# May I Have This Dog?

## 107th Founders Day Offers Tu-Tu Much Fun

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - Carmichael marks its 107th anniversary on Saturday, September 24. A day-long festival in Carmichael Park commemorates the historic 1909 venture of town founder Daniel Carmichael. In the colony he named for himself, the businessman sold 10-acre farmlets for an average price of \$1000.

In contrast, anniversary celebrations are free to the public. Live music, dancing, children's activities and a vendor fair will form a festive hub at the North Avenue end of the park. A classic car show will be installed at the Grant Avenue corner.

In keeping with the park's dog-friendly fame, a master-and-mutt dance contest is part of morning events. In divisions for small and large dogs, contestants will demonstrate their footwork. Owners who prefer to slow-dance with pet-in-arms are equally welcome. Efforts at choreography may garner extra judges' points. Costumes are encouraged but not required. Contestants should register beside the band shell at 10:45 am. All dogs - and owners -- must be on-leash.

Caporting canines aside, the anniversary promises a variety of additional fun. A pancake breakfast will be served at the park's clubhouse (5750 Grant Avenue) from 8:30 am as a fundraiser for the fair oaks Lions Club. At 10 am, opening ceremonies will raise the band shell flag. John Skinner's Band follows with a concert and dancing. More music is promised by the Dave Russell Band at 12:30 p.m.

Children's activities will include carnival games, bounce houses, a petting zoo and a visit from firefighters. Food will be provided by food trucks. Anyone may attend Founders day. ## Water District Begins Restoration Activities

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - As part of the American River Pipeline Project, Carmichael Water District (District) will begin environmental restoration activities in the American River Parkway and waterway in September to reduce the presence of abandoned facilities. This work includes the removal of concrete debris from the southerly side of the American River and removal of an existing 33-inch steel water pipeline crossing the river. The work will be completed in stages, including the removal of the pipe, beginning September 13, 2016 starting in the early morning and continuing through approximately 2:00 PM. As a safety precaution the river flow during this period may be reduced from approximately 1,500 cubic feet per second (cfs) to 1,000 cfs.

Temporary restrictions on watercraft launching from American River parkway will be in place on Tuesday, September 13, 2016 beginning at dawn and continuing until approximately 1:00 PM. The restrictions will include watercraft launching at Rossmoor Bar and all upstream access points.

# CDPH Urges New Tuberculosis Screening Recommendations

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Director and State Health Officer Dr. Karen Smith has urged health care providers to adopt new recommendations recently announced by the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force calling for adults 18 years of age or older who are at increased risk of tuberculosis (TB) to be screened for the disease.

Those considered to be at increased risk of TB include individuals born in countries with elevated rates of the disease and individuals who live in settings with a large number of people, like group homes or homeless shelters.

“I urge health care providers in the state to adopt these new screening recommendations as quickly as possible,” said Dr. Smith. “Local health departments should work with providers to ensure that today’s new recommendations are implemented. Today’s recommendations, if universally adopted, can help us eliminate TB in California in the next few decades.”

Evidence shows that screening of individuals at increased risk for TB is an effective method for preventing the development of TB disease.

TB is a disease caused by bacteria called Mycobacterium tuberculosis. The bacteria usually attack the lungs but can also attack any part of the body such as the kidney, spine and

brain. It can be spread through the air from one person to another by coughing, sneezing or speaking.

When TB bacteria actively grow in people and cause symptoms, the condition is known as TB disease and can be deadly. People with TB disease can infect others. The bacteria can also be inactive, causing no symptoms and held in check by the immune system. This condition is known as latent TB.

Elimination of TB in California is possible by detecting and treating latent TB infection before it progresses to infectious TB disease.

In California, an estimated 2.4 million people have latent TB infection. In 2015, 2,137 people were diagnosed with TB disease in the state.

Health care providers can consult with their local health departments to develop specific plans for screening their patient populations. The CDPH Tuberculosis Control Branch provides technical assistance to local health departments and health plans to implement tuberculosis prevention efforts.

