CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Candidates for Susan Peters' seat on Sacramento Board of Supervisors faced voters last week in Carmichael. Mission Oaks North Neighborhood Association ran a forum that packed a room at Mission Oaks Community Center. Association President Cathy Cook chaired the evening's town hall-style gathering. Taken from an audience of 70, questions raised matters of community concern. Homelessness; property taxes; the need to protect the American River Parkway; park improvements and the unsatisfactory state of District 3 roads were hot-button issues.

After introductions, each of the six candidates had a minute to speak to each question. "They were well-informed, sincere and statesman-like," observed Cathy Cook. "I was impressed by what they said. The candidates were cordial among themselves and to the attendees. Each had party affiliations but I felt they were running because they love and care about our area. Meetings like this are a great opportunity for voters. We all had one-on-one conversations with the candidates; these will help us to make decisions."

Declared candidates for Susan Peter's District 3 seat are: Charles Crowder: real estate developer; lives in Carmichael; Rich Desmond: CHP chief; Carmichael

resident; Catrayel Wood: Senior Budget Analyst (Judicial Council of California); lives in Fair Oaks; Tiffany Mock: business administrator; resident of Carmichael; Gregg Fishman: SMUD board member; Arden Arcade resident; Matthew Ceccato: District Director Office for Congressman Ami Bera; lives in Arden Arcade.

More candidate town halls – in Foothill Farms, Carmichael and Arden Arcade neighborhoods of District 3 – are planned before the Primary elections of March 2020. Several Democratic clubs will convene a forum on Sunday, October 27 at the Conzelmann Center (Howe park) 2201 Cottage Way. This meeting begins at 2:30 pm. ★

Reported Sexually Transmitted Diseases Reach Epidemic Levels in California

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) released final data on sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) in California in 2018. According to the data, syphilis, gonorrhea, and chlamydia cases are continuing to increase throughout California and are at the highest levels in 30 years.

Particularly concerning, the number of congenital syphilis cases was 14% higher than the previous year and nearly 900% higher than in 2012. Congenital syphilis can be fatal to infants: there were 22 stillbirths or neonatal deaths in 2018.

STDs can cause a number of serious health problems. If left untreated, chlamydia and gonorrhea can cause pelvic inflammatory disease and lead to infertility, ectopic pregnancy, and chronic pelvic pain. Syphilis can cause permanent loss of vision, hearing and other neurologic problems.

The highest rates of STDs are among young individuals ages 15-24.

"STDs are preventable by practicing safe-sex, and many can be cured with antibiotics," said Acting State Public Health Officer Dr. Charity Dean. "Regular testing and treatment are essential prevention strategies, even for people who have no symptoms. Most people infected with an STD do not know it."

CDPH is collaborating with local health departments and organizations throughout the state to coordinate efforts to control STDs, hepatitis C and human immunodeficiency virus infection (HIV).

The 2019-2020 state budget includes increases in funds to help address the rise in STDs, including:

\$40 million over four years to enhance the capacity of local health departments to identify, monitor and respond to communicable diseases;

\$5 million per year for STD prevention and control by local health departments and community based organizations;

\$5 million per year for HIV prevention and control by local health departments and community based organizations.

\$5 million per year for Hepatitis C prevention and control by local health departments and community based organizations.

\$2 million per year to enhance local health department capacity for STD prevention and control.

Spend Twenty Minutes With Me

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Attending the 14th Annual California Capital Airshow at Mather Airport on October 5-6, 2019, was a thrilling experience!

My original intent was to focus and write about the 75th anniversary of the D-Day invasion which was one of the highlights of the show. As it turned out, I was distracted by a documentary that was being filmed about the WASP organization. As I eavesdropped, I became more and more interested in the Women's Airforce Service Pilots who were very instrumental in adding to the success of the United States Air Force.

