RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Hundreds of Lancers returned to Rancho Cordova on Friday night, September 30, for Cordova's homecoming game against Foothill.

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Global Semiconductor Company Builds Research and Development Facility

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA, (MPG) - Solidigm, a U.S.-based subsidiary of global semiconductor company SK hynix, Inc., along with the City of Rancho Cordova and the Greater Sacramento Economic Council(GSEC), announced the largest high-wage jobs project in Greater Sacramento's history.

After an exhaustive site search in the Greater Sacramento region, Solidigm chose the City of Rancho Cordova to build its global research and development (R&D) campus, which will be home to more than 1,900 professionals in highly paid technology jobs over the next five years with more than \$100 million investment in the facility. is the largest semiconductor industry R&D project Greater Sacramento has seen over the last decade.

Solidigm is a leading global provider of innovative NAND flash memory solutions. The company launched as a U.S.-based

subsidiary of SK hynix, Inc., the world's second-largest memory chip maker, on December 29, 2021, following an October 2020 agreement by SK hynix to acquire Intel's NAND and SSD business for \$9 billion.

Solidigm is currently working on tenant improvements to the 230,000-square-foot R&D campus and is targeting a move-in date in the first quarter of 2023. The site was chosen for its ample

Lancers Fall Flat in Homecoming Loss to Foothill

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Spirits were high with fans packed in the stands for homecoming Friday night in Rancho Cordova.

Unfortunately for the hundreds of Lancers fans in attendance, the good times did not last for long, at least on the field. In the first game of Greater Sacramento League (GSL) play, Cordova was soundly defeated by Foothill (3-3, 1-0 GSL).

The Mustangs scored 20 points in each of the first and second quarters and led 40-6 at halftime. Foothill added 14 in the third and eight in the fourth to ultimately win 62-6. Sixty-two is the most points allowed in a game by the Lancers this season. All seven of Cordova's opponents have scored at least 41 points.

The Lancers' only score of the game came in the

second quarter on a break-away 50-yard rushing touchdown from do-it-all senior captain Kevin Lewis. Cordova has lost all seven games it played so far this season.

However, the Lancers overall record is (1-6). That is because their week two opponents El Camino, who beat Cordova 41-0, were forced to forfeit the win. The Eagles had an ineligible player suit up and play against the Lancers who switched schools from Del Campo, to Rio Americano then to El Camino, according to The Sacramento Bee.

Cordova's record may have a one in the win column, but the reality is, the Lancers have not won a game yet this season under interim coach Kyle Williams. Cordova will attempt to regroup and seek its first victory Friday on the road at Natomas (4-2, 1-0 GSL) with kickoff scheduled for 7:15 p.m. ★

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Rancho Cordova's MACC (Mills Station Arts & Culture Center) celebrates its 5th year anniversary Oct. 6-22 with the sweetest exhibit yet! Join the celebration as the MACC is throws a birthday party – and it is all about sweets, ranging from Oreo art to award-winning cakes.

Utah artist Christopher Creek traded in his miniature stamp size paintings for an exploration into sculpting the creamy centers of Oreo cookies. Creek began with creating these tiny pieces of art by sculpting the 17 prophets of the Latter-day Saints. During the pandemic, he set out to do one sculpture a day for a year. These small creamy creations look like porcelain on the chocolate cookie palette.

Creativity grew as he continued his experimentation, and the results became more complex and dimensional as he pushed the cookie medium further along. An accomplished tiny portrait painter, Creek decided he could also use the blank white canvas to paint, using a variety of colored creams. Before he knew it, Creek had painted all the Marvel superheroes, animals, politicians, holiday themed characters, foods like hot dogs,

apple pie ala mode, and even sushi.

Next, he thought it would be fun to have a bigger palette, so he crushed up the chocolate wafers and added a binder to stick the crumbs back together using a 7-inch springform pan to create the "ultimate Oreo." The MACC exhibit will feature 80 of these mini-masterpieces and some of the larger 7-inch cookie paintings. Creek and his son coined "Creotions" as the name of these artful snacks made from Oreo cookies.



Meet Christopher Creek and son Kyle from 5:30-8 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 6 for a reception and artist talk on how he got started down this cookie path, sharing stories of his journey. In addition to Creotions (Oreo Art), the MACC will also feature Northern California artists' works in a juried show of "Sweets" which will include paintings and artwork that deals with candies, cookies, pies and all things sweet.

