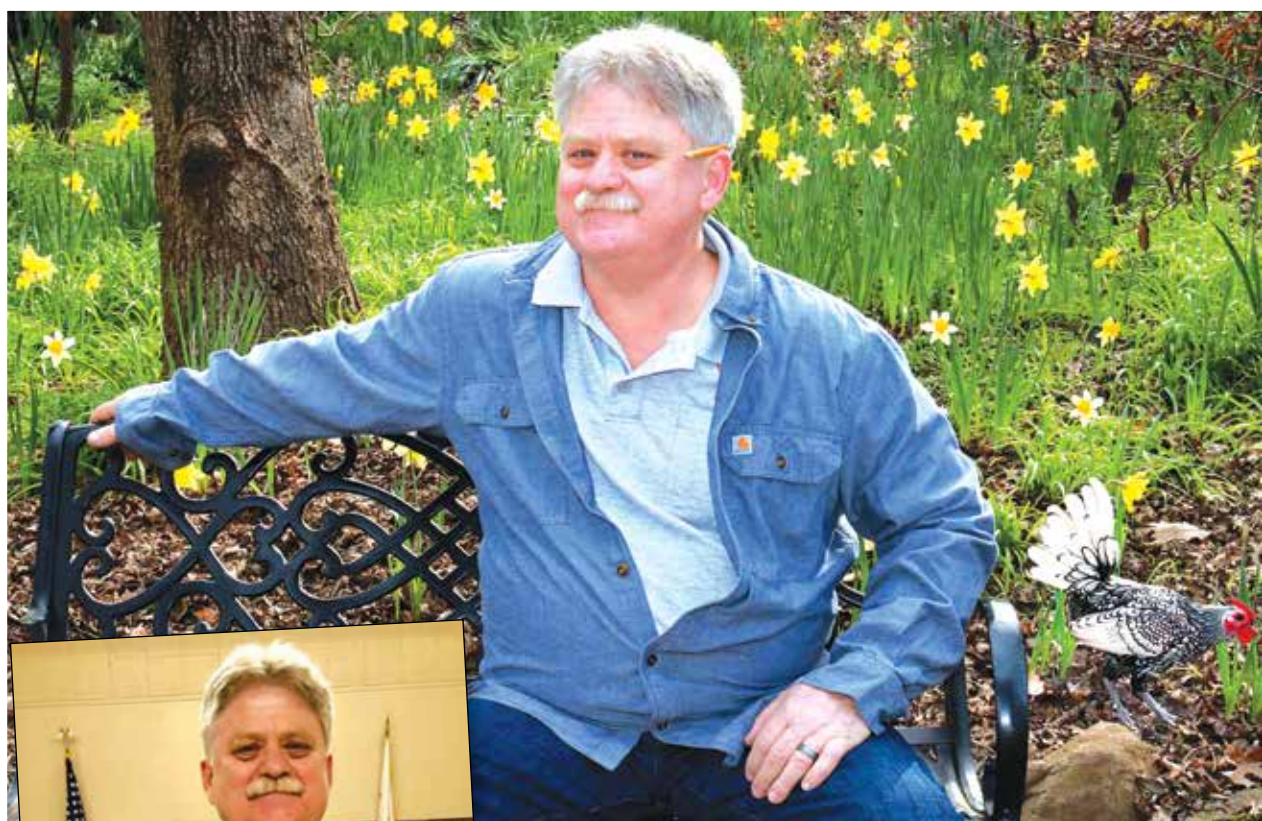

## Hanging Up His Hammer

*Retiring Park Services Manager Keith Maddison's final projects included improvements at Carmichael Park District's Jensen Gardens.*

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Thirty-six years after signing on for seasonal work, Keith Maddison this month retires as Carmichael Park District's service manager. Maddison (61) has overseen development of five community parks and is credited with saving the cash-poor district millions of dollars by thinking outside (and sometimes inside) the box.

