### Expanding the Recall of P.F. Chang's Home Meals

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - ConAgra Foods is expanding a voluntary recall of P.F. Chang's Home Menu Brand products due to the potential presence of small metal fragments (2-9mm) in the sugar used in the sauce. This voluntary action is being undertaken because of impacted sugar from a supplier.

Foodborne foreign objects that are not hard and sharp and less than or equal to 7mm in length may cause minor injuries such as temporary reflexive choking and irritation of the gastrointestinal system. There have been no reports of adverse reactions or injuries due to consumption of these products to date.

An initial recall was issued on July 7, 2016 after a ConAgra employee observed metal fragments while dispensing sugar from a supplier for a P.F. Chang's Home Menu Brand sauce ingredient. On July 14, 2016, ConAgra Foods was notified by the supplier of additional production lots of sugar that were impacted, such that the initial recall needed to be expanded to include additional P.F. Chang's Home Menu Brand meals.

Products covered by this recall were distributed throughout the U.S. No other ConAgra Foods are impacted by this recall and these products are not served in P.F. Chang's restaurants. Meals in P.F. Chang's restaurants are made fresh every day and in every restaurant.

Consumers who have purchased these items are advised not to consume them and return them to the store where originally purchased. ConAgra Foods is cooperating with both the FDA and USDA on this recall and is working with customers to ensure the packages are removed from store shelves and are no longer distributed. ## Grants Expand Natural Gas Vehicle Use

From Sacramento County

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - To serve Sacramento County, a lot of ground needs to be covered. Whether it's our Department of Transportation, Waste Management and Recycling or our Sacramento International Airport, king-sized vehicles integral to our operations, such as dump trucks, waste collection trucks and shuttle buses, can be expensive to buy and fuel.

Kelli Sequest from the Department of Waste Management and Recycling, aware of the need for this vital equipment and the investment, jumped at the chance to apply for the Natural Gas Vehicle Incentive Project, a first-come-first-served competitive grant from the California Energy Commission's Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program (ARFVTP). Kelli also made sure other County departments were aware of these incentives

to reduce the purchase price of their department's natural gas vehicles.

"Thanks to the efforts of Kelli and other County staff, the County was awarded \$600,000. These funds were used toward the purchase


of new Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) vehicles for three County departments. Because CNG is a lower cost fuel and better for the environment, our goal is to transition all of our Department's fleet to alternative fuel vehicles," said Paul

Philleo, Department of Waste Management and Recycling Director.

Best fleet practices are always followed in managing the County's more than 2,300 vehicles and pieces of

# Taking a Final Bow

One of Northern California's most enduring bandleaders has taken his final bow.

Long-time Citrus Heights resident Buddy Harpham died last weekend. He was 94. Sax-player Harpham combined many jazz-age stereotypes. He was a dapper dresser; a favorite with the ladies; a dry wit; a prince on the dance floor. He was also a mentor to thousands of Northern Californian musicians. A life time of gigging, he often said, taught him "a thousand tunes." No one ever doubted him.

Though big band glory days are past, the fame of American treasures like Harpham prevails among those for whom Glenn Miller tunes brightened darkest WW II years. When hundreds of fans honored Harpham at the Carmichael Elks in 2009, they saluted a man who kept feet tapping for more than 70 years. It

also allowed brother musicians to cruise memory lane. They aired tales of lederhosen-clad October fests; jobs where sidemen forgot instruments and where singers forgot lyrics; train wrecks when amps exploded and horns were flattened in parking lots.

Veteran of more gigs than he could recall, Orval "Buddy" Harpham got his first horn as a gift from a sister when he was 13. At 14, he joined his Placer High School (Auburn) band and turned pro at 16. He studied music at Sacramento City College before marching with the US Navy Band during war years. When peace came, he continued directing Navy bandsmen in Washington DC and eventually completed his musical education at University of the Pacific (Stockton). Student Harpham roomed with legendary jazz pianist and life-long chum Dave Brubeck.

