## Miracle In The Making

Milagro is Spanish for miracle. For developers Nancy and Allan Davis, miracles take time. Two years ago, they bought the

run-down Hillside strip mall and saved Carmichael's main street from a big box store development. The visionaries planned a civic destination whose theme the entire world could identify with: food.

With the first sods dug, the Milagro Centre entered its development phase last week.

"Things didn't happen as quickly as we'd hoped," admitted Nancy Davis, daughter of Sacramento developer Joe

Benvenuti. "Getting our vision honed and on paper took planning and re-planning. The County was on our side but there are no shortcuts with permits and

**Resource Center  
 Provides Support  
 for Family  
 Caregivers**

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - Family members caring for patients diagnosed with Alzheimer's or dementia know how all-consuming their task is. In California alone, there are more than 4 million family caregivers, each spending 20 to 40 hours per week caring for their loved ones.

Family caregiving is typically what sustains adults with disabilities, yet caregivers often make major sacrifices to help loved ones remain in their homes. The stress of caring for family members with dementia has been shown to impact a caregiver's health and immune system for up to three years after their period of caregiving ends.

"Many family caregivers for brain impaired adults and frail elderly don't know they have local resources to support them," said Michelle Nevins, executive director of Del Oro Caregiver Resource Center. "Del Oro Caregiver Resource Center provides opportunities for education, respite care and support groups that understand the day-to-day tasks and struggles of a family caregiver."

Del Oro Caregiver Resource Center is part of a statewide system of resource centers serving family caregivers. Del Oro serves California's gold country counties: Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, Colusa, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Sierra, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba. It provides support groups, educational events and respite care for local families, free of charge.

According to Del Oro Caregiver Resource Center, nearly one out of every four households care for brain impaired adults and the frail elderly. Through Del Oro's online resource, family caregivers can find information on chronic and disabling conditions and diseases, aging, caregiving issues and community resources. Del Oro also supports local families through consultation, case management services, respite care and short-term counseling.

The reality of caregiving is best understood not with statistics but through the stories of spouses, children, siblings, and friends who have stepped forward when a loved one needed them. Their experiences illustrate the need for support, encouragement and resources to empower them in their caregiving journey.

## Check Before You Burn

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA** - On Friday, November 1, the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (AQMD) began its seventh Check Before You Burn season to reduce the harmful health effects from wood smoke.

Wood burning will be restricted or prohibited on days when fine particle pollution is forecast to be high. Atmospheric particulate matter is tiny pieces of solid or liquid matter suspended in the atmosphere. Some particulates occur naturally, originating from volcanoes, dust storms, forest and grassland fires and sea spray; others occur from human activities, such as burning of fossil fuels in vehicles, power plants and various industrial processes. They can adversely affect human health and also have impacts on climate and precipitation.

The effects of inhaling

particulate matter have been widely studied, particularly asthma, lung cancer, cardiovascular issues, respiratory diseases, birth defects, and premature

death. The size of the particle is a main determinant of where in the respiratory tract the particle will come to rest when inhaled. Because of their small size,

particles can penetrate the deepest part of the lungs.

The AQMD law restricting wood burning applies to residents and businesses in Sacramento County and the cities of Citrus Heights, Elk Grove, Folsom, Galt, Isleton, Rancho Cordova and Sacramento through February 28, 2014. Citizens must Check Before You Burn in indoor or outdoor fireplace, wood stove, firepit or chiminea that burns wood, pellets, manufactured logs or any other solid fuel.

approvals.”

By mid-2014, Nancy plans to be sipping wine beneath 30ft palms at Carmichael’s new gathering place. The imported trees will augment nearby historic Palm Drive and specimens recently planted for in Fair Oaks Corridor revamp.

Through Milagro’s development, our ageing boulevard will gain a booster shot of privately-funded beautification. Milagro Centre will have a Napa-style theme. A vineyard and low stone walls will run road-side; the entrance will evoke arches popular in small towns all over America. Among shaded tables, cool water will bubble in urns. Indoors, an atrium with fountain and fire place will be focal point. “The idea is for people to gather somewhere with ambiance, art and music,” explains Allan Davis.

