It's a Clean Sweep Party

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Many sponsoring agencies sent an unfiltered message at Carmichael Park: everyone – young and old – must save and protect water. Earlier that morning, 2000 volunteers formed an army to scour more than 80 county locations. Creeks from the Delta to Folsom and from Elk Grove to Antelope benefited from the clean-up.

Six work areas within Rancho Cordova community yielded more than 1500 pounds of trash. City biologists also opened the Bear Hollow retention area for guided walks. Planted with native wetland vegetation, the man-made reservoir now supports many bird species.

In its 29th year, Sacramento County's Creek Week program aims to refresh waterways by removing garbage and invasive plants. AmeriCorps volunteers worked with 100 Mira Loma High School students to clear non-native growth from an Arcade Creek tributary near Auburn Boulevard. Some of these

volunteers scaled a log jam near Haggin Oaks Golf Course and retrieved wads of plastic waste.

Bolstered by youth groups, service clubs, neighborhood associations and families, the work force was joined by the Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps, whose members recycle dumped rubber tires. Beyond tires, mattresses and shopping carts, the 2019 junk-hunt gleaned many tons of smaller stuff alien to healthy arteries.

Sacramento Area Creeks Council President Alta Tura noted that high waters from recent rains washed much trash downstream into river flows. "At the same time, more garbage entered our creeks and was trapped by vegetation," she said. "Cigarette butts, plastic straws and fast food packaging are more damaging to wildlife than big stuff. Animals ingest plastic and can starve to death. Waterfowl can become entangled in old fishing lines." "There's no place in our waterways for

plastic in any form, yet many thousands of plastic items were among the tons of junk we bagged," she reported. "The volunteers did a stellar job."

At Carmichael Park, rewards for the weary included clean tee shirts and hot dogs dished up by Carmichael Chamber of Commerce and Mission Oaks Park District volunteers. "The party celebrates everyone's hard work," said Tura. "It also teaches people about nature: how to save water and be better stewards of our environment."

Experience the Union Pacific Rail Car Available for Free Tours

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - As part of a series of special events, activities and exhibits designed to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the completion of the Transcontinental Railroad, the California State Railroad Museum & Foundation proudly invite the community to Experience the Union Pacific Rail Car that will be on display Friday, April 19 through Monday, April 22, 2019.

Free public tours will be available each day from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. inside the visually-exciting rail car on display at Old Sacramento State Historic Park.

The Experience the Union Pacific Rail Car is a new, multi-media walk-through exhibition that provides a glimpse at the past while telling the story of modern-day railroading. Through sound, images and interactive technology, visitors will see how Union Pacific is building America in their communities and throughout the world. The Experience the Union Pacific Rail Car is part of Union Pacific's historic Heritage passenger rail car fleet going on a multi-stop tour that begins in Sacramento followed by a stop in Roseville before moving on to Sparks, Nevada and Ogden, Utah.

After entering the converted baggage car, guests will first learn about the investment, hard work and knowledge that went into building the Transcontinental Railroad. Moving forward along one

wall they'll learn about the evolution of the locomotive, beginning with the world-famous UP No. 119 and leading to the modern-day diesel powerhouses. On the opposite wall, rail fans will trace how fresh apples are delivered from California and Washington to New York and understand every aspect of rail operations and innovation along the way. Next, exciting interactive technology will show how Union Pacific is using lasers, cameras and other detection devices to accurately inspect moving rail cars and railroad track. Guests will even be able to test their skills to see how they measure up as rail car inspectors. Before exiting, visitors will be able to communicate how they connect to the railroad using high-tech thermal reactive tiles. A final display celebrates the history of Union Pacific's Passenger Heritage Fleet through vintage photos.

Historical Reenactments Highlight Annual Pioneer History Day

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Before the famed California Gold Rush brought tens of thousands of gold seekers and others to Northern California, there were hundreds of pioneers who paved the way for them to arrive, already having constructed homes and businesses, started farms and even began building cities.

On Saturday, May 4, area residents can learn more about how they lived and their accomplishments during the California Pioneer History Day at Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park in Coloma.

This free family event features historic reenactments and displays, a parade with descendants of early California pioneers, stage shows and musical entertainment, and many activities for families and children, including a cannon that shoots candy, free wagon rides, pioneer games and children's crafts.

"Few Californians know about the rich early history of our state," said Michelle

Jones of Placerville, who is heading the effort along with Robert and Peni Frew from Auburn. "The California Pioneer History Day will give them the opportunity to discover this inspiring heritage in a fun and interactive way."

The event will be held from 9 a.m.-3 p.m., with the parade at 10 a.m. and an opening ceremony following. This is the third California Pioneer History Day, which is sponsored by the California Pioneer Heritage Foundation and organized by members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the Sacramento Valley and Sierra foothills. While the event is free, the state parking fee is \$8. Food concessions will be available, or attendees can bring their own lunch.

During the Pioneer History Day, three-dozen interactive exhibits and activities organized into two "tent towns" will straddle Highway 49, the main thoroughfare into Coloma.

Among the reenactments will be cannon and musket firing, giving a detailed

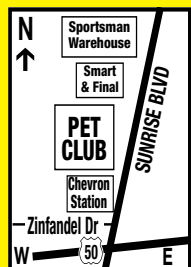
demonstration of how they were loaded and the safety precautions taken before firing. These will be held at 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. The Pony Express will also recreate a mail hand-off during those same times, and free wagon rides will be available from 11 a.m.-3 p.m. In addition, there will be historical demonstrations on pioneer medicine, frontier justice, blacksmithing, wood carving, and free old-time photos with pioneer garb will be available.

The Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park in Coloma features a museum and visitors center, a replica of John Sutter's sawmill where gold was discovered in 1848, and many other buildings that recreate the town of Coloma during the Gold Rush.

