## Deputy Robert French Added to Wall of Honor

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Dozens of uniformed Sacramento Sheriff's officers last weekend joined families who sacrificed loved ones in service does not shield you from the emptito community or nation.

The gathering saluted Deputy Susan Peters told families of the Robert French, who was inducted to men whose names are recalled by the Wall of Honor at Patriots Park. The ceremony added French's plaque to those of 13 previous honorees. Erected by Carmichael Park District, the monument salutes heroes who fell since the District was established in 1945.

A Los Angeles native, French perished during a criminal incident in August 2017. The 52-year-old father of three fell while protecting fellow officers during a gun fight at the Ramada Inn, Auburn Boulevard. A 21-year Sheriff's Department veteran, he had worked with Problem Oriented Police in the North Area Division. Speaking at Patriots Park,

his daughter Kaylen French praised the dad who raised her and siblings in Arden Arcade. "It's heartbreaking, but I am very proud and honored to celebrate his life today," she said.

"We recognize the passage of time ness you feel," County Supervisor 14 plaques. "We nevertheless hope Patriots Park is a source of comfort and pride in remembering your loved ones. ## Help Turn the Tide of **Opioid Use**

Sacramento County Release

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Progress is being made as opioid prescriptions in Sacramento County are decreasing, but more work needs to be done to prevent opioid overdose emergency department visits and deaths.

Opioids can have a number of serious side effects even when used appropriately; when used for non-medical purposes, opioids can become highly addictive.

To provide solutions, Sacramento County is an active participant in the Sacramento County Opioid Coalition that is comprised of a regional coalition of healthcare professionals, community-based organizations, law enforcement, county agencies and concerned citizens.

The Sacramento County Opioid Coalition goal is to work collaboratively on a comprehensive plan to address the opioid epidemic effectively with the following strategies: promoting safe prescribing; expanding treatment access; promoting safe medication disposal; encouraging early intervention treatment and recovery, overdose prevention; expanding public education and media outreach.

"Opioid misuse and dependency is a complex public health issue that requires a multidimensional community response," said Dr. Olivia Kasirye, Sacramento County Public Health Officer. "Through the Sacramento County Opioid Coalition, we're bringing together local organizations and citizens committed to saving lives through collaboration and action. We're engaging the medical community, providing law enforcement with life-saving tools, promoting safe medication disposal, and working to raise awareness about opioids in our community."

Sacramento County, in 2016, had 241 opioid overdose emergency department visits and 55 opioid overdose deaths. The numbers trended down in 2017 and in that year, Sacramento County received a State grant of naloxone nasal inhaler kits that were distributed to law enforcement agencies and community-based organizations.



#### Defendant Convicted of Attempted Murders of Police Officers, Shooting at Occupied Apartment

**DATE:** October 31, 2018 CASE: Armani Lee (Case #17FE002754)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Matthew Moore, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit

Armani Lee was convicted by a jury of attempted murder of a police officer, attempted murder, shooting at an inhabited dwelling and felon in possession of a firearm.

On February 4, 2017, Armani Lee got into a physical altercation with a female victim. After the fight was over, Lee pulled out a gun and fired at the victim's apartment. Both the victim's boyfriend and friend were in the apartment at the time of the shooting.

On February 10, 2017, officers tracked Lee to a house and tried to arrest him for the shooting. Lee fled and fired multiple shots at the officers. Officers returned fire and hit Lee, who was then taken into custody.

Allegations that Lee suffered prior "strike" convictions for robbery in 2010 and 2006 will be determined at sentencing.

Lee faces a maximum sentence of 139 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for December 7, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 28 before the Honorable Richard Sueyoshi.

#### **Defendants Convicted of Multiple** Child Sexual Assault Charges DATE: November 6, 2018

CASE: Chantell Gosztyla & Richard Gosztyla (Case #18FE004488)

PROSECUTOR: Principal Criminal Attorney Nancy Cochrane, Special Assault & Child Abuse Unit

Chantell Gosztyla and Richard Gosztyla were convicted by a jury of multiple counts of lewd and lascivious conduct against a young family

The defendants sexually assaulted the victim together for more than one year. When they were apprehended in Napa County, they had with them passports and \$9,000 in cash. It is suspected that they were planning on fleeing the country.

Both defendants face a maximum sentence of life in prison. Sentencing is set for December 14, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 21 before the Honorable Steve White.

#### Defendant Convicted of Shooting at Family Members in Front Yard

**DATE:** November 7, 2018 **CASE:** Markees Brown (Case #17FE017680)

**PROSECUTOR:** Markees Brown was convicted by a jury of three counts of first-degree attempted murder with premeditation and deliberation, three counts of assault with a semi-automatic firearm, three counts of shooting at individuals from a car, shooting at an inhabited dwelling and felon in possession of a firearm. The jury also found true multiple firearm enhancements.

Markees Brown was dating a young woman who was in an ongoing dispute with members of a family who lived in the Strawberry Manors neighborhood. On September 11, 2017, members of that family were out in the front yard, including a 4-year-old boy. Brown and another individual drove up to the family's residence. Brown then got out of the car, pulled out a semi-automatic handgun and shot four times at the residence. No one was struck by the gunfire. Brown got back into the car and drove away. Several family members were able to identify Brown as the

Allegations that Brown suffered three prior first-degree residential burglary convictions from 2015 and 2016 will be determined at the sentencing hearing.

