

The Flu Has **Had Serious** Consequences in Sac County

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The flu season is already in full swing in Sacramento County. With these flu cases increasing so early in the season, Sacramento County Public Health urges everyone to prioritize getting the flu shot now to protect you and your family from the deadly virus.

Since the beginning of this year's flu season, 12 flu cases have been admitted to the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) in Sacramento County and Public Health has received reports confirming influenza has claimed the life of a Sacramento County 66-year-old, as well as a 7-year-old who had multiple underlying medical conditions. This is the second pediatric death in California for the 2019/20 flu season.

Getting vaccinated is the best defense against the flu, but it takes a couple of weeks after vaccination for the body to build immunity. The strains of influenza that are circulating in Sacramento County this season are Influenza B, which is most prevalent among the cases (ICU and deaths, all ages) reported to Public Health, and Influenza A (not subtyped and subtype H1N1 and H3N2). The flu vaccine, which is readily available, covers the strains of the flu that have been detected in Sacramento County.

California The Department of Public Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommend annual influenza vaccinations for everyone six months of age and older - including pregnant women - who do not have medical contraindication to receiving the vaccine.

A person's decision to receive the flu vaccination or not affects the entire community - especially those who medically cannot have the flu vaccine. Those who have regular contact with people more vulnerable to the complications of flu - including babies, children with chronic health conditions such as asthma and diabetes, and adults 65 years and older - should get vaccinated so the flu virus isn't spread to them.

"Everyone in the community, who can get vaccinated, should get vaccinated. Vaccination is the best protection against the flu, which is a preventable illness," Sacramento County Public Health Continued on page 8

Open Enrollment for District Residents Now Underway

San Juan Unified School District

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - We would like to inform all residents of San Juan Unified School District that our annual Open Enrollment lottery for the school year of 2020-2021 is held between Monday, Dec. 2 at 8 a.m. through Friday, Jan. 17 at 5 p.m.

Open enrollment is a process to request a school other than your neighborhood school or to return to your neighborhood school following a transfer. Once you receive your open enrollment results, you will either be assigned to your school of choice (which becomes your residence school) or placed on the waiting list for that site. ALL waiting lists expire on Dec. 31 each year. Open enrollment is NOT on a first-come, first-served basis. A computerized random selection will determine which students are accepted for their choice schools.

Additionally, schools across the district are going to be hosting information nights for interested families. Visitations and tours give parents an opportunity to explore the school and classrooms. Some schools combine information and visitation events, and we highly encourage you to visit and learn more about what San Juan Unified School District has to offer. Families who reside in San Juan Unified School District's boundaries have the opportunity to enroll students in any of the district's schools providing:

Space is available in the appropriate program. (Available space is determined by defined physical and program capacity of the school after placement of enrolled resident students) AND;

You would like your student to attend a school other than your current school of

You would like your student who currently attends a K-6 or K-8 school to attend 6th grade at a middle school;

You would like your student to attend any of the following schools: Cowan Fundamental, Dewey Fundamental, Green Oaks Fundamental, Cambridge Heights Open, Mission Avenue Open, Orangevale Open (K-8), Arcade Fundamental (6-8), El Camino Fundamental (9-12);

Your student was overloaded to the school they currently attend, you have not submitted an intradistrict transfer, and you would like for him/her to remain at the overloaded site;

Your student is currently enrolled in a Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program at a school site other than your resident school and you would like them to continue at the same site for Kindergarten;

San Juan Unified residents may apply online for any currently enrolled student if they have access to the Parent Portal or they may submit an open enrollment application to the San Juan Central office, located at 3700 Garfield Ave. in Carmichael. CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - "2020 is a decision year for the Sacramento Bee." said Sacramento Bee columnist Marcos Breton–the invited guest at the Carmichael Chamber Luncheon on Tuesday, November 29.

Breton was referring to the recent financial situation at McClatchy Company-parent company of the Sacramento Bee. "It's been happening in many communities that they are losing the newspaper platform," he said, concerned with the industry-wide decline of newsprint which worsened in a decade of national economic decline, shifting advertising trends and internet competition.

