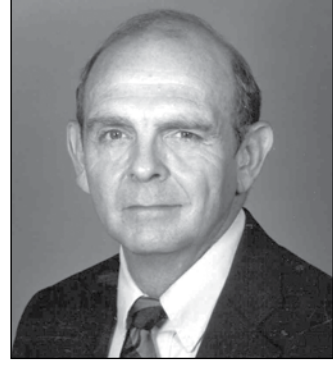

## Remembering All of Them



We can all wonder why wars happen, but we can also stop long enough to honor the sacrifice given for what others believed in. They believed in us.

On one sacred day each year we stop and honor all those who have gone before us to secure our freedoms and our way of life. War is ugly. It is a tragedy. It is far too often unavoidable.

The common men and women who gave their lives for the good of our country became great to each of us through their sacrifice. There is no greater deed than to give your life for your fellow man.

In my own family I have three brothers who have served in the military. There are many uncles, cousins, nephews and nieces who have also served. Each of them is a part of a larger community that the rest of us will never really understand. But we can honor their service.

I remember the funeral I went to as a

young school boy for my cousin Michael Borges. I remember seeing him in the casket, and that it didn't look anything like him. He was killed in Vietnam when his Jeep ran over a land mine. It was the first time that I remember seeing anyone that I had known dead. Wasn't it just a few short years ago I stood safely by him in the big family Christmas photograph?

My cousin's name is engraved in the Vietnam Memorial at the Sacramento Capital. When my son was a young boy I took him there to see the name, tell him the story and to talk about war. Hopefully it had an impact and someday he will return, and remember.

Another cousin, Leroy Kramer, was one of the greatest guys you would ever want to meet. He was always funny, loud, and enjoyed life to its fullest. He served in Vietnam as a U.S. Marine, and in later

years suffered horribly from a neurological disease from the effects of agent orange. He passed away a few years ago, but over many of his last years while suffering from the disease he became a huge fundraiser for other veterans need. Lee was on a mission to help as many of his fellow veterans as he could.

On Memorial Day, I remember these two men especially. Both of their examples changed my life in way that is difficult to explain. I think of all the families that have similar stories and how our nation is full of heroes lost. We must honor them all.

This Memorial Day enjoy the BBQ, the parties, the day to relax. But most of all remember why the sacred and historical day exists. We can all wonder why wars happen, but we can also stop long enough to honor the sacrifice given for what others believed in. They believed in us. ★

**SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)** - Sacramento's Boy Scout Troop One will be holding its 100-year anniversary, known as the 100ofOne Celebration, this June. Popularly believed to be the oldest, continuously running Boy Scout troop west of the Mississippi River, Troop One is currently reaching out to alumni to attend its 100-year celebration.

Scouts, scouters, Eagle Scouts and anyone that has ever been associated with Troop One are invited to

attend the celebration at The Center at Twenty Three Hundred located at 2300 Sierra Blvd in Sacramento on Sat. June 11 from 6 to 9 p.m. Interested alumni are encouraged to join the troop's mailing list to receive invitation information and updates on the event.

Throughout Midtown Sacramento's many recent changes, Troop One is one of the few institutions that have endured. The troop held its first meeting in 1916 at the

First United Methodist Church on the corner of 21st and J streets, where its meetings are still held today. In 1955, Troop One nearly folded as membership dipped to only nine scouts. However, by 1976, the troop was back to making history, as Eagle Scouts H.J. and Robert McCurry became the first pair of brothers in the nation to win the Distinguished Eagle Scout Award.

Today, Troop One alumni make up some of

Sacramento's most successful business and community leaders. The troop typically rosters 70 registered Boy Scouts from all over Sacramento and the surrounding areas and its Alumni Club boasts 170 former Troop One scouts, comprised of members from as far back as the 1930s.

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - Metro Fire recently opened the application period for Fire Camp, a day camp that takes place from July 12-15, 2016. Fire Camp provides local children a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to experience today's fire service, first hand. The program is designed to instill self-confidence, teamwork, teach life safety skills and

provide a basic understanding of the firefighting profession, in a fun and exciting atmosphere. Campers are grouped in "strike teams" of eight campers, and each strike team is mentored by two Metro Firefighters. # New 401k Benefits for UC Elites to Cost over \$500 million, Assembly Panel votes to Block

**OAKLAND, CA (MPG)** - A new University of California retirement plan that encourages UC's highest paid employees to circumvent the cap on pensionable compensation (also known as the PEPR cap) required by the Governor as part of a 2015 budget deal to boost state funding for UC will cost the university over \$500 million over the next fifteen years, according to a new actuarial study.

