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East Area Rapist Suspect Caught

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento County Sheriff's Department and the District Attorney's Office have confirmed that they are working a significant break in the search for the East Area Rapist.

Law enforcement sources have named 72-year-old Joseph James DeAngelo as the suspect arrested in the case.

Many law enforcement agencies, both local and federal, converged on DeAngelo's home in Citrus Heights on Wednesday, April 25. He was arrested at approximately 2:30 am. He was booked on two counts of murder from a Ventura County Sheriff's Department warrant. Agencies were later seen removing boxes of evidence from the home after the arrest.

DeAngelo lived in a neighborhood near Old Auburn and Twin Oaks, on Canyon Oaks Drive.

This case has been open for decades. Law Enforcement believes the East Area Rapist or Golden State Killer was responsible for at least 12 homicides, approximately 50 rapes and some 120 home burglaries. All the crimes spanned a decade starting in the late 1970s and into the mid-1980s throughout the Sacramento region, the San Francisco Bay Area and in Southern California.

The East Area Rapist is believed to be responsible for at least nine sexual assaults in Sacramento, six more in Rancho Cordova and Citrus Heights, four in Carmichael and two in Orangevale.

The FBI web site states: “Burglaries

and rapes began occurring in the eastern district of Sacramento County—hence the name East Area Rapist—in the summer of 1976. The subject ransacked homes and took coins, jewelry, and identification. Neighborhood burglaries were often followed by clusters of sexual assaults. Then, on February 2, 1978, Brian Maggiore and his wife, Katie,

were on an evening walk with their dog in their Rancho Cordova neighborhood when they were chased down and murdered. After July 1981, no associated incidents are known until 1986, when an 18-year-old woman was raped and murdered in Irvine, California—the last known crime associated with the subject.”

“For us here in Sacramento it was a time of innocence in 1976,” said Sacramento District Attorney Anne Marie Schubert at Wednesday’s press conference. “For anyone who lived here the memories are vivid.”

The Sacramento DA’s Office confirmed DeAngelo was employed twice with law enforcement agencies, including the Auburn Police Department.

News reports say neighbors claimed DeAngelo was occasionally prone to profane outbursts heard throughout the neighborhood. It was also reported that

he has lived in the neighborhood for more than 30 years. Neighbors were shocked that all this was happening in their neighborhood. Later reports said DeAngelo is now on suicide watch.

“It is the most prolific unsolved serial killing case probably in modern history,” said Schubert. “This case affected the entire state.”

Sacramento County Sheriff Scott Jones told the media that agencies also report that the East Area Rapist was also known as the Golden State Killer, the Original Night Stalker and the Diamond Knot Killer.

Schubert, who is passionate about the pursuit of justice through DNA evidence and cold case prosecution, formed the Cold Case Prosecution Unit in 2002 and served as its first prosecutor.

“The answer was in the DNA,” Schubert explained. “It is fitting that today is National DNA Day.” ★

Koobs Nature Area Reconnects with the Wild

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - You don’t have to listen very hard to catch the high-pitched laughter of Girl Scout Troop 3191 as they race to their hideout made from live oak branches. You can join in with Key Clubbers from Foothill and Del Campo high schools as they lead a family through the caterpillar lifecycle. And you can watch the look of trepidation on the face of a Troop 55 Cub Scout as he decides whether or not to pick up the crawdad being offered to him. This is a typical morning at the Koobs Nature Area, a five-acre nature preserve in the heart of our community maintained by the Kiwanis Club of Carmichael.