Adds his wife Nancy: “We want people to sit down with a newspaper and coffee and enjoy their day. We don’t want another strip mall; we planned the center to draw people from all over Sacramento. Nothing like it

exists anywhere else.” Interior design is open plan. Several restaurants are just a start. Nearly 50,000 square feet space will host purveyors of anything fit for a table. Coffee, wine, bread and cheese merchants are among future tenants. Chocolate and pastry stores will be icing on the cupcake. “We’re getting daily enquiries from businesses,” says Allan. “We’re choosing tenants carefully. We don’t want to be

ordinary. Vendors must fit our vision.”

The designers Michael Martin and Kenton Russell have also incorporated an event center – overdue in a community that does not boast a town hall – for celebrations and meetings. “Any of our restaurants could cater banquets here,” says Nancy. “Artists could stage exhibitions; new products could be launched.”

Scheduled to begin next year, the project’s phase two will include a 30ft glass and metal “tower” likely to become a community landmark. Of vital import to breakfasters, the iconic Waffle Barn restaurant – the only remaining mall tenant – will get a facelift. “It will close temporarily for the work to be done,” says Allan Davis. “The owner isn’t upset; he’s thrilled to gain a great looking building where he can serve customers more efficiently.”

Though the Davises’ budget remains classified, penny-pinching seems unlikely. Mature palm trees don’t come cheaply. Décor will include fabric constructions by Marco Alvarez, whose creations graced the 2012 London Olympics. “If we were just slapping on paint and re-doing the parking lot, it would be so easy,” says Nancy Davis. “But we want something better for Carmichael. We want to create a landmark people will talk about for years to come. Something that draws the community together is so needed here.”

burn season by the Air Pollution Control Officer

- Devices that operate exclusively with natural gas or propane
- Cooking devices

Enforcement is through sightings of visible smoke by Air District enforcement staff. In addition to regular observation routes, staff visits locations determined by

complaints. Staff will observe the smoke, write down the address and a notice of violation will be mailed to the property owner.

To report a complaint, or suspected violation, call the District at 1-800-880-9025. *First time violations will result in a \$50 fine or the violator can choose to complete and pass a wood smoke awareness course. Fines for subsequent violations are higher.* ★

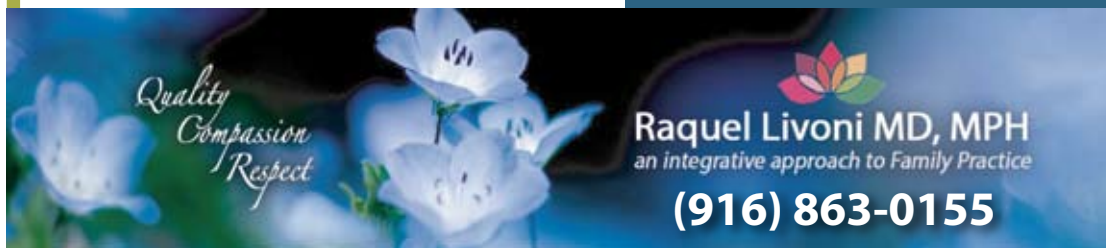

# Student-Run Campaign Seeks to Create First Tobacco-Free CSU Campus

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** -Hornets for a Healthy Hive announces the launch of its student-run campaign to create the first tobacco-free campus in the California State University system at Sacramento State.

"The health of our students and the beauty of our campus are things we all take pride in here at Sacramento State University," said Campaign Director Walter Michael. "We want to ensure that for many decades to come."

Hornets for a Healthy Hive plans to "set the trend for tobacco end," according to their campaign's slogan. In order to ensure the health and longevity of Sacramento State students, they have begun campaigning to protect students from the multitude of risks that come with secondhand smoke in hopes to be the first tobacco-free CSU campus.

The campaign has three main



goals to reach: eliminating secondhand smoke from campus, being the first CSU campus to be 100% tobacco free, and to keep the Sacramento State campus beautiful for many years to come.

The student-run campaign hopes to work with the Faculty Senate, the Associated Students Incorporated, and many other groups on campus and in the community in hopes of winning their support and expanding the reach of the campaign. Hornets for a Healthy Hive hopes to gain enough support to be able to encourage President Gonzalez to sign the policy into place by December 4, 2013.