I have never heard of this military group, but by show's end, I became quite a fan. The WASP organization was formed in 1942 with 23 women making up the first graduate group of Service Pilots. Their job was to ferry and test aircraft and to train other personnel in their use. While this group became part of history by being the first women to fly military aircraft for the United States, their organizational mission was just beginning. The title of this article is attributed to Kimberly Johnson, one of the keepers of the official archives of the WASP organization located at Texas Women's University in Denton, Texas. Kimberly told me a fascinating story about Colonel Paul Tibbets, the pilot of the Enola Gay and the B-29 Superfortress, (the plane that dropped the atomic bomb on Hiroshima, Japan during World War II). "The B-29 was a scary

plane to fly and the male pilots were finding excuses not to fly it," said Kimberly. Colonel Tibbets had to find a way to convince his pilots to start training and becoming familiar with the aircraft. He turned to the WASP's and found that Dorothea Moorman and Dora Daugherty were willing to fly the B-29 and encouraged the male pilots by telling them it was safe to fly. "Imagine the look on the male pilots' faces when two ladies stepped off the plane!" she concluded.

I had the privilege of learning so much more about the WASP's and came to realize that more than 25,000 women signed up to join the first class! The WASP's were official members of the United States Air Force, but it took more than 60 years before Congress bestowed upon the group the Congressional Gold Medal for contributions made during World War II.

One of the WASP display highlights was a B-25 Mitchell medium bomber available for visitors to climb aboard and visit the cockpit. This is where I found pilot and Boeing engineer Vera Martinovich. She flew the B-25 from its base in Madras, Oregon to Mather Airport and was experiencing her first airshow. The plane is part of the Erickson Aircraft Collection, an organization with "a wide variety of WW II Aircraft," which began in the 1970s.

As I climbed into the cockpit area, I asked Vera if she experiences "any visitors" when she is flying the B-25? "I think about those 20-year old WASP's talking together," she said. She

joined as a pilot to fly the B-25 "to keep them flying" to honor the history of the WASP pilots. As we spoke, Vera mentioned the people who were attend-

and has made an impact on young women of today. It certainly made an impact on Vera as she said "this is the plane I wanted to fly."

I also met two other pilots who emphasized the importance for the general public to know about the WASP's. Delane Buttacavoli and Kaitlan Comm are part of the WASP National Soar Tour. They both told me that they "love the WASP's" and they wanted to take the WASP story to other airshows across the United States. It was easy to understand these women's passion for doing so. I watched them enthusiastically greet show spectators and then assist them to climb onboard the B-25.

As with any group throughout history who want to make a positive difference to those around them, I can say the Women Airforce Service Pilots did just that. Kimberly Johnson said she felt the women "persevered and really had something

to contribute to the war effort." As it is stated "the mission of the WASP Archive is to honor the first female military pilots, tell their story of service, bravery, and heroism to their country, and celebrate the place women in aviation occupy today, tomorrow, and yesterday inspiring future generations."

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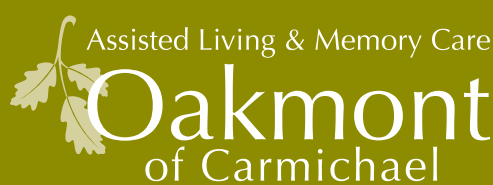

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With Halloween on the Horizon, Halt Hazards with These Tips!

Halloween has become a hugely popular time for fun and festivities, but with it comes the potential for a variety of fire hazards. The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) encourages everyone to take these simple precautions to stay safe without sacrificing that fun.

"Halloween brings an opportunity to wear fun costumes, decorate our homes, and eat too much candy," says Lorraine Carli, NFPA's vice president of Outreach and Advocacy. "However, without proper safety precautions, we run the risk of turning good times into the wrong kind of scary ones."

According to NFPA

research, between 2012 and 2016, decorations were the item first ignited in an estimated average of 800 reported home structure fires per year, resulting in an average of two civilian deaths, 34 civilian injuries and \$11 million in direct property damage. The decoration was too close to a heat source such as a candle or equipment in almost half of these fires.

NFPA offers these tips to stay safe during the spooky season:

Costumes: Avoid fabric that billows or trails behind you, as these can easily ignite. If you are making your own costume, avoid loosely woven fabrics like linen and cotton, which can be very flammable.

Decorations: Many common decorations like cornstalks, crepe paper, and dried flowers are very

flammable. Keep these and similar decorations far away from any open flames or heat sources, like candles, heaters, and light bulbs.

Candles: Using candles as decoration can be risky if not

done correctly. Keep them in a well-attended area out of the path of potential trick-or-treaters. Remind children of the dangers of open flames, and make sure they are supervised at all times when candles are

lit. Extinguish candles before leaving an area.