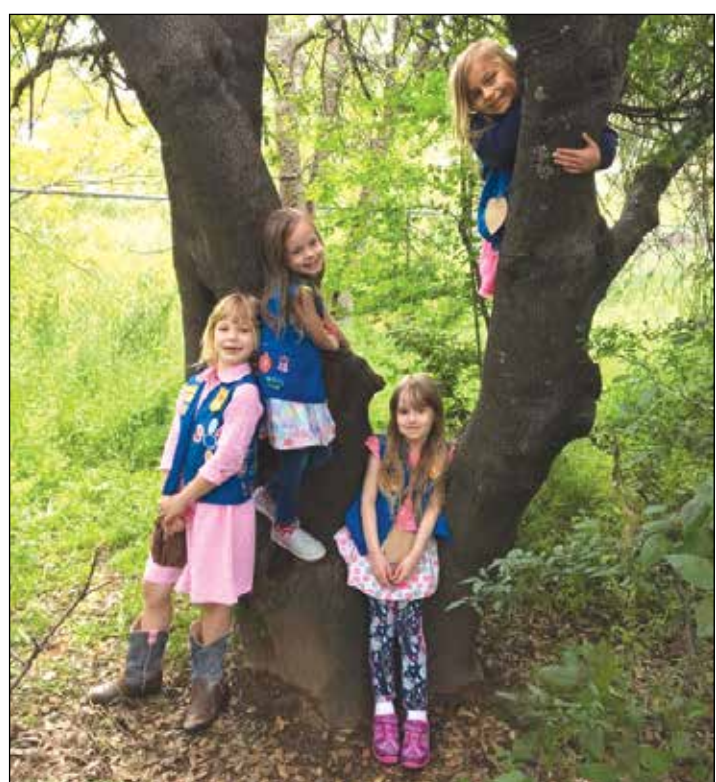
The Koobs Nature Area, named after former science teacher Earl J. “Ranger Jack” Koobs, is home to a diverse ecosystem of flora and fauna that includes ponds, creeks, bird boxes, a butterfly garden and trails that spread out for visitors to explore. But on top of that, each second Saturday of the month, the

Kiwanis Club of Carmichael opens up the Koobs Nature Area for kids and families to enjoy activity tables highlighting art and science. “We hope that children have a meaningful experience with nature, learning, and having fun,” says Wayne Lang, President of the Kiwanis Club of Carmichael. Each month has a different theme. March 10’s theme was Colors of Nature; April 21 was Earth Day; May 12 will be Birds and Birding; June 9 will be Critters that Crawl and Fly; July 14 will be the Water Cycle and Pond Habitats; August 11 will be Mapping and “Treasure” Hunting; September 8 will be Trees, Leaves and Seeds; October 13 will be Seasons.

While the art and science tables are often a big draw for young kids, the Koobs Nature Area truly offers what so many people in cities and even suburbs lack: access to nature. “My kids and I love visiting Koobs,” says Jasmine Crabtree, mother of two and parent at CMP-Carmichael. “There is always something fun to find and spots to explore. Depending on

the time of year, there are birds, bugs, mushrooms and plants to discover.” The Kiwanis Club of Carmichael made the running of the Koobs Nature Area their signature project in 2016 in the hope of giving children and families a place to reconnect with nature, and the growth of the project that has been inspiring for everyone involved. It has brought together adults, parents, grandparents, teachers, community leaders, families, teens and children from all over the Carmichael area. Each public open day allows visitors to experience this natural treasure.

The Koobs Nature Area is free to all visitors and open from 10am to 2pm on the specified dates. It is located at 5325 Engle Road, along the eastern driveway of the La Sierra Community Center and across from the California Montessori Project. Visitors will see the banner sign on Engle Road (west of Garfield Avenue) for the week prior to the open dates.

Project visionaries, Dr. Lou Vismara, M.D. and Michael Bernick, Esq., invited Eskaton to spearhead this endeavor. Other organizations involved in this project include the California Conservation Corps, CCC Foundation, Pride Industries and Alta California Regional Center.

development opportunities aims to introduce people living with special abilities into the workforce," said Kim Rhineholder, Eskaton VP of Communications and Philanthropy. "Eskaton's workforce development involves young adults living with autism. This teaches job skills and provides socialization, mentoring and intergenerational activities."

The senior care industry as a whole is challenged to hire and keep skilled labor, and within the next few decades will need two million new workers in the United States. Eskaton is helping to train new workers in Northern California.