On May 24th the State Assembly Budget Subcommittee on Education voted to withhold hundreds of millions of dollars in pension stabilization funding until UC rescinds the plan.

Under the terms of the 2015 State Budget, by imposing to cap pensionable compensation for new employees hired after July 1, 2016 at the IRS Limit of \$117,000, the University of California would be eligible to receive \$436 million (over three years) in Prop. 2 Funds from the state to pay down its unfunded pension liability.

While imposing this cap on its defined benefit participants, the UC Regents approved a plan in March to create an entirely new "401k" option for its employees. Under this plan, instead of limiting employer contributions to 8% of the first \$117,000 of salary, UC would provide employer contributions of 8% on the first \$265,000 in salary—or \$7400 more in annual contributions to an employee making over \$265,000 per year.

Unlike its defined benefit pension, which has a five year vesting period and is not portable, UC's new 401k has just a one year vesting period, and is portable. As such, it provides clear incentives for UC's highest paid employees to select a 401k in order to circumvent the state-imposed cap, and in doing so, could risk the financial stability

of the defined benefit program on which lower wage workers rely.

"What UC has done is akin to a health insurance company incentivizing its healthiest participants to bail out of a plan that also helps people who happen to get sick, leaving the most vulnerable individuals behind to face ever-increasing costs and fewer benefits," said AFSCME Local 3299 President Kathryn Lybarger. "Worse, in this case, it enables UC's executives to circumvent the expressed wishes of State Legislative leaders, at a cost of more than \$500 million over the next 15 years."

A key issue behind the Legislature's desire to impose a pension cap on UC had been the skyrocketing cost of compensation for UC's highest paid employees—growth that has occurred alongside a tripling of student tuition and growing concerns about access for qualified California students.

Since 2004, the number of UC Employees receiving salaries in excess of \$265,000 per year has grown by more than 500% and an annual cost of more than \$1 billion. In 2004, 629 employees earned these salaries at an annual cost of \$222 million, and in 2014, 3,343 received these high-end salaries at an annual cost of \$1.3 billion.[i]

When factoring in the total

cost of the new Retirement Benefits—including the 401K "opt out" approved by the Regents in March—UC is slated to save only \$9 million per year. According to the actuarial analysis, if UC were to eliminate the Opt-Out program and keep all of its employees in the same defined benefit pool, the savings would jump to \$49 million per year, or another \$580 million over fifteen years.

"The Legislature is deeply troubled by not only the cost of UC's new 401K plan, but by what appears to be an effort to circumvent the terms of the 2015 Budget Act," said Assembly Budget Education Subcommittee Chair Kevin McCarty. "State taxpayers should not be expected to subsidize the destruction of UC's defined benefit plan, nor the enrichment of UC's growing executive class."

attorney specialist and staff counsel. He was an attorney at the California Department of Business Oversight, Division of Corporations in 2001, business development counsel at 3Com Corporation from 2000 to 2001 and corporate and securities counsel at Gray, Cary, Ware and Freidenrich from 1999 to 2000.

Owens was an associate at Boutin, Dentino, Gibson, Di Giusto and Hodell from 1996 to 1999 and president at Industrial Friction Supply

Company Inc. from 1984 to 1993. He earned a Juris Doctor degree from the University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law and a Master of Business Administration degree from California State University, Sacramento. This position does not require Senate confirmation and the compensation is \$150,720. Owens is a Republican.

## Nearly 400 San Juan Unified Seniors Earn State Seal of Biliteracy

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - Nearly 400 San Juan Unified seniors will graduate this spring with special honors reflecting their dedication to linguistic excellence.

In a recent countywide ceremony, 397 San Juan Unified students earned the State Seal of Biliteracy Award for their fluency in 10 languages, including Spanish, French, Arabic and Mandarin. Of those students, 82 are former English learners who have shown proficiency in English and their native language. Honorees receive a medal to be worn during graduation, a certificate, a seal for their diploma and a special notation on their transcript.

Students earned the award by achieving a high level of speaking, reading and writing in one or more languages in addition to

English. This year, over 1,400 students from 12 districts in Sacramento County received the seal, with the greatest number of honorees hailing from San Juan Unified.

