Towering Move Funds La Sierra Gym Re-vamp

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - After a \$220,000 refit, Carmichael Park District's Johnson and Villareal gymnasiums reopened last weekend. Renovation costs were met from the district's sale of a cell tower lease in La Sierra Community Center campus.

The botanically disguised facility allows transmission for thousands of wireless phones in surrounding areas. Its 2008 installation supplied a regular income for CRPD -- which is one of several Sacramento park districts that host telecommunication centers. By a recent arrangement, a 30-year lease with T-Mobile garnered a lump sum to boost the Carmichael district's ailing budget.

The deal enabled new floors for 18,000 square feet of sports courts. Original floors were installed for La Sierra High School students of the 1950s. San Juan School District shuttered the school in 1983 and Carmichael Park District has since administered its amenities for public use. Hundreds of basketball, volleyball and pickle ball players regularly use the

gyms and 60-plus years of thumping feet inevitably took their toll. Floor replacement was completed over three-months this summer. The project included new electronic controls for basketball hoop backboards. Beyond the La Sierra work, T-Mobile cash will assist other district projects.

"We could not have afforded these improvements without the sale of the lease," said CRPD Administrator Tarry Smith. "The recent loss of new funding opportunities (resulting from a legal challenge to the property-owner approved 2014 special assessment), has curtailed many potential CRPD projects. We must now be creative with finding ways to pay for improvements. Selling the tower lease was a step in that direction"

Supervisor Susan Peters joined park district directors and 80 supporters to

applaud the gymnasiums' reopening. Festivities included a ribbon cutting and exhibition games.

Ag Overtime Law Will Hurt Family Farms and Farm Workers

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Governor Brown signed Assembly Bill 1066 (D-Gonzalez), on September 12th, 2016, a measure that will require farmers to pay overtime after eight hours or 40 hours per week. Vice Chair of the Senate Budget Committee Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Gerber), a life-long farmer and advocate, issued the following statement: "Last year's agriculture production was down from the previous year*. Farmers continue to suffer from the historic drought and ongoing burdens of the state's regulations. "It is inarguable that this new mandate will have significant negative impacts on farmers and farm workers.

"Farmers, ranchers and growers cannot afford this mandate. To keep their family farms in operation, they will hire one crew for eight hours or less; and a second crew for another.

"Farm workers will end up working for one farm in the morning, getting back in their cars to drive to another farm to work the afternoon shift.

"I am disappointed at the insensitivity to this vital industry. And sadly I say, stay tuned for loss in salary for workers and higher prices for consumers."

*This first set of data indicates that production value fell by \$9.5 billion, or nearly 17 percent compared to 2014, to a total of \$47,071,513,000 as stated in an August 30 report by the California Department of Food and Agriculture.

Westmoreland earned a Master of Arts degree in organizational management from the University of Phoenix.

This position does not require Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$110,028. Westmoreland is a Republican. ★

Mountain Man Climbs Final Peak

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Community leader and born-again mountain man Ron Cuppy died last month. The former Carmichael Park District Administrator and historian was 73 years old.

Iowa-raised Cuppy joined the district in 1976. In 30 years, his efforts spurred many district achievements. When La Sierra High School was closed in 1983, Cuppy worked with the County to garner the Engle Road property for community use. Today, the campus serves as an arts, sports and recreation center. July 4 fireworks light up its playing field; the auditorium is Carmichael town hall. Vital to CRPD finances, part

of the campus is leased to the California Montessori Project.

With community supporters, the administrator helped acquire Jensen Botanical Gardens as a Carmichael treasure. He also finessed a 1989 deal with developer Danny Benvenuti; as a result, Garfield House (adjacent to Jensen Gardens) entered the district fold and Glancy Oaks Park was developed. "We had some slim budget years," recalls a Cuppy staffer. "Ron was never discouraged. He had a skill for creative solutions."

When not in coat and tie for the district, he lived passionately in the past. Sporting coyote hat and fringed breeches as "One Dog Hawk," the park boss escaped civic pressures. "Chief Angus

Seamus McCrae" - a Celtic tribesman -- was Cuppy's second alter-ego. "Ron felt he'd lived before," considered his partner of 14 years, Debra Henningsen. "He was comfortable as a mountain man or Scottish chief. He felt he'd been there before."

