Streets. Tell your friends as this is going to Doing Nothing is Not a Solution

Commentary by the Carmichael **PBID Committee**

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Fed up with homeless encampments, vandalism, panhandling, graffiti and other messes, a group of Carmichael businesses is trying to form an organization to tax themselves to pay for fixes including private security.

"I've been on this street almost all the time since 1972 and it's just gotten worse," said Gary Hursh, an attorney and chair of the steering committee for the project. "Just this week, I rousted four homeless people sleeping behind my building," he added.

The avenue by which Hursh and others seek to achieve a turnaround is a "Property Business Improvement District" covering Fair Oaks Boulevard from El Camino Avenue to east of California Avenue, plus a spur to the Bel Air-Safeway commercial hub at Manzanita and Cypress avenues. It would cover 350 parcels

on 380 acres. Such "PBID" arrangements have formed elsewhere including Fulton Avenue, Watt Avenue north of Auburn Boulevard and Mack Road.

As problems have eased at those, nuisances have migrated to other communities including Carmichael, Hursh said. "I've watched this situation continually deteriorate. Doing nothing is not a solution," he added, noting that the new entity would take over responsibilities the county is unable to finance.

"This idea for Carmichael is the right solution at the right time," added Allan Davis, developer of the new Milagro Center.

The steering committee, an offshoot of Carmichael Chamber of Commerce, is collecting signatures from owners who hold more than 50% of the assessed value of the designated properties. The next step is clearance from the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors, tentatively on Oct. 18. If supervisors approve, there would be an election among the property owners to back up the original petition. If that is successful, a non-profit corporation and a board of directors would be created to administer the assessment district. It would hire security and other firms to carry out the group's goals. The aim, said Hursh, is to

be ready to go early next year. Proposed assessments vary by property usage and would bring in about \$300,000 the first year. About half would go to hiring private security to supplement sheriff's deputies tied up on more critical calls. Another 30 per cent might go to economic development such as filling empty stores or lots.

Besides businesses, the tax topping out at 2 cents per square foot - would apply to a handful of other uses including apartments, churches. Carmichael Park and utility substations. No homes would be assessed.

Under state law, a PBID sunsets after five years and owners would have to vote again to extend it. Hursh said experience has shown some business owners may be reluctant to tax themselves at first but are more supportive at renewal time. "They see the benefits," he

Domestic Violence Shelter Funding Extensions Signed by Brown

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Governor signed two bills strongly supported by the Chairwoman of the California State Board of Equalization (BOE) Fiona Ma, CPA, to help victims of domestic violence and businesses devastated by natural disasters.

AB 1559 (Baker) will create a checkoff box on California personal income tax return forms which will allow Californian's to donate to the newly created Domestic Violence Victims Fund. Domestic violence shelters

will be able to apply for a grant from the new fund, administered by the California Office of Emergency Services, to help provide much-needed assistance to victims.

According to the National Network to End Domestic Violence (NNEDV), nearly one-third of all women murdered in the United States in recent years were murdered by a current or former intimate partner. In 2010, 1,017 women, more than three a day, were killed by their intimate partners. A survivor's safety and well-being is most at risk during episodes of violence and when attempting to leave an abuser. Domestic violence shelters are a key part of safety planning to prepare ahead of time and be as protected as possible.

"Women and children who have endured physical, mental, and emotional abuse need our help putting their lives back on track. AB 1599 (Baker) will help keep the shelter doors open and provide a place where women and children can sleep soundly, without fear," said Chairwoman Ma.

During her six year tenure in the Legislature, Chairwoman Ma served as Chair of the Domestic Violence Select Committee and witnessed how many California domestic violence shelters were forced to turn away women and children because of a lack of funding. In 2013 NNEDV conducted a 24-hour survey of domestic violence programs across the nation and reported 66,581 adults and children had found refuge and assistance, while an additional 9,641 requests for services were unmet because of a lack of resources. Each one of those unmet requests is another lost opportunity to break the cycle of violence. Now that Governor Brown has signed AB 1399 (Baker), shelters will receive greatly needed financial resources.

"California business owners who have been severely impacted by natural disasters are focusing on the recovery of their business, which will affect their ability to file and pay their taxes," said Chairwoman Ma.

"The Board of Equalization can now grant tax relief to countless businesses across the state that have been impacted by natural disasters. I'd like to thank Governor Jerry Brown for recognizing the urgency of this bill and acknowledging that California needs to do more to assist victims in the recovery process," said Assemblymember Bill Dodd. ★





SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (PRWEB) - Eskaton's No Falls League recently got out on the football field and recorded a video for National Falls Prevention Awareness Day, coming September 22, 2016. The video, "Ready Steady Balance," was named after the National Council on Aging's 2016 initiative. Eskaton developed the video to highlight efforts in providing resources and programs to transform the aging experience while supporting larger efforts to reduce the number of falls. In the video, Eskaton's Fall Prevention Team shows their peers how to have fun while exercising and prevent falls.