Jack-o-lanterns: Glow sticks or electric candles are the safest choice when it comes to lighting up your jack-o-lantern, but if you

choose to use a real candle, do so with extreme caution. Light a candle inside a jack-o-lantern using long fireproof matches or a utility lighter, and keep it away from other decorations.

Visibility: Give children flashlights or glowsticks for lighting, these can even be incorporated into the costume. If your child has a mask, ensure the eye holes are large enough for them to see clearly.

Smoke Alarms: This is a great time to make sure your smoke alarms are functional and up-to-date.

Exits: Exits are NOT an appropriate place for decorations. When decorating, ensure that nothing is blocking any escape routes.

Sacramento County DA Reports

Defendant Convicted of Murdering Girlfriend at Hotel
DATE: October 17, 2019
CASE: Lucas Sanchez (Case #17FE016812)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Allison Dunham, Homicide Unit.
 On October 4, 2019, Lucas Sanchez was convicted by a jury of the first-degree murder of Jennifer Rutter. The jury also found that Sanchez personally used a deadly or dangerous weapon in the commission of the murder. Sanchez entered a plea of not guilty by reason of insanity. On October 16, 2019, the jury found Sanchez was legally sane when he committed the murder.
 Sanchez and the victim were in a relationship. On the morning of September 11, 2017, Sanchez and the victim were sleeping at a local hotel. Sanchez woke up paranoid and delusional from using methamphetamine. He took a closet rod out of the closet and beat the victim in the head as she slept. The victim fled out of the hotel room naked and bleeding. Sanchez proceeded to beat her in the head with the closet rod in the hotel hallway. A public safety conference was taking place at the hotel that morning. Law enforcement officers arrested Sanchez on the scene. An autopsy determined the victim died from seven to 10 blunt force blows to her head causing multiple facial and skull fractures.
 Sanchez faces a maximum sentence of 26 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for November 14, 2019, in Department 20 before the Honorable Michael Sweet.

Zamora-Canada was convicted of the second-degree murder of Cesar Aleman-Luna, attempted murder and being a felon in possession of a firearm. The jury also found true firearm allegations for both defendants.
 On October 9, 2016, Julian Garcia and German Zamora-Canada got into an altercation with the surviving victims after a concert at La Nueva Tropicana nightclub on Arden Way. Garcia and Zamora-Canada pulled out guns and opened fire, striking three victims. Those victims survived, but suffered major injuries. Cesar Aleman-Luna was working at a taco truck outside the nightclub when he was also struck five times, killing him.
 Both Garcia and Zamora-Canada have a prior strike conviction and both were sentenced under California's three strikes law. Garcia was previously convicted of assault with a firearm in 2010 and Zamora-Canada was previously convicted of robbery in 2012.

Defendants Sentenced for Murder Outside Arden Way Nightclub
DATE: October 15, 2019
CASE: Julian Garcia and German Zamora-Canada (Case #16FE021333)
PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Jeff Hightower, Homicide Unit
 The Honorable Ernest Sawtelle sentenced Julian Garcia to 149 years to life in prison and German Zamora-Canada to 99 years to life in prison. On September 17, 2019, a jury convicted Garcia of the first-degree murder of Cesar Aleman-Luna, two counts of attempted murder and being a felon in possession of a firearm.

Defendants Sentenced for Murder and Abuse of 22-Month-Old Victims
DATE: October 11, 2019
CASE: Taylor Montgomery-Gutzman & Rebecca Thomas (Case #16FE022095)
PROSECUTOR: Supervising Deputy District Attorney Chris Ore, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit
 The Honorable Allen Sumner sentenced Taylor Montgomery-Gutzman to 31 years to life in prison. Rebecca Thomas had been previously sentenced 25 years to life in prison. On May 3, 2019, a jury convicted Taylor Montgomery-Gutzman and Rebecca Thomas of the second-degree murder of 22-month-old Kash Thomas, and felony child abuse involving Kash's 22-month-old twin brother. Montgomery-Gutzman was also found guilty of assault on a child causing death.
 On October 13, 2016, Taylor Montgomery-Gutzman strangled Kash Thomas to death. Rebecca Thomas, the children's mother, had seen injuries on her children prior to the murder, but nonetheless left the 22-month-old twins in Montgomery-Gutzman's care. Thomas had been told to seek medical attention for both children, but she failed to do so. ★

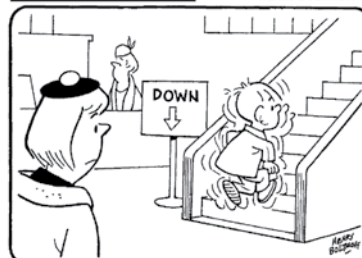

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The Foolhardy Campaign Against 'Endless Wars'

Barack Obama and Donald Trump are diametrically opposed figures, representing the categorical rejection of the other for his supporters, yet they share significant foreign-policy DNA.