Youth with developmental disabilities face one of the highest rates of unemployment and underemployment in California. Unemployment for individuals with autism is over 90%. Additionally, 85% of adults with autism live with parents/family

and/or depression and lack social skills. Eskaton is filling a need by offering training opportunities for developmentally disabled individuals with a broad spectrum of functional abilities and talents.

"We are pleased to serve as a catalyst to ignite the potential of those living with special abilities," concluded Rhineholder. "The layers of solutions offered by these opportunities, along with societal impacts, inspire our organization and aim to serve as an example for others."

Eskaton's attention to workforce development and special abilities training has encouraged other organizations to take action. The California Community College system may explore the possibility of establishing a vocational training curriculum and certification program, while California Conservation Corps has interest in vocational training

and career advancement opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities and other special needs.

Sacramento's Society for the Blind Receives \$15,000 from Whitmore Foundation

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Seniors with vision loss in the Sacramento region will have greater access to tools for independence, thanks to a \$15,000 grant from M&M Whitmire Family Foundation in Roseville to Sacramento-based nonprofit Society for the Blind. The grant will help fund Society for the Blind's Senior IMPACT Project that empowers people 55 and older with alternative, non-visual techniques and skills that enable them to perform day-to-day tasks and activities so they can maintain or increase their independence.

"As the senior population continues to grow rapidly in Sacramento, it is imperative that we provide services that help them stay as independent as possible," said Shari Roeseler, executive director, Society for the Blind. "When seniors begin to lose vision, they are not only three times more likely to fall and experience injury, they often feel profound loneliness. This grant from the M&M Whitmire Family Foundation helps us ensure they have a support system so they can feel hope and possibility."

The Senior IMPACT Project includes an eight-day retreat offered monthly at Society for the Blind that gives seniors an immersion experience where they learn alternative techniques and skills to travel safely, efficiently and independently. They practice alternative techniques and use adapted tools to perform tasks of daily living including cooking, cleaning, shopping, home maintenance, organization, personal finance and more. They learn how to use the latest in assistive technology to operate computers and mobile devices for home, school and work, and they learn Braille. Participants receive individualized attention from instructors and mentors who are blind or low vision, and they have the opportunity to join in discussion groups with peers on issues around vision loss and participate in community

activities.

For those unable to attend retreats, Society for the Blind sends instructors to their homes to teach skills and offer resources. The Senior IMPACT Project also includes monthly peer support groups for English and Spanish speakers and workshops throughout the year.

For more than 60 years, Society for the Blind has created innovative ways to empower individuals living with low vision or blindness to discover, develop and achieve their full potential. Society for the Blind has grown from a dedicated group of volunteers that included the Lions Clubs of America to a nationally recognized agency and the only comprehensive rehabilitative teaching center that provides services for a 27-county region of northern California. The nonprofit provides low-vision eye care, life and job skills training, mentorship, and access to tools to maintain independence for 6,000 youth, adults and seniors experiencing vision loss each year. SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Arcade Middle School's Theater program will present The Thrilling Adventures of the Three Musketeers, a comedic play loosely based on the novel by Alexandre Dumas, on May 10, 11 and 12. A tale of swashbuckling heroes set in mid-17th century France, it includes daring escapades, royal intrigue - even a bit of romance - and these middle schoolers are ready to pull it off!

This play presents new challenges for the student actors, including learning to sword-fight and deliver lines with comedic timing and phrasing. A stage combat coach came in to help the students (including the backstage crew) learn basic swordsmanship, each constructing their own sabre from PVC pipe and pool noodles. The actors also studied films such as The Princess Bride and Stardust to understand comedic timing and the use of humor in action sequences.

"The Thrilling Tale of the Three Musketeers" is all about adventure, thrills and laughter. "The students are having a ball with it," says Adams. "For many of these kids, Theater is their creative outlet and a social interface - a balance to the digital, tech-dominated world they are growing up within. It is important that schools provide an avenue for expression and engagement."

