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

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - In case you haven't noticed, Carmichael has slowly but steadily been expanding your options for food and drink over the last year or so, particularly along the Fair Oaks Boulevard corridor, welcoming in as many as half a dozen dining options, some in just the last few weeks, including the long-anticipated opening of The Patriot restaurant, which put one of the last puzzle pieces

into place at the 46,000 squarefoot Milagro Centre.

While The Patriot is serving only dinner at this point, the 6,000-square-foot restaurant's owner, Chris Jarosz, said lunch and brunch options should be in full swing by late fall. The Patriot features an open-air space with wooden sculptures, a wraparound reclaimed wood bar, a specialty pizza kitchen, a private dining room and patio area.



Gov. Brown Fails Oroville Dam **Issue, Threatens Thousands of Lives** Oroville Legislators Reacts to

Bombshell Oroville Dam Memo

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - On September 5th, Assemblyman James Gallagher released the following statement in reaction to the release of a new Independent Forensic Team memo criticizing the state's dam inspection process:

"The findings of this memo are consistent with what I, and others, have been saying: California lacks a process to thoroughly review original design and construction of major infrastructure projects. This memo highlights that reviews should be conducted by independent experts who will go deeper into the integrity of structures and not simply provide visual reviews and regurgitate findings of past inspections.

"There are many lessons to be learned as a result of the Oroville Dam incident. I stand shoulder to shoulder with a coalition of downstream stakeholders who are ready and willing to help champion real change. Maintaining the status quo will only continue to endanger tens of thousands of families who narrowly escaped tragedy a few short months ago."

"We have two kitchens and we are working out a menu for the smaller kitchen that can support the lunch crowd," Jarosz said.

The last puzzle piece at Milagro, by the way, also belongs to Jarosz. He's leased the remaining retail space at Milagro's far west end and plans to open a grab-and-go restaurant sometime in the coming months that will offer lighter fare options, such as salads, sandwiches and small bites.

Noah's Bagels has been operating since June of 2015 at Carmichael Village on Fair Oaks Boulevard and patiently warming up the scene for the complex's newest tenant, Wing Stop, which opened its doors in July. Right next door to Wing Stop construction is underway

in preparation for the Village's next and highly anticipated foodie tenant: Jamba Juice, originally set to open in August but, according to developers, currently navigating the county's multi-faceted and somewhat complicated permitting process. Not to fear. Jamba is set for opening by October 31.

"We are moving forward and Jamba Juice is coming in as planned, said Brooks Erickson of Carmichael Village, LLC. "They have been at the county with their permits and going through several iterations, so I'm shifting toward Halloween for the opening. But they are still on track and coming in."

As of Sept. 1, there were two other open retail spaces left in the Village complex and, according to Erickson, one is being marketed to another food

retailer, although he declined to say which one. The other space is potentially being eyed by a medical-related service provider, he said, although indications are strong that it too could go to one more retail food outfit.

"Our objective would be for more food in at least one of those spaces," Erickson said. "If you look at retail tenancy the action is with retail food. If you are a resident in Carmichael, you want service, you want food and you want choices and things to do. If we are going to see Carmichael go to the next level, it's going to be more of the kinds of retail offerings that give locals and visitors alike offerings of experiential places."

ciencies in the spillway and continues to confirm my observations, those of my father-in-law who worked as an electrician during the dam's construction, and many who are familiar with the Oroville Dam Spillway."

"Decades of neglect have contributed greatly to the recent spillway failure and this can no longer continue."

"The Governor and Legislature must prioritize investment in the state's critical water infrastructure, which includes allocating \$100 million for our levees. The state must do more thorough inspections and invest in repairing damage that is found.

"The emergency evacuation of nearly 200,000 people and their pets should not have happened, and must not ever occur again!"

In response to the Oroville Dam crisis, Assemblyman Gallagher introduced legislation (Assembly Bill 1270) to ensure proper inspections, transparency, and independent oversight of critical water infrastructure. AB 1270 passed off the Assembly Floor earlier this year but was killed in the Senate Appropriations Committee last week.