To earn the seal, established by California Assembly Bill 815 in 2012, students must receive good grades in all English classes required for graduation and proficiently score on the California Standards Test in English Language Arts. Additionally, students must show proficiency in one or more languages by passing a test — such as an Advanced Placement test — or by completing four years of a foreign language with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.

“Having achieved this level of proficiency, these students are well-poised to continue in their

language studies to attain even higher levels of proficiency, eventually including language unique to their lines of work or areas of expertise,” said Nicole Naditz, who teaches Advanced Placement French at Bella Vista High School.

The seal is a statement of linguistic and academic accomplishment that offers a variety of benefits after high school, including giving students a competitive edge in applying for jobs. Heather Berkness, a special programs counselor with the English Language and Multicultural Education Department, said the seal also adds value to college applications and allows students to connect with a worldwide community.

## IRS Marks National Military Appreciation Month

*Free Tax Guide Focuses on Tax Benefits for Members of the Military*

- May is National Military Appreciation Month, and the Internal Revenue Service wants members of the military and their families to know about the many tax benefits available to them.

Each year, the IRS publishes Publication 3, Armed Forces Tax Guide, a free booklet packed with valuable information and tips designed to help service members and their families take advantage of all tax benefits allowed by law. This year's edition is posted on [IRS.gov](http://IRS.gov).

- Available tax benefits include:
- Combat pay is partly or fully tax-free.
  - Reservists whose reserve-related duties take them more than 100 miles from home can deduct their unreimbursed

travel expenses on Form 2106 or Form 2106-EZ, even if they don't itemize their deductions.

- Eligible unreimbursed moving expenses are deductible on Form 3903.
- Low-and moderate-income service members often qualify for such family-friendly tax benefits as the Earned Income Tax Credit, and a special computation method is available for those who receive combat pay.
- Low-and moderate-income service members who contribute to an IRA or 401(k)-type retirement plan, such as the federal government's Thrift Savings Plan, can often claim the saver's credit, also known as the retirement savings contributions credit, on Form 8880.
- Service members stationed abroad have extra time, until

June 15, to file a federal income tax return. Those serving in a combat zone have even longer, typically until 180 days after they leave the combat zone.

- Service members may qualify to delay payment of income tax due before or during their period of service. See Publication 3 for details including how to request relief.

Service members who prepare their own return qualify to electronically file their federal return for free using IRS Free File. In addition, the IRS partners with the military through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program to provide free tax preparation to service members and their families at bases in the United States and around the world. ★

## Two Vehicle Collision Results in Fatal Injuries

- On May 18, 2016, at approximately 2:30 pm, Marcus Ashford (22), was driving a 1998 Dodge Neon southbound Walnut Ave., north of Cypress Ave., in the #1 lane. Nikolaus Berzins (34), was driving a 2011 Ford F-150 pickup truck northbound Walnut Ave., north of Cypress Ave., in the #1 lane.

For an unknown reason, the Dodge Neon swerved into the two-way left turn lane toward the

F-150 pickup truck. Mr. Berzins was unable to avoid a collision with the Dodge Neon as the Dodge Neon entered the #1 northbound lane. The Dodge Neon and the Ford F-150 collided head-on in the northbound lanes. The right front passenger of the Dodge Neon, an unidentified adult female, was transported to Mercy San Juan Hospital where she succumbed to her injuries. Mr. Ashford was transported to Mercy San Juan

Hospital with moderate injuries.

Mr. Berzins sustained minor injuries, but was not transported from the collision scene.

The collision is still under investigation.