The McCarthyite Crusade Against Chick-fil-A

The fast-food chain Chick-fil-A is wanted on suspicion of aiding and abetting Christian organizations.

The home of the "original chicken sandwich" was banned from its second airport in two weeks for the offense of contributing to Christian groups deemed anti-gay by its critics.

The San Antonio City Council voted to exclude the restaurant from its airport, and Buffalo, New York, soon followed suit, thus denying travelers the option of juicy chicken sandwiches and waffle fries in the cause of social justice.

This is about punishing the Georgia-based company for the faith of its leadership. The official bans are anti-Christian, unconstitutional and a harbinger of a larger effort to hunt down and punish any organization that has uncongenial views on sexual morality.

In San Antonio, the leader of the anti-Chick-fil-A effort, City Councilman Roberto Trevino, explained that, "Everyone has a place here, and everyone should feel welcome when they

walk through our airport." The irony of discriminating against Chick-fil-A in order to demonstrate the city's famous open-ness was, of course, lost on him.

The hostility to Chick-fil-A stems from a controversy back in 2012 when its CEO, Dan Cathy, made statements opposing gay marriage, and the foundation established by the company's founder contributed to politically engaged social-conservative groups. There was nothing wrong with this, but since most profit-seeking enterprises don't like controversy, Cathy said the company would back off the gay-marriage debate and focus on the chicken.

It has, but its critics still detect a lingering stench of Christianity.

The left-wing outfit ThinkProgress issued a report cited widely in the press and among Chick-fil-A opponents accusing the company's foundation of "anti-equality" giving. By which it means it donated to the Salvation Army and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (and a small Christian home for troubled young men in Vidalia, Georgia).

Needless to say, a lot of other people are guilty of the same offense, given that the Salvation Army raises about \$2 billion a year. To consider all that the Salvation Army does -- its thrift shops, aid for the homeless, disaster relief, anti-trafficking

programs, Christmas gifts to needy children and much, much more -- and reduce the organization to an allegedly anti-LGBT group is perverse.

For its part, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes stands accused of seeking "to spread an anti-LGBTQ message to college athletes." It's true that FCA asks its leaders to forswear homosexual acts, but it also wants them to pledge not to engage in heterosexual acts outside of marriage and, for that matter, refuse to use drugs, alcohol or tobacco.

According to Chick-fil-A, its donation to FCA supported sports camps and school programs for inner-city kids -- not exactly controversial causes. And its gift to the Salvation Army went to youth camps and Christmas presents for thousands of Atlanta kids.

The latest campaign against Chick-fil-A is based on the idea that it is impermissible for it to associate with any group with a traditional Christian understanding of sex and marriage, for any purpose whatsoever, no matter how unobjectionable or noble.

It is the enemies of Chick-fil-A who are intolerant and out-of-the-mainstream. They desperately need to abandon their tawdry McCarthyite crusade and "Eat Mor Chikin."

ASK MATT BY MATT ROUSH TV Guide Senior Critic

Is A New Twilight Zone A Good Idea?

Question: I have to admit that reviving/rebooting *The Twilight Zone* is a much less egregious “sin” than reviving shows as iconic or classic as *Magnum P.I.* or *Full House* since an anthology series is a different thing. But: How fresh is TZ in 2019 when we have *Black Mirror*? Even movies such as *Get Out* and *Us*. I found it rather run of the mill. –Tyrell

Matt Roush: The fact that you reference *Get Out* and *Us*, both from Jordan Peele (who's the face and creative engine of the new *Twilight Zone* revival), is reason enough to cut the new *Zone* some slack. I remember reading a comment by Peele that while he's a fan of *Black Mirror*, which has often been likened to a “technological *Twilight Zone*,” the cynicism and darkness of so many of those episodes was why he

wanted to delve into the more humanistic world of fantasy established so long ago by Rod Serling. There's a timelessness to *Twilight Zone* at its best that argues for a remake in the right hands – although as with any anthology, the new *Zone* is unquestionably uneven. But having seen four to date, I'm eager to see more. (The episode, “Replay,” with a #BlackLivesMatter context in a story about a magical camcorder, felt like a classically topical *Zone* allegory to me – and I loved the new twists on the “Nightmare at 30,000 Feet” episode.)

New Rate Study Confirms Republicans' Calls for Increase Funding for Persons with Developmental Disabilities

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The California Department of Developmental Services released a long-awaited study last Friday evening regarding payments for services for persons with developmental disabilities.

The study indicates that if provider rates are set fairly, the state would need to increase the budget by more than \$1.8 billion dollars to provide adequate services for this community.

Prior to the rate study release, Senate Republican Leader Shannon Grove (R-Bakersfield) delivered

a letter from all Senate Republicans to the Chairs of the Senate and Assembly Budget Committees requesting several budget actions. One of the requests included an 8 percent across-the-board payment rate increase as a down payment for providers who serve the developmentally disabled

community. Advocates and stakeholders agree there is a need for a transitional rate increase in this budget to sustain services while the state determines how to implement the larger rate study, including improved accountability and transparency.

"The recent rate

study supports Senate Republicans' request to place a higher priority for persons with developmental disabilities and their families. The state made a promise to serve this community, but that promise falls short if we do not provide enough money for necessary services.

"My colleagues and I stand united in advocating for some of California's most vulnerable population. With an anticipated \$21 billion surplus in the state budget, let's do the right thing. The developmentally disabled community deserves better," said Leader Grove.

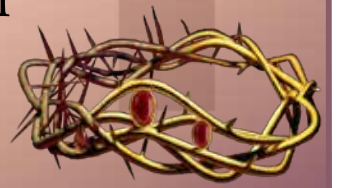
