is a positive transition.

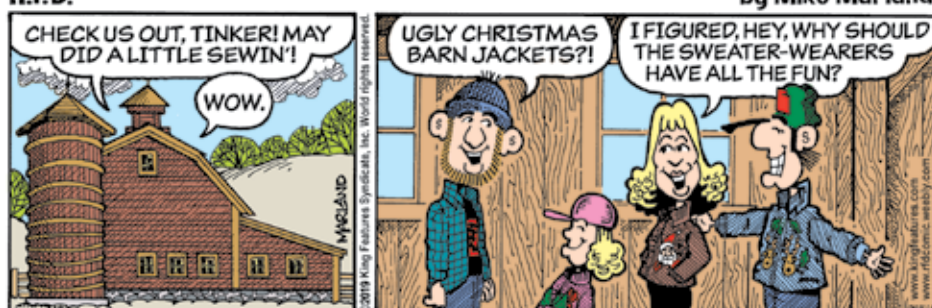

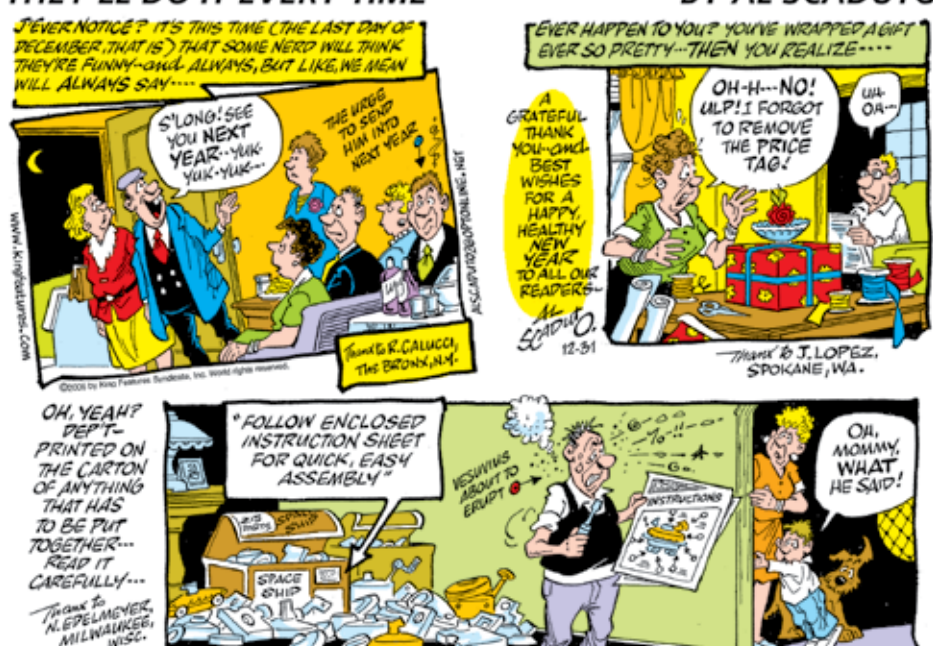

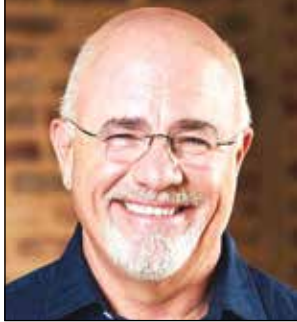

Dear Meg, If you know me, you probably have a good idea what's coming next. I'm not a huge fan of layaway programs, because they're not the answer to a problem. I mean, *Christmas* comes at the same time every year. It's not like it

snuck up on you. What's wrong with just saving up money for Christmas ahead of time?

Here's a good rule of thumb: if you don't have the money on hand, you can't afford it. Now, sometimes there are instances when certain popular items are on sale, and you can take advantage of them through layaway if you don't have enough cash at that very moment. I don't have a huge problem with this sort of thing, as long as it's not habitual behavior, and you're already saving money and you're already saving money with fees attached.

It may be too late to budget for this Christmas, but I want you to make plans to start living on a written, monthly budget in January. Make it a resolution! Give every dollar a

name, on paper, before the upcoming month begins. You can include Christmas spending in those monthly budgets, too. If you set aside a little bit each month from January until next December, you won't have to worry about layaways or Christmas debt.

Remember, Christmas is about God and it's about love. There are many, many ways to bless people and make them happy without overextending yourself financially!

# The Senate's New Drug Bill is Socialism Lite

House Speaker Nancy Pelosi has a radical new plan to let the federal government set drug prices.

Republicans are holding up Senator Chuck Grassley's Prescription Drug Pricing Reduction Act as a more moderate

alternative.

That's a mistake. While Grassley's bill isn't as radical as the Pelosi's, it includes similarly dangerous reforms. Neither bill would do much to save patients money. And both would make it harder for Americans to access new drugs.

Pelosi's bill empowers government officials to set prices for a variety of drugs. The bill instructs the Secretary of Health and Human Services to "negotiate" the prices of up to 250 medicines.

These negotiations would hardly be fair. The bill caps the negotiated prices at 120 percent of the average price paid for these drugs in six other countries. Any

company that refused to negotiate would have to pay the government 65 percent of last year's sales for the drug in question.

Grassley's bill also contains its fair share of government price setting. Like the section that prohibits drug companies from raising Medicare prices faster than the rate of inflation. Firms that raise prices too quickly would have to pay a rebate to the government, equal to the difference between the old and new prices.

Like all price setting, this so-called "inflation penalty" would prohibit drug companies from setting market prices. But that won't lower costs for patients. Over time, companies will begin

launching drugs with artificially high prices, to avoid having to raise prices and face the penalty down the line.

The Senate plan would also tax manufacturers for certain drugs sold in Medicare Part D. Once Part D beneficiaries spend \$5,100 out of pocket on prescriptions, the government begins paying for the majority of each drug they take. Under Grassley's bill, drug makers would have to pay for 20 percent of each drug sold in this "catastrophic phase."

But most Part D beneficiaries never reach the catastrophic phase. So this reform won't do anything to lower their drug costs. In other words, the

government is the primary beneficiary of this new tax on drug makers.

The Senate bill would raise taxes on pharmaceutical firms by \$100 billion. And as any Republican senator should know, raising taxes is bad for business.

This is especially true for the drug industry, where developing just one new medicine costs an average of \$2.6 billion. The more money researchers have to fork over to Uncle Sam, the less they'll have to spend on research.

Price setting also makes it harder for patients to access new drugs. Consider that Americans had access to almost 90 percent of all new medicines released between 2011 and 2018.

Meanwhile, patients in the United Kingdom only had access to 59 percent of those drugs. Canadian patients had access to just 46 percent.

Grassley's plan may be a slightly better alternative to Pelosi's. But watered-down socialism is still socialism and would be equally disastrous in the long run. Let's hope Republicans come to their senses and drop this bill before it's too late.