Other than the Governor's Administration, the bill had no formal opposition.

Assemblyman James Gallagher represents the 3rd Assembly District, which encompasses all of Glenn, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba counties as well as portions of Butte and Colusa counties. Senator Nielsen represents the Fourth Senate District, which includes the counties of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba.

Gourd Festival Returns to Sacramento Region

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - The Gourd is Back. The Northern California Gourd Art Competition and Gourd Exhibit is returning to Orangevale this September, roughly 14 years since it was moved from its original location in Folsom, due to construction of a new shopping center.

The gourd competition and festival, co-hosted by the Folsom and Amador Gourd Artists associations will make its return to Orangevale September 30 at the Orangevale Community Center, where organizers are hoping to keep the festival moving forward, as it has moved more than four times in the last decade.

"We are really thrilled to be able to have the festival back in Orangevale," said newly installed chairman of the event, Barbara Rippetoe, an accomplished gourd artist and member of both the Folsom and Amador associations, which have a combined membership of 80 gourd artists. "I really wanted to help move the festival back to Orangevale and after a lot of discussion and investigating, we finally found a new home and are very excited to be coming back."

The original festival, known as

the West Coast Gourd Festival, was launched at Zittel Farm in 1996 in Orangevale. It was held at the farm annually through 2003 with solid attendance and a strong following of some of the region's most renowned gourd artists, Rippetoe said. But in 2004, a shopping center was built adjacent to the original location at Zittel Farm, forcing a move to Greg Leiser Farms in Knights Landing, followed by another move to Folsom Park until 2009. Complications with the Folsom Park location forced another move, this time to Davis Ranch Slough House, where the festival ran through 2015. It did not run in 2016, said Rippetoe.

Now, with a permanent spot back in Orangevale, says Rippetoe, expectations are high for a large turn-out, both by local gourd artists and novice competitors alike, as well as locals who just want to witness firsthand how many different ways there are to create art from a gourd, typically the dried, hard shell of We are really thrilled to be able to have the festival back in Orangevale... and after a lot of discussion and investigating, we finally found a new home and are very excited to be coming back.

any one of the countless plants belonging to the cucuritaceae (pronounced kyoo-kur-bi-tey-shuh) family of squash or a pumpkin.

The festival kicks off on Friday, Sept. 29 with gourd art classes taught by several well-known gourd artists, including Toni Best, Joyce Campbell, Vickie Echols and Bettie Lake. Classes are open to all. Then, from Sept. 30 to Oct. 1, gourd artists will compete in several

design categories and divisions, including a novice category for student entries from the classes held prior to the launch of the competition.

Competition divisions will be available for youth, novice, intermediate, advanced and master level gourd art makers. Gourds will be scored using a point system and judging will consider originality, quality of craftsmanship, creativity and artistry, color and use of accessories, as well as overall decorative work. These can range from pyrography (burning in designs and shapes) and carving gourds, to those embellished with a vast array of mediums, including paint, fiber art, jewelry, beads, feathers and more.

You don't have to be a gourd artist to get in on the action. The event is free and, in addition to the competitions, classes and even a gourd hat parade, individual artists will be selling their wares, which may include everything from purses, dolls, jewelry, drums and other items, all made from gourds, of course.

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

Togo's on New Year's Eve of 2016. The franchise is owned by Terry Cornwell and family, a Carmichael native who already had a Togo's store up-and-running in Davis.

"The company wanted to open one more store in the region in 2016, so we made it in on that deadline and we have been busy since," said Cornwell. "We have people who come here almost every day. It's just been amazing how popular it is. We are very happy to be here."

Pizza Hut opened its doors right next door to Togo's in June, and, although the store is a take-away operation only, it is doing brisk business. Blocks away, six or so employees at Carmichael's new Dutch Bros. Coffee on Fair Oaks Blvd., which opened its doors in March, are rockin' out to highdecimal tunes inside the store, shaking smoothies and iced-coffee beverages for a line of cars in the drive-thru 10-deep at 2 p.m. in the afternoon.

