

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - The Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) today presented its 2018 Excellence in Water Leadership Award to Carmichael Water District General Manager Steve Nugent for his leadership and commitment to collaborative regional integrated water management through the American River Pipeline Conveyance Project.

Working with Aerojet and the Golden State Water Company through an innovative public-private partnership, Nugent led the district in implementing the project, which recovers 10,000 acre feet of remediated groundwater

The American River Pipeline Conveyance Project not only ensures a clean water supply for neighboring Golden State Water Company customers, it also provides an additional water supply for Carmichael Water District to help guard against future droughts, and included extensive environmental restoration along the American River. The project has been recognized with awards from the American Water Resources Association and the Sacramento Environmental Commission.

The program combines self-esteem courses, job training, health classes and support services to help homeless women across diverse ages, races and cultures. Respond to Governor's May Budget Revision

- Today, Senate Republican Leader Patricia Bates (R-Laguna Niguel) and Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama), vice chair of the Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee, responded to Governor Jerry Brown's 2018-19 budget proposal.

The Governor's May Revision outlines a record breaking \$199.3 billion state budget. While it is good news that a growing economy has increased state revenues, Senate Republicans agree with the Governor that what goes up must come down, and applaud the increased funding proposed for the state's "Rainy Day" savings.

The Governor rightly acknowledged that the state is over-extended, despite the record revenues. With unfunded liabilities of over \$200 billion for pensions and retiree health care, Senate Republicans agree with the

"With nearly \$9 billion in surplus moneys, it is clear that the new taxes recently levied on the people of California were entirely unnecessary."

"The Legislature must refrain from the dangerous temptation to spend on permanent programs that we cannot afford when our state faces another inevitable economic downturn. Now is the time for fiscal discipline. Investing in our rainy day fund savings and our infrastructure, including our water infrastructure, should be the priorities."

Senate Republican Leader **Bates:**

"While it is clear that the state cannot afford to go on a spending spree, I do hope that the final budget the Governor signs this year will fund priorities such as

expanding efforts on infrastructure and homelessness. There must be a focus on addressing our growing public safety crisis. We should eliminate the rape kit testing backlog and increase efforts by the state Department of Justice to remove guns from dangerous individuals.'

"Senate Republicans also believe that the state should release a total of \$3 billion in voter-approved K-12 school bonds in the 2018-19 fiscal year, and include budget language to require at least \$3 billion in construction and repair projects to be awarded to schools that need these funds in 2018-19. If the Governor is unwilling to release voter-approved bond funding, the state should immediately commit part of the growing budget surplus to school construction and modernization projects."

North State Lawmakers Thank Governor for Proposed Funding to Protect Levees By Nghia Nguyen

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Senate Budget Vice-Chair Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama) and Assemblyman James Gallagher (R-Yuba City) issued the following statement on the Governor's revision of his budget proposal:

'We thank the Governor for

heeding our and our constituents' call to fund the repairs of the damaged levees. The increased funding of \$125 million for levee repair and maintenance is welcome news to our communities.

"Last year alone, high water events resulted in significant damage to the levees that protect our homes and communities with an estimated \$800 million in needed repairs. Maintaining and repairing these levees will require an ongoing funding commitment. While more is needed, we are pleased to see the Governor's revised budget includes funding for this purpose."

Reported Sexually Transmitted Diseases Reach a New High in California

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) -

A record number of Californians were diagnosed with a sexually transmitted disease (STD) in 2017, according to a new report released by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). More than 300,000 cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea,

and early syphilis were reported: a 45 percent increase compared to five years ago.

Particularly concerning, in 2017, there were 30 stillbirths due to congenital syphilis in California. This is the highest number reported since 1995.

STDs can cause a number of serious health problems. If left untreated, chlamydia and gonorrhea can cause pelvic

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inflammatory disease and lead to infertility, ectopic pregnancy, and chronic pelvic pain. Syphilis can cause permanent loss of vision, hearing and other neurologic problems.

Chlamydia and gonorrhea rates are highest among people under age 30. Rates of chlamydia are highest among young women, and males account for the majority of syphilis and gonorrhea cases.

"STDs are preventable by consistently using condoms, and many STDs can be cured with antibiotics," said CDPH Director and State Public Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith. "Regular testing and treatment are very important for people who are sexually active, even for people who have no symptoms. Most people infected with an STD do not know it."

CDPH is collaborating with local health departments and organizations throughout the state to raise awareness. CDPH is working with the California Department of Education and community groups to implement the newly enacted California Healthy Youth Act, which mandates comprehensive STD/HIV prevention education in schools.

