Army Veteran Furniture Program Serves Once Homeless Vets

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - ABC Channel 10 News aired a 90-second prime-time special on Thursday, March 18, at 6 P.M. highlighting Frank Squire, U.S. Army veteran and member of American Legion Sacramento Legislative Action Post 861 in Sacramento, California, and his Furniture Program team which picks up and delivers home

furnishings to newly-housed, previously homeless veterans.

Previously, on Thursday, January 21, 2021, Frank received The Outstanding Member of the Year Award for the year 2020, for his work with the program, presented by Cmdr. Don Harper, American Legion Sacramento Legislative Action Post 861. COVID restrictions required some good old-fashioned American ingenuity to devise a way to surprise Frank with his well-earned award,

so, with a "Honey-Do" list of distractions provided by Frank's wife, Diana, a self-described military brat, Cmdr. Harper was able to assemble a small unit of retired 'ne'er do wells' from the post, including Bob Fitzgerald, Air Force; Don Sparks, Army; Dwight Davis, Navy WWII; Ernie Larson, Army; Lisa Harnett, daughter, and, of course, Diana.

Five years ago, Frank began volunteering at Mather VA Medical Center

Celebrating 100,000 Great Plates Meals

City of Rancho Cordova

Since the launch of the Great Plates Delivered program in May 2020, the City of Rancho Cordova, in partnership with local restaurants, has delivered over 100,000 nutritious meals to seniors and those vulnerable to COVID-19. Through this program, the city has also been able to provide over \$2 million in economic support to local businesses.

"The Great Plates Delivered program has been great," said Renee Morton, a participant since the program launched. "I'm saving money on groceries, and I don't have to go out and potentially expose myself to the virus."

The program was initially created by Governor Newsom to aid Californians impacted by the stay-at-home orders by delivering three free, healthy and delicious meals every day. But Rancho Cordova restaurants went above and beyond, delivering so much more than meals.

Many restaurants left residents positive notes and uplifting messages with their deliveries, learned what types of foods residents preferred, and developed entirely new menu items to accommodate certain health conditions. To show their appreciation, residents have sent thank you cards, letters and even paintings to restaurant staff.

"We were ready to strike up the band when we heard about the extension of the Great Plates Delivered program!" said a program participant. "We sincerely appreciate the good food and excellent customer service."

This program also allowed restaurants to provide their staff with additional hours while the stay-at-home orders were in place.

"I couldn't email back fast enough when I we received the invitation to participate in this program," said Jamal Kabir, Owner of BurgerIM. "It has kept our doors open and our 20 employees working every day!"

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Moving to a new home can be a big change for kids, so the Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce via the Explore Rancho Cordova program came up with a fun solution to help alleviate any woes and help them feel a part of the city - a coloring book with page after page showing local nearby destinations and attractions curated especially for the young. "We want to make them feel seen and welcome and teach them about their town," says Program Director Bee Lopez.

Explore Rancho Cordova welcomes new residents and employees to the city through receptions, a newsletter, and welcome bags filled with information, business offers and small gifts. It's the latter, where the coloring book titled *My Hometown: Let's EXPLORE* has just started appearing.

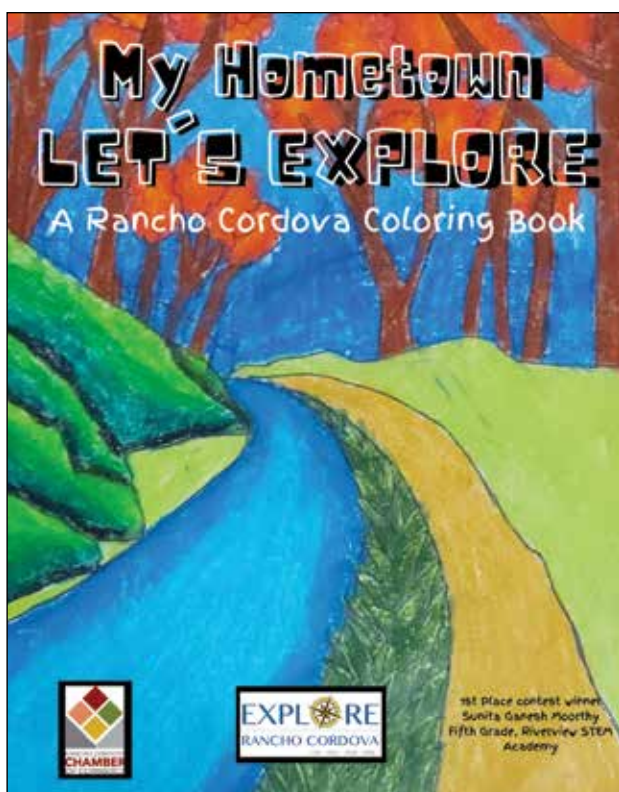

And as Lopez charmingly adds, "What's a coloring book without crayons?" She states a pack of colors will be included too.