Further west in the 6700 block of Fair Oaks Blvd. is Wave Fish & Chips, which opened for business July 13. Founder Daniel Dondov got his back-ofhouse training as a sushi chef at Blue Nami in Folsom. He says he had an eye on a space inside the Milagro Centre, but as a first-time restauranteur, he

decided on a lower-priced space in a strip mall nearby.

Dondov scoped the Carmichael area with the thought of opening his own sushi restaurant, but realized the market was saturated with sushi. Instead, he opted to do fresh fish entrees, and his menu includes traditional fried fresh cod fish and chips, fish tacos, fish burgers and grilled salmon, as well as a good selection of appetizers, including fried crab-stuffed mushrooms, brussel sprouts in a honey and sriracha sauce, a grilled cod fish and spring mix salad and a desert he calls "Dragon Delights,"

which is fried banana splits with ice cream.

"Everything is fresh daily here," says Dondov. "No one is doing fresh, daily fish here in Carmichael. There's a lot of sushi but not fresh cooked fish meals, so I thought this would be a great addition to the area."

The explosion of new food and drink retailers have come in as Carmichael enjoys the longawaited completion of the first of two phases of the county's roughly \$8 million Fair Oaks Boulevard Corridor Plan, funded by a combination of Measure A dollars, developer fees and state and federal transportation funds. Street scape improvements, bike lanes, new tree-lined medians, signal and traffic intersection modifications to mitigate congestion are already in place after what felt like years of red cones and five-mile an hour traffic flow through much of the Fair Oaks Corridor.

Phase two is set to begin sometime in 2018 and, in addition to more bike lanes, sidewalk and streetscape improvements, and signal and traffic flow modifications, will included a plan for replacement of overhead utilities with underground facilities. "I think if you are new to Carmichael or have lived here for many years and call it home,

ing businesses, as well as the new food retailers setting up shop, is the long-awaited implementation of two of the top objectives of the Carmichael Improvement District (CID): security and street maintenance. In July, CID board members signed management contracts with security and street cleaning service providers to address deep-seeded concerns by business owners about growing homeless encampments, crime and safety issues, as well as illegal dumping, graffiti and trash.

There's more good news, according to Melody. The CID contracts, the expansion of retail food options and the completion of the first phase of the Fair Oaks Boulevard project are contributing to a drop in commercial retail vacancies across the area, which were as high as 23 percent in 2009, but now hovering at roughly 17 percent. She adds that the celebration plans for Carmichael's 108th birthday on September 30 will be particularly special, as a result.

"We are all very excited to see all of these restaurants coming in because the vacancy rates have been so high for so long," said Melody said. "We want to see more food businesses and, with the improvements, we are showing other retailers that we are putting the money and the projects into place, which attracts more businesses to our area. This is what we want here as we celebrate founders' day. We are going to be 108 in September, so it's very exciting time in Carmichael right now."

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

CERT Training Offered, Seeks Sign-Ups

Special Release from Sac Metro Fire Dept

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) -The Sacramento Metropolitan Fire Department (Metro Fire) Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is having an introductory (Basic) training open to the public this September.

Citizens may take the class just for their own information, they may also take the class as the first step in becoming a member of the Metro Fire CERT program. As a member, participants are eligible to attend additional training including: advanced Medical Training, Severe Weather / Downed Lines Training, and Sandbag Training; to name a few. Mentorship and support is provided throughout this process to help all interested

volunteers become active members of the program.

Metro Fire CERT members have served in numerous capacities including staffing the Sacramento County Emergency Operation Center, Sacramento County Sand Bag Stations and deployment to areas impacted by wild fire. CERT members also volunteer numerous hours within local communities for events including but not limited to: Capital Air Show, Hot August Bites, Special Olympics Softball, Rancho Cordova 4th of July, and Eppie's Great Race. During all events CERT members serve as Outreach liaisons and Stand-By First Aid.