For the hip duo, practice was a daily discipline. Well into their 90s,

both noodled daily in separate cities. "You've got to do it if you want to stay good," Harpham advised his many students. In dance-crazy years that followed WW II, he toured with Jimmy Dorsey, Artie Shaw and Nelson Riddle's bands. The sideman's "legit" chops graced local symphonic woodwind sections but his own swing band, formed in 1955, became name ensemble for ritzy Northern California shindigs. As a day-gig, the bandleader taught at many Sacramento area schools and served the State as a music therapist. A staunch union man, he was a life member of the American Federation of Musicians and a long-time Local 12 director.

Harpham was never above gracing volunteer ensembles. He was a dedicated Carmichael Elk and a Shriner and, as Fair Oaks Boulevard tar melted each July 4, Harpham's baton conducted the Shriners' band float. He played Capitol Pops Concert Band shows until his 90th

year. "Sometimes my eyes water on outdoor gigs," he admitted. "It's hard to read the music. I wear magnifying glasses to make the notes twice as big."

Ballroom ensembles like Buddy Harpham's Big Band were on borrowed time from the day Elvis commanded pop culture. "Financially, the big band business is over," Harpham surmised a decade ago. "We can try to keep it alive culturally. The best music was written between the 1920s and 50s. Now musicians just holler and scream." Harpham's

musical philosophy nevertheless remains relevant: "There are two kinds of music; good and bad," he considered.

"I've always played good music and tried to do it right."

Buddy Harpham is survived by three children, one grandchild, two great grandchildren and his wife of seven years, Dolores. A service is planned for 1 pm on July 29 at the Carmichael Elks Lodge (5631 Cypress Ave. A reception and music will follow. Information: 489-2103. ★



# Help Reduce the Use

*Sacramento Suburban Water District Asks Customers to Help Reduce Water Use by 10 percent*

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)**

-Sacramento Suburban Water District (SSWD) is asking its customers to keep up the great work this summer and voluntarily reduce their water use by 10 percent and to follow District's recommended watering day schedule.

"Our customers did a fantastic job conserving water during the drought emergency, and reduced water use by nearly 30 percent from June 2015 to February 2016," said Greg Bundesen, SSWD Water Conservation Supervisor. "We're now asking them to continue their outstanding efforts by limiting landscape watering during the summer when water use is at its highest."



The District is asking customers who have addresses that end in an even number (0,2,4,6,8) to water on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday and those with addresses

that end in an odd number (1,3,5,7,9) to run their sprinklers on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Watering is only allowed before noon or after 8 p.m. through the end of September.

SSWD also has many rebates available for its customers to make conserving water even easier. Rebates are available for water-efficient sprinkler heads, drip irrigation systems, pool covers and WaterSense-labeled weather-based irrigation controllers. Weather-based irrigation controllers act

like a thermostat for a sprinkler system, and use local weather and landscape conditions to run the sprinklers instead of running according to a pre-programmed schedule.

Customers who install drip irrigation systems and register their WaterSense-labeled weather-based irrigation controllers with SSWD will not be subject to future watering restrictions. Complete details and rebate applications are available on [sswd.org](http://sswd.org).

equipment, and that includes smart purchasing and using the most economical and environmentally-friendly fuels. The California Energy Commission states that natural gas is the cleanest burning of all fossil fuels, cheaper than gas or diesel and contributes to significant reductions in greenhouse gas.

Each year, the County's 100 waste collection trucks consume more than one million gallons of the cleaner burning natural gas, which reduces diesel fuel consumption by more than 500,000 gallons per year. Substituting one petroleum truck with a CNG truck, the County reduces petroleum-fuel

use by 270 barrels of oil per year. Thus far, Waste Management and Recycling has transitioned about 90% of its on-road fleet to use alternative fuels, with its entire south area collection fleet now operating on CNG.