Other state efforts leverage innovative strategies such as courses for medical providers and teachers, expedited partner treatment to local clinics, and free and low cost online ordering options for home delivery of condoms and STD test kits. Carmichael's oldest school has begun its 101st year. Carmichael Elementary (Sutter Avenue) opened its doors for Centenary celebrations last week. An estimated 600 past and present students -- and many former teachers -- attended family-style festivities.

The formal program included a performance of the school song. Borrowing melody from the US Army's "Caisson Song," the school's previous Principal, Brandei Smith, authored its lyrics. The "Cougar Song," declares:

"We are bright, we don't fight -- we will always choose the right -- as the Cougars go rolling along (Rah! Rah!)..."

Oldest reunion participant was Jack Pefley, 94, a WW II veteran who trudged to school from his family's Palm Drive farm during the 1920s. He and


siblings began three generations of his clan to attend the institution. Youngest centenary attendees included 2018 kindergarten pupils.

Community founder and real-tor Daniel Carmichael donated ten acres to establish the two-room Carmichael School in 1917. Hosting Farm Bureau dinners and church services during the Depression, the school also served as a community town hall. Baby-boom years saw huge school graduating classes. Administered by the San Juan Unified School District, Carmichael Elementary now has 400 pupils from kindergarten to Fifth Grade.

Though the 100-year milestone was reached last year, festivities were designed for the 2018 spring semester. Near neighbor since 1931, the Crossroads Church co-sponsored the event with hotdog dinners for all comers. A history display included old yearbooks and vintage teachers' clothing;

a 1917 school bus recalled transport in founding years; a mock pirate ship catered for energetic attendees; a contest offered naming rights for the school mascot. After speeches and presentations, the program show-stopper starred kindergarten pupils singing and signing Louis Armstrong's "Wonderful Word."

Among alumni staff, two contemporary school principals attended. Principal Brandei Smith master-minded the centennial but recently transferred to head Howe Avenue Elementary. Principal Marianne Williams takes the Carmichael Elementary job in August. Williams predicts high achievement for Carmichael charges. "I'm passionate that all students should receive an education that prepares them for college or for a career," says Williams. "Carmichael has a long and rich history. I'm humbled by the opportunity to lead this school into its second century."




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Less Toxic Alternatives for Pest Control

Now that we're getting into the "spring of things", are you seeing more bugs crawling in and around your home or garden? Although pesticides are commonly used to get rid of pests, they can pollute our creeks and rivers. Toxic chemicals in pesticides can be washed away by rain water or sprinkler runoff sending those pollutants into a nearby storm drain. Once in the drain, those toxins end up in a nearby creek or river, which is home to many plants and aquatic life.

Before you reach for that can of bug spray to defend your garden, please consider these less toxic steps to ward off pests:

Know your Friends

Many bugs are not pests and may actually be beneficial because they control other bugs or pollinate flowers. For example ladybugs, both adults and larvae, are known primarily as predators of aphids. Parasitoid wasps are also keen hunters of aphids and caterpillars. You may not like spiders, but they can also be the best sentry to keep your plants safe. Knowing which bugs are friends or pests is the first step in managing pests wisely. The UC Statewide Integrated Pest Management Program (www.ipm.ucanr.edu) offers ideas about natural enemies to pervasive pests.

Less Is More

Chemicals in your yard kill both good and bad bugs. For pest or weeds, use less-toxic or non-toxic methods to keep garden-friendly bugs on your side and unwanted bugs under control. The Our Water Our World Program offers simple ideas online at ourwaterourworld.org. You can also look for convenient eco-friendly options at your local garden or hardware supply store. The Our Water Our World Program partners with stores to help consumers find less-toxic products for use in their homes and gardens.


Attraction is Essential

Attract and keep beneficial bugs in your yard and let them do the work for you! You should plant flowers and shrubs that attract good bugs to your garden. There won't be a need for chemicals when the good bugs can keep the "bad bugs" under control. Unwanted bugs will always be in your garden but a healthy garden filled with good bugs will minimize pests. The UC Statewide Integrated Pest Management Program (www.ipm.ucanr.edu) has dozens of ideas for finding the right plants to control pests around your home and in the garden.

Choose Plants Wisely

Select pest and disease resistant plants as well as plants that attract good bugs to keep a healthy balance of garden friends close by. Plants like rosemary, zinnia and coyote brush make great additions to the yard. Plants that are native to your area will adapt best to the climate, making them stronger and healthier.
