**FAIR OAKS, CA (MPG)** - Two beloved US presidents and their first ladies were joined this week by frontiersmen, Buffalo Soldiers, colonial infantry and a huge sampling of Americana at Mount Vernon Memorial Park in Fair Oaks. The annual event celebrates Presidents' Day.

A chime from a Liberty Bell replica began hours of reenactments and educational opportunities. While prospectors panned for gold, nimble-fingered ladies demonstrated the

genteel art of lace-making. Abraham Lincoln introduced "my wife, Mary" and George Washington presented a sedate Martha to hundreds of visitors.

Pony Express recruiters were on hand seeking "Young, skinny, wiry fellows... willing to risk death daily." Activities were loudly punctuated by the firing of an antique Howitzer cannon, provided Sierra Nevada Mormon Pioneer volunteers. For a warmer and more fuzzy experience, children were encouraged to pet the baby goats that represented milk and meat to many early pioneer farmers.

Heritage Day's historical cast was

augmented by US Army officers and a Huey Vietnam helicopter. "It came on a trailer," explains Mount Vernon manager Lisa Goudy. "Its active days are over but, for the kids who got to sit in the cockpit, a Huey is still exciting."

The free event aims to bring history to life and honor US presidents. "It was a perfect day for everyone," reports Goudy. "Everyone enjoyed the part they played, from our two presidents to the baby goats."

## California DTFA Reports Cannabis Tax Revenues for Fourth Quarter of Last Year

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - The California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) reported revenue numbers on February 19, 2019 for cannabis sales for the 4th quarter of 2018. Tax revenue reported by the cannabis industry totaled \$103.3 million for 4th quarter returns due by January 31, 2019, which includes state cultivation, excise, and sales taxes. It does not include tax revenue collected by each jurisdiction.

As of February 14, 2019, California's cannabis excise tax generated \$50.8 million in revenue reported on 4thquarter returns due by January 31, 2019. The cultivation tax generated \$16.4 million and the sales tax generated \$36.1 million in reported revenue. Retail sales of medicinal cannabis and medicinal cannabis products are exempt from sales and use taxes if the purchaser provides a valid Medical Marijuana Identification card and valid government-issued identification card.

Previously reported revenue for 3rd quarter returns was revised to \$100.8 million, which included \$53.3 million in excise tax, \$12.6 million in cultivation tax, and \$34.9 million in sales tax.

Revisions to quarterly data are the result of amended and late returns, and other tax return adjustments.

In November 2016, California voters approved Proposition 64, the Control, Regulate, and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act. Beginning on January 1, 2018, two new cannabis taxes went into effect: a cultivation tax on all harvested cannabis that enters the commercial market and a 15 percent excise tax upon purchasers of cannabis and cannabis products. In addition, retail sales of cannabis and cannabis products are subject to state and local sales tax.

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Some eye-popping antiques slip easily through a buttonhole. At the California Button Society's March 9 expo, you might snag a Civil War tunic fastener for \$50. If you lust for hand-painted 18th century pieces, be prepared to unbutton your billfold.

What astonishes at such bazaars is the availability of seriously old stuff. Snipped from long-ago rotted garments, many are thumb-nail masterpieces. "We often look at old buttons and imagine the stories they could tell,"

says Button Club treasurer Susan Rhoades. "They were traded, stolen and inherited. Lives were lost in making them; pearl dust and mercury (for gold plating) killed many. "You learn so much about history, art and manufacturing from buttons."

In the Middle Ages, no material was too grand for the button makers' art. Georgian aristocrats later bespoke Gainsborough-style portraits – sometimes of their pets – to fasten vests. When Queen Victoria took to wearing jet specimens, society followed. Though zippers have revolutionized modern fastening, nifty little buttons

have never been completely undone. "People visit our shows show seeking that one perfect item," says Sacramento collector Faye Wolfe. "One lady brought a vest she'd sewn; she wanted buttons for it. In the end, she chose four, each different. Who says they have to match? Our button world is full of eccentricity."

The Button Bazaar runs from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, March 9, at the La Sierra Center, 5325 Engle Rd, Carmichael. The show offers a free service for valuing buttons. Admission is by \$2 donation. For information, contact fwolfe@surewest.net. ★

## FBI Teen Academy Provides High School Juniors Unique Opportunity

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Are you a high school junior who wonders if TV shows featuring the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) are realistic, what the FBI really does day-to-day, and what it really takes to work for the FBI? If you are a teen currently attending school within the area the FBI's Sacramento field office serves, you can apply to attend the Spring 2019 FBI Teen Academy to find out. The application is available for download online on the FBI Sacramento Field Office's Community Outreach page.

The FBI Sacramento Field Office will host its Spring 2019 FBI Teen Academy at its headquarters in Roseville on Friday, April 12, 2019. All high school juniors—whether enrolled in public, private,

charter, or home school—may apply by downloading the application located on the FBI Sacramento Field Office's Community Outreach web page. When complete, the application package includes three mandatory elements: application, essay, and release forms. All applications must arrive at the FBI Sacramento Field Office by 4 p.m. on Monday, March 11, 2019. Email and electronic submissions are not accepted.