To support the use of CNG, the County opened a new natural gas fueling station in 2015 that allows multiple vehicles to fill up at the same time without waiting as vehicles fill overnight. It is also planned that the County will move to bio-methane Renewable Compressed Natural Gas to fuel the refuse fleet to achieve even more greenhouse gas emission reductions. ★



# Here is a Date Night Idea

Yep, this can be a fun, and entertaining evening for you and your significant other, or possibly a chance just to get to know someone better. This is also a great idea for a group that would like to have shared time with hands on experience or just a bonding time with your daughter-in-law. The House of Gekkeikan Sake offers an exotic opportunity to share in the world of Sake along with a Sushi making class every other month at the brewery in Folsom.

The tasting room is all set up with all the tools you need, except you must bring a sharp knife. A welcome is extended by the tasting room representative with an invitation to take part in a buffet before beginning. It begins with an appetizer of Mango Tequila Sauce over cream cheese and crackers, Caesar Salad, Pineapple Sake Teriyaki meatballs, Meyers Lemon Rosemary sausages and cookies for dessert. Their sauce source is the excellent products from Earth & Vine\*. The first tasting of Sake begins with the award winning Black & Gold, but this can depend on the weather. My class was in March so this was served warm, but in the summer months they follow the Japanese tradition serving cold Sake which is more fruity in nature.

Our teacher is Chef Metha of Kanpai Sushi Restaurant. He begins by telling us exactly how to hold the rice and place it on the Nori seaweed sheets. We are split into small groups and receive instruction on creating the perfect California Roll using the correct technique including the moistening of our fingers for working the rice. We return to our seats and have the all the ingredients to make our first roll, which is a practice run, preparing us for the Sushi competition later. While other class members are receiving their instruction we sample Haiku a light medium dry wine that is served chilled and then Suzaku, considered premium sake.

At this point I have made my practice California Roll and ate most of it while enjoying the tastings. We now enter the competition phase and have an opportunity to show off our skill. I am feeling pretty confident and make the second roll along with a pour of Zipang, a sparkling sake. This is bright and light which would complement a wide array of appetizers. However, my beautiful rolls plated with a ginger flower and slivers of cucumber did not even figure into the final

two. There was lots of laughter with winners declared for both gals and guys. Our second lesson was a hand roll. Right up front, this technique was beyond my capabilities, but others seemed capable. Again we could practice and then have a second chance with winners receiving prizes. We finished our tasting with two plum wines Kobai, light and sweet, with a suggestion to be paired with blue cheese and Plum Gekkeikan, which was very good. Raffle drawings for great prizes completed the lesson.

It really was a very enjoyable and educational evening with wonderful hosts. The class cost was \$35.00. 

**Snowball switch?**

Dear Dave,  
We're working the debt snowball, and together my husband and I make \$93,000 a year. The amounts of our remaining three debts are so close we wonder if we should take interest rates into account. Two are student loans for \$2,970 and \$6,700, while the other is credit card debt in the amount of \$4,750. I also got a recent bonus of \$3,600. Should we put that toward our debt snowball?  
- Robin

Dear Robin,  
In a strictly mathematical sense, my advice of paying off debt smallest to largest may be wrong, but it's still the correct advice. Besides, if people were so good at math they wouldn't have debt in the first place, would they? If I'm in your shoes, I'd have that lowest student loan paid off in a heartbeat with the bonus you mentioned. I'd throw the remainder, along with your regular snowball payments, at the credit card and keep the debt snowball rolling just like I normally advise.

When you're pushing to get out of debt fast, interest rates don't really matter much when you add up actual dollars on interest spent. If you were going to keep debt around for six or seven years, then we'd have something to talk about. But when you knock out the

little debt and immediately plow through the others with a vengeance, it gives a real sense of accomplishment and confidence. Remember, personal finance is 80 percent behavior and only 20 percent head knowledge. So, mathematically speaking, the advice I'm giving you might be a few dollars wrong, but you'll benefit in other bigger, long-lasting ways by gaining a sense of closure on your debts, learning how to delay pleasure and staying on a plan!