Working with Chamber

President Diann Rogers, artist Cheryl Gleason of the Mills Station Arts and Culture Center as well as an advisory committee, production began in the fall of 2019 with

Lopez and Rogers generating content and Gleason illustrating. Calling Gleason's work (at times taken from actual photos) "outstanding", Lopez states "she took our vision and surpassed it."

Lopez says their goal with the coloring book was to get the kids "out and about exploring the town, recognizing places or give ideas of places to go." Accordingly, such iconic Rancho Cordova locations like the Children's Museum, Hagan Community Park and the American River Trail are depicted plus city info, questions, activities and other ways to inspire a child's imagination. Lopez hopes children will feel as much "plugged in, and part of community" as their parents.

Like practically everything in the past year, the project ran into snags due to the pandemic. For example, Lopez wanted to include local kids in the book's creation by holding

Local Adventurer's Podcast Discovers the 'Burbs

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - When the pandemic restrictions began in 2020, Sonia Weaver of Citrus Heights decided to start a podcast that she calls Discover the 'Burbs. "The original idea was . . . to let people know about the people who were suffering in their own communities, and hopefully encourage them to patronize local shops." Her more recent podcasts have evolved to chronicle the outdoor activities available in the suburbs of Sacramento. "Everyone wants to get out and be physical and find things to do," Sonia said, "but they sometimes just don't know where to go or what to do."

Sonia came up with an initial list of 58 locales, hikes, kayaking sites and activities to be enjoyed within a 50 mile radius of Sacramento. "I just keep adding to the list when I talk to people about the podcast," Sonia said. "They tell me about places . . . and the list just keeps getting longer."

The April 5 episode features pickleball, and for April 19, Sonia will be kayaking to Lake Natoma Island. Past episodes include hikes to Old Salmon Falls Bridge near El Dorado Hills,

and Middleridge Trail near Fair Oaks. Currently the episodes come out every other week. "I enjoy so much getting out in nature," Sonia said. "It gives me a reason to go explore new places, and so for me this is a perfect project . . . One of my favorite things is taking along friends that I haven't normally hiked and gone on adventures with." She went to the Old Salmon Falls hike with the Bartletts - Jake, Shamay and three of their five children. In addition, Discover the 'Burbs podcast helps people know what to expect and how to prepare. "I would love if people want to suggest places that they love to visit, that they would like to share," Sonia said. To make suggestions, just e-mail discovertheburbs@gmail.com

Sonia's husband Richard Weaver, who is an avid runner, said that Sonia always needs something to do. "This is a really great project for her," Richard said. "I've listened to them all . . . but the people that are just talking about their lives, those are the ones I like best." Sonia's podcast of January 18, 2021, titled "Creating Your Own Limits" features Richard.

Sonia is a longtime resident of the Sacramento area and teaches Spanish

at Bella Vista High School. She is a world traveler as well, having visited Nicaragua a couple of times, where she helped establish a program to teach English to children at an orphanage. "If they begin to learn English," Sonia said, "they can get a job in the tourism industry, which is much more lucrative than most other things they can do." She has also traveled to Italy and Spain, and in Central America to Honduras, Belize, and Mexico. She lived a year and a half in Argentina.

To listen on an iPhone people can use Apple podcast, Spotify, or other apps, and for Android, Google Play; also people download apps like iHeartRadio or Stitcher. It is on the Web at <https://www.buzzsprout.com/1247372>.

Originally the purpose of the podcast was to promote getting to know those that live around you, to foster love and understanding. The current subject of hikes and activities near Sacramento fits into that purpose quite well, as families go outside and bring their friends and neighbors. Sonia felt that one reason there is such a lack of love in the world is that people just don't know each other. "I was hoping that if people could just get to know those that live around them, they would see that we share lots in common," Sonia said. "We are all passing through the same things, and it would encourage people to reach out to people around them as well." ★

Traffic Safety Partners Stress Dangers of Distracted Driving

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The California Highway Patrol (CHP), California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) and Impact Teen Drivers (ITD) are working together this April to remind Californians of the dangers of not giving the road their full attention when behind the wheel as part of Distracted Driving Awareness Month.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration reports 3,142 people were killed in motor vehicle crashes involving distracted drivers in 2019 nationwide. That same year in California, there were at least 18,698 crashes from distracted driving that resulted in 108 deaths and more than 13,500 injuries.