"I've used district staff in as many projects as possible," the handyman explains. "We've economized

by not hiring project managers or general contractors. I could usually fill those roles myself. We did a Carmichael Park water system renovation to my plan. It was approved by our engineers and with help from Carmichael Water District, we saved more than a million dollars in construction. This plan also cuts meter tap fees by \$40,000 a year." When Jan Park trails met a ditch, Maddison located an old metal bridge among Sunrise Park District relics. "They gave it to us and we renovated it." Says the boss. "That saved us \$10,000. When you don't have money, it's good to have friends."

Maddison's can-do attitude evolved over a lifetime of fixing stuff. "At 14, I built a house with my dad in Des Moines, Iowa," he says. "While enlisted, I worked in a US Navy shipyard. I built luxury mobile homes in Woodland. There's hardly a hitch I haven't encountered

on building sites. I don't stand around barking orders; I work from the trenches. I pride myself on problem-solving but I've had a fantastic district staff; I couldn't have managed without them."

A harder problem to solve is how the father of five will deal with retirement. "I started off doing a job," he considers. "It developed into a career and at some point, I took emotional ownership of all our facilities. It'll be hard to leave."

Maddison hopes to see through improvements at Sutter/Jenson Community Park. His vision for the redeveloped beauty-spot includes turning a 70-year-old former family home into an event center. Garfield House will be available for private events by fall.

"It'll be great to see it functioning to enrich our cash-poor district," he predicts. "I don't want to retire and walk away from this project. So, I'll probably come back and volunteer." ★

## CA Has Some of the Worst Drivers

If you're constantly frustrated with the drivers you share the streets with, you're not alone. And there may be some truth to your road rage. Car crashes are a leading cause of death in the US and were expected to cause around 40,000 deaths by the end of 2018.

To put it plainly, America's roads are dangerous. Texting behind the wheel is a major reason for many traffic fatalities, and it's only getting worse. In 2016, 3,450 people were killed by distracted driving. Plus, cheap gas and a strong economy means America's 222 million licensed drivers are driving more than ever. More people on the road leads to more accidents and citations.

Every state has their share of bad drivers, but some are worse than others. We ranked all states from worst to best based on the methodology outlined at the end of the article. These states have the worst drivers, in order; Maine, South Carolina, Nebraska, California, and North Dakota.

The US has been politically polarized for a long time. But after the 2016 presidential elections and the 2018 midterms, there's a rising divide between Democrats and Republicans. We took it upon ourselves to settle the score by determining which political party is better behind the wheel.

So, which is it - red or blue? The final score is a bit of a tossup. Considering two-thirds of the best driving states are historically red, and the worst driving state is blue, it looks like red takes the lead. But, the second and third worst driving states are conservative strongholds. So, we're calling it a tie.

Whether you live among the best or the worst drivers in the country, you still need a strong auto insurance policy. Especially if you live in Maine, South Carolina, Nebraska, California, North Dakota, or one of America's worst driving states.

Your rates depend in part on how well the people around you can drive. Why? Because the more bad drivers there are on the road, the higher the chance of a collision. Even if you're a fantastic driver, living in a state full of speed demons or reckless traffic weavers can cause your rates to skyrocket. Car insurance companies look at your zip code to determine your prices. And if your zip code has a propensity for poor driving, you'll pay more for coverage.

The rankings are a sum of weighted means calculated from these incidents: Accidents; Speeding tickets; DUIs; Citations; Fatalities.

## Sac County Extended Foster Care Program Offers More

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - Each year in Sacramento County, approximately 170 youths turn 18 years old while in foster care - which for many can mean they will be without a family and often without supportive adults in their lives as they age out of the system. But, most 18-year-olds still need financial help, emotional support and other assistance as they enter adulthood and begin to plan for the future.

The Extended Foster Care program - provided through Sacramento County Department of Child, Family and Adult Services - allows 18 to 21-year-olds to stay in foster care with the intent of providing them with supportive housing while also

teaching independent living skills to help them achieve self-sufficiency.

