## Another Star is Born



Sacramento Fire Fighters recently helped restore Palm Drive's Christmas tree star. Firefighter Jason Baldwin scaled a 100-foot ladder to replace lights on the Carmichael landmark.

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Stretched by calls to fight Butte County fires, Sacramento firefighters recently found time to foster Christmas cheer at home. Thanks to the officers and Property and Business Improvement District leaders, the old Post Office star on Palm Drive shines more brightly.

Located in the central business area, the historical route is lined with Canary palms that community matriarch Mary Deterding planted around 1909. At the same time, her neighbor John Scroggs nourished a deodar cedar. The exotic transplants grew up with Carmichael. Scroggs' cypress became famous in 1960, when the US Post Office planned a Palm Drive facility. Federal architects sentenced the evergreen to the saw mill.

Carmichael's famed naturalist Effie Yeaw lived yards from the giant and began a petition to save it. Washington DC relented. Marking the community

victory, a low concrete wall and a plaque for Effie Yeaw remains beneath the tree. Later in its 100-plus years, the deodar was crowned with a five-foot star whose illumination became a Christmas tradition. Long-time residents recall finding their way home on winter nights by the lofty icon.

The ornament shone through many more Decembers after the Post Office moved to Fair Oaks Boulevard. About 10 years ago, its wiring fizzled. The deodar remained dark until last year, when PIBD chairman Gary Hursh beheld its forlorn bauble. "PIBD's trying to improve the quality of local businesses and our residential environment," the attorney explained. "We decided the star needed to be relit." AAA Crane Company owner Gary Matranga rose in a crane basket to string new lights on the stellar frame. As night fell last December, the



lights came on again.

Gary Hursh this year supplied brighter lights and a new mission for firefighters. The job was completed last week when officer Baldwin restrung the icon. "We work hard to keep people safe," observed Baldwin. "But by doing something like this, we have a chance to bring joy to the community."

## IRS Warns of "Tax Transcript" Email Scam

*Special Dangers to Business Networks*

**WASHINGTON (MPG)** - The Internal Revenue Service and Security Summit partners warned the public this week of a surge of fraudulent emails impersonating the IRS and using tax transcripts as bait to entice users to open documents containing malware.

The scam is especially problematic for businesses whose employees might open the malware because this malware can spread throughout the network and potentially take months to successfully remove.

This well-known malware, known as Emotet, generally poses as specific banks and financial institutions in its effort to trick people into opening infected documents. The Summit partnership of the IRS, state tax agencies and the nation's tax industry remind taxpayers to watch out for this scam.

However, in the past few weeks, the scam masqueraded as the IRS, pretending to be from "IRS Online." The scam email carries an attachment labeled "Tax Account Transcript" or something similar, and the subject line uses some variation of the phrase "tax transcript." These clues can change with each version of the malware. Scores of these malicious Emotet emails were forwarded to [phishing@irs.gov](mailto:phishing@irs.gov) recently.

The IRS reminds taxpayers it does not send unsolicited emails to the public, nor would it email

## Jingle Bell Run Honors Local Arthritis Warrior

*Six-Year-Old Fights Juvenile Arthritis Every Day*

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - In a Carmichael home where a family with three boys under 10 live, super heroes are widely respected, and even part of the décor. Breakfast is served on top of Avenger placemats and Superman and Thor are nearby. Ironically, the kid eating his cereal from a bowl placed on top of Black Panther (his favorite) is a superhero in his own right. He is sharing his own battle with juvenile arthritis to bring awareness to the disease.

Six-year-old Jeremy Kelley

will leave Black Panther behind and don a reindeer suit for a day the whole family is celebrating. Jeremy will be leading the Reindeer Games and Kid Run at the Arthritis Foundation's 2018 Jingle Bell Run for Arthritis, supported by Sutter Health (where Jeremy's mom works). The race takes place on December 9.