I'm in the middle of a Chapter 13 bankruptcy. I've worked for years in the automotive industry, but lately I've been thinking about a different line of work. The problem is I'm afraid I will be discriminated against when applying for jobs because of the bankruptcy filing. I think the government has given businesses the permission to look at my financial history. Do you have any suggestions?

Dear Joe,  
The government doesn't give businesses permission to look at your history. They had that right anyway. And it wouldn't be discrimination, because it's a part of their analysis as to whether or not they want you working for them. That kind of thing is perfectly reasonable. It's not discrimination. A lot of this, however, depends on the job and how seriously the employer is considering you. If you'd be doing something where you have to be bonded, then you'll have trouble because the bankruptcy

David Price, signed to a huge contract in the offseason, has been good – but not great – in his first season with the Red Sox.

AROUND THE HORN

San Diego went all in on 2015 to build what Padres management planned as a pennant contender. Instead, the Padres finished 74–88 and 13 games out of the final wild card playoff spot. San Diego started its dismantling in the offseason by dealing closer **Craig Kimbrel** to the Red Sox for top prospects **Manuel Margot** and **Javier Guerra**, and let **Justin Upton** walk in free agency. The Padres further rebuilt on July 14, dealing their most effective starting pitcher, **Drew Pomeranz**, to Boston for 18-year-old pitcher **Ander-son Espinoza**, whom *Baseball America* ranked as its 15th-best prospect in the game in its recently updated prospect ratings. The Padres may unload **Matt Kemp** in the coming weeks, especially after recently promoting 26-year-old outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (who was hitting .382/.425/.622 in 240 plate appearances at AAA) and 24-year-old **Hunter Renfro** (.335/.362/.633, with 21 homers in 373 plate appearances) also ripping the cover off the ball at El Paso. ...

What is it with the NL West and rebuilds gone wrong? Arizona's offseason trade of prospects **Aaron Blair** and **Dansby Swanson** and everyday MLB outfielder **Ender Inciarte** for starting pitcher **Shelby Miller** looked bad then and looks even worse now. Miller was optioned to AAA on July 14 after accumulating a 7.14 ERA in 69 innings pitched. Arizona outfielder **A.J. Pollock**, perhaps the team's best everyday player, has missed the entire season with injury, and \$206.5 million pitching signee **Zack Greinke** may end July on the disabled list. The Diamondbacks, dead last in the division at 40–53 overall and 17 games behind the division-leading Giants, would probably like a do-over on the last nine months. ...

Atlanta continued building one of the game's best farm systems with the signing of Venezuelan **Kevin Maitan**, a 16-year-old shortstop considered one of the best young international free agent signings in years. There's debate as to whether Maitan will remain at short — some think his future is at third or in right — but what nobody's debating is that he can be a plus hitter, and perhaps one with 20-to-25-home-run power. ...

The Astros also went to the international well to land Cuban infielder **Yulieski Gourriel** to a five-year, \$47.5 million contract. The 32-year-old has the glove and the bat to be a difference-maker in the majors, but he hasn't played competitively this year. He'll play in the minors before likely joining Houston before August.

Time to step up  
Pressure is on for these stars to produce

We're nearing the two-thirds point of the regular season, with at least half of baseball's teams still legitimately in playoff contention. As the season's last two months stand to separate the pretenders from the contenders, here are some stars on contending teams who need to give their squads more than they've provided so far. All stats are through July 17.

Michael Brantley, LF, Indians

The 29-year-old outfielder recorded OPS marks of .891 and .859 his last two seasons, but in '16, that number has declined to .561. The issue isn't Brantley's ability, but his balky shoulder, which has limited him to 43 plate appearances. The Indians can match starting pitchers with any team in the league, and have hit surprisingly well — their 4.96 runs scored per game is sixth in baseball — but a boost from Brantley could potentially help Cleveland run away with the American League Central.