The program began in Sacramento County in January 2012, and social workers assist the young adults in maintaining a safety net of support while offering the experience of independent living in a

secure and supervised environment. As of December 2018, approximately 360 youth are actively participating in the program.

To qualify, youth must meet one of five conditions: Be in the process of completing high school or an equivalent program (GED); Be enrolled

in a university, vocational school or community college at least half-time; Be employed at least 80 hours a month; Participate in a program designed to promote employment or remove barriers to employment; Be unable to meet the above requirements due to a medical condition.

County social workers work closely with the youth to determine which housing program will best suit their needs. Housing options include: Supervised Independent Living Placement (SILP); Least restrictive and most popular placement; Allows youth to select their own housing and live independently; Must participate in a readiness assessment that determines the youth's

# SacRT Board Approves New Bus Network

**SACRAMENTO, CA** - The Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) Board of Directors approved a new bus network proposal, which comprehensively re-designs SacRT's bus system. "We are excited to begin the process of rolling out our new bus network in a few months," said SacRT General Manager/CEO Henry Li. "To ensure the success of the new network, SacRT will conduct frequent monitoring of the new bus service to optimize and adjust service where it's needed most."

A draft plan was released for public review on December 10, 2018. Since then, major outreach efforts took place to let riders and stakeholders know about the proposed plan, called SacRT Forward.

Based on the comments received, and reviewing ridership and demographic data, staff spent the past two and half months making adjustments to the plan. A revised bus network proposal was released for public review on February 18, 2019, and approved

by the SacRT Board of Directors on February 25, 2019. The new service is expected to start in summer 2019.

"We have been actively listening to our riders and the community for the past year and a half to make changes that will best fit their lifestyle and help improve mobility options for the Sacramento region," said SacRT Board Chair and Sacramento County Supervisor Patrick Kennedy. "Travel patterns have changed, regional mobility options have been expanded and development has occurred on the periphery."

The focus of the new network has been on building a solid network of core routes on major corridors that will lead to economic growth and reduce congestion. Adjustments have been made to almost every route, some minor and some much more substantial, which will provide improved schedules and better service reliability. The new network consists of: 27 regular routes; 14 peak hour only routes; All routes have 7-day service (with the exception of bus route 33); All routes have

45 minute or better service (with the exception of one rural route); Complements the new 15-minute weekend light rail service

In many areas that don't have high demand for fixed-route bus service, or are not designed for large buses to navigate the neighborhood, SacRT will deploy Smart Ride micro-transit service.

Annual bus ridership is forecasted to go up between 400,000 and 1,000,000 boardings a year with the new service improvements. For route by route details, visit sacrt.com/sacrtforward.

SacRT operates approximately 70 bus routes (fixed-route, dial-a-ride and microtransit) and 43 miles of light rail all within a 400-square mile service area throughout Sacramento County, which includes service in the cities of Citrus Heights, Folsom, Rancho Cordova and Elk Grove. Sacramento buses and light rail trains operate 365 days a year. SacRT's entire bus and light rail system is accessible to the disabled community. ADA services are provided under contract with Paratransit, Inc. ★

level of preparedness for independence including identifying strengths in areas such as budgeting, daily living skills and safety; Receive a monthly stipend; Meet monthly with a County social worker.

Transitional Housing Placement Plus Foster Care (THP+FC) assists with costs associated with rent, and provides a monthly stipend for utilities, furnishings, food and other necessities. You are required to meet weekly with a THP+FC social worker/case manager and meet monthly with a County social worker. It offers links to experts in the community to help in the navigation of jobs, resumes, applications, higher education and financial aid.

The Independent Living Program (ILP) provides financial assistance and services to current and former foster/probation youth, 16-20 years of age and offers assistance with vital documents, life skills classes, support groups, transportation and tutoring.

“Youth who agree to participate in the Extended Foster Care Program demonstrate more positive outcomes in areas such as employment, education and housing stability than their peers who do not,” said Stephanie Sandmeier, Human Services Program Planner. “This program is vital to help our young adults move forward and make the right decisions for their future.”