Students chosen for the class spend an informative, interactive day at FBI Sacramento Field office headquarters in Roseville. The class learns about the FBI's investigative priorities, participates in unique, interactive experiences, and engages directly with FBI personnel. After completing the class, students are familiar with the FBI's mission and what personal and academic choices

one may make to be eligible to become a member of the FBI workforce. Students are also more aware of the threats their communities face, they fully understand the challenges of the online environment, and they are better prepared to mentor their peers.

The FBI Sacramento Field Office serves 34 California Counties: Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, El Dorado, Fresno, Glenn, Inyo, Kern, Kings, Lassen, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Modoc, Mono, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Stanislaus, Sutter, Tehama, Tulare, Tuolumne, Trinity, Yolo, and Yuba.

The FBI Teen Academy is a no-cost experience for students; however, families may incur personal expenses for any travel necessary to attend the class. ★

## U.S. Department of Transportation Announces Cancellation of Grant Funds to CA High-Speed Rail Project

**WASHINGTON** - The U.S. Department of Transportation announced today that the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) intends to cancel \$929 million in Federal grant funds yet to be paid for the California High-Speed

Rail project envisioned to connect the L.A. Basin to the San Francisco Bay Area. In addition, the Department announced it is actively exploring every legal option to seek the return from California of \$2.5 billion in Federal funds

FRA previously granted for this now-defunct project. FRA Administrator Ronald L. Batory notified the California HSR Authority (CHSRA) of this action in a letter today, February 19, 2019.

## Defendant Convicted of Murder, Attempted Murder, Gun Charges

**DATE:** February 6, 2019  
**CASE:** David Eggman (Case #18FE000227)  
**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Shelly McGill, Homicide Unit

David Eggman was convicted by a jury of the second-degree murder of Angelo Reyes, attempted murder, assault with a semi-automatic firearm, discharging a firearm at an occupied vehicle and being a felon in possession of a firearm. The jury also found true allegations that Eggman personally used a firearm causing great bodily injury or death.

On December 16, 2017, Angelo Reyes went to a convenience store and ran into people he knew. A verbal confrontation ensued and the other party called David Eggman and others to the scene for reinforcement. Eggman punched Reyes, who then left and later went to a house where Eggman had gone. After another verbal confrontation, Eggman produced a gun and started shooting. Reyes was shot and killed. Reyes' brother was struck, but he survived.

An allegation that Eggman suffered a prior strike conviction for voluntary manslaughter will be determined at the sentencing hearing. Eggman faces a maximum sentence of approximately 85 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for April 5, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 62 before the Honorable Michael Savage

## Defendant Convicted for Foothill Farms Murder

**DATE:** February 5, 2019  
**CASE:** Souksavanh Phetvongkham (Case #17FE005490)  
**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Matt Chisholm, Homicide Unit

Souksavanh Phetvongkham was convicted by a jury of the first-degree murder of Mario Benitez-Gallegos. The jury also found that

Phetvongkham personally used a deadly weapon during the murder.

The victim and Souksavanh Phetvongkham had been friends until a recent falling-out. A mutual friend of the two gave a ride to Phetvongkham. During that ride, the two stopped and picked-up the victim. During the course of the car ride, the two men agreed to fight and got out of the car. During the fight, Phetvongkham stabbed the victim multiple times, including a stab wound to the heart. The victim was taken to a hospital by his friend, but he died from blood loss.

An allegation that Phetvongkham suffered a prior strike conviction for aggravated felony assault will be determined at the sentencing hearing.

Phetvongkham faces a maximum sentence of 56 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for March 8, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. in Department 31 before the Honorable Gerrit Wood.

## Defendant Convicted of First-Degree Murder

**DATE:** February 1, 2019  
**CASE:** Joshua Childers (Case #17FE005883)

**PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Satnam Rattu, Homicide Unit  
 Joshua Childers was convicted by a jury of the first-degree murder of Victoria Vasquez. The jury also found true a use of firearm enhancement.

On March 28, 2017, a Placer County 911 dispatch received a call from a man reporting he had shot his wife and she could be found in a mobile home park in South Sacramento. A record check of the phone number used to call 911 located an address associated with the phone number. Officers responded to the residence and found a deceased woman in a bedroom. Law enforcement located Childers by pinging his phone and he was taken into custody the same day.

Childers faces a maximum sentence of 50 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for March 22, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. in Department 34 before the Honorable Ernest Sawtelle.

# Assemblyman Ken Cooley Introduces the Climate Innovation Act to Prepare for Climate Risks

- On Monday, January 28, Assemblyman Ken Cooley (Rancho Cordova) introduced

AB 296, the Climate Innovation Act, that would award grants for the research, development, and acceleration of innovations and technologies mitigating the impacts of climate change. The program would award matching grant funds through a competitive peer review process to make advancement on significant challenges climate change poses.

Scientific reports warn of the devastating impacts to human health, the economy, and our natural environment, unless action is taken to mitigate global warming immediately.

According to the recently released UN Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Special Report and the National Climate Assessment, impacts on natural systems from global warming have already been observed.