"Driving safely requires your full attention," CHP Commissioner Amanda Ray said. "Distractions put you and others on the road at risk. Together, with our traffic safety partners, enforcement, and the cooperation of the motoring public, we can save lives and eliminate this dangerous behavior on California's roadways." ★

Distractions are not limited to cellular phones. Other electronics, children, pets, and eating or drinking while driving can also divert attention and result in a crash.

Breaking distracted driving laws becomes more serious this year. Beginning July 1, a violation for using a handheld cellular phone or texting while driving will result in a fine and also add a point to the driver's record for each violation occurring within 36 months of a prior conviction for the same offense.

"Distracted driving is a serious issue that is 100 percent preventable," OTS Director Barbara Rooney said. "That text, phone call, or social post is never more important than the task of driving."

As part of Distracted Driving Awareness Month, the first week of April is California Teen Safe Driving Week. Throughout the week, CHP and ITD will place an increased emphasis on informing California's newest drivers about the dangers and consequences of reckless and distracted driving.

"Parents, your kids have been watching you drive since they were in a forward-facing car seat," Kelly Browning, Ph.D., executive director of ITD, said. "Your driving habits will become their driving habits - be the driver you want your kids to be."

The mission of the CHP is to provide the highest level of Safety, Service, and Security. ★

in California by providing rides to patients in need. It wasn't long before Frank found himself being asked by Volunteer Services to deliver some items of home furnishings to the new living quarters of enrolled formerly homeless veterans at the request of Mather VA social workers who were implementing the HUD-VASH program. The U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development-VA Supportive Housing (HUD-VASH) program is a collaborative program between HUD and VA which combines HUD housing vouchers with VA supportive services to help homeless veterans and their families find and sustain permanent housing.

With Diana's support and encouragement, Frank's furniture delivery program grew along with other hospital programs, and he found himself coordinating the work of several volunteers from within American Legion Post 861 and VFW Post 10125 as well as family members, friends, and even veterans who received furniture. Eventually, Frank was paying for as many as seven storage units himself, and delivering furniture to Woodland, Davis, Jackson, Elk Grove, Del Paso, and to all cities in the Greater Sacramento Area. These home furnishings have been picked up from donors by members of the volunteer furniture team, and were initially stored in 10'x20' commercial

storage units and delivered to the new living quarters of enrolled formerly homeless veterans at the request of Mather VA social workers who are implementing the HUD-VASH program. As the program grew, so did the storage requirements that were not donated. Frank has been struggling for several years to get help from Mather VA and local government to provide storage facilities, and to acquire some financial support from local Veterans Service Organizations to help take some of the load off, so he wouldn't have to continue paying for the needed storage units himself, but without much success.

Over the years, volunteers who have helped Frank with the furniture delivery program include Diana Squire, Dana & Ruth Johnson, Roger Meier, James Sullivan, William Holmes, Ed McDaniels, Brian Womack, John Lowe, Brent Downend, Peter & Lisa Harnett and their son Owen and daughter Lily, Mike Harris, Janet

Whetstone, plus several formerly homeless vets.

CONGRATULATIONS and THANK YOU, Frank, and to all of you who have volunteered your time, hard work, vehicles, and gasoline to deliver home furnishings to many hundreds of grateful formerly homeless veterans!

Kiefer Landfill Accepting Treated Wood Waste

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG)

- Treated wood, or pressure-treated wood, has been treated with a chemical preservative to protect it from decay. It is considered hazardous waste by the state of California. Fence posts and decking material are the most common household uses. It is also found in guardrail posts, railroad ties and pilings.

On Jan. 1, the state law that allowed disposal of treated wood waste in California landfills expired. As a result, acceptance of treated wood waste at the Kiefer Landfill – and for landfills across the state – was suspended.

The Sacramento County Department of Waste Management and Recycling applied for and received a variance from the state to accept the material.

Pandemic has Damaged California's School Children

A comprehensive history of the COVID-19 pandemic's effect on California would surely conclude that the state's school children have been treated shamefully.

The incessant political squabbling over closing and reopening schools, and the sporadic efforts at in-home learning, have once again demonstrated that the supposed adults who manage and operate public education in California are more focused on their own interests than on the wellbeing of students.

Indeed, one could easily describe what has happened and not happened in the schools as child neglect on a massive scale.

California schools were not a roaring success even before pandemic struck more than a year ago. By almost any measure, we lagged behind other states, particularly in meeting the needs of the more than three million students classified as poor or English-learners.

The many billions of dollars that the Legislature appropriated to improve their outcomes under former Gov. Jerry Brown's Local Control Funding Formula were often misdirected with little accountability.