Until 2006, The Sacramento Bee had been growing economically and becoming the head of one of America's largest news corporations, but few knew that the Great Recession was just around the corner in 2007. In addition to the national economic com

crisis, a lot of the Bee's momentum was slowed with "the debt incurred from its previous purchase of Knight Ridder in 2006," said Breton.

During the following decade, McClatchy did a lot in streamlining, cutting costs and significantly paying down its debt from \$4 billion to \$708 million, but next year the corporation is in serious jeopardy with respect to an upcoming pension contribution.

As it navigates through the upcoming year, Breton said, "Several options with investors, financers and other news companies are still being contemplated at headquarters."

'Committed to the role the newspaper plays in a democratic society," Breton added that its online traffic at sacbee.com really helps to stabilize and supplement the capital newspaper with a very affordable and accessible digital platform.

experience with domestic models. Buck Family Automotive offers services such as oil changes, regular scheduled maintenance, brakes and suspension, engine and transmission repair, heating and cooling systems, and electrical work.

"My love is diagnostics ... so when people have that weird, strange electrical issue, that's what I strive for, I love that," said Jeff. Instead of just plugging into a car's computer, he goes a step further, conducting pin-point testing of individual wires. He uses a labscope to read the sigin milliseconds what they're doing" so he can figure out the specific problem.

The shop has an innovative repair order system that Rosie said is "a key component of our business and our communication with our clients." The Bucks' digital system sends a link to the client that they can access online. The page shows real-time photos and videos along with notes from the technician.

Rosie said, "We really wanted to have transparency ... by basically allowing them to see what we see when we're looking at the cars." Clients can share the link with others for a second opinion, and they can also approve the order through the

The Buck family also has a passion for helping the community — frequently offering their services to those in need. Jeff explained that "Rosie is really integrated and involved in the online community chats for local Carmichael groups. Sometimes she'll find people on there who are having an issue and it's something that ... Since it's something that I can do easily, it's something that I'd like to do to help."

A single mother has been giving music lessons in a back room of the Buck Family Automotive office since July. Another single mother needed a new alternator in her Honda, so Jeff installed it free of charge.

And Jeff is storing the body of a drift racing car for a young man with a muscular dystrophy disease, which causes paralysis of the legs; Jeff will be helping him build a car that he can operate with hand controls instead of foot pedals. Jeff said, "Building something for someone else is just as fun and also more motivating."

Buck Family Automotive also welcomes interns through the ROP at Del Campo, and Jeff is now serving on the committee that oversees the quality control of the ROP to ensure it's up to today's standards.

While most technicians are ASE certified, Jeff took additional automotive courses to gain a Master ASE-level certification through the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE). Repairs at the Buck Family Automotive are also covered under a three-year/36,000mile warranty supported by TechNet Professional Automotive Service, a nationwide network of repair shops. "You're covered on most of our repairs even if you're on a road trip," said Jeff.

Buck Family Automotive has a spacious and comfortable waiting area, a kids' room with toys to keep little ones occupied, and a selection of snacks and drinks. The shop is open seven days a week by appointment, from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM Monday through Saturday and noon to 4:00 PM on Sunday.

The Bucks are currently a drop-off donation station for the holiday food drive held by Carmichael Homeless Assistance Resource Team (HART). You can drop off non-perishable food at Buck Family Automotive until the end of December and receive a coupon for \$5 off a future repair.



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

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CHP Revamps Registration Violators Program

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The California Highway Patrol (CHP) announced a new CHP Registration Enforcement and Guidance (CHP REG) program to reduce out-of-state registration violators. The CHP REG program replaces the Californians Help Eliminate All The Evasive Registration Scofflaws (CHEATERS) program.

Since the program's inception in 2004, the CHP has recovered approximately \$26 million in registration fees. In 2018, the CHP surpassed \$3.2 million in recovered fees from residents avoiding California registration.

"California loses millions of dollars in revenue every year from vehicles being unlawfully registered in other states or countries," CHP Commissioner Warren Stanley said. "This program relies on the public's input to support our investigators in returning funding to the state. Recovered registration fees are important to the California economy and are invested back into local communities."