Though he'd served the Marine Corps as an ammunition specialist in the 1960s, his later preference was antique weaponry. Cuppy packed a shotgun for the American River Muzzle Loaders and, with powder horn and axe, was dressed to dozent at Sutters Fort. He was claymored and killed for ancient Scottish reenactments. Earlier this year, the man for all centuries was knighted by the American Medieval Combat Federation.

Cuppy and his "Lady Debra" were distinctive in costume on Founders Days; they also educated youth groups about trappers who forged westward in the 18th and 19th centuries. "Ron had a passion for service," considered a veteran of Cuppy's CPRD administration. "This went beyond his park district career. The talks he did for schools were part of his mission to educate. He wanted his work to have lasting value."

A celebration of Ron Cuppy's life will be hosted at the La Sierra Community service this Saturday, September 17. In lieu of flowers, supporters are asked to donate to a Go-Fund-Me family fund. For information, call (916) 485-5322. ★

DWR Seeks Proposals for Habitat Restoration Projects

First-of-its-Kind Request for Proposal Invites Non-Governmental Participation

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - In an effort to quicken the pace of habitat restoration in California's biggest estuary, the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) recently invited private companies, non-profit groups and individuals to submit proposals to create wetlands in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta.

Through a first-of-its-kind Request for Proposal (RFP), DWR seeks partners to help fulfill its obligations under the U.S. Endangered Species Act. At the direction of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the National Marine Fisheries Service, DWR must restore or create 8,000 acres of tidal habitat to benefit Delta smelt and another 800 acres for long-fin smelt, plus 17,000 acres to 20,000 acres of seasonal floodplain to benefit juvenile winter-run chinook salmon, spring-run salmon and Central Valley steelhead. Projects to fulfill these obligations also could help meet DWR's restoration responsibilities under the California Endangered Species Act.

These projects will advance California EcoRestore, a program to fulfill Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr.'s direction to State agencies to begin restoration of at least 30,000 acres in the Delta over the next five years. In addition, the Brown Administration's

five-year Water Action Plan calls for restoration of important ecosystems.

DWR will weigh proposals received through the RFP process and enter into agreements with the proponents of acceptable projects. These may be private companies, non-profit groups, individuals, or a combination of such. Respondents to the RFP must demonstrate control of property desirable for habitat restoration. Proposals will be judged competitively based on factors that include location, cost, site quality, site design, property characteristics and project schedule and readiness. Projects must be completed within five years.

"Our new Request for Proposal will help us harness the power of partnerships in a straightforward, transparent, efficient way," said Dean Messer, Chief of the DWR Division of Environmental Services and the Fish Restoration Program. "We want to maximize results and get large-scale tidal marsh wetland habitat restoration under way for the sake of native fishes."

The department is prepared to award contracts worth a total of \$42.5 million over the next five years for acceptable proposals. Proposals must be received by November 30, 2016. Find out more at SaveOurWater.com.

Community Information Meetings on Measure B

A special community meeting will be held in Carmichael on Thursday, October 6, to provide information about Measure B, the half-cent transportation sales tax proposal that will be on the November ballot which is expected to raise \$3.6 billion over 30 years to repave streets, repair aging roads and bridges, and fund new highway, connector and interchange projects as well as provide funding for Regional Transit.

Back to School? Learn About Tax Credits for Education

If you pay for college in 2016, you may receive some tax savings on your federal tax return, even if you're studying outside of the U.S. Both the American Opportunity Tax Credit and the Lifetime Learning Credit may reduce the amount of tax you owe, but only the AOTC is partially refundable.

Here are a few things you should know about education credits:

The American Opportunity Tax Credit is worth up to \$2,500 per year for an eligible student. This credit is available for the first four years of higher education. Forty percent of the AOTC is refundable. That means, if you're eligible, you can get up to \$1,000 of the credit as a refund, even if you do not owe any tax.

The Lifetime Learning Credit is worth up to \$2,000 per tax return. There is no limit on the number of years that you can

claim the LLC for an eligible student.

You may use only qualified expenses paid to figure your credit. These expenses include the costs you pay for tuition, fees and other related expenses for an eligible student to enroll at, or attend, an eligible educational institution. Refer to IRS.gov for more on the rules that apply to each credit.