When the coronavirus

reared its ugly head, schools were quickly shuttered and educators scrambled to replace classroom instruction with at-home instruction via the Internet. But once again, many of the children already at risk of failure were left behind, lacking the resources and/or familial support to participate.

The damage has been huge, widening the already yawning gap between the at-risk students and their more privileged peers. A new report on impacts in Los Angeles Unified School District, the nation's second largest school system, reveals the extent of the damage.

LA Unified's classrooms have been closed for more than a year and will only begin to reopen later this month, largely due to conflicts between the district's managers and its unions – a syndrome that's delayed reopening in many large urban districts.

"The COVID-19 pandemic has interrupted the livelihoods, health, education, childcare, and financial stability of millions," says the report issued by Great Public Schools, a local advocacy group. "Students in Los Angeles Unified School District...are experiencing the painful loss of connection with their peers, teachers and school staff, and serious loss of learning that will have life-long consequences if not addressed."

"We may not know the full impact of this last year on our students for another year or more, but the preliminary data we have paints an alarming picture," the report adds.

Among the specific findings, based on LA Unified's own data:

40% of LAUSD middle and high schoolers were disengaged or absent from classes in spring 2020; Disengagement was likely even higher for elementary students; More than 13,000 middle and high school students were consistently disengaged in fall 2020. An additional 56,000 did not actively participate on a daily basis; Two-thirds of LA Unified students are falling behind in literacy and math. Fewer young students of color are on target in reading skills compared to a year earlier; Across all academic progress indicators, students of color, low-income students, English learners, foster children, students with disabilities and homeless students have been set back further than their more advantaged peers; Many high school students are at risk of not graduating. Currently, 20% of the class of 2021, 43% of the class of 2022, 37% of the class of 2023, and 30% of the class of 2024 will not graduate.

These numbers are – or should be – shocking and embarrassing to every adult involved in the operation of California schools, from Gov. Gavin Newsom downward. Not only are the futures of the affected children dimmer but their educational lapses will affect the entire state for decades to come.

Is At Home Recovery After a Transplant Covered by Medicare?

Reader Alert:

This week, I received a text message from one of Toni Says® Medicare clients that I would like to share with the Toni Says® readers. You may never

know when you or one of your family members will experience a life changing medical diagnosis. The text reads:

Toni: I need to put together a 24/7 home care recovery plan after a liver transplant. The surgery is over a year out, but I would appreciate some tips on Medicare and how to plan for this event. Thanks in advance, a Toni Says client. (name withheld for confidentiality)

To My Readers:

This text made me realize that America is not prepared for a life changing medical need such as a transplant.

Luckily, my client has Original Medicare with a Medicare Supplement allowing him and his team of medical providers together to pick which rehab/skilled facility and home health agency he will use while recuperating from his liver transplant.

In the Medicare and You handbook, there is a segment in Section 2 that discusses transplants and immunosuppressive drugs. It states that “you **must** have Part A in place at time of the covered transplant and that you **must** have Part B at the time you get immunosuppressive drugs. You pay 20% of the Medicare approved amount for the drugs and the Part B deductible applies.”

It also discusses that “Medicare covers doctor services for heart, lung, kidney, pancreas, intestine and liver transplants under certain conditions, but only in Medicare-certified facilities.”

The handbook also states, “if you’re thinking about joining a Medicare Advantage Plan (like an HMO or PPO) and are on a transplant waiting list or believe you need a transplant, check with the Medicare Advantage plan before you

join to make sure your doctors, other health care providers, and hospitals are in the plan’s network. Also, check the plan’s coverage rules for prior authorization.”

Note: Medicare drug plans (Part D) may cover immunosuppressive drugs if Medicare Part B doesn’t cover them. In other words, be sure you have a complete Medicare Part D planning consultation before you enroll in a specific Medicare Part D plan to be sure that the Part D plan chosen covers all your transplant drugs as well as prescriptions you take daily.

If your Part D plan does not cover your transplant prescription drugs, then who will pay **You will!**

Regarding my client’s question about Medicare paying for 24/7 at home care while he is recuperating from his liver transplant, I do not have good news.

Medicare pays **absolutely nothing** for at home care while recuperating from a transplant or any illness. Medicare will pay for home health visits if there is a doctor’s order and it meets Medicare requirements.

Medicare will only pay for rehab or skilled nursing. If you do not meet Medicare’s qualifications for skilled nursing, you will pay 100% of the cost out of your pocket

I have informed my client to begin speaking with what is called at-home provider services, his church, or friends about getting their help with round-the-clock help at home to help his wife. If he has a long-term care policy, it may pick up some costs.

In today’s financial climate, America has new long-term care options to maximize the 401K capabilities and get more bang for your 401K dollars!