"Our honorees and volunteers are what make this event memorable every year, and this year we're humbled to honor Jeremy Kelley who, along with his parents, is a true arthritis warrior," says Heather Funk, the Arthritis Foundations'

Pacific Northwest region development director. "We are all pulling for him to be able to finish the Kid Run."

Jeremy's warrior-status journey started right before his third birthday. He was simply doing what kids do when they are three, but had a decidedly different outcome.

"Jeremy jumped off the couch in the living room and onto a beanbag chair," his mother, Jaime Kelley says. In a few days, his leg was swollen to triple its size. X-rays didn't show any damage, but Jeremy didn't improve over

a sensitive document such as a tax transcript, which is a summary of a tax return. The IRS urges taxpayers not to open the email or the attachment. If using a personal computer, delete or forward the scam email to [phishing@irs.gov](mailto:phishing@irs.gov). If you

see these using an employer's computer, notify the company's technology professionals.

The United States Computer Emergency Readiness Team (US-CERT) issued a warning in July about earlier versions of the Emotet in

Alert (TA18-201A) Emotet Malware. US-CERT has labeled the Emotet Malware "among the most costly and destructive malware affecting state, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) governments, and the private and public sectors." ★

# ARC Breaks Ground on New STEM Center

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - This Fall the campus of American River College has provided new challenges for students and staff with the groundbreaking of a new Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) building. The 38,000 sq. ft. three-story building will replace the Liberal Arts Wing that has existed at the college since the 1960s. The demolition of the Liberal Arts Wing has forced students and staff to abandon routine parking lots, walkways, and drop off points formerly familiar, a necessary complication to a much needed

infrastructural upgrade. Design elements of the new building will provide shared, flexible and movable space and labs for programs and disciplines that include Business & Computer Science, Mathematics, Astronomy, Physics and Engineering. The second phase of the project will benefit the Science division (which produces 47% of ARC's graduates and is the largest division in the Los Rios Community College District) with long-awaited lab space modernization and state-of-the-art wet labs for biology and chemistry. Many successful and notable alums in the fields of science, healthcare,

engineering, biotech and research have benefited from their start at American River College. This new STEM Center will offer greater opportunities to even more students. ARC has launched a major fundraising effort for STEM Innovation and 21st Century Science. This campaign will seek to raise \$3.5M in private support and provide a margin of excellence for students in both phases of the project. 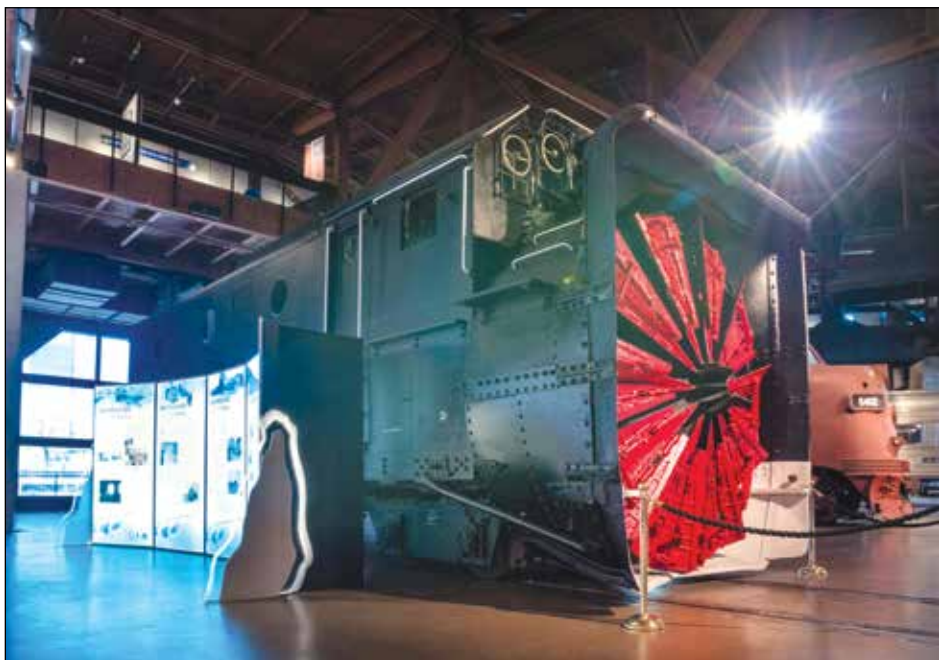