The Metro Fire CERT Basic Training Includes: What your local risks are and what you need to do to prepare; How to manage utilities, hazardous materials, and put out small fires using the appropriate Fire Extinguisher; How to use "START Triage" and how to treat the "Three Medical Killers" by: opening airways, controlling bleeding, and treating for shock; How to provide basic medical aid; How to effectively search for and rescue victims safely; How to organize yourself and spontaneous volunteers to be effective as a team and collect disaster intelligence to support first responder efforts; Disaster Psychology; Terrorism.

The dates are: Thursday September 21st, Saturday September 23rd, Thursday September 28th, Saturday September 30th. There is no cost for this training.

Defendant Sentenced for Injuring for the second-degree murder of Christopher

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Deputy During Vehicle Pursuit

DATE: August 8, 2017 CASE: Somephone Siacksorn (Case #16FE009419)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Nicole Shaker, Vehicle Theft Unit

The Honorable Michael Kenny sentenced Somephone Siacksorn to 17 years and 4 months in prison. On June 8, 2017, a jury convicted Siacksorn of recklessly evading officers causing serious bodily injury, recklessly evading officers, vehicle theft, and possession of a stolen vehicle.

On May 11, 2016, sheriff's deputies attempted to stop Somephone Siacksorn for driving a vehicle without plates. Siacksorn fled, leading deputies on a chase through Oak Park while speeding and running stop signs. The chase continued onto Highway 99 until Siacksorn exited on Broadway, where a deputy conducted a PIT maneuver. Siacksorn lost control of the vehicle and ended up on a sidewalk. The pursuing deputy also lost control of his vehicle and crashed into a tree. The deputy sustained significant injuries during the crash. After refusing to exit the vehicle, Siacksorn was able to restart the vehicle and led deputies on a second pursuit down Broadway and Martin Luther King Boulevard while running red lights. Siacksorn turned onto 15th Avenue and jumped from the moving vehicle, causing it to crash into a parked vehicle. Siacksorn then fled on foot, but was found hiding in a nearby backyard by a K9 unit. The vehicle Siacksorn was driving had recently been reported stolen and Siacksorn was on probation at the time of this crime.

At sentencing the Court found that Siacksorn had suffered several prior felony convictions including robbery with the use of a firearm, a strike offense.

Defendant Convicted for Murder of Disabled Man

DATE: August 16, 2017 CASE: Joshua Lowery (Case #14F01574) **PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney William Satchell, Homicide Unit Joshua Lowery was convicted by a jury Sorgani. The jury also found true the allegation that Lowery personally used a deadly weapon.

On October 23, 2013, Christopher Sorgani took light-rail and a bus home from work. Mr. Sorgani was physically disabled and often walked the last stretch of his trip home for exercise. As Mr. Sorgani walked down Greenback Lane, Joshua Lowery approached him from behind and struck him in the head with a hammer multiple times, killing him. Mr. Sorgani and Lowery had no connection with each other and there was no apparent motive for the murder.

Lowery faces a maximum sentence of 16 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for October 27, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 21 before the Honorable Steve White.

Trevon Brown was convicted by a jury for the second-degree murder of Linda Hull. Brown was also convicted of felony evasion causing great bodily injury.

On April 26, 2015, officers attempted to arrest Trevon Brown for an active felony warrant. Brown fled on foot to a minivan parked nearby and drove off at a high rate of speed on Eleanor Avenue. Officers pursued Brown, who exceeded speeds of 60 mph while running red lights and stop signs in a residential neighborhood. At the intersection of Helena Avenue and Del Paso Boulevard, Brown ran a stop sign at 50-60 mph and crashed into a pick-up truck and a pedestrian. The pedestrian, Linda Hull, was killed at the scene. The driver of the pick-up truck was ejected from his vehicle and suffered severe injuries.

Brown faces a maximum sentence of 18 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for September 8, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. in Department 23 before the Honorable Geoffrey Goodman. ★

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
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

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

My mind was racing with thoughts so I don't think I'm going to wait for the kiddos' input. I already know most of what they'll say.