Extended Foster Care is proud to partner with iFoster, a national non-profit which has developed a jobs

program specifically for eligible foster youth between the ages of 17 and 24. iFoster helps prepare foster youth for the workforce by providing a curriculum focused on job skills, soft skills and life skills. The non-profit also partners with major employers like Raley’s, Starbucks and CVS. When young people are ready for a job, they can be matched with a potential employer. iFoster matches youth with employers offering permanent employment, guaranteed hours, decent wages, opportunities for advancement and scholarship programs.

# Having a Disability Doesn't Mean Life Stops

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Laura Monaco of Carmichael spent her whole life trying to fit in. It wasn't until she came to Society for the Blind in her mid-30s that she finally found what she was looking for – and she's never been happier.

Born with albinism, Laura grew up in Chico with white hair, fair skin and pink eyes. She was legally blind from birth. Teased her whole childhood until she could finally dye her hair and wear makeup at age 12, Laura struggled through school all the way through receiving her associate's degree at Butte College in Chico. No matter what activity she participated in, she always felt different.

“I struggled my whole life to be the same,” Laura said. “I didn't want to be that albino girl or that blind girl. I was a good cheerleader, but I would burn in the sun at cheerleading camp and couldn't see well, so I'd get discouraged.”

She became a daycare provider and ran her own business for 12 years, but sometimes faced discrimination from parents because of her vision. Married for 11 years with three children, Laura hit rock bottom in her struggle for acceptance when she got divorced at age 34. She started doing drugs, her children went to live with her parents, and she was homeless for a year

and a half until the summer of 2017 when she checked into a treatment center in Carmichael and was connected to a transitional housing program.

“I came from a good home, but I struggled with depression from feeling like an outsider my whole life,” Laura said.

In January 2018, Laura finished the transitional housing program and started classes at Society for the Blind. Here, for the first time in her life, she found a group of employees and students who understood how it felt to be blind. She began learning independent living

skills like how to cook and how to get around town using public transportation, and she learned how to use assistive technology to her advantage. She began to feel like she had a family.

“I realized how much I lived in fear and I was ready to face it,” Laura said. “Society for the Blind made me finally feel at peace with myself. I have friends who all have the same struggles and understand me.”

When she had the opportunity to apply for a job working in the North State Assistive Technology Store at

Society for the Blind, she jumped at the chance – and was hired. A year later, she can't say enough positive things about her job and her daily opportunities to help people discover the same assistive technology tools that have changed her life. She plans to go back to school for her bachelor's degree and wants to stay working at the store as long as possible – and she's seen the effect her new life has had on her kids, now ages 21, 16 and 12.

“My kids are really proud of me,” Laura said through tears. “There was a lot that had been broken during those years. Now they love me walking in the mall with my cane and helped me celebrate my first anniversary of sobriety. They're glad to have their mom back, and I've shown them that you can pick yourself up from these things. Having a disability doesn't mean life stops.”

Laura's number one recommendation to people who feel different in any way is to get connected.

“Find a support group, a friend, someone you have something in common with,” Laura said. “There's a lot out there now because of the Internet and Facebook, and it makes a huge difference. If I had done that when I was younger, my life and my kids' lives would have been a lot different.”

**Matt Roush:** I was startled to see *Counterpart* axed so abruptly on the eve of its second-season finale. It may have been a cult hit at best, but a network like Starz could use a few more of those. But as with many outlets in this turbulent

industry, Starz is undergoing some corporate and executive changes, and marginal series tend to become casualties. It's always possible that the producing studio could shop it to a new home—and streaming a show this addictive and dense makes the most sense—but even with J.K. Simmons' marvelous dual performance at the core, this may be a tough sell.