They both defined themselves in opposition to George W. Bush's foreign policy. Obama probably wouldn't have defeated Hillary Clinton for the 2008 Democratic nomination if she hadn't voted for the Iraq War and if he didn't speak out against it at the time. Likewise, Trump outpaced all his 2016 GOP rivals in denouncing our Middle East commitments.

Obama represented the internationalist left, while Trump is the champion of the populist right, and there are important policy differences between the two (Obama cut the Iran nuclear deal; Trump withdrew from it). Yet, in his pullback from the Syrian border, exposing our Kurdish allies to a Turkish invasion, Trump now has his own

version of Obama's foolhardy pullout from Iraq that created the opening for the rise of ISIS.

The cost of Trump's decision is a betrayal of the Kurds, a worsening relationship with Turkey, a possible lifeline for ISIS and a boost to the influence of Russia, which should be able to leverage it for continued strategic gains in the region.

The pullback has managed, astonishingly enough, to alienate both the Kurds and Turkey from the United States. Usually, given the historic enmity between the two, it's possible to alienate only one at a time. After we dumped them, the Kurds have fallen into the arms of the Assad regime in Syria, while Turkey will be as hostile to the U.S. as ever once Congress gets done trying to punish it for its invasion.

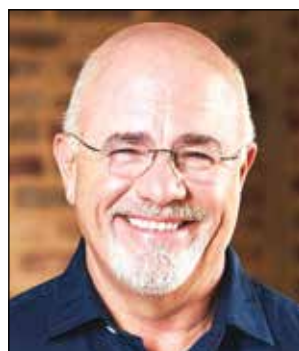
Just like Obama's withdrawal from Iraq, Trump's pullback in Syria is a belated reaction to the Iraq War. Obviously, there is no political support on the right or left for invading and occupying a Middle Eastern country again. But there's a vast distance between the height of the occupation of Iraq, when we had 150,000 troops fighting a war of counterinsurgency, and our minimal commitment in Syria aimed at creating and supporting a proxy force to do the hard fighting against ISIS.

To throw both the Syria and Iraq interventions together under the rubric of "endless war" is to fail to make distinctions. It's senseless to oppose a relatively cost-free action in Syria that has succeeded in its own terms (the ISIS caliphate has been defeated) because the Iraq War was fought for years at a high cost with dubious results. It'd be like opposing the invasion of Grenada because the invasion of Normandy required so much blood and treasure.

The long-standing American military reflex is to win and go home, but it's rare that even the most clear-cut victory is so neat. We won a decisive conventional military victory in World War II in Europe, and we still have troops in Germany. The first Gulf War is supposed to be the model of a rigorously limited commitment, but it still resulted in a no-fly zone over Iraq, the creation of an autonomous region for the Kurds in the north and a constant effort to enforce U.N. sanctions.

Nor is getting out as clean as advertised. Obama triumphantly exited Iraq, only to have to go back in when things spun out of control. If Trump wants to be done with Syria, it might not be done with him.

The first thing I'd advise telling him is that you and his mom aren't going to whip out the checkbook, and make his problems disappear. That may sound harsh, but he had a really good thing going until he messed it up by acting impulsively and irresponsibly with his finances. Nope, I wouldn't take care of it for him – not at his age. This young man needs to have some skin in the game.

I'd tell him to sell the fancy car, and get something way cheaper to drive for a while. I'm talking about a little beater in the \$2,000 to \$3,000 range. It sounds like he'll have to get a small loan to cover the difference, but a little car debt is better than a lot of car debt. I'd also advise him to pick up a part-time job nights or weekends until he gets that credit

card debt paid off.

In other words, let him wallow in it and worry about things for a while. Then, if he's willing to accept responsibility for his actions, and starts handling money more wisely, you two might help out every so often with a little extra cash on the payments.

But I'd test his resolve first. And I'd want to see proof he has learned from his mistakes! – Dave