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The City of Rancho Cordova and Nimbus Films is proud to announce the premiere of Rancho Cordova, from the Gold Rush to the Space Race, a documentary film that chronicles the fortunes of Rancho Cordova beginning with the Gold Rush.

The film will debut on Thursday, October 13, 2022, during a 6:30 pm presentation at the Mills Station Arts & Culture Center (MACC), 10191 Mills Station Rd., Rancho Cordova, and will be screened at the MACC again on October 20 at 6:30. Admission is complimentary.

First serving as a transportation corridor to the gold fields, Rancho Cordova underwent numerous transformations throughout its history. In the 1800s, its lush soil and American River access attracted farmers, and became famous for grape and hops production. Then, due to its climate and wide-open spaces, the U.S. military created Mather Air Base in the early days of aviation, and generations of people served there through the 1980s. Another critical player in the region's rise was Aerojet General Corporation, which developed rocket engines and fuel for the space vehicles that took America to the moon in 1969.

The end of the Cold War and the related closing of Mather Air Force Base provided tough challenges for the local economy. The film explains how concerned citizens organized and successfully gained cityhood for the area in 2003, a critical move that has led to the area's revitalization.

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Playmakers Goes National

- Local non-profit organization The Playmakers has been teaching character and leadership through sports since the founding in 2009. The Playmakers founder Greg Roeszler, known as Coach Roz, saw the need for at-risk kids, such as foster youth and kids with developmental differences, to have real opportunities to be included and build relationships through team sports.

Playmakers has reached thousands of local kids through their summer football camps and after-school programs, all of which are free to students and their families. And Playmakers is expanding their reach by taking the football camps national: This summer, in addition to the local Sacramento camp, Playmakers hosted camps in Ohio, Iowa, and Florida.

It costs about \$10,000 to host a camp, and they are completely free for the students and their families. The camps are funded through private and corporate donations, various fundraising events, and with support from local civic groups, schools, and churches.

The camps are facilitated by athletes from the local high schools, who oversee the activities and participate along with the kids. Coach Roz said, "It's been encouraging to see high school kids want and be willing to serve. ... A lot of kids are craving that."

And next summer, in addition to the existing camps, Playmakers will be expanding to Washington D.C.—hosting a camp at Gallaudet University for the deaf and hearing impaired. And the high school students who help out locally at the Sacramento camp will have the opportunity to travel with Playmakers to Washington D.C.

to help at that camp, allowing them to further practice their leadership skills in a new venue.

"There are kids everywhere that need this opportunity," said Coach Roz. "We can expand anywhere there is an interest."

For many of the kids who attend these camps, it's the first time they've had a chance to play a sport with other people and be included this way – and Coach Roz said it means so much to both the kids and their families. "It's a great experience for everyone

involved," he said.

"It all just revolves around relationships," explained Coach Roz. "We're learning so much, spending time with them." And these lessons are expanding into a new avenue for Playmakers, as they give the high school athletes the opportunity to become leaders of inclusiveness on their own campuses. Just launched this school year is a calendar of events, a playbook for the athletes to follow as they take the initiative and build relationships with the special education

classes at their schools. The Playmakers' calendar of events includes activities such as painting pumpkins for Halloween and decorating ornaments for Christmas. Coach Roz said these activities keep the kids involved and the relationships connected throughout the school year.

So, in multiple states across the country, as this new school year is getting started, high school athletes are taking those lessons of connection and inclusion to heart, and forging

relationships with special education students to make them an integral part of the social life on campus.

As Playmakers is growing and expanding, these high school students are serving as delegates, bringing that message into the schools, serving as role models to other students on how to lead with character and compassion and make a difference for those who need it most.