Climate related risks to health,

livelihoods, food security, water supply, human security, and economic growth are projected to increase with global warming of 1.5°C (estimated to occur approximately in the next 20 years) and increase further with warming of 2°C (estimated to occur within the next 100 years). There is a significant possibility that unanticipated and difficult or impossible-to-manage changes in the climate system will occur throughout the next century as multiple climate related events occur simultaneously and key warming thresholds are crossed.

Though the predictions are dire, the world's leading climate scientists provide

hope – outlining a path forward. Future climate risks would be limited by enhancing investments in climate mitigation efforts, making behavioral changes, and accelerating innovation.

"The aim of AB 296 is to accelerate innovation and add more tools to our toolkit to better prepare us for the significant challenges climate change poses," said Assemblyman Ken Cooley. "With human ingenuity and innovation, we can enable the protection of our natural environment and limit impacts and risks global warming poses to human health, public safety, and the economy."

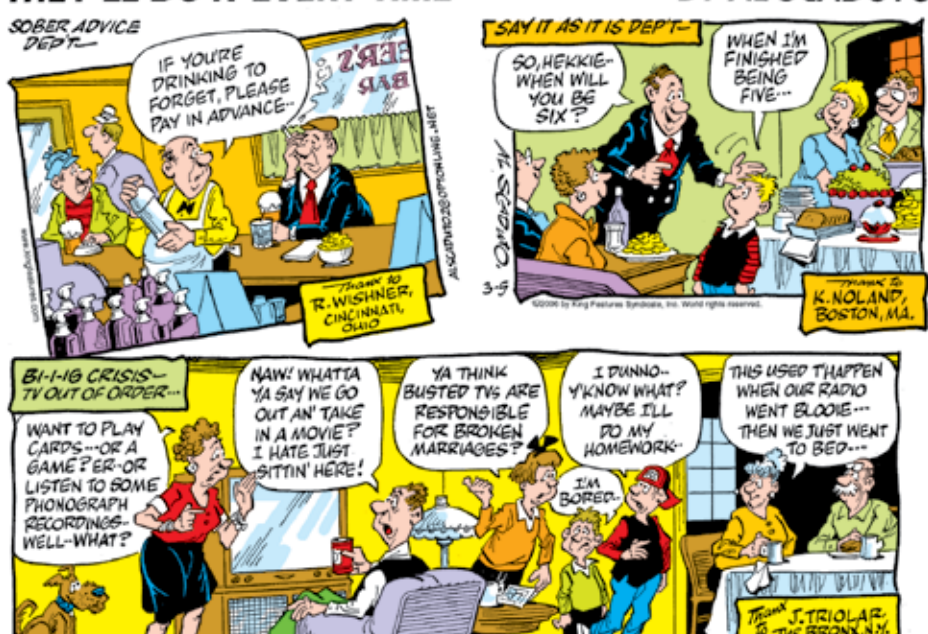

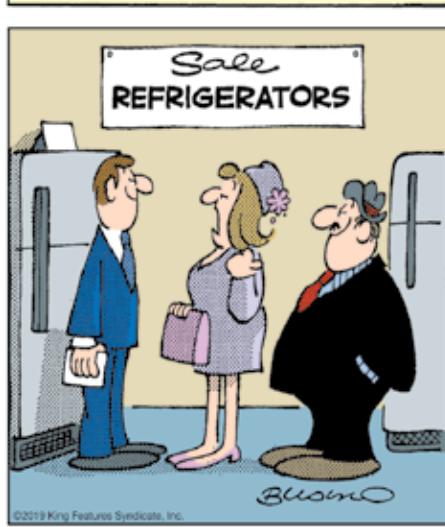

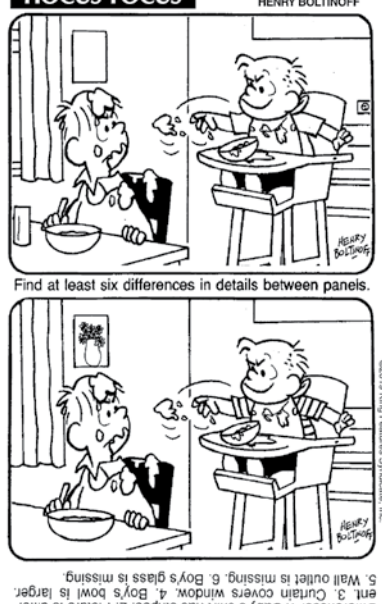

**February Community Meetings**

I will be holding my second community meeting for this month on Thursday, February 28, to provide an update on Sacramento County's Homeless Initiatives. The guest speakers will be Deputy County Executive Bruce Wagstaff and the Director of Human Assistance Ann Edwards who will report on the progress being made to address critical needs of those experiencing homelessness through four major initiatives Sacramento County began in October 2017.

This meeting will be in Arden Arcade at Sacramento Suburban Water District's Board

Room, 3701 Marconi Avenue, on Thursday, February 28, at 6 pm. An earlier meeting on the same topic was held in Carmichael on February 13.

**Learn Criminal Justice First-Hand**