Eligible educational institutions are those that offer education beyond high school. This includes most colleges and universities. Vocational schools or other postsecondary schools may also qualify. If you aren't sure if your school is eligible ask your school if it is an eligible educational institution, or see if your school is on the U.S. Department of Education's Accreditation database.

In most cases, you should receive Form 1098-T, Tuition

Statement, from your school by February 1. This form reports your qualified expenses to the IRS and to you. The amounts shown on the form may be either: (1) the amount you paid for qualified tuition and related expenses, or (2) the amount that your school billed for qualified tuition and related expenses; therefore, the amounts shown on the form may be different than the amounts you actually paid. Don't forget that you can only claim an education credit for the qualified tuition and related expenses that you paid in the tax year and not just the amount that your school billed.

The education credits are subject to income limitations and may be reduced, or eliminated, based on your income.

To see if you're eligible to claim education credits, use the Interactive Tax Assistant tool on IRS.gov.

Head-On Collision Kills Both Drivers on Watt Ave

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - On September 11, 2016, at 9:55 p.m., a 50 year old male from Sacramento, was driving a, black Chevrolet pick-up s/b on Watt Ave., north of Marconi Ave., at a high rate of speed in the #1 lane. A white Ford Explorer driven by a 47 year old male from Sacramento, was in the #1 lane northbound on Watt Ave. The Explorer had two other passengers in the

vehicle all from the Sacramento area. The pick-up, per a witness, had a right rear tire go flat and the driver of the pick-up was unable to maintain control of his vehicle. The driver of the pick-up allowed the vehicle to cross over the raised median into the northbound lane of Watt Ave. The pick-up collided head on into the Explorer. The impact killed both drivers. 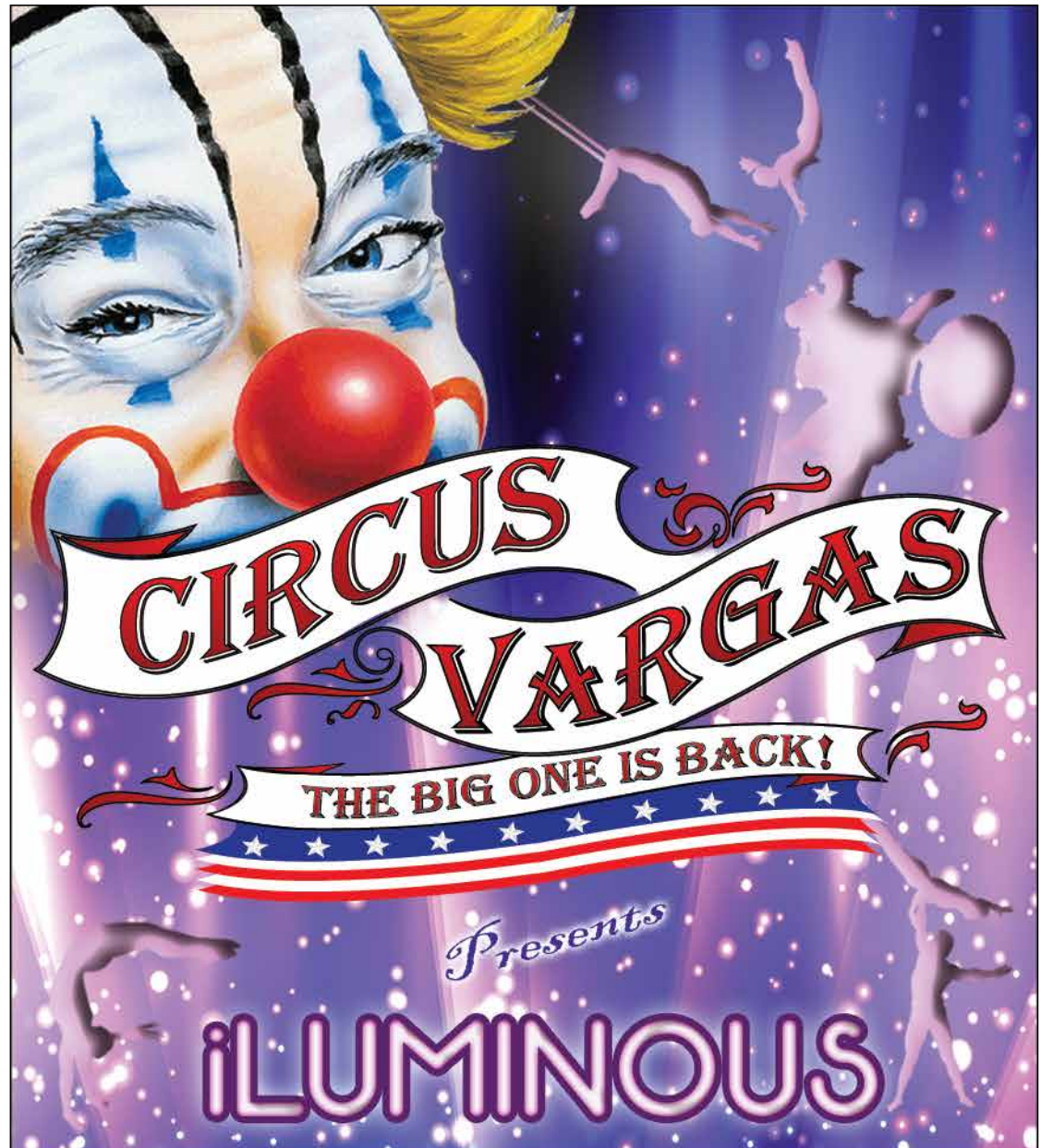
At this store you could buy a legal book that takes you step-by-step in qualifying to receive compensation for your disorder.

