CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Many sponsoring agencies sent an unfiltered message at Carmichael Park: everyone – young and old – must save and protect water. Earlier that morning, youth groups, 2000 volunteers formed an army to scour more than 80 county locations. Creeks from the Delta to Folsom and from Elk Grove to Antelope benefited from the clean-up.

Six work areas within Rancho Cordova community yielded more than 1500 pounds of trash. City biologists also opened the Bear Hollow retention area for guided walks. Planted with native wetland vegetation, the man-made reservoir now supports many bird species.

to refresh waterways by removing garbage and invasive plants. AmeriCorps volunteers worked with 100 Mira Loma High School students to clear non-native growth from an Arcade Creek tributary near Auburn Boulevard. Some of these

neighborhood associations and families, the work force was joined by the Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps, whose members recycle dumped rubber tires. Beyond tires, mattresses and shopping carts, the 2019 junk-hunt gleaned many tons of smaller stuff alien to healthy arteries.

Sacramento Area Creeks Council President Alta Tura noted that high waters from recent rains washed much trash downstream into river flows. "At In its 29th year, Sacramento the same time, more garbage entered County's Creek Week program aims our creeks and was trapped by vegetation," she said. "Cigarette butts, plastic straws and fast food packaging are more damaging to wildlife than big stuff. Animals ingest plastic and can starve to death. Waterfowl can become entangled in old fishing lines." "There's no place in our waterways for

plastic in any form, yet many thousands of plastic items were among the tons of junk we bagged," she reported. 'The volunteers did a stellar job."

At Carmichael Park, rewards for the weary included clean tee shirts and hot dogs dished up by Carmichael Chamber of Commerce and Mission Oaks Park District volunteers. "The party celebrates everyone's hard work," said Tura. "It also teaches people about nature: how to save water and be better stewards of our environment."

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) -Before the famed California Gold Rush brought tens of thousands of gold seekers and others to Northern California, there were hundreds of pioneers who paved the way for them to arrive, already having constructed homes and businesses, started farms and even began

building cities. residents can learn more about how they lived and their accomplishments during the California Pioneer History Day at Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park in Coloma.

This free family event features historic reenactments and displays, a parade with descendants of early California pioneers, stage shows and musical entertainment, and many activities for families and children, including a cannon that shoots candy, free wagon rides, pioneer games and children's

The Marshall Gold Discovery State Historic Park in Coloma features a museum and visitors center, a replica of John Sutter's sawmill where gold was discovered in 1848, and many other buildings that recreate the town of Coloma during the Gold Rush.

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The McCarthyite **Crusade Against** Chick-fil-A

The fast-food chain Chick-fil-A is wanted on suspicion of aiding and abetting Christian organizations.

The home of the "original chicken sandwich" was banned from its second airport in two weeks for the offense of contributing to Christian groups deemed anti-gay by its critics.

The San Antonio City Council voted to exclude the restaurant from its airport, and Buffalo, New York, soon followed suit, thus denying travelers the option of juicy chicken sandwiches and waffle fries in the cause of social justice.

This is about punishing the Georgia-based company for the faith of its leadership. The official bans are anti-Christian, unconstitutional and a harbinger of a larger effort to hunt down and punish any organization that has uncongenial views on sexual morality.

In San Antonio, the leader of the anti-Chick-fil-A effort, City Councilman Roberto Trevino, explained that, "Everyone has a place here, and everyone should feel welcome when they

walk through our airport." The irony of discriminating against Chick-fil-A in order to demonstrate the city's famous open-ness was, of course, lost on him.

The hostility to Chickfil-A stems from a Fellowship of Christian controversy back in 2012 when its CEO, Dan Cathy, made statements opposing gay marriage, and the foundation established by the company's founder contributed to politically engaged social-conservative groups. There was nothing wrong with this, but since most profit-seeking enterprises don't like controversy, Cathy said the company would back off the gay-marriage debate and focus on the chicken.

It has, but its critics still detect a lingering stench of Christianity.

The left-wing outfit ThinkProgress issued a report cited widely in the press and among Chickfil-A opponents accusing the company's foundation of "anti-equality" giving. By which it means it donated to the Salvation Army and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (and a small Christian home for troubled young men in Vidalia, Georgia).

Needless to say, a lot of other people are guilty of the same offense, given that the Salvation Army raises about \$2 billion a year. To consider all that the Salvation Army does -- its thrift shops, aid for the homeless, disaster relief, anti-trafficking

programs, Christmas gifts to needy children and much, much more -- and reduce the organization to an allegedly anti-LGBT group is perverse.

For its part, the Athletes stands accused of seeking "to spread an anti-LGBTO message to college athletes." It's true that FCA asks its leaders to forswear homosexual acts, but it also wants them to pledge not to engage in heterosexual acts outside of marriage and, for that matter, refuse to use drugs, alcohol or tobacco.

According to Chick-fil-A, its donation to FCA supported sports camps and school programs for innercity kids -- not exactly controversial causes. And its gift to the Salvation Army went to youth camps and Christmas presents for thousands of Atlanta kids.

The latest campaign against Chick-fil-A is based on the idea that it is impermissible for it to associate with any group with a traditional Christian understanding of sex and marriage, for any purpose whatsoever, no matter how unobjectionable or noble.

It is the enemies of Chickfil-A who are intolerant and out-of-the-mainstream. They desperately need to abandon their tawdry McCarthyite crusade and "Eat Mor Chikin.'