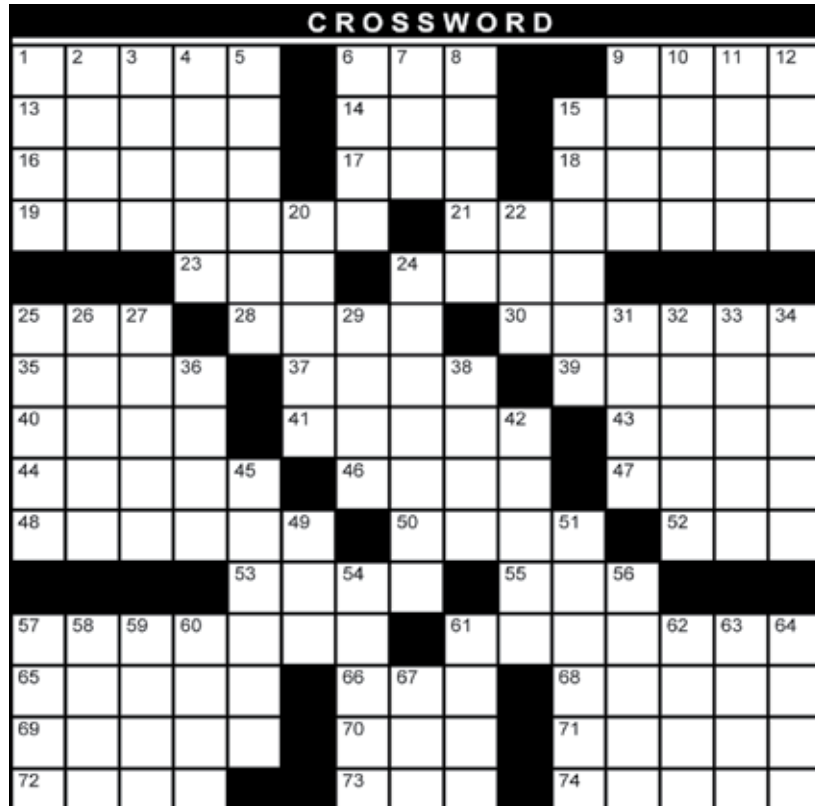

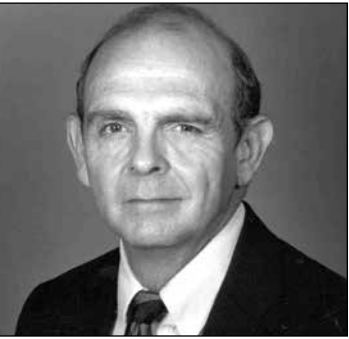

# Registering Women for the Draft: A Charade, Not a Necessity

The Armed Services Committee (ASC) recently approved a measure requiring American women aged 18 to 26 to register for the draft and sent it to the full House for consideration. If this measure becomes law it will do nothing to enhance gender equality in the Department of Defense that recently lifted a ban on women serving in combat.

The ASC's action typifies the inanity extant in the legislative branch. Although the measure passed by a vote of 32 to 30, Representative Duncan Hunter, the Republican head of the committee who submitted the measure, voted against it. If it becomes a bill and makes it to the White House, President Obama will sign it. Why is it inane?

First, it has been 43 years since anyone has been drafted. Over

those years the Army shrank from over 1,000,000 active duty soldiers to half that number and is on track to dip to 420,000 by 2017. Additionally, the Department of Defense claims the all-volunteer force works well. Indeed it does.

Second, modern conscription of citizen soldiers began with the French Revolution's Levee en Masse in 1793 to raise a citizen's army to oppose European monarchial armies marching to crush revolutionary France. Conscription also was used during the American Civil War—though unpopular on both sides. North and South allowed bounties for substitutes and many Confederate states refused to support the draft.

Washington and Richmond turned to conscription because Civil War battles were deadly confrontations between armed masses where the latest technological advances like rifled musketry and rifled artillery fostered previously unimagined slaughter.

Third, by 1914 the Industrial Age factories and transportation systems made it possible for major powers to raise, train, equip, feed and then transport immense armies. Further advances in military technology to include machine guns, rapid-fire rifles, chemical weapons and

combat aircraft escalated the carnage. Conscription heightened by nationalism and driven by competing ethnic and ideological dispositions drove armies into battles that consumed humans at a rate that made the first half of the 20th century the world's bloodiest. In 1945, at end of World War II, the atomic bomb and later the proliferation of nuclear weapons made that kind of warfare almost impossible for the handful of powers able to raise and sustain such armies because using them was no longer necessary or desirable given that the ultimate ridiculous conclusion would be mutual nuclear annihilation.

Fourth, while North Korea, China, and to some extent Russia still field modified examples of large Industrial Age armed forces, the United States does not. North Korea chooses to have an army of 1,000,000 (twice the size of the U.S. Army) because its sole reason for being is to overwhelm South Korea. The armed forces of China and Russia are much more sophisticated but also large because these countries are major land powers sharing the same Eurasian continent.