Clearly, the Fun Ship 2.0 upgrades Carnival Cruises has been making fleet-wide since 2011 are just a tease for something bigger and better. That something, the freshly christened, bar-raising Carnival Vista, comes to America in November.

Carnival's fun for all ages reputation is bolstered by new offerings for often underserved older teens and the cruise line's first-ever raft and watertubing adventure called Kaleid-O-Slide.

Industry Firsts: Carnival has found an innovative way to combine excitement with exercise with its brand-new, no extra cost SkyRide. Created by the founder of Rollerblade, it's like riding a bike, only you're pedaling while suspended on a rail above the deck. And the view! Breathtaking vistas are found inside the ship as well on the three-deck-high screen of the first IMAX at sea. The 187-seat IMAX, combined with the intimate Thrill Theater, a separate screen showing exhilarating multi-dimensional, shorter-length movies, makes the Vista the first nautical multiplex. Carnival marketing says the new Havana Cabana suites (for guests 12 and older) on Deck 5 will make you feel like you're staying on an island resort. Believe the hype. The sense of going tropical is complements of special décor, a private lanai and exclusive access to the

lively indoor-outdoor Havana Bar that serves complementary Cuban-style food during the day along with specialty coffees and cocktails.

Development Areas: For a new ship with the latest systems available, ventilation inside the casino is surprisingly poor. Exacerbating the problem is the inability to walk around the cloud of smoke when heading from the lobby to key food and entertainment venues on Deck 4. I can't recall

another megaship that doesn't have an alternative path to circumvent the gaming area. Also, opting against traditional stadium seating in favor of individual chairs, the design of the 1,400-seat Liquid Lounge where the big production shows are staged is problematic. Without stationary chairs, people were configuring rows that essentially created barricades, removed natural aisles and gave some folks no leg room — a potential fire hazard. Also, only the two back rows are tiered and fastened, so line of sight was lousy for all but the very tall and those in the first rows.

Bon Voyage: Carnival's new flagship will spend the remainder of her inaugural season cruising the Mediterranean before embarking on a 13-day repositioning voyage to New York on Oct. 21. With the ship's second cruise out of the Big Apple in November, Carnival Vista will arrive at her new home of Miami to offer year-round Caribbean sailings. For additional information, contact any travel agent, call 1-800-CARNIVAL or visit carnival.com.

Bottom Line: Overbrimming with novel features and others that improve on the familiar, Carnival Vista sets the bar for the company. Casino notwithstanding, the fleet's biggest and brightest is a breath of fresh air, and ranks among the best ships this frequent cruiser has sailed. ★

but if your heart is set on trying other fare, newer choices include Seafood Shack, serving up New England-style dishes for an upcharge at lunchtime. Dishes representing the region you just visited are part of nightly "Port of Call" specials in the main dining room, and not once did the fish or lamb selections disappoint. While the

EASTWOOD AND HANKS FLYING HIGH IN "SULLY" AVIATION DRAMA

winning ticket for a high-flying adventure that soon comes down to Earth and requires plenty of personal, troubling reflections and great moments of tension to sustain the approximate 90-minute running time.