CDPH has developed the California Risk Assessment Screening Tool to help health care providers to quickly identify people at risk for developing the disease and also a fact sheet that offers suggested courses of treatment.

**CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG)** - Phil Horn (Vice President, Ticket Sales and Service, Sacramento Kings) visited the Carmichael Chamber of Commerce August luncheon to provide the Carmichael business community an update on the Golden 1 Center and surrounding incoming attractions.

Phil Horn shared an update on the Golden 1 Center and entertainment offerings found inside and outside the center. The arena will have 17,500 seats, which is roughly the same seat count at the Sacramento Kings previous home stadium the Sleep Train Arena. The Golden 1 Center is said to provide its guests the ultimate arena experience. Totalling over 30 feet long, a center-hung video board will hover above the basketball court, running from basket to basket. The video board is intended to provide optimal viewing from every seat. As Phil explained, the food and beverage offerings will break any existing stereotype of arena cuisine. 90 percent of all food and beverage concessions from farms with environmentally-friendly business practices within a 150-mile radius of the arena. Sierra Nevada is a new partner with the Sacramento Kings and will open



Sierra Nevada Draught House, which will have a premium view of all events.

Designed with a smaller upper section and consolidated seats into the lower level, the Golden 1 Center was designed with the visitor in mind. The glass roof is modeled after an airplane hangar door, which will blur the line between outside and inside. Phil explained that the goal of the open air concept is to bring the delta breeze into the arena and allow guests who are outside the arena to enjoy the live event as well.

Sacramento Kings games will carry a dynamic pricing schedule, higher demand = higher price, lower demand = lower price. Phil assured the group that the pricing is only marginally higher than it was at Sleep Train Arena. With over 150 events a year at the center there truly is an event for every visitor! Concerts

begin early October with Paul McCartney performing October 4-5. Opening night of the Sacramento Kings is October 27. Other events joining the Golden 1 Center are NCAA tournaments, Disney On Ice, Cirque du Soleil and more! To see the full schedule of events, visit <http://www.golden1center.com/events/>.

The Downtown Commons (DOCO Sacramento) has named partnerships with the Kimpton hotels, Punch Bowl Social, Pour Society an American Pub, and Sauced BBQ & Spirits. Pour Society is a modern interpretation of a classic American pub. Sauced BBQ & Spirits provides their guests a southern-inspired restaurant concept with modern flavor and design. The Downtown Commons will stand with 630,000 square feet of retail, restaurants, and cinema.

# Sikhs Host Historic Forum with CA Legislators and Civic Leaders

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - The American Sikh Public Affairs Association (ASPAA) hosted two groundbreaking events featuring state lawmakers, local elected officials, and Sikh civic leaders from across California. A noon program at the State Capitol offered legislators and their staff an opportunity to learn more about their Sikh constituents and a dinner program with close to three-hundred guests highlighted the accomplishments and goals of the American Sikh community.

The evening program entitled, "Inaugural Civic Engagement Dinner" held at the Mirage Banquet Hall in Sacramento, featured keynote presentations from Sacramento Mayor-Elect Darrell Steinberg and Republican National Committeewoman Harmeet Kaur Dhillon. Mayor-Elect Steinberg offered encouraging remarks on the accomplishments of Sikh leaders in California. "It is efforts like the American Sikh Public Affairs Association that help break down the barriers and uplift the young men and women in our communities," said Steinberg, who will succeed Sacramento Mayor Kevin Johnson in December of 2016.

Additional congratulatory comments were offered by Assemblymember Jim Cooper, Sacramento Sheriff Scott Jones, Former Assemblymember Mariko Yamada, State Senator Ted Gaines, and a representative for Assemblymember Susan Eggman.

Republican National Committeewoman Harmeet Kaur Dhillon's remarks emphasized the importance of Sikh leaders in all levels of civic leadership from the local planning commission to running for political office. Dhillon herself ran for State Assembly, she previously

served as Chairwoman of the San Francisco Republican Party, and was the first female Vice Chair of the California Republican Party. Today, she serves as the RNC National Committeewoman and made international headlines by offering Sikh prayers at the 2016 Republican National Convention in Cleveland.