Arcade's theater program is experiencing a renaissance,

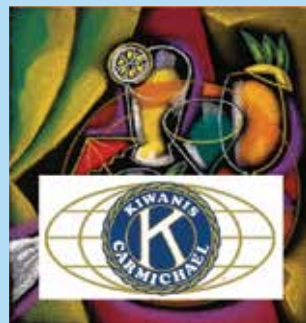
thanks to the efforts of Josie Adams, Stage Director and Counselor at Arcade Middle School, and Lisa Cannon-Wheeler, Technical Director. After a 20-year absence of any kind of theater productions at Arcade, Adams volunteered to re-start a program in the Fall 2016, as another way to engage students at school. Cannon-Wheeler, a parent volunteer, got involved initially to support her 7th grader's interest in theater, but has seen the program make

a difference in many kids' school experience - both on and off the stage. The guidance and energy of these two passionate ladies have raised Arcade's theater program to new heights.

This after-school enrichment program, managed by the Arcade PTO, doesn't charge a fee for students to participate, but instead operates on donations and ticket sales, and probably wouldn't exist without a small foundation grant from the San Juan Unified School District's Visual & Performing

Arts department. The reborn Spartan Theater started with a one-act murder mystery and quickly took on two Disney musicals, the latest being 'The Little Mermaid Jr.' last December.

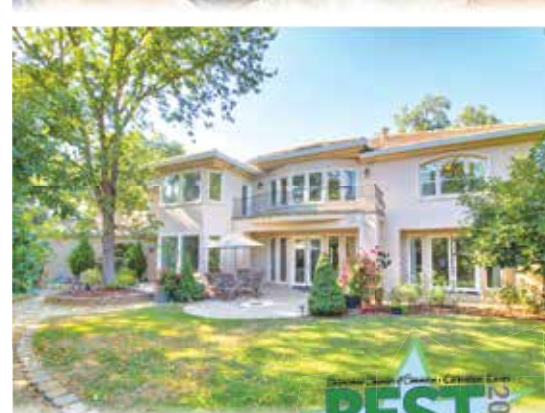



SacRT Seeks Public Input for World-Class Transit System

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - The effort to develop a new generation network for the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) has officially been launched. The first stakeholder public input meeting was held earlier this month, and nearly a dozen community workshops are planned for April and May. It's all part of a new route optimization study, now coined "SacRT Forward," which seeks to create a world-class transit system that is reflective of today's travel patterns.

"Our transit system has not seen a route redesign in 30 years and travel patterns in the region have changed substantially since then," said SacRT General Manager Henry Li. "SacRT Forward will take a blank slate approach in creating a new network that will focus on connectivity with light rail as well as service frequency, and bus routing that takes customers to destinations where they want to travel to."

SacRT Forward will have variety of community involvement components, including two stakeholder meetings, SacRT

Board workshops and nearly a dozen community events where planners will solicit input from current riders and potential riders alike. "We want everyone's feedback in this process so that we can come up with the best transit network possible," said SacRT Board Chair and Sacramento County Board of Supervisors Vice-Chair Patrick Kennedy. "Our vision is to create a state-of-the-art transit system that features new low-floor light rail trains along with excellent bus connectivity and reliability. We have made great strides in the last two years improving SacRT's

service, and now we look forward to the next round of changes as we strive to develop an exceptional transit network in the growing Sacramento region."

There are 11 opportunities for Sacramento residents to learn more about the 15-month long project. SacRT's planning and outreach teams will be out in force during the months of April and May seeking public input during a series of pop-up workshops. Below are a list of upcoming public workshops that residents are invited to stop by and comment on the project.

Participants will be asked to provide feedback on ways SacRT might be able to redesign its bus routes given available resources. This means individuals will be asked to prioritize their preferences, and in many cases determine which trade-offs they prefer in order to remain revenue neutral. Another series of workshops will be held in the fall to evaluate two proposed networks that will be developed by the SacRT Forward planning team based upon community and stakeholder input.

SacRT is working with Jarrett Walker & Associates to help

develop two network proposals for community review. The first network redesign will offer a revenue neutral proposal, while the second proposal will feature a route design that presupposes increased funding levels. Both proposals will be available for community review in winter 2018.