DRESS: Dress comfy and cute with hair brush handy. Have slip on shoes, small sized blankets that can be used for pillows or covers or both.

FOOD: I have a dry food bag and a cooler bag up with me and a different colored bowl for each person and every person has a water bottle with his/her name on it. I'm a bit stingy on the food because I can't stand food trash in the car. The front seat and back seats have trash bags, wipes and napkins. You can use the cute little totes from the dollar store to put these in. I think it's best to have something that closes so it can be on the floor and won't matter if it

gets stepped on or falls over.

As needed I'll put some "clean" snacks in a bowl and pass it to them. They never know what they are getting. Clean snacks are healthy and do not make a lot of crumbs, like apple slices, carrots, almonds, other fruits and veggies and every oncein-a-while I might throw in M&Ms or something for fun. But I keep candy to a rarity as it doesn't help with sitting still for hours at a time.

PACK: Each person has a small travel bag with them with their favorite stuffed animals or toys and things to do inside.

HAVE A PLAN FOR STOPS: On our annual trips, we have regular stops that we go to no matter if we need them or not. It builds tradition, memories, familiarity and fun to return to the same place every time. For a new trip, have a laminated

map with white board pens to write on so that everyone knows where they are and how far until they get there. Rotate travelers writing in a single travel journal.

ENTERTAINMENT: I limit the kids' movie time and electronics time so these are some other things we do or could do. It's handy to have a timer that goes off for every-one to hear.

We have "just look around time" so they can get a feel of the area we are traveling through.

Listen to an audio book time together. Each kid has his/her own blank sketch book (my kids' favorite) with colored pencils (little kids could have coloring books). Sewing: crocheting, friendship bracelets.

Play games: Question cards, "I Spy," "Would you rather?" Sing along songs Category alphabet game License plate/billboard alphabet game Bingo and scavenger hunt print outs you can find online

print outs you can find online (laminate and use dry erase markers) Name that song Tic tac toe dry erase Printable battleship game Name that song (only listen to the intro) Movie one-liners Fidgets Window clings 21 questions

White board markers on windows (I just thought of this, but I've never done it. I figure it'd have to get it wiped off quickly.)

Rotate DJ responsibilities.

For a long and new trip, every place you stop, get everyone to try a "local" food item that is unique.

On our move to and from Texas, I made some "grab bags" for Rachel. Every so often (I can't remember my time span, maybe it was every two hours), she would get to pick out a little closed brown lunch bag out of a box. Inside of it would be some sort of cheap toy or thing that would consume her for the next little bit of the trip. (The dollar store or cleaning out a junk drawer is great for this. Sticky notes, stickers, widgets, etc.)

I saw something where each kid gets their own cookie tray so they can do puzzles and such. I've never done this, but might be a good idea especially if their toy is magnetic. I like bowls instead of flat things because they can find a place for them to sit better than a flat tray.

Pre-paid debit cards for kids? Dear Dave,

I've seen lots of companies marketing pre-paid debit cards for kids. They seem to position them as a way parents can set spending limits for their children. Do you think these are a good idea? It seems to me they are just a form of conditioning to get kids to rely on cards. - Keith

Dear Keith,

I agree with your assessment. I don't recommend pre-paid debit cards for children, except in very unusual situations. Let's say your kid was going on a trip, and you wanted him or her to have something in their pocket for limited access to cash. But if they're old enough and responsible enough, I'd rather them have a traditional debit card attached to their own account.

What I really want parents to do is <u>teach their children</u> how to work, give, save and spend *wisely*. It's all about teaching your children to become good adults, and handling money is part of the equation. How does

that apply to something like a pre-paid debit card for a kid? For the child, they're looking at it like mom and dad are an ATM. They don't equate it with real money unless they put *their* cash into the card.

I suggest helping them open a checking account with a debit card attached around age 15 or 16, provided you have taught them – and they have demonstrated – wise money management practices up to that point. Teach them to reconcile and balance the account, and walk with them when they do this so they don't slip into the idea a debit card is some magical portal to free money!