Brown faces a maximum sentence of 118 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for November 30, 2018, at 10:30 a.m. in Department 19 before the Honorable Ernest Sawtelle.

## The Politics of E15



Commentary by Dr. Mark Hendrickson

On October 9, President Donald Trump announced that he was lifting the EPA's ban on summertime sales of E15—a motor fuel blend consisting of 15% ethanol instead of the usual 10%. Trump's announcement is telling. It teaches much about politics, trade policy, and the sorry state of the environmentalist movement.

That Trump's announcement was politically motivated is obvious. The proposed new policy was announced during a campaign visit to Iowa. A crucial biennial election looms, and Trump unveiled his plan there to give a boost to the electoral prospects of Republicans in the Corn Belt.

Such a move was politically necessary after Trump's tariffs on Chinese imports triggered retaliatory tariffs that reduced American food exports to China and cut

American farmers' incomes. developing as a "two steps The president needed to demlooking out for their interests. The call for greater use of E15—which would increase the demand for corn—was music to the ears of many

voters in the Farm Belt. This sequence of events economically disruptive tariffs followed by a policy designed to mitigate or offset those disruptions—illustrates a profound truth about political economy. The great Austrian economist Ludwig von Mises elucidated this truth in his essay, "Middleof-the-Road Policy Leads to Socialism." [Stay calm; I am NOT suggesting that Trump wants socialism!]

Mises' point was that government intervention into markets, however well intentioned, inevitably impacts prices and patterns of production. Intervention helps some and hurts others. Those who now have a government-induced problem, like American farmers after the imposition of tariffs, expect the government to solve that problem. But whatever government does in the attempt to offset the damage its policies caused will further distort markets. This will stimulate cries for further intervention. Thus, the tendency of intervention is to breed further intervention.

Trump's trade policy is

forward, one step back" proonstrate to farmers that he is cess. (Let's hope it doesn't end up being one step forward for every two steps back!) Clearly, the proposal for increased usage of E15 is a government subsidy to corn growers and the ethanol industry. It moves us even farther away from Trump's professed goal of dropping all tariffs, trade barriers, and subsidies. Realistically, given our current political alignment, zero subsidies for American agriculture is inconceivable for the foreseeable future.

> I have written before about the negative economic effects of using corn-based ethanol as a motor fuel. The negative environmental impacts are significant. too. Although some green groups, such as the Sierra Club, have warned about the environmental consequences of corn-based ethanol in the past, they have remained strangely silent about Trump's plan to increase its usage. Apparently, they are too busy trying to use the climate change issue to scare Americans into embracing socialism to challenge a policy that truly is environmentally harmful. This underscores my long-held belief that preserving a healthy environment is not the primary goal of environmentalists.

40% of the American corn crop already gets burned up in our vehicles' engines. That represents millions of acres of land that are converted from wildlife habitat to tillage. It causes the use of who-knows-how-many tons of fertilizers that unnecessarily contaminates water (e.g., red tide in Florida).

Worst of all, any government policy that hastens the pace of water consumption in the Midwest, where aquifers already are dangerously depleted, is environmentally shortsighted. If environmentalists really cared about the environment more than they want to increase government control of the economy, they would oppose cornbased fuel more vigorously than they oppose fracking. Fracking does not jeopardize our precious water supply; corn-based ethanol does.

The good news is that Trump may not have the legal authority to revise existing limits on E15. If not, then his Oct. 9 announcement could be a stroke of political genius: It could help Trump's party retain control of Congress at no cost to the environment.

ing more than \$1,000,000.

In Sept. 2017, the Environmental Enhancement Fund, administered by California Department of Fish and Wildlife's Office of Spill Prevention and Response, granted Regional Parks \$89,900.00. The Delta Conservancy Prop 1 grant funded the remaining \$942,631.00 of the project in Jan. 2018.

The project was designed to restore the lake and surrounding upland areas, improve water quality and aid in groundwater retention while providing habitat for the giant garter snake, the Sandhill crane, the western pond turtle, the western toad and the California tiger salamander, all considered threatened or

"We are very thankful for the generosity of the Environmental Enhancement Fund and the Delta Conservancy," says Liz Bellas, Deputy Director of Regional Parks. "These grants are allowing us to preserve the land that threatened species need to survive."

Construction on this project ended on Oct. 29 and seeding is underway. During construction approximately 88,000 cubic yards of invasive water primrose was removed to restore 30 acres of open water wetlands habitat, including 10 acres of perennial and 20 acres of seasonal water that previously existed in the lake bed.

This projects is working with Galt Union Elementary School District students to plant and maintain new valley oak trees to ensure the long-term sustainability of the nesting structure of the heron/egret/cormorant rookery around the lake.






## SSPCA Receives Over \$100,000 in Grants

Petsmart Charities Donates to Help Pets Find Forever Homes

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento SPCA recently announced their receipt of two new grants of \$50,000 and new environment. \$51.821 from PetSmart Charities, the leading funder of animal welfare in North America. 
