Cameron's Cans Fight Hunger

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - This holiday season will be brighter thanks to the sixth food drive organized by one Carmichael boy.

Not yet in his teens, Cameron Dax has done enough grocery shopping for lifetime. The 12-year-old out penny-pinches the frugal. He can't find a bargain, he'll haggle for one. Two cans for a dollar is his top bid for tomatoes.

From the age of six, he's been pushing a shopping cart like a pro. Since he started Cameron's Canned Food Drive, he has given nearly 10,000 non-perishable items to Carmichael Presbyterian Church, whose food closet helps families and the homeless. The home-schooled kid also donates supplies for San Juan School District's outreach to families.

"When I first saw people who didn't have enough food, I wanted to give them all peanut butter and jelly sandwiches," recalls the young philanthropist. "I learned that food must be non-perishable to be helpful, so I started my canned food drives. This year, I began collecting in October. I leave bins at the offices of friends, at the gym, at our doctor's and chiropractor's clinic. Mom and dad's financial advisor also collects for me. The Carmichael Chamber of Commerce is a new supporter and a motor club in Grass valley has promised a load of groceries." His November collection at Emigh Hardware store yielded a palette of food and 50 crews from Alpha One Ambulance recently pledged help for the young visionary.

Many others donate to fund sixcart shopping sprees at stores that offer good discounts. Throughout the year, Cameron saves his allowance to boost his budget. "I've also sold some of my art projects to raise funds," he says. "My Go Fund Me account (on social media) helps to get donations from out-of-town people. They know I'm helping others. It makes me feel good inside. If all other kids did something like this, perhaps hunger wouldn't be such a problem."

Dax, is ecstatic to have a pre-teen kid with such a monumental heart. "It's inspiring when an 12-year-old thinks to be businesslike and resourceful. He recruits friends to help; he's confident talking to adults. He tells everyone he meets about the project

FTB Responds To Gaines' Call to Help Victimized Veterans

Ted Gaines (R-El Dorado) reported that, per his request, the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) has put into place a dedicated study team to evaluate the taxation of California National Guard Bonus repayments.

"I called on the FTB to create a special task force to aid California National Guard veterans who may need to file amended tax returns resulting from the resolution of this bonus scandal and am pleased to hear they are moving forward," said Senator Gaines. "I want these veterans to have

to their plight so they are not mired in bureaucracy when trying to resolve their tax status. I appreciate the FTB working with these service men and women to ensure our veterans are being honored for their service and not suffering from this betrayal at the hands of the Pentagon."

The FTB reports that they have reached out to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) requesting information on the IRS interpretation of the federal tax consequences of the bonus repayment and are awaiting a

The FTB is also awaiting the final decision from the Department of Defense regarding the repayment of bonuses. Once the appropriate information is received, the FTB will take action to notify taxpayers and tax professionals of the appropriate tax treatment.

CARMICHAEL. CA (MPG) - Picnickers are now spared wobbly tables thanks to a Carmichael Rotary Club project. Through 2016 fundraising – and matching funds from Rotary International - the club last week presented seven concrete tables to the Carmichael Park District.

The tables each weigh about 2400 pounds and are embellished with the non-profit's logo.

Considered less likely to be stolen or vandalized than existing picnic furniture, they are also less portable. Indeed, a 13-ton semi was needed to transport the behemoth benches from their Anderson, CA manufacturer. Once delivered, a fork-hoist placed them on concrete pads installed by Rotarian volunteers and park staff.

After the loss of funding opportunities that resulted from a legal challenge to the 2014 property-owner assessment, the Rotay donation - valued at \$7000 -- was doubly welcomed by CRPD. "We're grateful to the club," said district administrator Tarry Smith. "Gifts from community organizations provide amenities we could not otherwise afford.'