Other elected guests at the Civic Dinner included Assemblymembers Kevin McCarty and James Gallagher, Sacramento District Attorney Anne Marie Schubert, and Elk Grove City Councilman Steve Detrick.

A slideshow showcasing the one-hundred year history of Sikhs in American public life was delivered by ASPAA board member Bhajan Singh. "It is important for this next generation to understand the challenges our parents have overcome to establish their

identity as both Americans and Sikh," said Singh. The slideshow and event program featured information commemorating Dalip Singh Saund; the first Indian, first Asian, and first Sikh Congressman elected in 1957, and Bhagat Singh Thind; who challenged American citizenship laws that barred Indian immigrants.

ASPAA proudly introduced a large list of Sikh civic leader from throughout California including Preet Didbal, Yuba City Council Member; Kash Gill, Yuba City Council Member; Amarpreet Dhaliwal, San Joaquin Mayor; Parveen Tumber, West Sacramento Planning Commissioner; Mandeep Grewal, Modesto City Council Member; Gary Singh, Manteca City Council Candidate; Sarb Takhar, Chair of the Sutter County Republican Party; Mikey Hothi, California Democratic Party Delegate;

and Amar Shergill, California Democratic Party Delegate.

Community leaders from other faith organizations also joined the event including Jon Fish from the Sacramento County Interfaith Council, Basim Elkarrar from the Council on American Islamic Relations (CAIR), and Father Joshua Lickter from the Anglican Church in North America. Dr. Tom and Felicia Bhe were introduced as the organization noted its gratitude for the leadership of the Asian Pacific Islander American Public Affairs Association and the Organization of Chinese Americans.

Closing remarks were offered by Darshan Mundy, ASPAA board member and public relations officer for the West Sacramento Gurdwara Sahib, who thanked the event's attendees and sponsors for their generous contributions to the

association. Earlier that day at the State Capitol, ASPAA hosted a seminar at the California State Capitol with the office of Assemblymember Jim Cooper. Asm. Cooper has remained a strong ally of the Sikh community after leading an effort that led to California's recognition of the 1984 Genocide against the Sikh community in Punjab, India. His district office is also led by the only Sikh district director in the State Assembly, Mikey Singh Hothi. Hothi helped facilitate the capitol event which featured Assemblymember Cooper and guest speakers Amar Shergill from the American Sikh Public Affairs Association, Winty Singh of the Sikh Coalition, and Deep Singh from Jakarta, a Sikh youth organization.

"This Sikh seminar is the first of its kind," says Amar Shergill, "It is the first step in truly embracing California's diversity and empowering minority communities like the Sikhs in the legislative process." Shergill, who serves as a board member for ASPAA is also a delegate for the California Democratic Party and hopes to partner with legislators to create Capitol internships and voter registration programs that engage the Sikh community in the civic process.

## County Budget Balances Reinvestment, Fiscal Stability

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - During final budget hearings on September 7th, the Board of Supervisors reviewed and approved the Adopted Budget Documents for Fiscal Year 2016-17.

"The nearly \$4B budget, including \$2.4B in General Fund, is a good balance between investing in critical Health and Human Services and shoring up fiscal stability," said Chair of the Board Roberta MacGlashan. "We're also making a much needed General Fund investment of \$1.4 million towards a phased-in plan for improving roads in the unincorporated County."

The Health and Human Services areas slated for increased funding include Mental Health, Public Health, Child Protective Services, Alcohol and Drug Treatment, and Senior and Adult Services.

The fiscal stability funding includes meeting the Board's directive of placing 10 percent of the Available Fund Balance into a savings account for a rainy day, repaying transfers made at the height of the recession, and setting aside funds for major projects required in the coming years, including the mandated replacement of the Voter Registration IT system, and replacing the Assessor's Property Tax IT system.

"Funding for these investments comes from a variety of discretionary, federal and state funds," said County Executive Nav Gill. "In addition to putting aside prudent funds in reserves, we're making enhancements to key County services, including 72 positions in the Department of Health and Human Services, 40 of which are dedicated to Child Protective Services."