The fateful day begins uneventfully at New York's LaGuardia airport, when the flight bound for Charlotte, North Carolina looks routine, even with three ecstatic late-arriving passengers excited to just barely get on the plane.

Speaking of the passengers, mostly ordinary folks traveling on business or to meet family, only a few are given just the slightest glimpse of any character, whether it's a mother with an infant or some elderly ladies.

Nothing much is asked of the passengers except for the constant command to "brace for impact" and to keep heads down during the landing. That all passengers were saved meant, of course, that nobody was left behind or froze to death during the water rescue.

Captain Sully was fortunate to have with him in the cockpit his co-pilot Jeff Skies (Aaron Eckhart), a looser, funnier guy who contrasted with Sully's more reserved, quieter demeanor but was fully in agreement with the split-second decisions that had to be made.

In fact, later on during the hearings before the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB), it was First Officer Skiles who corrected the inquiry about how a plane ended up "in" the Hudson River when he replied "On the Hudson."

Both Sullenberger and Skiles were in sync with the belief that the daring and unprecedented landing on the water was a "controlled landing" that offered only the best outcome given the limited options.

The fact that Captain Sully and his co-pilot remained cool and collected during crisis was a testament to their professionalism, though Sully later tells his wife Lorrie (Laura Linney) in a phone call that "I want you to know that I did the best I could."

Because the forced landing consumes only a matter of minutes, the tension has to be developed in other arenas, and a film like this could use a few "villains," so to speak, to drive the narrative that the harrowing experience had repercussions.

This tension is explored by the adversarial NTSB hearings in which lead investigator Charles Porter (Mike O'Malley) and panel members Ben Edwards (Jamey Sheridan) and Elizabeth Davis (Anna Gunn) insist that Sully had other options for an emergency landing.

The bureaucrats, naturally, question Sully's judgment during intense grilling and forcefully contend that flight simulators and computer analysis demonstrate that a landing could have been made at LaGuardia or even in New Jersey.

Holding their ground, Sullenberger and Skiles manage to poke large holes in the line of questioning. On a side note, the airline itself could not have been thrilled to lose an expensive aircraft to a watery grave.

Outside the hearing room, Sully has to cope with a number of predicaments, from self-doubt worries about whether he did the right thing to having nightmares about crash landing into Manhattan buildings in a vision reminiscent of the 9/11 horrors.

What we already know, that is now reaffirmed by Eastwood's skillful direction, is that Sullenberger and Skiles executed a successful water landing that created a national hero in the airline's captain and "Sully" celebrates the valor and courage.

Sure, we know the story, but "Sully" is a finely-tuned, nail-biting drama that shows that a good result can come from a bad situation, while also portraying the heroic efforts of first responders who accomplished the rescue of everyone within 24 minutes. ★

SULLY (Rated PG-13)

The famous "Miracle on the Hudson" landing of disabled US Airways Flight 1549 on a cold day in January 2009 in the frigid waters of New York's Hudson River dominated the news cycle for many days and to this day remains etched in the public memory.

An instant hero was created in Captain Chesley "Sully" Sullenberger, the veteran airline captain who piloted the Airbus A320 after its engines had been taken out at the low altitude of 2,800 feet by a flock of geese.

Captain Sullenberger, a self-effacing Everyman, thought of himself as a man just trying to do his job while keeping his wits about him to save the lives of the 155 passengers and crew members onboard the crippled aircraft.

The ordeal unfolded during a period of 208 seconds and the challenge for the movie "Sully" was to turn the events of a short, yet terrifying white-knuckle ride into a full length feature film with plenty of drama.

It's difficult to imagine any current actor better suited to playing the role of the titular character than Tom Hanks, a modern-day Jimmy Stewart who can pull off the essential Everyman character that "Sully" demands.

For his part, Clint Eastwood as the director of "Sully" knows his way around searing real-life drama, something he proved most recently with "American Sniper," a film that received six Oscar nominations, including for Best Picture.