An annual crab feed raises money for all Carmichael Rotary donations. The 2017 event is planned for February 4 at the La Sierra Community Center. For information, visit www.carmichaelrotary.org

Father and Son Convicted of Felony Auto Insurance Fraud



Defendant Convicted of **Charges Stemming from** Vehicle Shooting

DATE: November 8, 2016 CASE: Harpreet Singh & Satnam Singh (Case

#16FE007779) PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Kelly

Harpreet Singh and his father, Satnam Singh, pled no contest to felony auto insurance fraud and misdemeanor making a false report to police. Harpreet also pled no contest to felony hit and run with injuries.

On Sept 2, 2015, Harpreet caused a major vehicle crash while driving an Acura registered to his father, Satnam. The crash injured the driver of one of the involved cars. Harpreet fled the scene, but was followed by witnesses who reported his license plate to police. Harpreet then abandoned the car and walked to his gym to call his father, who picked Harpreet up and took him home. One hour later, Satnam called police to report his car had been stolen from his house. He also claimed he had no children and no one else ever drove his car. Satnam also filed an insurance claim for the allegedly stolen Acura. Before discovering the claim was a fraud, CSAA paid Satnam approximately \$22,000. CHP officers investigating the incident spoke to one of Satnam's neighbors who showed them surveillance video of Harpreet driving the Acura away from the house on the morning of the crash.

The Honorable Curtis Fiorini sentenced Harpreet Singh to 270 days in jail and 5 years formal probation. Satnam Singh was sentenced to 240 days in jail and 5 years formal probation. Both men were ordered to pay \$26,240 in restitution to CSAA (the cost of the payout on the claim plus investigative costs), \$9,041 to Allstate Insurance (cost of claims paid to their insured) and restitution to the other drivers involved in the crash.




PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Shelly McGill, Gangs & Hate Crimes

Daevon Love was convicted by a jury of assault with force likely to produce great bodily injury, discharging a firearm at an inhabited vehicle, three counts of assault with a semiautomatic firearm, and being a felon in possession of a firearm. The jury also found true allegations that Love personally used a firearm and committed crimes while out on bail. The Court found in a separate proceeding that Love has a prior strike conviction.

On July 31, 2014, Love and his friends attacked a man and beat him. On November 8, 2015, Love, while out on bail, was a passenger in a Buick. The Buick nearly collided with another car. When the occupants of the other car honked at the Buick, Love pulled out a firearm and shot at them. Neither the car nor the occupants were struck, but an unrelated individual who was walking to work suffered a gunshot wound to his neck.

Love's prior strike conviction is for battery with serious bodily injury. He faces a maximum sentence of 56 years in prison. Sentencing is set for January 20, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 39 before the Honorable James Arguelles. ★



While you have something of a modest income, I think you make enough money to pay off the house and become prosperous during the next five to seven years, without going to the extreme.

Health insurance options

Dear Dave,

My husband and I are selfemployed, and we currently pay almost \$1,000 a month for health insurance. I've heard you talk about the potential for rates to increase as much as 40 to 60 percent next year. Are there other options, such as just saving the money in case of medical emergencies?

Dear Anna,

You don't want to go completely without insurance, because you'll get penalized by the government. Remember, when it comes to health insurance, the problem usually isn't

emergency room for a few stitches. The problem is a cancer diagnosis, which ends up costing \$500,000 or more.


You might want to check into an HSA (Health Savings Account) type of plan within the exchanges. Another thing you could look at is one of the medical sharing programs through a Christian organization such as Christian Healthcare Ministries.

But a higher deductible, HSAtype plan might help keep your premiums down. It's sad, but this is what Obamacare has done to independent people like you and me who are self-employed. It's destroying small group plans, and I guess that was their intent. I suppose they wanted to put those companies out of business, so the government could take it over.





Fun with Purpose Pays Off for Local Girl Scouts

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Girl Scouts may be 104 years old, but the organization continues to deliver relevant, modern experiences that build leaders right here in our community.

This year was an incredible year for local Girl Scouts. Not only did 48 young women earn the highest award in Girl Scouting (the Gold Award), but one local girl earned the prestigious national Girl Scout Medal of Honor for saving a friend's life using skills she learned while pursuing her first aid badge.