**Question:** The season finale of *Manifest* showed that Ben, Michaela and

Cal would possibly die on 6/2/2024. Tell them not to worry, the show will be canceled by then. — Lino

# Sacramento Keeps On Fooling Us

“Fool me once, shame on you. Fool me twice, shame on me,” so the saying goes. Unfortunately, California voters have been fooled (aka lied to) so many times by our political leaders that perhaps they have come to expect it. For a politician to actually keep his or her word is now the exception, not the rule.

And it's not just voters who get fooled. Interest groups and other officials are often snookered by those with more political power. Several recent displays of this political behavior show beyond any doubt that promises made in Sacramento have an extraordinarily short shelf life.

The first example deals with California's one-of-a-kind “cap and trade” law, a market-based regulatory system for incentivizing reductions in greenhouse gas emissions. Under this program, impacted industries must pay for emitting greenhouse gases by purchasing credits at auction. The program was set to expire in 2020, but in 2017 there was a big political push to extend “cap and trade” in a way that would impose another huge cost to refineries and utilities, which would then pass those costs to California drivers, truckers and electricity customers.

Surprisingly, many industries forced into the “cap-and-trade” auctions supported the extension. They did so because they were threatened by Gov. Jerry Brown, environmental extremists and powerful regulators that if they didn't, they'd be hit with an alternative program run completely by the government bureaucrats at the California Air

Resources Board. Taxpayer groups, small-business interests and most Republicans opposed the extension because it would further raise California's already sky-high cost of living. In addition to the cost, there was nothing in the political deal that guaranteed CARB wouldn't move forward with punishing regulations anyway.

Regrettably, the “it could have been worse” argument persuaded a handful of Republican legislators to vote for the cap-and-trade extension. And, true to form, the taxpayers' predictions have come true. CARB has adopted a regulation relating to a “price ceiling” that will increase the cost of the cap-and-trade program by an additional 60 percent. Today's gas prices and electricity costs will seem like a bargain compared to what they will be in a few short years under this new regulation.

The next example deals with the promises made regarding Senate Bill 1 in 2017, which imposed a huge increase in the car and gas tax. An effort to repeal those taxes with Proposition 6 failed at the ballot in November when the interests which benefit financially from the tax overwhelmed the repeal advocates with tens of millions of dollars in deceptive ad campaigns as well as illegal campaign activity.

The politicians who favored the tax hikes promised that money from SB 1 would be used to fix California's crumbling roads. But now, Gov. Newsom has said he would like to hold back those funds from local governments that fail to approve enough housing projects, typically

high-density, transit-oriented housing projects.

If local transportation funds are held hostage until local governments genuflect to state-imposed mandates on housing, that would expressly violate the promises made to voters that the state's transportation woes would finally be addressed.

A third example of a deal about to be broken involves beverage taxes. Before the 2018 election, the American Beverage Association spent several million dollars to gather signatures for an initiative that would have required a two-thirds majority for approval of any and all new state and local taxes in California. The proposal was strongly supported by taxpayer groups and the business community at large. But the ABA made a deal with Gov. Brown to remove the initiative from the ballot in exchange for a new law that would ban state and local beverage taxes for 13 years. Although the beverage-tax ban was passed, the deal will almost surely be broken. Supporters of the beverage taxes have already proposed a ballot initiative, and the law can always be changed by a new crop of legislators who never met a tax they didn't like.

There is an object lesson here. Political deals made in Sacramento are born to be broken. In light of this, it would behoove those who still believe in free enterprise, limited government and property rights to simply advocate for that which is right and decline to sit down and negotiate away our freedoms. Because all these deals have one thing in common – taxpayers always lose.

“I've been at the Government trough most of my life,” Sacramento Sheriff Scott Jones recently told Carmichael merchants. “But I know it's small businesses that build the economy and create jobs.” Jones was addressing nearly 100 Chamber of Commerce supporters at Christ Community Church.

His speech summarized trends and issues that challenge his department. A recent study he commissioned contradicted

opinion that that anti-police sentiment is rife and rising. “Our poll showed that 80 percent (of county participants) were satisfied with us,” said Jones. “That's close to the national average. The small proportion of people who feel otherwise is compounded by the media and politicians who don't live in the real world. My officers and I feel the support of our community every day.”

