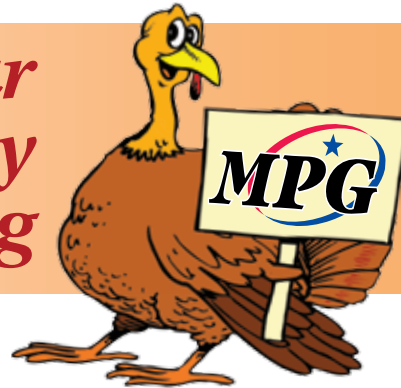

Kids Helping Kids Planning Big Gala Return

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Tickets are on sale for the upcoming Kids Helping Kids Sacramento (KHK) 6th Annual Benefit Gala, the seminal event for the nonprofit, which is comprised of and operated by 11th- and 12th-grade students at Del Campo High School in Fair Oaks.

The KHK gala is slated for Thursday, Jan. 11 at Harris Center For the Arts in Folsom. The gala will kick off with a silent auction at 6 p.m., followed by food, drinks, stellar musical entertainment at 7 p.m., featuring a return headlining performance by the Charleston, South Carolina-based pop sensation, NEEDTOBREATHE. The band's 2016 release, H A R D L O V E (Atlantic Records) debuted at number one on the Billboard Top Albums, Top Current Albums, Top Rock Albums and Top Alternative Album charts, and took the number two spot on the Billboard 200.

Launched in 2012, Kids Helping Kids Sacramento is a 100 percent student run nonprofit service organization modeled after the Kids Helping Kids Santa Barbara. The KHK class and nonprofit is open to seniors and juniors at Del Campo, who must apply to serve as a volunteer in class, or for a seat

on the senior management team each year. Service positions on the KHK senior management team rotate out upon graduation. The management team is overseen by a board of volunteer business advisors from across the Sacramento Business community.

The KHK's mission is two-fold: empower students with the tools they need to make a difference in the classroom, the community and the world at large, while learning the ins and outs of running a nonprofit. Secondly,

be of service to those less fortunate.

To date, KHK Sacramento has raised roughly \$500,000 for individuals and families within its four core areas of service, according to Lindsey Terra, the nonprofit's director of marketing, currently a senior at Del Campo. Those include a tutoring and mentoring program for youth; the College Bound program, which offers foster and at-risk youth support with the transition from

The award-winning organization has graduated 1,457 homeless women and their 3,500 children. Last year, 92 percent of graduates found homes and 81 percent found jobs or enrolled in school or training. The program combines self-esteem courses, job training, health classes and support services to help homeless women across diverse ages, races and cultures.

Hospice House, Promises of Peaceful Endings

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - A \$2 million facility near Carmichael will soon offer end-of-life care to the terminally ill.

The Sehr-Allen Hospice House (named for its husband and wife founders and their sons), offers rooms for six patients. Nestled in three-acres of Arcade Creek woodland, the one-level design provides French doors through which beds can be rolled onto private patios. The center is said to be the first hospice home in Sacramento.

Here stay-over friends or relatives can bolster professional care. Though meals are provided, a communal kitchen is available for visitors to cook favorite meals. Pets are allowed. "As a nurse, I've seen first-hand many patients who could not end their lives at home with family and beloved pets," says career nurse and facility co-owner Angela Sehr. "It's my dream and, I hope, my legacy to provide a peaceful place for people to die. Here, they'll have expert medical care and be surrounded by love and compassion."

high school to college; financial aid for families with children fighting cancer through a new partnership the Roseville-based Keaton's Child Cancer Alliance launched this year; and, on a global scale, funds to support the Love, Light + Melody Foundation, which works with underserved children in Nicaragua.

"This is our signature event and it is going to be amazing," Terra said. "We start planning this just about as quickly as we wrap up the previous gala, so a lot of work goes into it. And although we do have mentors in the community, it is primarily executed from top to bottom by the KHK team of students."

Proceeds from the KHK annual gala represent the largest chunk of funding for the non-profit each year. The 2017 gala generated roughly \$146,000, Terra said.

The KHK gala's silent auction will offer opportunities to bid on a range of high-end gift baskets, donations from local restaurants and retail shops and several big-ticket items, including Napa Valley wine tours, passes to big sporting events and other "vacation experiences."

The Sehrs hope to admit patients in early 2018. "In the meantime, there's plenty of work to do," says Dr. James Sehr. "We're choosing furniture, recruiting staff and getting the word out about our charitable foundation." His wife purchased the Walnut Avenue site in 2005 and though she and he funded

construction, donations will be sought to support the home's ongoing operations.

The couple has established a foundation to assist patients of limited means. "I believe everyone has the right to die with dignity, regardless of their circumstances," says Angela Sehr. "But my husband and I are only two people. We hope this house

will become a community effort. Keeping this place going really will take a village."

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - A new solar farm, anticipated to provide more than a third of the electrical needs of Sacramento International Airport, is expected to be operational by the end of the year.

Airport staff is working on final permits, inspections, and other finishing touches. Once online, the facility will be capable of producing nearly eight megawatts of electricity, enough to power 1,600 homes.

The solar farm consists of a photovoltaic system located on two sites on otherwise unused airport property. The facility will use more than 23,000 solar panels mounted on equipment that tracks the sun's path from east to west over the course of the day, maximizing efficiency

and energy production.

Energy company NRG owns and operates the airport solar facility and will sell electricity to Sacramento International Airport at below-market rates under a Power Purchase Agreement. Projected cost savings from the project are an average of \$850,000 a year over the 25-year term of the agreement.

"This is an exciting development for the Sacramento International Airport. By partnering with a private company, we will have a source of clean, renewable energy that will save us money and further our commitment to sustainable practices," said John Wheat, Director of Airports for the Sacramento County Department of Airports. "It's truly a win-win scenario."

Sacramento International Airport will have a grand opening at a date to be named later.

The more inexpensive, and cheaply made a car is, the more likely it becomes that it would be worn down by higher mileage. Some vehicles start to get a little ragged at 100,000 miles, while others — some of the better makes — are just getting a feel for the road at that point. Of course, a lot depends on your budget, too.

Overall, I would advise you to look for something that has a good reputation, a solid history, and as little mileage as possible. There are good, used cars out there that will last for years!

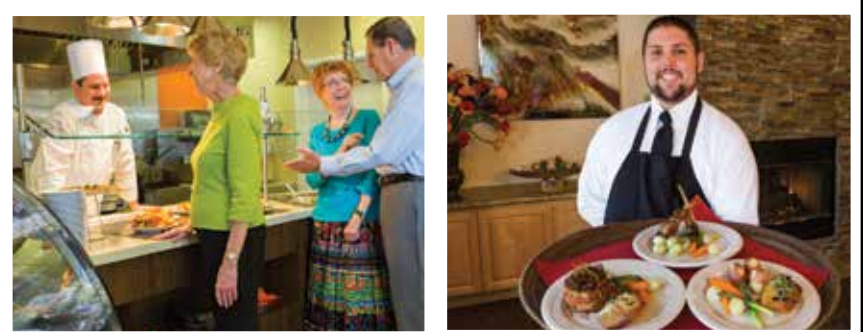

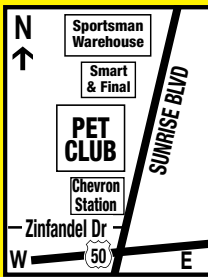