There are more than 70

bright minds from the Strategic Planning and Management class working constantly to ensure this campaign's success. These students are divided into five departments: Creative Outreach, Research and Evaluation, Media Relations, Social Media and Writing.

"We're excited to see what Hornets for a Healthy Hive can accomplish for the sake of our students," said Michael.

The group will also be producing a scholarly paper discussing the work done by the campaign as a model for future student-run campaigns on college campuses.

# IRS Warns of Pervasive Telephone Scam

**SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG)** - The Internal Revenue Service warned consumers about a sophisticated phone scam targeting taxpayers, including recent immigrants, throughout the country. Victims are told they owe money to the IRS and it must be paid promptly through a pre-loaded debit card or wire transfer. If the victim refuses to cooperate, they are then threatened with arrest, deportation or suspension of a business or driver's license. In many cases, the caller becomes hostile and insulting.

"This scam has hit taxpayers in nearly every state in the country. We want to educate taxpayers so they can help protect themselves. Rest assured, we do not and will not ask for credit card numbers over the phone, nor request a pre-paid debit card or wire transfer," says IRS Acting Commissioner Danny Werfel. "If someone unexpectedly calls claiming to be from the IRS and threatens police arrest, deportation or license revocation if you don't pay immediately, that

is a sign that it really isn't the IRS calling." Werfel noted that the first IRS contact with taxpayers on a tax issue is likely to occur via mail.

Other characteristics of this scam include:

- Scammers use fake names and IRS badge numbers. They generally use common names and surnames to identify themselves.
- Scammers may be able to recite the last four digits of a victim's Social Security Number.
- Scammers spoof the IRS toll-free number on caller ID to make it appear that it's the IRS calling.
- Scammers sometimes send bogus IRS emails to some victims to support their bogus calls.
- Victims hear background noise of other calls being conducted to mimic a call site.
- After threatening victims with jail time or driver's license revocation, scammers hang up and others soon call back pretending to be from the local police or DMV, and the caller ID supports their claim.

Taxpayers should be aware that

there are other unrelated scams (such as a lottery sweepstakes) and solicitations (such as debt relief) that fraudulently claim to be from the IRS.

The IRS encourages taxpayers to be vigilant against phone and email scams that use the IRS as a lure. The IRS does not initiate contact with taxpayers by email to request personal or financial information. This includes any type of electronic communication, such as text messages and social media channels. The IRS also does not ask for PINs, passwords or similar confidential access information for credit card, bank or other financial accounts. Recipients should not open any attachments or click on any links contained in the message. Instead, forward the e-mail to [tophishing@irs.gov](mailto:tophishing@irs.gov).