The combination of Tom Hanks and Clint Eastwood is the

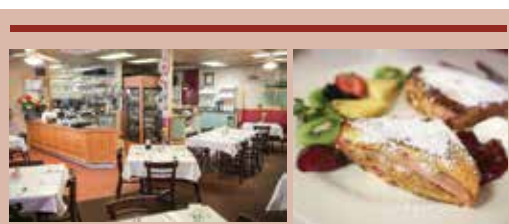

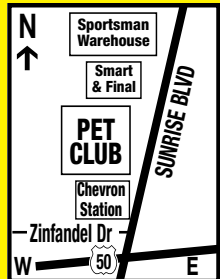

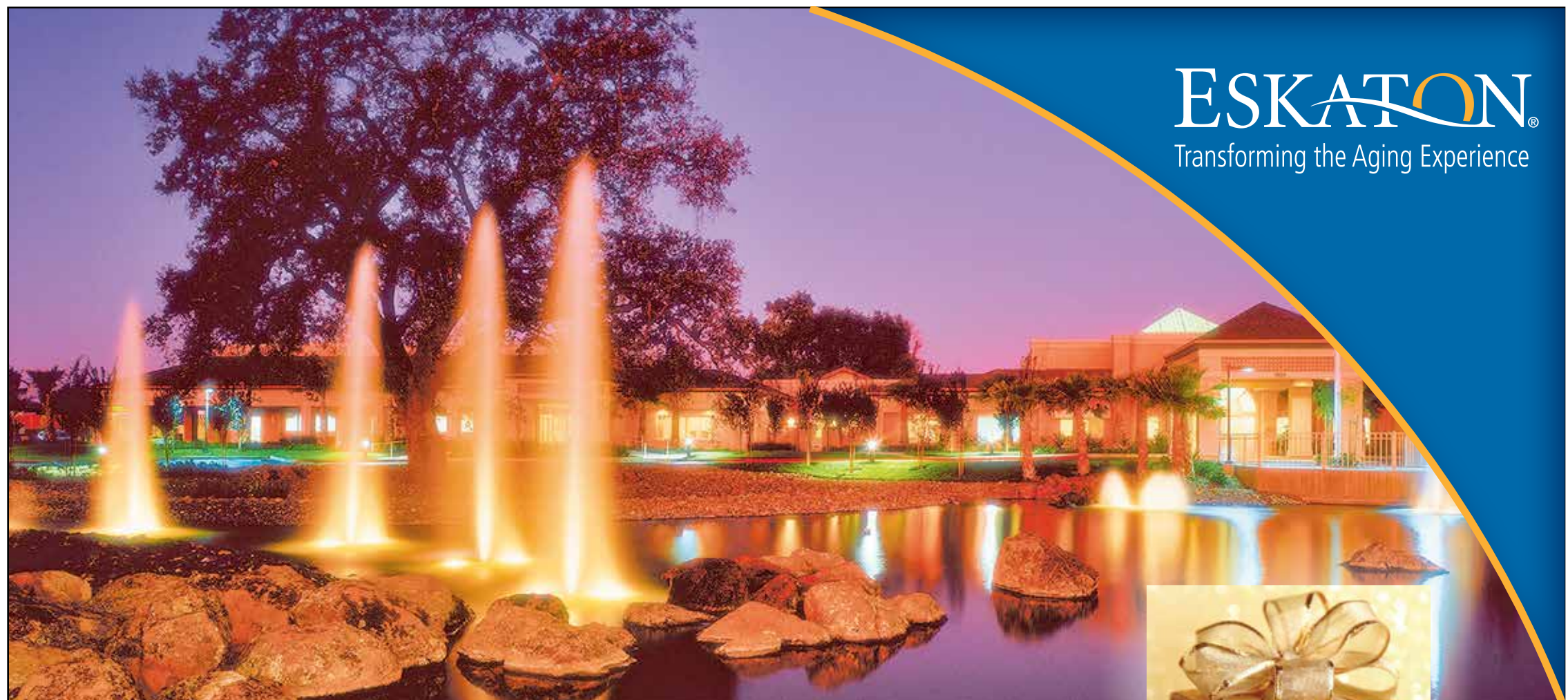