"We take a fun and new approach to teaching fall prevention, which can help reduce the number of falls each year," said Eskaton Fitness and Wellness Coordinator Christy Barry. "The specially designed fall prevention exercises help strengthen muscles, improve coordination, and build faster reaction times, just in case you do lose your balance."

The No Falls League, comprised of Eskaton's independent living residents, are seniors aged 67 to 95, wearing football jerseys reflecting their age. Led by Barry, the seniors in the video demonstrate several exercises showing how easy it is to improve balance and strength, helping to reduce fall risk. Low-impact exercises include knee lifts, weight shifting, shoulder rolls, overhead arm reach, arm reach across the chest and more. 





It's not what you do for yourself that has the greatest impact, rather it's what you do for others that really matters. You can get whatever you want in life by helping enough other people get what they want.

Although this concept has been proven time and time again throughout history, many people take the opposite approach by focusing on what they can do for themselves. They have an attitude of "what's in it for me," and "what can I get," when deciding on a course to take.

To illustrate this principle, let's look at a prospective employee at a job interview. The candidate is concerned about pay, benefits, and vacation time. Although these issues are relevant, they have no bearing on the person's suitability for the position. A job offer will only be made to someone who can best solve an employer's problems.

A successful candidate utilizes their interview to expound on how much they can be of service to the employer. When the employer wants what the candidate has to offer, they respond by offering something in return; salary and benefits.

For another example, consider Linda and Bob, two employees looking for a promotion. Bob feels that his obligation is to perform only the work he is being paid for. He reasons that if his employer become cynical, thinking their © 2011 Bryan Golden.

wants him to do more work and take on additional responsibilities, they should first give him a raise and promotion. Bob decides how much he will do based on how much he's getting.

Linda on the other hand, always does more than she is being paid for. She looks for work that needs to be done without being asked and is always willing to assume more responsibility. Linda does as much as she can without worrying about how much she is getting.

Most employers would readily promote Linda over Bob. Even if Linda doesn't get a promotion with her current employer, she will get one with another. It's what you do for others that determines what you get in return.

Successful businesses are the ones that do more for their customers and employees than is expected. Customers are thrilled when they feel as if they are getting more than their money's worth. They are more likely to return to a business that treats them well.

Employees work harder for, and stay longer with employers where they are respected and appreciated. The principle is universal. What you receive is based on what you give.

This cause and effect doesn't always work immediately. There's no way to know how long it will take. Some people

efforts are going unrewarded. Their response is to cut back on what they give until they receive what they want. This is a self-defeating strategy that is doomed to fail.

Giving always precedes getting. However, you must give without expectation of receiving something in return. This concept goes against our conditioning. It requires a lot of faith. If you have trouble with this approach, look at it from a different perspective.

Since giving with strings attached is proven to fail, you have nothing to lose by taking the opposite approach; giving without expectation. Although it may feel uncomfortable at first, give it a try. As you experience more successes, it will become a more natural option for you.

Look for opportunities to be of service. Let go of the need to receive something in return. This does not mean allowing people to take advantage of you. Rather, it's a change in your outlook. Give more to get more. Try it, it does work.

The Honorable Steve White sentenced Love Davis Jr. to 57 years to life in prison. On June 30, 2016, a jury convicted Davis of carjacking and evading an officer with willful disregard.

On March 24, 2015, Davis accosted a 58-yearold woman and pushed her away from her car, which was parked at a gas station on Auburn Blvd. and Watt Ave. The victim struggled with Davis, but Davis jumped into her car and drove away, dragging the victim several feet on the pavement. Soon after, Davis was spotted by the California Highway Patrol. A pursuit began that lasted nearly an hour and covered four counties, including Sacramento, Placer, Yolo, and Sonoma. Davis drove nearly 110 mph, drove the wrong way, ignored stop signs and stop lights, passed on the shoulder and center divider, wove in and out of traffic, and finally crashed into the concrete median near the intersection of 65th and Highway 50. He was arrested and positively identified by the victim.

Davis' criminal history includes two prior strike convictions for robbery and first-degree burglary. He also has multiple past convictions for possession of stolen cars, evading police, theft, resisting arrest, possession of stolen property, possession of tear gas, and possession of meth in prison.

DATE: September 9, 2016

CASE: Palmer Beverly & Antoine Fulbright (Case #15F05769)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Samuel Alexander, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit Palmer Beverly was convicted by a jury of three counts of residential burglary and two counts of being a felon in possession of a firearm. Antoine Fulbright was convicted of one count of residential burglary.