Adrian Gonzalez, 1B, Dodgers

Gonzalez has been a different player since turning 30. He hasn't posted a full-season on-base percentage better than .350, which was still okay since he was still slugging north of .460. This year, Gonzalez's slugging number is threatening to dip below .400, and his home run output has declined to seven; that's dangerous territory for a first baseman. With Gonzalez, it may just be age: He's now 34, and his hard-hit ball rate of 29.6 percent, according to FanGraphs, is far worse than his full-season low of 33.3 percent in 2006. Los Angeles ranks 19th in baseball in runs scored per game, and more offense from Gonzalez would solve some problems.

Andrew McCutchen, CF, Pirates

The perennial All-Star had been one of baseball's most consistent players since 2012, with batting averages ranging from .292 to .327 and on-base percentages between .400 and .410 each season. So, the fact that McCutchen, just 29 years old, is hitting only .244/.314/.415 is one of baseball's biggest surprises. The main culprit is a batting average on balls in play of .296 — that's way below his range of .339 to .375 in his previous four campaigns — with a 20.1 percent rate of "soft" contact, according to FanGraphs, far above his career mark of 14.1. He's striking out in nearly a quarter of his plate appearances, also a career-worst figure.

McCutchen said in early July that a thumb issue that had plagued him during most of the first half was subsiding. He started to hit more like the old McCutchen as July progressed, which is good news for a Pirates team trying to contend for a Wild Card spot.

David Price, SP, Red Sox

When Boston signed the big lefty to a seven-year, \$217 million deal in the offseason, it expected better than the 4.36 ERA that Price gave them in his first 20 starts given his career 3.20 mark. The 30-year-old is in some ways as good as he's ever been — his 9.76 strikeouts per nine innings is just 0.06 shy of a career high, and his 1.94 walks per nine is lower than his career average of 2.28. The problem with Price is, according to FanGraphs, 35.7 percent of the balls hit off him are classified as "hard-hit" — that's way over his career average of 27.5 — and his home-run-per-fly-ball rate of 14.5 percent is far above his career norm of 9.4.

The former Cy Young Award winner has been a victim of rising home-run rates across baseball, and that may limit his upside somewhat. The good news: Price's fastball velocities in his last four starts have been his best of the season.

Troy Tulowitzki, SS, Blue Jays

Throughout his career, the only thing limiting the five-time All-Star has generally been his health. In 2016, he's spent some time on the disabled list with a quad injury. While Tulowitzki's overall .239/.313/.459 batting line has been cause for concern on the heels of last season's .280/.337/.440 marks, especially since he's now 31, his .333/.383/.574 marks in a 54-at-bat sample in mid-July indicate that perhaps again, injuries are what held him back. If he retains that level, Toronto will feature perhaps the most feared lineup in baseball.

The Giants bullpen

I'll cheat here and indict an entire unit, since six players have combined for an MLB-leading 18 blown saves. Closer Santiago Casilla has been the culprit five times in 26 chances, though a .353 batting average allowed on balls in play shows he's been a victim of some bad luck, especially with a career-high 11.42 strikeouts per nine innings. There's reason for hope here — elite set-up man Sergio Romo is back after missing most of 2016 with a forearm injury, and talented 27-year-old Hunter Strickland can also pitch better than his 3.12 ERA and 1.15 WHIP. But the Giants need production and not excuses, as well as something better than the bullpen's 7.31 strikeouts per nine innings over the season's first three months that ranked as the third-worst mark in baseball.

Also needing to step up: Prince Fielder (1B, Rangers); Adam Jones (OF, Orioles); Francisco Liriano (SP, Pirates); Justin Upton (OF, Tigers); Ryan Zimmerman (1B, Nationals); the Baltimore and Texas rotations.