“That's not to say everything's hunky-dory,” he continued. “I wish I had a solution for homelessness. The County devotes a

lot of resources to help the homeless. But they also want to protect residents and businesses. They've made new regulations but because homeless people have advocates, it's hard to get those regulations to stick.”

He urged people affected by itinerant loitering and trash to keep calling his Homeless Outreach Team. “We can get things cleaned up. Our officers also have access to resources to help people who are open to assistance,” he said. “But we still must be cops. We still have to keep the community safe.” ★

# Sacramento County DA Reports



## Defendants Sentenced for Multiple Armed Robberies

**DATE:** February 22, 2019  
**CASE:** Ceariaco Cabrellis & Frank Moppins (Case #16FE002475)

**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Scott Schweibish, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit

The Honorable Allen Sumner sentenced Frank Moppins to 25 years in prison. An allegation that Moppins has a prior strike conviction for first-degree burglary was found true at the sentencing hearing. Ceariaco Cabrellis was previously sentenced to 27 years, 8 months in prison.

On September 26, 2018, a jury convicted Ceariaco Cabrellis and Frank Moppins of four counts of robbery with the allegation Cabrellis and Moppins personally used a firearm during the robberies. Cabrellis was also found to have caused great bodily injury to one of the victims.

On February 4, 2016, Ceariaco Cabrellis and Frank Moppins were at a park smoking marijuana. When they saw the four victims arrive at the park, the defendants asked them if they had any marijuana to sell or to smoke. The victims replied they did not have any marijuana and left. The defendants followed the victims, approached them and asked again if they had any marijuana. Cabrellis and Moppins then pulled out a gun and ordered the victims to get on the ground face down. When one of the victims refused, Cabrellis pistol whipped him causing a broken orbital socket and broken nose. The defendants proceeded to rob the victims of items they had in their possession before fleeing the scene.

Cabrellis had two pending felony cases against him at the time of this offense.

## Defendant Convicted of Hotel Room Murder

**DATE:** February 14, 2019  
**CASE:** Mario Michael Mayorga (Case #16FE022652)

**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Caroline Park, Homicide Unit  
 Mario Michael Mayorga was convicted by a jury of the first-degree

murder of Tina Morales. The jury also found true that Mayorga used a deadly weapon during the murder.

Mario Michael Mayorga and the victim were in a dating relationship. On November 24, 2016, Thanksgiving Day, the victim checked into a motel near Stockton Boulevard and Mack Road. The victim had Thanksgiving dinner with Mayorga and the two then walked to a friend's house. Another friend drove the two back to the victim's motel room at 1:30 a.m. At 11:30 a.m. that day, motel employees found the victim with multiple stab and puncture wounds.

Allegations that Mayorga suffered two prior strike convictions for assault with a firearm and assault with a deadly weapon will be determined at the sentencing hearing.

Mayorga faces a maximum sentence of 75 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for March 15, 2019, at 10:30 a.m. in Department 10 before the Honorable Eugene Balonon.

## Defendant Sentenced for Murder, Attempted Murder for shooting at Cinco de Mayo Party

**DATE:** February 11, 2019  
**CASE:** Kejhonne Henderson (Case #17FE008447)

**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Caroline Park, Homicide Unit

The Honorable Stacy Boulware Eurie sentenced Kejhonne Henderson to 72 years to life in prison. On November 16, 2018, a jury convicted Henderson of the second-degree murder of Jordan Pannell and attempted murder. The jury also found true firearm allegations on both counts.

On May 5, 2017, Kejhonne Henderson was at a Cinco de Mayo house party in North Highlands. When Henderson got upset about the Mozy music being played, Jordan Pannell intervened. Henderson and Pannell walked outside, where Henderson shot Pannell nine times, killing him. As Henderson tried to flee, he was tackled by the second victim and the two struggled over the gun. Henderson shot that victim in the thigh. The second shooting victim survived his wounds. ★