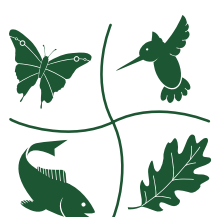

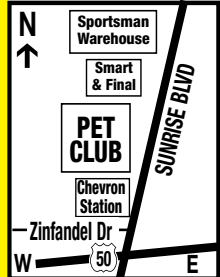

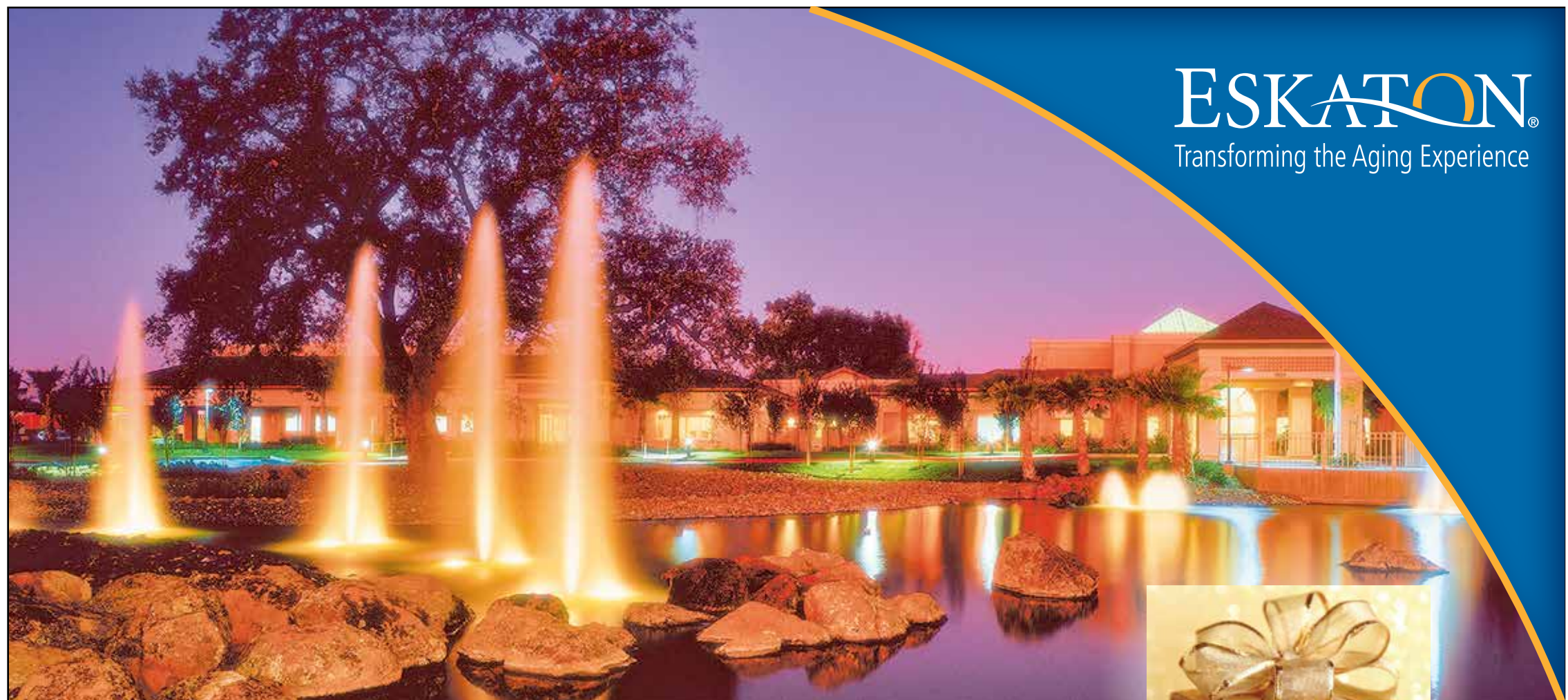