## Historic 1920s Rotary Snowplow and Compelling “Snowbound in the Sierra” Exhibit Returns

### SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)

- For a limited time, visitors to the California State Railroad Museum have a special opportunity to see a 251,000-pound rotary snowplow from the Museum’s impressive collection along with a compelling exhibit titled “Snowbound in the Sierra.” The SP MW205 (formerly known as SP 715) snowplow on display was built in 1920, converted to electric in 1958, retired by Union Pacific in 2004 and was donated to the Railroad Museum in 2008. Since then, the historic snowplow has been housed in the Shops in the Sacramento Railyards except for short-term displays at the Railroad Museum each winter.

With the historic snowplow as an eye-catching centerpiece, the exhibit highlights the dramatic story of 226 passengers and crew members who were

rescued – with the help of crews working around the clock and seven rotary snowplows – after being trapped on a luxury streamliner locomotive during a massive snowstorm in the Sierra Nevada in 1952. The exhibit includes riveting narrative from passengers and crew, a special kiosk, exhibit case and video along with an interactive game.

The historic snowplow and exhibit help give Museum visitors an understanding of the various snow removal methods used by the railroad to allow for year-round locomotive use. While Museum guests will learn how cumbersome, arduous and dangerous snow removal on the railroad can be and how the preferred methods have changed over time, they will also gain insight into the critical role they played in saving lives and clearing the path for freight and transportation. Rotary snowplows were often used by the railroad as a very

last resort – such as was the case for the City of San Francisco locomotive highlighted in the exhibit – due to the incredible expense involved. Rotary snowplows only moved five to ten miles per hour, had high fuel costs and required an elite crew. It is estimated that less than 200 rotary snowplows still exist throughout the world today.

Currently on display in the Museum’s Roundhouse, the rotary snowplow and companion “Snowbound in the Sierra” exhibit will remain on public view through March 2019. Viewing the exhibit and locomotive are included in Museum admission: \$12 for adults; \$6 for youths ages 6-17; free for children ages 5 and under. # Get Ready for Taxes:

Here's How the New Tax Law Revised Family Tax Credits

**WASHINGTON (MPG)** - More families will be able to get more money under the newly-revised Child Tax Credit, according to the Internal Revenue Service.

This is the third in a series of reminders to help taxpayers get ready for the upcoming tax filing season. Additionally, the IRS has recently updated a special page on its website with steps to take now for the 2019 tax filing season.

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA), the tax reform legislation passed in December 2017, doubled the maximum Child Tax Credit, boosted income limits to be able to claim the credit, and revised the identification number requirement for 2018 and subsequent years. The new law also created a second smaller credit of up to \$500 per dependent aimed at taxpayers supporting older children and other relatives who do not qualify for the Child Tax Credit.

"As we approach the 2019 tax-filing season, I want to remind taxpayers

to take advantage of this valuable tax credit if they are eligible to claim it," said IRS Commissioner Chuck Rettig. "Tax reform changed the tax code significantly and doubling the Child Tax Credit is an example of how the changes impact taxpayers."

Here are some important things taxpayers need to know as they plan for the tax-filing season in early 2019:

### Child Tax Credit increased

Higher income limits mean more families are now eligible for the Child Tax Credit. The credit begins to phase out at \$200,000 of modified adjusted gross income, or \$400,000 for married couples filing jointly, which is up from the 2017 levels of \$75,000 for single filers or \$110,000 for married couples filing jointly.

