

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Business folk were toast of the town when the Carmichael Chamber of Commerce and Carmichael Times hosted a "Best of Carmichael" awards gala last week. Winners were decided by online vote and received proclamations from Congressman Ami Bera, Senator Jim Nielson, Assemblyman Ken Cooley and Sacramento County Supervisor Susan Peters.

Thirty-one contested categories included professional services, supermarkets, restaurants, fitness centers, non-profits – and dozens more entities that make Carmichael a business and residential hub. Dominating winners, the Carmichael Kiwanis Club took dual awards for best service group and for hosting the popular Taste of Carmichael Event. Rey Azteca Taqueria gained distinction as best restaurant and the River City

Brewery took kudos for preferred pub. Ancil Hoffman Park was this year voted tops for recreation and the La Sierra Center (Carmichael Park District) scored as best community facility. The best grocery store award went to Bel Air #511. Best Automotive Service - American Eagle Auto Body took an additional award as the business that won the most votes overall.

Now in its second year, the competition has gathered steam; 600 more voters than in 2017 participated and 150 guests enjoyed the celebration gala. A fundraiser for the Chamber of Commerce, the event included a dessert

auction with tempting treats bespoke from local bakeries and restaurants. In the Milagro Centre's ballroom, Carmichael's business community ate, drank and was exceedingly merry.

SJUSD Offers Mental Health First Aid Training For Youths

- The district is offering a free Youth Mental Health First Aid training to all district staff, parents and the adult community on Saturday, June 23 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the district office, located at 3738 Walnut Avenue in Carmichael

The interactive, eight-hour course teaches adults to identify the early warning signs of mental health challenges, including substance use, in young people between the ages of 12 and 18. Participants will increase their understanding of the importance of early intervention and learn to use a five-step action plan to help adolescents who may be developing signs of a mental health challenge or experiencing a mental health crisis.

Realtor Unflagging Friend to Felines

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Clients who do business with Katie Mack seldom learn the Carmichael realtor has a nocturnal sideline. Mack (68) rescues some of the most vulnerable animals in our community – feral and abandoned cats. "Few people know how many lives are lost due to feline over-population in Sacramento," she says.

Mack has long waged a one-woman campaign to supply friendless felines the help they need.

Not only does she have four semi-ferals enjoying the good life in her home, she visits, feeds and watches over a colony of 15 homeless cats several times each week. Using free spaying

and neutering programs, she makes certain that these animals will not multiply their problems. In the past 15 years, she has also found homes for more than needy 100 kitties. "It's not like I go looking for lost cats," she explains. "They've a way of finding me."

Mack's latest rescue was a non-feral Russian blue male she called Mister Blue. "I used every method of advertising to find his owners," she says. "He'd been so well taken care of, I couldn't imagine how he ended up in the streets. He was laid-back, friendly and comfortable on any lap. He was clearly used to affection. He showed up at my doctor's office on Fair Oaks Boulevard some weeks ago and decided to hang out. We took him to a vet and established he had a clean bill of health. I brought him home but he couldn't stay with me; he needed a forever family."

Through a rescue agency called Fluff Buddies, a Napa area family heard about the handsome orphan. "The husband and wife came to Carmichael to meet him with two of their kids," says Mack. "They'd had a Russian blue for 13 years before he died. Mister Blue immediately jumped on the young daughter's lap. He seemed to know these were his people. I heard he slept with his new mom and dad on his first night with them. The adoption came just in time; I was getting too fond of that sweet guy. A happy ending makes res-







The bottles were wrapped in birthday paper and I gave one to each child. I said, "Okay, when I say 'go' open your present and do what comes naturally. There'll be a prize for the first three who finish first. One, two three, GO!"

Because it was a race, they tore open their packages and of course began sucking the little bottles. (I recommend not doing

this with children who have recently been weened because they just might go back on the bottle!)

They had a ball but the most amazing thing transpired! Even though it was Kool Aid and loaded with sugar, the whole party became tranquil. They all wanted to refill their bottles and I let them, just because they were so peaceful and happy.

7. Kill Two Birds with One Stove

If you've known me for very long, you know about the Thanksgiving in which I shoved a Cornish Game Hen in the Turkey because I didn't have stuffing. At the dinner table when my husband pulled that little bird out of the big bird it was like a National Geographic special. My mother (who was a BO... Born Organized) was aghast at the whole spectacle and I very famously said, "I have literally cooked two birds with one stove."

8. Object of Enlightenment and Sleepwear

Teach them while they're young

Dear Dave,

My wife and I want to begin teaching our son how make a budget and live on one. He's 16, and he has a part-time job and a handme-down car. Is this a realistic idea?

Dear Mike,

Your son is at a great point in life to learn how to make money behave. Even in his situation, when he's still living at home, there are plenty of things he can include in a budget. There's gas for his car, along with maintenance and insurance. He'll need to save a little money — maybe even for college — and I'm sure he'll want some spending cash, too.

Sit down, and teach him how to make a written budget by figuring out the upcoming month's income and expenses ahead of time. Also, make sure he knows how to properly balance and

reconcile his bank account.

It's still your responsibility to provide him with the basic necessities at this point. But I love your willingness to teach your son how to handle money intelligently. The sooner he learns some basic money management principles, the sooner he'll be able to handle his finances responsibly in the real world!

Controlling your cash

Dear Dave,

I work long hours, and I make pretty good money. The problem is the money from my paychecks always seems to disappear before the end of the month. I know part of the problem is grabbing quick meals between extra shifts, and eating out a lot after work, because I'm usually too tired to cook when I get home. How can someone who has very little free time start gaining control of their finances?

-Sheila

Dear Sheila,

No matter how little free time you think you have, or how tired you are, you *must* make time do a written budget every month. This is essential. Making a budget for the month ahead isn't a

lot of hard work, and it really doesn't take long. When you give every dollar a name before the month begins, you're taking control of your money instead of allowing a lack of it to control you.

Start with the income you know is predictable. If that isn't possible, look back over the last few months and find the minimum amount you brought home during a month over that period of time. This will be the basis for your budget. Once you've established a baseline income, you can write down and prioritize bills and other expenses. Just remember, restaurants are not a priority!

When you make a prioritized spending plan, and start telling your money what to do ahead of time, you'll have the ability to do what's important with what you've earned!


