

Local Girl Shines as Broadway Star

CARMICHAEL, CA (MPG) - The old W. C. Fields adage about not working with animals or children was never more tested than by Sacramento singer/actress Teal Wicks, whose latest Broadway role lumps her with both species of scene-stealers. Fortunately, the star loves them all.

Backstage, Wicks embraces the woolly pooch who plays Porthos in "Finding Neverland"—a musical prequel to J.M. Barrie's "Peter Pan"—and coos: "I know I'm supposed to hate you. But I just want to love you." A big juvenile cast also gets plenty of hugs. "I've never worked with this many kids before," Wicks said. "These boys are incredible. They make me feel lazy because they're balancing school and performing. They just blow my mind."

Another new experience for the willowy thespian is onstage voluptuousness. "Mary Barrie is supposed to have a Gibson-girl figure," she explained. "So I pull on my padded hips and thighs. My Spanx go on over the top. It was hard to move around and keep my balance at first. Now I like my curves. I'm experiencing a 'me' I'll probably never be."

J.M. Barrie's upwardly mobile wife is not the female lead. But for the 33-year-old former star of "Wicked" productions in San Francisco, Los Angeles, and on Broadway in New York, playing Mary Barrie comes as a welcome plum. "It's an easy role," she said. "Mary only has one solo song. But the part gives me

time to do for outside concerts and other jobs. After "Wicked," anything's easy."

A "wicked" perk was Teal's kinship with an elite bunch of actresses who survived the role and formed the Elphaba Alumni club. "We don't often see each other but we text," she explained. "We commiserate. We all have some battle scars from bing Elphaba."

Exhaustion was among them. Three years performing eight shows a week (with no understudy) left the diva little time for trips to Carmichael to see mom. Happily, Gail Allen is a

Carpenters Endorse Sheriff Scott Jones for Congress

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - The Northern California Carpenters Regional Council has endorsed Sheriff Scott Jones for Congress in the 7th district, giving Jones a major labor endorsement in his race against incumbent Ami Bera.

"Sheriff Scott Jones understands the need to protect and promote American workers and the pressures middle class families are facing in today's economy," said Agustin "Augie" Beltran, director of public and governmental relation for the carpenters.

"While we have supported Congressman Bera in the past, he has not demonstrated the commitment to working men and women that we expected. Scott Jones, having come up through the ranks in the sheriff's department, has the background and experience we are looking for in Congress," concluded Beltran.

The Northern California Carpenters are the latest in a growing list of labor endorsements for Jones.

"It is extraordinary for a Republican candidate for Congress in a swing district to have the support of so many in the labor community, but it is a testimony to Scott Jones' background and commitment to helping working families who are struggling in the current economy," said Jones' campaign consultant Dave Gilliard.

Sheriff Jones is the current President of the California Peace Officers Association and sits on many professional and community boards, including Make-a-Wish. Jones has a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from CSU Sacramento, and a Juris Doctor (Law) degree from Lincoln Law School. He is also a graduate of the West Point Leadership Program, as well as the FBI's National Executive Institute.





Celebrate Pi Day... and the Day After

Walk With the Sacramento Walking Sticks

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)
- The Sacramento Walking Sticks will be celebrating the ratio between the circumference of a circle to its diameter—approximately 3.14—on Pi Day, Monday, March 14th and the day after on Tuesday, March 15th, 2016. They invite everyone to join in on the event; walking and eating “pie” with them afterwards.



The start/finish of the event will be Marie Callender's, 5622 Freeport Blvd, Sacramento, Calif., 95822. Registration for the walk on Monday will run from 3 to 4 p.m.; finishing by 7 p.m. and on Tuesday will run from 9 to 10 a.m.; finishing by 1 p.m. People will have their choice of walking either a 5K (approximately 3.14 miles) or a 10K (approximately 3.14 miles x 2) route with are flat and almost entirely on pavement. The walk is through South Land Park neighborhoods passing by Belle Cooledge Partner's Dog Park, Belle Cooledge Park and Library and Bahnfleth Park. The routes are wheelchair and stroller friendly; the family dog will love the outing. Children are encouraged to come and walk on foot, use their scooters or skates.

(The normal fee for volkswalk credit is \$3.00 per walk—the extra \$.14 will be donated to a local food closet at the Centennial United Methodist Church.) Participants are encouraged to donate canned or other non-perishable food that will also be donated to this food closet.