Increased from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per qualifying child, the credit applies if the child is younger than 17 at the end of the tax year, the taxpayer claims the child as a dependent, and the child lives with the taxpayer for

more than six months of the year. The qualifying child must also have a valid Social Security Number issued before the due date of the tax return, including extensions.

Up to \$1,400 of the credit can be refundable for each qualifying child. This means an eligible taxpayer may get a refund even if they don't owe any tax.

### New Credit for Other Dependents

A new tax credit – Credit for Other Dependents — is available for dependents for whom taxpayers cannot claim the Child Tax Credit. These dependents may include dependent children who are age 17 or older at the end of 2018 or parents or other qualifying relatives supported by the taxpayer.

During the upcoming tax-filing season, the IRS urges taxpayers to use the agency's Interactive Tax Assistant to see if they qualify for either of these credits. To find out more, visit IRS.gov. ★

- Choose the right size pot for cooking so that you don't use and heat more water than necessary.

- Put a couple of pitchers of water on the table instead of filling up everyone's water glass.
- Use leftover drinking water on your houseplants. Be sure to check the soil moisture to make sure they need water first. SSWD has complimentary moisture meters available for its customers.
- Use the dishwasher instead of hand washing. Using an Energy Star-certified dishwasher can save you energy and thousands of gallons

of water a year. You can find a complete list online at: <https://www.energystar.gov/products/appliances/dishwashers>

- If there is a lot of food left over on a plate, scrape the dish into the trash instead of using the garbage disposal, and if you have a newer dishwasher, you can skip pre-rinsing. Many new dishwashers have sensors that detect how dirty dishes are.
- Compost leftover vegetables instead of using the garbage disposal.
- If you have to hand wash some dishes or pots, make sure to fill one basin with wash water and the other with rinse water.
- Soak pots and pans instead of running water over them while you scrub them.

# Motorist Killed in a Two Vehicle Collision

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - On November 23, 2018, at approximately 12:24 AM, the California Highway Patrol (CHP) received reports of a multiple vehicle traffic collision on northbound SR-51 (Capital City freeway) just north of Arden Way. 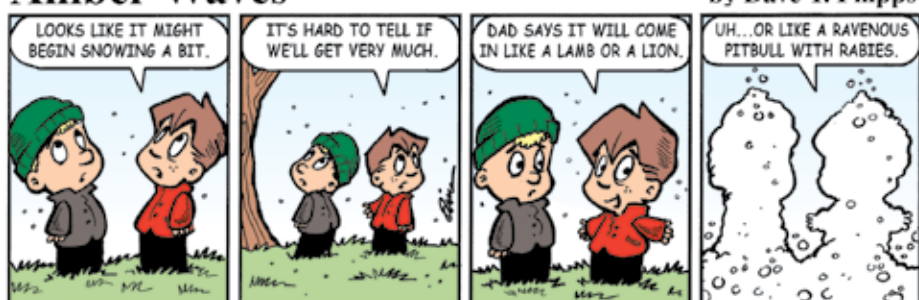