The CHP REG program focuses on residents who register their vehicles out-of-state

while living or working in California and operate those vehicles on California's roadways. The primary goal of the program is to obtain voluntary registration compliance through education, but, when necessary, enforcement action is taken.

California vehicle registration through the Department of Motor Vehicles is required within 20 days of establishing residency and for all vehicles primarily operated in the state.

The CHP encourages members of the public to report vehicles driven on a regular basis on California roadways with out-of-state registration to the CHP REG program Web site at https://www.chp.ca.gov/Notify-CHP/CHP-REG-(Out-of-State-Registration-Violators). When reporting a suspected violator, it is important to include: state of the plate, license plate number, date and time observed, where observed, make, model, vehicle color, and any additional identifying comments. In 2018, more than 24,000 tips were reported to the Web site, leading directly to cases investigated by CHP personnel and dedicated senior volunteers.

Officer Dr. Olivia Kasirye said. "As the number of vaccinated individuals in a community increases, it decreases the transmission of the flu virus to those who have not, or cannot be health conditions. vaccinated resulting in fewer hospitalizations and deaths."

much as possible to keep from infecting them.

Stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone except to get medical care or for other necessities.

Cover your coughs or sneezes with your sleeve or with a tissue, throw it in the trash and wash your hands.

Wash your hands often with soap and warm water.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread

and objects that may be contaminated with flu germs.



The map shows the approximate extent of contamination in the vicinity of the Aerojet Superfund Site where contaminant concentration exceed regulatory standards established to ensure safe long-term consumption. There are currently two regulatory actions (Westerr Groundwater Operable Unit and Perimeter Groundwater Operable Unit) that require Aerojet Rocketdyne to halt the spread o contamination, remediate the contamination, and restore the groundwater to beneficial use. Aerojet Rocketdyne has installed and is currently operating the treatment systems necessary to remediate and restore the off-site groundwater. Additional system modification are anticipated to be completed in the next several years. Groundwater in portions of areas south of the Aerojet Superfund Site is also contaminated. Other regulatory actions are addressing these areas.

Drinking water in this area is primarily provided by public water supply systems, which monitor water quality and shut down impacted wells under the oversight of the State Water Resources Control Board-Division of Drinking Water



Construction of new private and public water supply wells in Sacramento County requires a County permit. The Sacramento Count Environmental Management Department has developed a special review procedure for permit applications associated with wells propose to be constructed near sites with known groundwater contamination. CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) -Now is a great time to add some trees and lowwater use plants to your landscape. The days are shorter and cooler so less water is needed for them to become established. but the soil is still warm, growth.

It's an especially good time of year to plant trees. Fall's cooler temperatures and the rainy days ahead will help trees become well established before the heat of next summer. You can find an easy to use database of flowering plants, trees, grasses and shrubs ideally suited for our region pacted soil so your lawn at BeWaterSmart.info.

Fall is also the perfect time to upgrade your existing sprinkler

system with drip irrigation, high-efficiency pop-up rotator sprinklers and a WaterSense-labeled weather-based sprinkler timer. SSWD has rebates available to help with the cost. You can find complete details at sswd.org/

You can also take steps which encourages root now to improve the health of your soil to make your existing plants do even better. One of the best ways to help them succeed is by making sure they have access to oxygen, water and nutrients. When soil becomes compacted, it impedes the flow of the essential elements that allow for healthy growth.

> Aeration breaks up comand plants will be able to get all of the resources they need. You can purchase or rent an aerating

tool from your local hardware store.

After aerating your soil, add a layer of compost to add nutrients and help the soil retain water. Spread a couple of inches of compost over planting areas and then work it into the top 6 inches of the ground to improve soil health. You can also put a thin layer of compost over your lawn after reseeding or to revitalize your existing lawn.

And remember to keep dialing back the run times on your sprinklers. With fall's shorter and cooler days, your yard won't need as much water, and be sure to turn them off completely when rain is in the forecast.

Taking these steps now will help you have a happy, healthy and water-wise yard all year round.