Between September 8, 2015 and September 17, 2015, three burglaries occurred in the South Land Park and Pocket areas of Sacramento. Witnesses obtained a partial license plate number, which was traced to a Rancho Cordova

address and the arrest of Beverly. During a search of that residence, property from all three burglaries was found along with two firearms. Fulbright was arrested when he was found near the residence with some of the stolen property in his possession. Shoe prints from one of the burglaries matched the shoes worn by Beverly and Fulbright on the day they were arrested.

Beverly's criminal history includes two prior strikes for residential burglary, receiving stolen property, grand theft from person, and possessing a knife while incarcerated. Fulbright's criminal history includes two prior strikes for residential burglary and robbery, second-degree burglary, vandalism, and possession of a controlled substance.

Beverly faces a maximum potential sentence of 31 years and 4 months in prison. Fulbright faces a maximum potential sentence of 25 years in prison. Both defendants will be sentenced on October 14, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. in Department 16 before the Honorable Marjorie Koller.

DATE: September 16, 2016

CASE: Joshua Vasquez (Case # 15F07111) **PROSECUTOR:** Deputy District Attorney Nancy Cochrane, Special Assault & Child Abuse

Joshua Vasquez pled guilty to 6 counts of committing lewd acts upon a child involving six separate victims.

Vasquez was employed by the Sacramento City Unified School District in an after school program, where he developed friendships with all of the victims. The victims ranged in age from 7 to 13 years old. While on school grounds, Vasquez took the children into his classroom, locked the door, and blindfolded them while he played different "games" with them. The games included the "cool whip," juice," and "treasure chest" game, which were all designed to have the children touch Vasquez's genitals in a number of ways. Vasquez recorded these acts of lewd and lascivious conduct with the children.

Vasquez will be sentenced to 150 years to life in prison. Sentencing is scheduled for October 28, 2016, at 10:30 a.m. in Department 11 by the Honorable Trena Burger-Plavan.

For Democrats, First Amendment Rights Stop at Climate Change

Democrats' grand plan for this election year doesn't seem to include free speech. The group that drafted the Democratic Party platform recently called for the Justice Department to prosecute energy companies that don't agree with Democrats on climate change.

But is that wise? If the government is allowed to punish those who merely question climate change, it should also be allowed to punish climate alarmists for false doomsday predictions.

That reasoning doesn't make sense. Democrats should end their crusade before they start feeling the brunt of their own logic.

Unfortunately, silencing climate dissenters with laws didn't start with the DNC platform. It's part of a growing trend.

Twenty state attorney generals nationwide have started investigating oil companies. The AGs allege that to maintain high profits, Big Oil purposely misled investors and the public about climate change consequences.

Right- and libertarian-leaning policy centers -- such as the Heartland Institute and Competitive Enterprise Institute -- are also facing scrutiny. My employer, the National Center for Public Policy Research was even targeted on the Senate floor. The green crusaders claim we were all accomplices in

helping oil companies obscure environmental threats.

Meanwhile, Attorney General Loretta Lynch recently acknowledged that the Justice Department may use a federal law originally created to fight organized crime to prosecute climate skeptics. In the Obama administration's distorted reality, the analogy isn't much of a stretch

Ironically, the state AGs unveiled their crusade at a press conference in March with former vice president and climate Svengali Al Gore. Gore, who predicted that the North Pole would be ice-free by 2013, has repeatedly cried wolf about the coming environmental apocalypse -- while snatching millions by promoting dubious green investments.

But what's to stop a newly formed league of climate-agnostic attorneys general, emboldened by the strategies of their green colleagues, from prosecuting those like Gore who have become rich off doomsday predictions?

Gore isn't alone. In 2008, ABC News predicted that because of climate change, New York City would be submerged by 2015. Concurrently, the United Nations warned that there were only eight years left to prevent a "dangerous" rise in global temperatures.

In 2007, the head of the organization's Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change cautioned that it would be "too

late" by 2012 without immediate global action. Previously, the UN warned that global warming was about to usher in a huge period of population disruption, creating 50 million climate refugees by 2010.

These are just a smattering of inaccurate predictions from environmentalists. Some utilized flawed models. Some were propaganda to influence public opinion and legislation. Others just wanted to get rich off government-subsidies for green technology.

Those motives are no better than the ones said to be driving oil companies. Were the tables turned and green zealots held accountable for misleading the public, many of the prosecutors would be the prosecuted.

Realistically, investigations like the one the state AGs are now pursuing are about harassing political opponents -- not protecting the public.

The investigation into these oil companies and think tanks is a flagrant attempt to bypass the Constitution and stifle political speech. It should be opposed regardless of their stance on climate change. It's shameful that a major political party has so little regard for free speech.