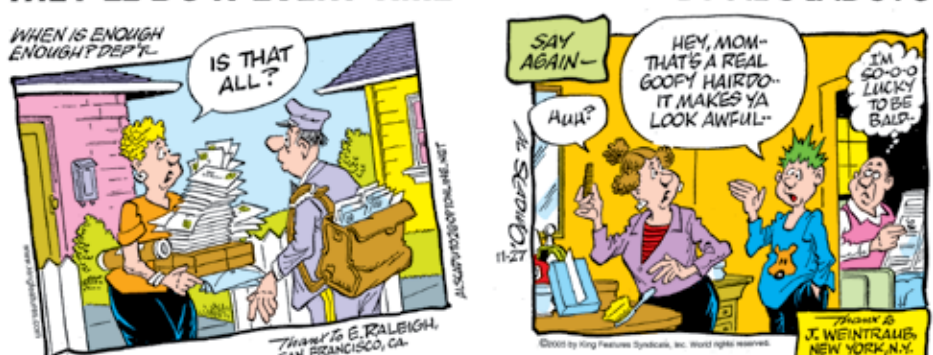

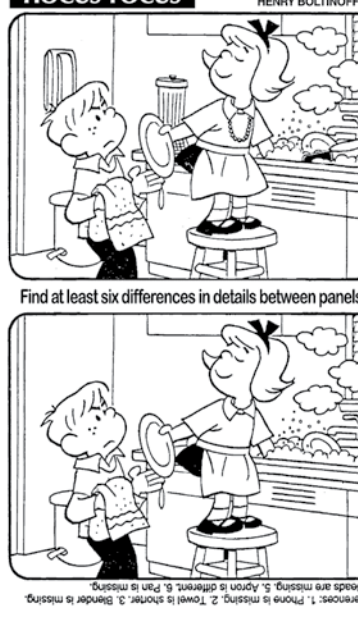

We will not be silenced by Goliath-sized secularists. We will stand up to their intimidation tactics and their attempts to censor Christmas. But we need a war chest to defeat them.

time. Clearly, jumping off the couch was not the issue.

The Kelleys went to their own pediatrician, were referred to Shriners Hospital and got an appointment several months later. By that time both knees and an ankle were severely swollen, and Jeremy was back to crawling. Doctors there did testing, but were also stumped by Jeremy's severe symptoms. Shriners Hospital suggested taking Jeremy to UC San Francisco, where doctors there gave him aggressive joint injections. They worked.

"He started running around like crazy, the previous six months seemed like a bad dream," Jaime Kelley remembers. "We couldn't believe we had Jeremy back."

Unfortunately, the "miracle" really wasn't. Despite Jeremy's newfound mobility, the disease wasn't subsiding. More shots followed, and injecting the medicine was up to mom. Jeremy developed a bad case of shot anxiety, turning the household into turmoil when it was time for yet another one. Knowing the injection routine was impacting the family and hoping the disease was in remission, the doctors decided to give Jeremy a break from

the rigid shot regime. The symptoms returned.

So now the Kelleys are in management mode, continuing with the injections sometimes, seeing a therapist for the shot trauma — and coping. Pain is still prevalent, and doctors say the remedy is harsh: push through it.

"It's something we will just have to deal with," says Jaime, "Right now we are trying yoga." Grateful for the help she received from the Foundation, Jaime is now an Arthritis Foundation activist who mentors — and learns from — other parents and the staff and board of the Foundation.

Andrew Pete, service line director for Perioperative Services at Sutter Medical Center Sacramento, is the Northern California Arthritis Foundation chair. He is one of many Sutter Health community volunteers who donate expertise and services to nonprofits throughout the region.

"People assume that arthritis is a condition you get when you get old," Pete says. "But our Arthritis Warrior Jeremy confirms that kids get arthritis too. We want people to know the symptoms and get help because there are treatments available."

Juvenile arthritis affects more than 300,000

children in the U.S., a figure experts consider on the low side. Considering the obstacles and determination parents must endure to convince their medical provider that the symptoms are more than just kids being kids, the disease is underreported and appallingly undertreated.

The Arthritis Foundation is trying to change the trajectory of misdiagnosis by funding cutting-edge research for new treatments and discovering a cure, advocating for health care access, and offering support to victims of the disease.

The Jingle Bell Run is part of that strategy. It is a holiday event where at least 1,000 people will gather at Sacramento's Crocker Park to join the movement to conquer the disease. The 5K run encourages participants to dress in festive costumes and get moving to raise awareness and funds to cure America's #1 cause of disability. Meanwhile, Jeremy loves to escape his trials and play Pie Face, a game-in-a-box with rules that dictate that if you are the unlucky opponent, a lever slaps whip cream all over your face. Jeremy thinks it's hilarious.