SacRT Forward's Public Information Plan is posted on sacrt.com along with additional details about the route optimization study.

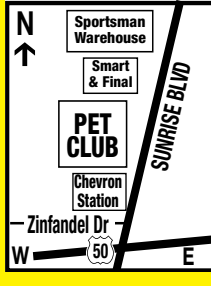

Assemblyman Cooley Honors Local Radiologist and Holocaust Survivor at 2018 Holocaust Remembrance Ceremony

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - On Monday, April 16, Assemblyman Ken Cooley (D-Rancho Cordova) honored Dr. Adam Greenspan at the annual Holocaust Remembrance Ceremony at the State Capitol.

Each year, the California Legislative Jewish Caucus hosts the Holocaust Remembrance Ceremony on California's Holocaust Memorial Day to recognize survivors, family of survivors or liberators.

"Dr. Adam Greenspan's entire life exhibits survival. The town he lived in with his parents at the tender age of 4 was bombed during the first week of the German Blitzkrieg by which the German Army started World War II. He recalls fleeing into the countryside with his parents after the attacks on Poland by the Germans and the Soviets in 1939," said Assemblyman Cooley. "Adam's persistence through the ensuing horror and the success that he and his family achieved despite the terrors of the Holocaust is inspiring. It is with great honor that I recognize Dr. Adam Greenspan as the honoree of the year for the Eighth Assembly District," continued Cooley.

Dr. Adam Greenspan is the only child of a physician, Bernard, from Rudnik nad Sanem, in eastern Poland. In 1939, 4-year old Adam fled with his family to Lvov, 92 miles away. When the Soviet forces invaded Poland under the Molotov-Ribbentrop agreement, Adam and his family were sent via cattle train on a five week journey to Novosibirsk, Siberia, where his father worked as an internist, surgeon, pediatrician, obstetrician, and dentist for the Russians with make-shift tools. Adam's family was relocated to Burnoje, Kazakhstan in 1941 where Adam collected cow "pancakes" as fuel for their

stove, their sole source of heat. After the war ended, Adam's family lived in Wroclaw (formerly Breslau) in western Poland, where Adam finished school, studied medicine, and became an orthopedic surgeon. Despite his accomplishments, Adam did not wish to spend his life living under a totalitarian regime in communist Poland, and he resolved to leave by any means necessary. After several unsuccessful attempts to emigrate legally to the United States, he escaped to Austria, where he sought asylum. He eventually made his way to the United States and settled in the Arden area of Sacramento.

Adam's father, Bernard passed away in Poland in 1964, and his mother Eugenia emigrated to

the U.S. a few years later, passing away in New York in 1984. Dr. Greenspan is a world famous orthopedic radiologist and Professor of Radiology at the University of California, Davis. He has written multiple articles and books on his specialty. He lives with his wife Barbara and has three grown children, a daughter-in-law, and three grandchildren.

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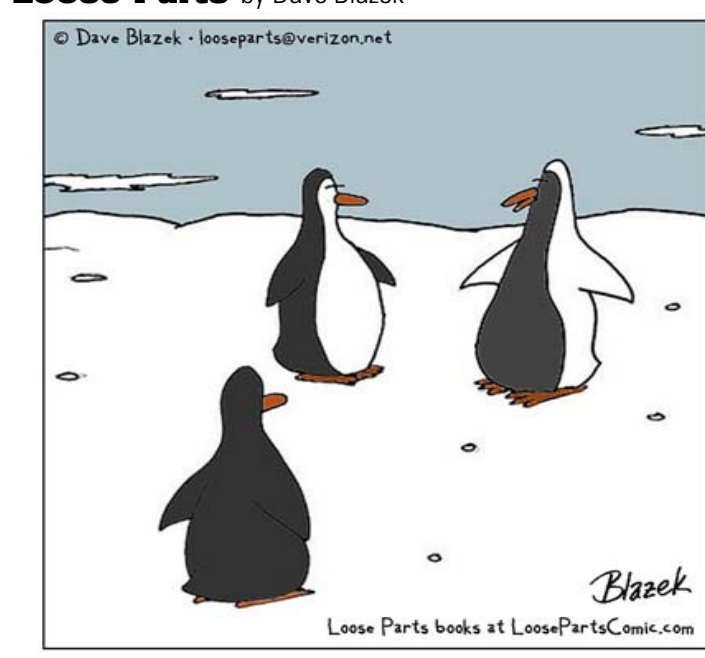