Volkssporting means “sport of the people” and has its origins in Germany. There are over 200 clubs throughout the USA and the Sacramento Walking Sticks is the largest club with

569 members. The Club offers a wide array of walking adventures for people of all ages and walking abilities; including the family dog. There are group walks on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday mornings, Wednesday evenings; and whenever there's a full moon. There are walks every weekend in northern and central California that people can join, too. Walking is one of the most inexpensive forms of exercise around and when people are walking and talking, they tend to walk further and faster than when they're alone or on a treadmill. The Club provides everyone with a set of written directions and map so no one gets lost and they're guaranteed a route with sights they would probably never have found on their own.

The Sacramento Walking Sticks host a membership meeting that anyone can attend on the second Thursday of every month in different locations (check our website for details). Our next meeting will be Thursday, March 10th, 2016 at the South Natomas Public Library meeting room, 2901 Truxel Rd, Sacramento Calif., 95833.




Biting Back Against Mosquitos

Eliminate Breeding and Feeding Opportunities

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (BPT) - Warm weather heralds the arrival of cookouts, lounging poolside, weekends at the beach, and a host of fun outdoor activities. Spring and summer are also mosquito season, and the little blood-suckers are far more than just an itchy nuisance. Mosquitos carry and transmit diseases that kill more than a million people worldwide every year, according to the American Mosquito Control Association.

In America, mosquitos have been linked to the transmission of West Nile Virus in humans and heartworms in dogs, the AMCA reports. In 2014, 47 states and the District of Columbia had reported cases of West Nile infections in people, birds, and mosquitos, according to the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention. Sixty percent of the 2,122 people infected in 2014 had infections that affect the brain, such as meningitis or encephalitis.

Fortunately, you can take effective steps to protect your home, family, and pets from exposure to mosquitos. Eliminating standing water where mosquitos breed and thwarting their efforts to feed can help keep your environment mosquito-free this spring and summer.

Eliminating Breeding Opportunities

"Many homeowners may not realize that standing water and

puddles in their yards can play a large role in attracting mosquitos," says Ryan Larsen, a civil engineer with NDS Inc., the nation's leading manufacturer of landscape drainage solutions. "Standing water is an ideal breeding location for mosquitos, which lay their eggs in still water."

Larsen advises homeowners to start their mosquito-prevention efforts by inspecting their yards to identify places where water may collect, such as low spots, downspouts, retaining walls, edging, walkways, and patios. Check gutters and downspouts to be sure they're free of obstructions, and address drainage issues in the landscaping.

"Low areas can easily turn into 'water reservoirs' that cause serious drainage problems," Larsen says. "Muddy, wet areas not only look bad, they kill grass, attract mosquitos and can evolve into more serious property damage."

Depending on your landscape and the severity of drainage problems, you may need to install a drainage system to prevent standing water from collecting on your property. Do-it-yourselfers can solve minor problems, but more severe situations may require professional intervention. In most cases, a drainage system can be installed in a single weekend, Larsen says.

Thwarting Feeding

Eliminating standing water on your property can help reduce mosquitos breeding in your yard, and other steps can help further protect you from marauding mosquitos. Some mosquitos will travel 40 miles for a meal, the AMCA says. When you're outdoors, take steps to protect yourself, your family, and pets from mosquitos hunting for blood.

Wear insect repellent on exposed skin and apply it to clothing as well, the CDC advises. Look for repellents with an active ingredient that's recommended by the CDC and EPA, like DEET, picaridin, IR3535, or oil of lemon eucalyptus. Dress in lighter-colored clothes as mosquitos are attracted to darker colors. If it's not too hot, wear long sleeves and pants to reduce skin exposure, especially between dusk and dawn when the mosquitos known to spread West Nile are most active.

When you're in your backyard, try burning citronella candles on patio tables, tossing some sprigs of rosemary on the grill, or running a fan at ground level to help keep mosquitos away.


The wide-eyed youngster sports a crisp new cap on his Charlie Brown head and holds a soon-to-be-his Louisville Slugger.


Hilda, who lived on East 52nd Street in Manhattan.

Really Hillary? Why not be honest and ask the biotech industry to support mandatory GMO labeling since polls regularly show that more than 90 percent of the American public supports GMO labeling?

How Hillary's State Department Became the Global-Marketing Arm of Monsanto

With no pledge to support mandatory GMO labeling from Hillary Clinton, right now all we have to assume for Hillary's opinion on GMO labeling is her track record as Secretary of State and from the few reports out there, it doesn't look good.

1. Directing embassies to "troubleshoot problematic legislation" that "might hinder biotech crop development."
2. Encouraging "the development and commercialization of ag-biotech products."
3. Producing pamphlets to promote biotech crops.
4. Sending pro-GMO DVDs to high school students in Hong Kong.
5. Flew foreign officials and media from 17 countries to the United States to promote GMO agriculture.