"I learned the Heimlich maneuver as a Brownie in third grade," recalls 6th grader Abby Egawa, adding, "I did not think I would ever be faced with an emergency like this, but I do remember thinking to myself that the Heimlich maneuver was important and that I should pay attention." Abby and her grateful friend Rosie Helft were interviewed on local television stations to talk about the harrowing experience and Abby's quick thinking.

Just last month, two young leaders from Sacramento were recognized as "National Young Women of Distinction." Each year, Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) confers special honors on just ten young women who personify the organization's goal of building girls of courage, confidence and character through their Gold Award projects. They are considered the organization's best and brightest young leaders, and the fact that two of them are from Northern California is an unprecedented honor.

Ayana Watkins, a senior and student body president at Christian Brothers High School, planned and executed a symposium for 200 underserved Sacramento youth entitled "Education Matters in Black Lives," to address the issue of the academic Achievement Gap and the need for educational support to ensure the success of African American youth.

Her symposium included a collegiate panel of students of

that carried her message on a digital platform. Ayana believes that education is an antidote to poverty and social injustice. Through the successful implementation of her Girl Scout Gold Award project, Ayana has made a difference in her community and changed the world through education. "I learned that my voice matters and that I can make a difference in society," she said. "I was able to create something that could address an issue, benefit others and make a positive change."

Leyna Reynolds set her sights on making California roadways safer for new drivers. Noting the high number of accidents involving inexperienced drivers, Leyna developed a program by which new drivers could post "Student Driver" decals to let other drivers know there is a newbie behind the wheel. Leyna created the decals and distributed them through a teen driver advocacy group (Impact Teen Driver) and at local driving schools and insurance companies. She even developed a partnership with Mothers Against Drunk Driving!

She worked with California Assemblymember Kansen Chu, who introduced Assembly Bill 2322 to make these decals available to all permit holders while they practice their skills. She has been able to testify before the California Legislature in support of the bill. "The Gold





1) CAYENNE PEPPER. This wonderful spice provides a three-pronged attack against obesity. First, eating cayenne may help fight off food cravings. Some experts believe that eating sharp-tasting foods such as hot peppers can overwhelm

taste buds, cutting off cravings. Second, cayenne helps you eat less. Researchers in the Netherlands gave men .9 grams of ground cayenne pepper either as a pill or mixed into a tomato juice beverage. Then 30 minutes later, they turned the men loose at an allyou-can-eat buffet. Compared with men who were given a placebo, the men who had consumed cayenne reduced their food intake by 16%. Third, it actually requires energy to eat hot peppers. That's right. That's because the heat you feel when you eat chili peppers takes energy to produce. That's why Dr. Jones adds cayenne capsules to her daily health and nutrition program. And especially with any large holiday meal, she finds ways to also consume some cayenne.

2) DON'T SKIP MEALS. Make sure to eat something every 3-4 hours so you won't get famished and end up eating more than necessary.

3) BRING HEALTHY SNACKS. While shopping or in the car, healthy snacks help your blood sugar not to plummet.

4) HAVE SOMETHING SMALL TO EAT. That's before you go out, especially to a holiday party or big dinner so you don't arrive with a voracious appetite.

5) DON'T HANG OUT NEAR THE

FOOD during holiday parties and large gatherings where there are tables of food.

6) DON'T JUST EAT TO BE **SOCIAL.** Choose wisely what food you hold in your hands while talking to others at hol-

7) KEEP YOUR BODY **HYDRATED** with purified water. We often confuse hunger with dehydration.

8) START ALL MEALS WITH **HIGH-FIBER FOODS to fill your** stomach. Fiber is your secret weapon to weight control.

9) EAT SLOWLY. Put down the fork between bites. Make a meal last 30 minutes so your brain's satiety center gets the signal when you are full.

10) MAKE SLEEP A PRIORITY. Lack of sleep causes your body to hold on to all of the calories you eat and strengthens your desire for junk foods.