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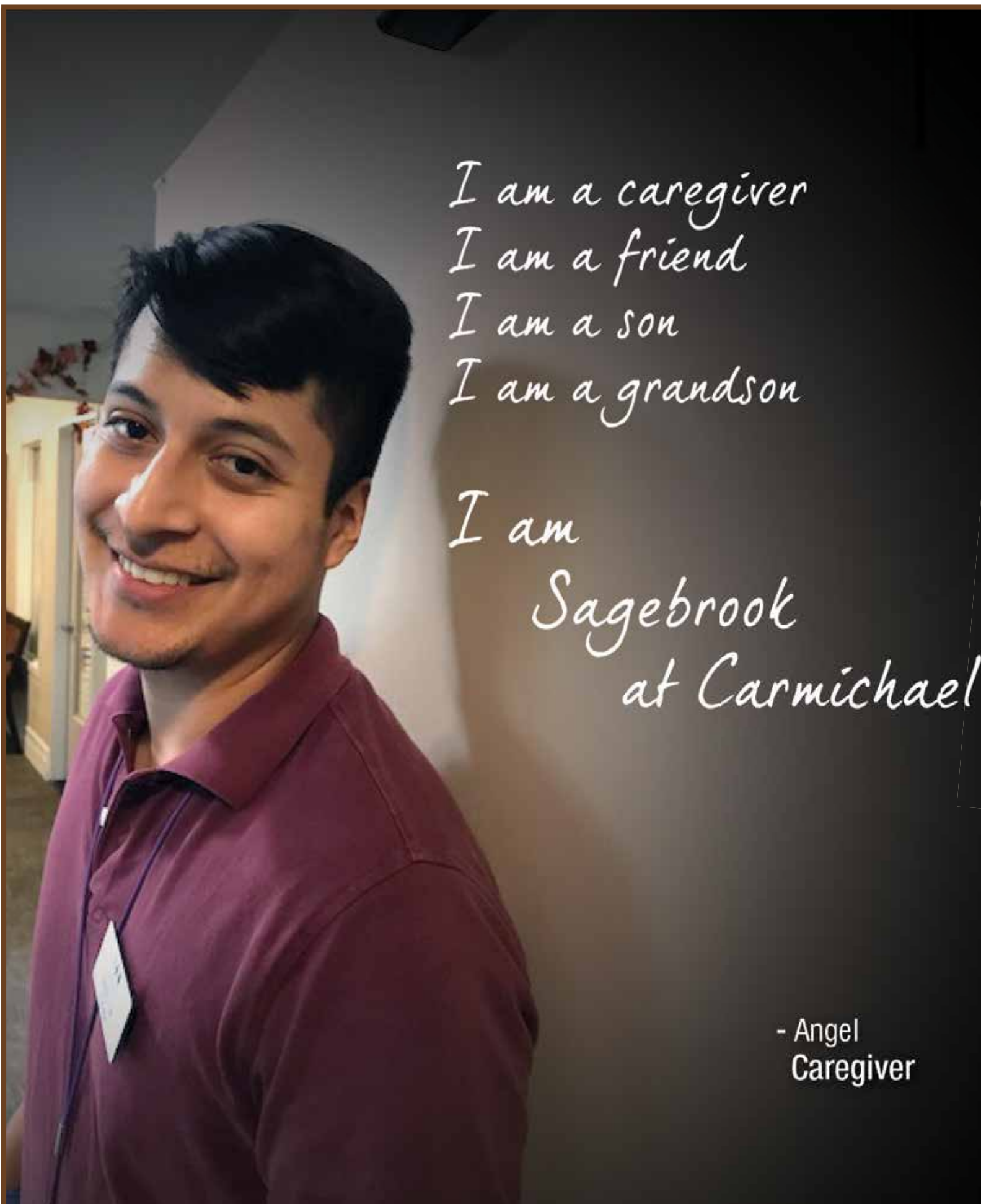