The armed forces of the United States are transitioning to Information Age and Cyber Age warfare. The United

States can use smaller forces to dominate battlespaces extending from space to the ocean's depths. These forces rely on speed, stealth, information dominance, and precision munitions to find, fix, and annihilate opposing forces. Even if needed, the United States could not generate a million-person Industrial Age armed force because America lacks the heavy industrial capacity and the wealth to do so. Given the cost of modern weapons, purchasing enough to support a force a quarter the size of our Industrial Age armies would be prohibitive. Beyond that, being nearly \$20 trillion in debt means that the United States cannot afford a massive military buildup. In any case, Beijing is unlikely to lend Washington the money to fight it.

As for gender equality, current policies allow women who want to serve to do so in any military capacity for which they physically and mentally qualify. Furthermore, given the size of the modern

battlespace, female service members have been in combat since Desert Storm, when two were captured, neither of them at the time involved in what would be considered a "combat" operation. Today's battlefield is multi-dimensional, not linear with the "front" and "rear" areas that previously existed.

Ultimately, the issue of conscripting women is a political charade. Republicans support it to avoid being accused of starting a "war on women." Democrats do so as a matter of social justice and social engineering and not national security. Either way, drafting women is inane.

Democracy, and respect for the voters of California, would suggest that there should be a vigorous debate in which the voters may determine whose ideas they support. I hope Secretary Clinton reconsiders her unfortunate decision to back away from her commitment to debate.

"I also would suggest that Secretary Clinton may want to be not quite so presumptuous about thinking that she is a certain winner. In the last several weeks, the people of Indiana, West Virginia and Oregon have suggested otherwise."

# America Marches Blindly Toward Single-Payer

attention. A recent survey found that 63 percent of people had a positive reaction to the term “Medicare for all.” Meanwhile, thousands of doctors recently signed on to a plan similar to Sanders’s.

Some states could even green-light single-payer in the coming months. This November, Colorado voters will decide whether to create a state-level single-payer system. The initiative would cost \$38 billion annually and require billions in new taxes.

Coloradans should take note of another state that tried to implement

a single-payer system and failed – Sanders’s home state of Vermont.

The state’s attempt at single-payer in 2014 was projected to cost \$4.3 billion – almost equivalent to the state’s entire \$4.9 billion budget. To fund the program, Vermont would have needed an extra \$2 billion in revenue – plus new taxes on businesses and residents. Officials abandoned the idea because it would have collapsed the state’s economy.

The recent history of single-payer systems sponsored by the federal government isn’t much more encouraging.

Take the Veterans Health Administration, which continues to subject beneficiaries to lengthy waits for care. In March, the Government Accountability Office tracked the experience of 180 newly-enrolled vets and found that 60 waited as many as 71 days to see a primary care doctor. Sixty more never even managed to get an appointment.

Patients haven’t fared much better under single-payer systems abroad.

Horror stories from Britain’s National Health Service emerge almost daily. Recently, a

government investigation found that hospitals are discharging elderly patients without ensuring that they’re fit to go home.

This spring, thousands of junior doctors went on strike. Patients had no choice but to wait for the walkout to end, as hospitals postponed more than 112,000 appointments and 12,700 operations in response.

Canada, my native land, has similar issues. Canadians must wait an average of 18.3 weeks to see a specialist after getting a referral. That wait time is 97 percent longer than it was in 1993.

Almost 900,000 Canadians are waiting for treatment.

The promise of single-payer – high-quality, universally accessible, free – is nothing like the reality of such a system. Taxpayers pay dearly for the promise of such care.

This fall, voters must not allow themselves to fall prey to the siren song of single-payer.

Hillary Clinton just dipped her toe a little bit further into the waters of single-payer health care, prodded by her competitor for the Democratic presidential nomination, Bernie Sanders.

She recently called for allowing more people to join Medicare – the government-run healthcare program for seniors – by allowing those “55 or 50 and up” to buy into it. Sanders can no doubt take credit for pulling her further left – his proposal to expand Medicare to all Americans has evinced cheers from his partisans.

But the record of other single-payer systems should silence those cheers. Single-payer would destroy health care quality and rob patients blind in the process.

Sanders has been agitating for single-payer for decades. The supposed price tag of his latest proposal for “Medicare-for-All?” About \$14 trillion over 10 years, he’s claimed.

But according to studies from the Urban Institute and the Tax Policy Center, the real cost would be about \$33 trillion. Even after accounting for the revenue that Sanders’s plethora of new taxes would take in, the government would still need \$16 trillion.

Nevertheless, Sanders’s focus on single-payer has attracted