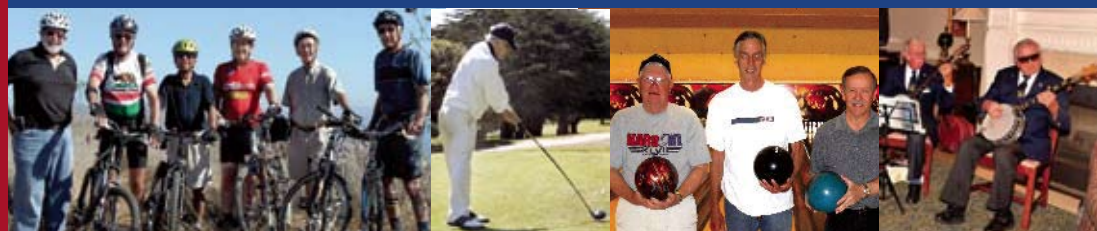

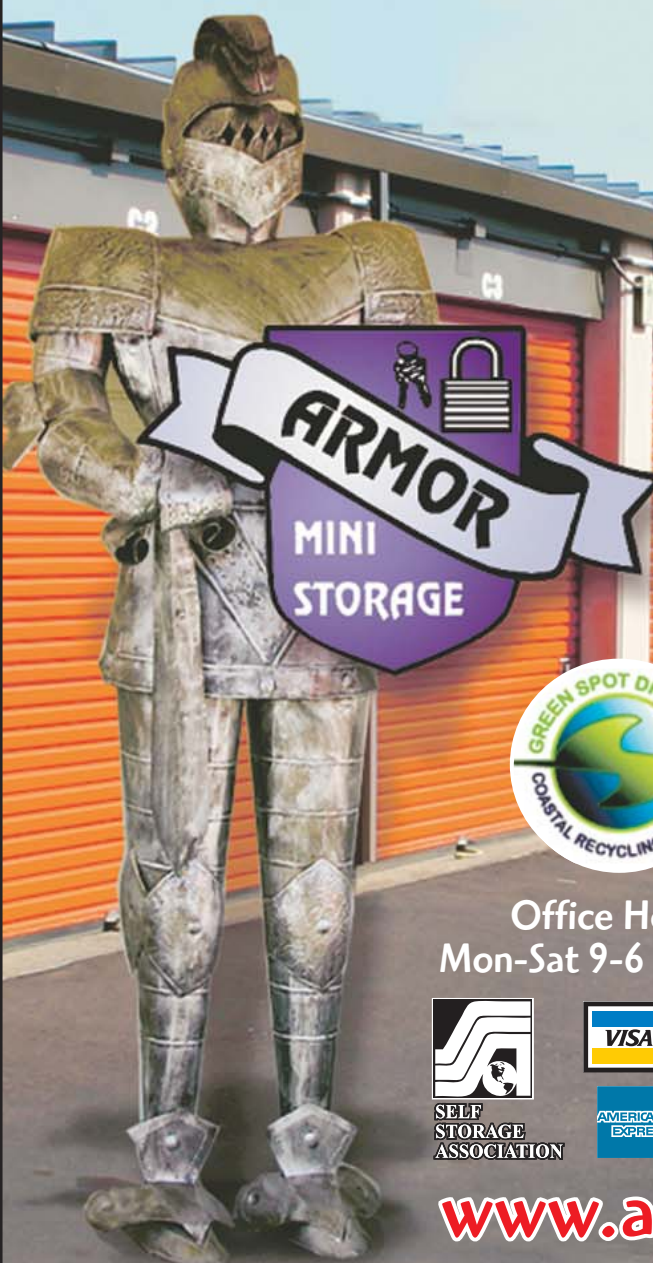

## Quick Action by Metro Firefighters Limits Fire Spread in 2 Story Arden Area Apartment Complex



**SACRAMENTO CA (MPG)** - This evening at 9:16 pm Firefighters from Sacramento Metro Fire were dispatched for a report of an apartment fire on the 1600 block of Bell Street in the Arden Area of Sacramento County, CA. On arrival crews reported a working apartment fire in a second story unit.

Fire crews immediately went to work stretching hose lines to limit the growth of the fire while additional personnel began the process of making sure adjacent units were

evacuated. A quick primary search was completed and it was reported to the incident commander that the two involved units were clear of any occupants. This coordinated attack resulted in a fire that was contained within 15 minutes sparing the remainder of the apartment complex from damage.

At the time of this release the Investigations Units from Metro Fire was headed to the scene to make the determination as to the cause of the fire. ★

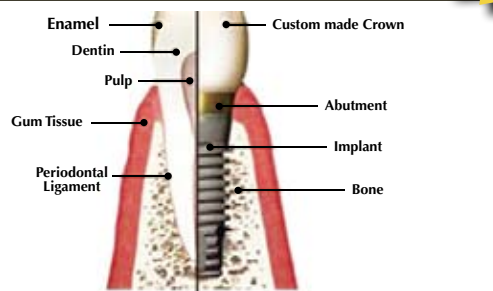

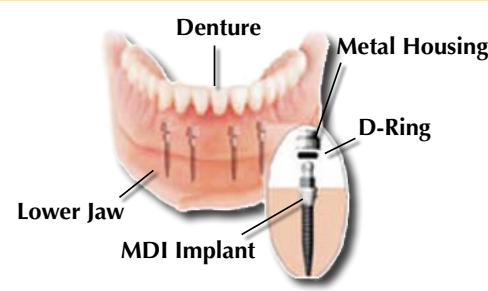