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Invalid Property Tax Assessments Remain Unpaid to Thousands of Property Owners and Commercial Properties in Carmichael



The following is a copy of the letter sent to all Sacramento County Supervisors regarding: **Refunds to Carmichael Taxpayers – Sacramento County Taxpayers Association, et al v. County of Sacramento, Carmichael Recreation and Park District, et al, Sacramento Superior Court Case No. 34-2014-80001869.**

Sacramento County Supervisors Peters, Kennedy, Frost, Nottoli and Serna:

It has been nearly two years since Superior Court Judge Christopher E. Krueger ruled that the Carmichael Recreation and Park District (CRPD) violated state law by charging an illegal assessment on approximately 13,000 residential home owners, apartment and commercial properties for the tax years 2014-15 and 2015-16. To date, it is estimated that less than 10 percent of the more than \$1.3 million collected has been returned to taxpayers. This latter figure has also now increased with the addition of ongoing interest.

As the Presidents of the statewide Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association and the Sacramento Taxpayers Association, we are formally requesting that the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors direct the County of Sacramento to issue a refund to all affected residential and business owners, who were subject to the unlawful collection of this property tax assessment over the foregoing two tax-year period.

CRPD's property tax assessments were held to be invalid in accordance with the Sacramento County Superior Court decision, *Sacramento County Taxpayers Association, et al. v. County of Sacramento, Carmichael Recreation and Park District, et al.*, Case No. 34-2014-80001869, court order dated May 19, 2016. The ruling by the Court negated the assessment on the grounds of numerous violations of the

California State Constitution (Proposition 218), designed to protect taxpayers by limiting the methods by which local governments can both establish or increase taxes, fees and property tax assessments such as the subject case. Please refer to the Court's decision for further information regarding these thousands of unlawful property tax assessments.

Currently, taxpayers must apply for a refund through a circuitous, arduous, and complex written refund process that also includes disclosing otherwise confidential, non-public full property tax bills for these two separate tax years. Many people do not even have bills going back several years; that process becomes another refund barrier, or disincentive.

Any purported refund process was designed to fail and limit the refunds rightfully due your taxpayers. In fact there was only one undated (and personally unaddressed and without property reference) cryptic letter that was apparently mailed to some, but possibly not all, taxpayers.

The letter, sent in the fall of 2016, contained the following incorrect and ambiguous reference of an application deadline: "Applicants are encouraged to mail a completed refund application with required supporting documents by November 30, 2016 as directed on the form." (SCI Consultants, which oversees the refund process, confirmed the application deadline to be June 30, 2018 for FY 2014-2015 assessments; and June 30, 2019 for FY 2015-2016 assessments).

This is a serious matter affecting more than 13,000 of your taxpayers, and should be diligently addressed now.

As background, the proponents' campaign never disclosed the actual thousand dollar-plus levies on businesses, apartments and commercial properties. Further, nowhere in any written materials were the

true facts disclosed. The assessment barely passed, and with a related vote count largely out of public view. This issue is not about parks, but fairness and accuracy by our local government and their proxies.

Additionally, information on the taxpayers, and amounts paid, are all computerized and readily available. The County was able to originally bill everyone within CRPD boundaries, and we only ask that refunds be coordinated in a like process. This should not be politically complicated if there is a will.

Property taxpayers within CRPD boundaries who were unlawfully assessed and had previously paid an additional direct levy tax on their residential or commercial properties, are entitled to a full refund. The simplest way is for the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors to order forthwith the return of these already-paid property tax funds to your 13,000 constituents and taxpayers. After all, they followed what they were told was the law.