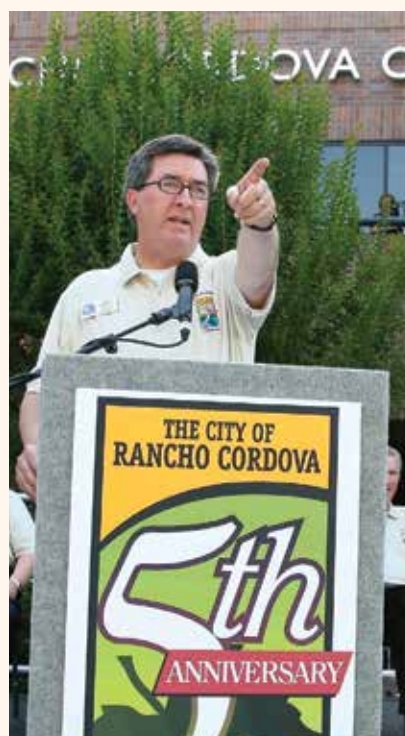

On September 30, 1947 the United States Air Force was officially established as a military branch on its own

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, September 30 and October 1 & 2, the California Capital Airshow was presented by Sacramento County in partnership with the City of Rancho Cordova, California. In addition to the fantastic airplanes and shows they presented to the audience, there was a multinational salute to the United States Air Force. On September 30, 1947 the United States Air Force was officially established as a military branch on its own, because until then, it was known as the Army Air Force (AAF).

“On September 26, 1947, by order of the Secretary of Defense, personal of the Army Air Forces (AAF) were transferred from the Department of the Army (formally the War Department) to the Department of the Air Force and established as the United States Air Force (USAF).” Either way, the Air Force officially became a branch of its own at the end of September, 1947. I know we celebrated the 75th Anniversary of the U.S.A.F. at the 2022 California Capital Airshow.

Something which was done September 30, 2022 was presented by Congressman Ami Bera. His staff member Matthew Ceccato, said that the California Capital Air Show Board was excited to invite us to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Air Force and to honor 7 Veterans for their military service. Matthew said it was called “OPLAN 2022: Veteran Tribute Flight”. It was truly an honor that I was listed as one of those Veterans.

On Friday, September 30, we departed from Mather Airport at about 10:30 am

on a military plane to Castle AFB. The plane we were on was a Douglas C-47 Skytrain. The plane was manufactured in 1943 and began service in WWII on 1944. It was a military transport aircraft which gave us a comfortable ride from Mather to Castle, then back from Castle to Mather. We landed at exactly 04:03 pm to start the Air Show. There were quite a few people who were waiting to thank the veterans who returned from the “Tribute Flight”. I thought it was very heartwarming for the people who came to the show to wait beside their cars to welcome and honor the Veterans who were on the flight.

On the ground at Castle AFB, the group was given exclusive access to their museum honoring the Air Force, as well as given a tour of the static displayed aircraft. There were 88 aircraft we saw on the tour of that part of the museum. For example we saw a “Convair RB-36H Peacemaker (Bomber) which had three propeller engines and two jet engines on each wing. “The B-36 was the largest mass-produced piston- aircraft engine aircraft ever built. It had the longest wingspan of any combat aircraft ever built, at 230 ft (70 m).”

The Castle Air Museum, which those of us who had the opportunity to see for a couple of hours, would probably return to visit at another time. Some of the planes in the museum have actually been seen flying not too long ago. If anyone has an opportunity to visit the museum, I think it would be a great place to study history and the present.

Kiley Responds to State Gas Prices \$2 above National Average

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - September 26, 2022, Assemblyman Kevin Kiley (R-Rocklin) released the following statement in response to California's average gas price rising to \$5.80, over \$2.00 above the national average of \$3.73.

“California drivers are now paying \$2.07 more than the national average and we are only 20 cents away from \$6 per gallon,” Kiley said. “This is what happens when the Legislature places relief for the people of our state at the bottom of their priority list. The politicians responsible for this must be held accountable.”

In January, Kiley introduced AB 1638, an urgency measure that would

have immediately suspended the gas tax and saved Californian's over 50 cents per gallon at the pump. That bill was rejected in the Assembly on multiple occasions. Instead of providing relief, the Speaker of the Assembly created the Select Committee on Gasoline Supply and Pricing to study the issue. To date, the committee has held two hearings and has yet to produce anything actionable.

Assemblyman Kevin Kiley represents the 6th Assembly District, which includes the Sacramento, Placer, and El Dorado County communities of Cameron Park, El Dorado Hills, Fair Oaks, Folsom, Granite Bay, Lincoln, Loomis, Orangevale, Penryn, Rocklin, Roseville, and Sheridan. ★
