RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - There are two new murals in town located at Folsom Cordova Community Partnership, thanks to a grant written by FCCP Director of Programs Michele Cook funded by the city's Community Enhancement Fund.

The first mural is "The Reading Tree" appropriately located behind the organization's Free Little Library. The mural, designed and painted by Shannon Scott and Griffin, is,

according to Cook, a gathering place for children and their parents to read.

"Our hope was that it would be something kids would look forward to seeing when they come in, to welcome them, and cause them to have their attention drawn to the Free Little Library where they could then

sit and read a book with their parent."

The second, and by far the largest of the two, is "Welcome to Rancho Cordova," a 50 plus foot mural that

CA Has Some of the Worst Drivers

If you're constantly frustrated with the drivers you share the streets with, you're not alone. And there may be some truth to your road rage. Car crashes are a leading cause of death in the US and were expected to cause around 40,000 deaths by the end of 2018.

To put it plainly, America's roads are dangerous. Texting behind the wheel is a major reason for many traffic fatalities, and it's only getting worse. In 2016, 3,450 people were killed by distracted driving. Plus, cheap gas and a strong economy means America's 222 million licensed drivers are driving more than ever. More people on the road leads to more accidents and citations.

Every state has their share of bad drivers, but some are worse than others. We ranked all states from worst to best based on the methodology outlined at the end of the article. These states have the worst drivers, in order; Maine, South Carolina, Nebraska, California, and North Dakota.

The US has been politically polarized for a long time. But after the 2016 presidential elections and the 2018 midterms, there's a rising divide between Democrats and Republicans. We took it upon ourselves to settle the score by determining which political party is better behind the wheel.

So, which is it- red or blue? The final score is a bit of a tossup. Considering two-thirds of the best driving states are historically red, and the worst driving state is blue, it looks like red takes the lead. But, the second and third worst driving states are conservative strongholds. So, we're calling it a tie.

Whether you live among the best or the worst drivers in the country, you still need a strong auto insurance policy. Especially if you live in Maine, South Carolina, Nebraska, California, North Dakota, or one of America's worst driving states.

Your rates depend in part on how well the people around you can drive. Why? Because the more bad drivers there are on the road, the higher the chance of a collision. Even if you're a fantastic driver, living in a state full of speed demons or reckless traffic weavers can cause your rates to skyrocket. Car insurance companies look at your zip code to determine your prices. And if your zip code has a propensity for poor driving, you'll pay more for coverage.

The rankings are a sum of weighted means calculated from these incidents: Accidents; Speeding tickets; DUIs; Citations; Fatalities.

SACRAMENTO, CA - The Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) Board of Directors approved a new bus network proposal, which comprehensively redesigns SacRT's bus system. "We are excited to begin the process of rolling out our new bus network in a few months," said SacRT General Manager/CEO Henry Li. "To ensure the success of the new network, SacRT will conduct frequent monitoring of the new bus service to optimize and adjust service where it's needed most."

A draft plan was released for public review on December 10, 2018. Since then, major outreach efforts took place to let riders and stakeholders know about the proposed plan, called SacRT Forward.

Based on the comments received, and reviewing ridership and demographic data, staff spent the past two and half months making adjustments to the plan. A revised bus network proposal was released for public review on February 18, 2019, and approved

by the SacRT Board of Directors on February 25, 2019. The new service is expected to start in summer 2019.

"We have been actively listening to our riders and the community for the past year and a half to make changes that will best fit their lifestyle and help improve mobility options for the Sacramento region," said SacRT Board Chair and Sacramento County Supervisor Patrick Kennedy. "Travel patterns have changed, regional mobility options have been expanded and development has occurred on the periphery."

The focus of the new network has been on building a solid network of core routes on major corridors that will lead to economic growth and reduce congestion. Adjustments have been made to almost every route, some minor and some much more substantial, which will provide improved schedules and better service reliability. The new network consists of: 27 regular routes; 14 peak hour only routes; All routes have 7-day service (with the exception of bus route 33); All routes have

45 minute or better service (with the exception of one rural route); Complements the new 15-minute weekend light rail service

In many areas that don't have high demand for fixed-route bus service, or are not designed for large buses to navigate the neighborhood, SacRT will deploy Smart Ride micro-transit service.

Annual bus ridership is forecasted to go up between 400,000 and 1,000,000 boardings a year with the new service improvements. For route by route details, visit sacrt.com/sacrtforward.

SacRT operates approximately 70 bus routes (fixed-route, dial-a-ride and microtransit) and 43 miles of light rail all within a 400-square mile service area throughout Sacramento County, which includes service in the cities of Citrus Heights, Folsom, Rancho Cordova and Elk Grove. Sacramento buses and light rail trains operate 365 days a year. SacRT's entire bus and light rail system is accessible to the disabled community. ADA services are provided under contract with Paratransit, Inc. ★

begins just down the hall from "The Reading Tree" and opens with a big, whimsical sun shining bright and smiling a welcome and wraps around the corner and down the remainder of the wall. This mural was created by Sacramento-based artist Demetris Washington (BAMR).

Washington's murals are located in Sacramento, Stockton, and Oakland, and tend to be what Cook referred to as edgier than what she was looking for – family-friendly and fun.

Center, and the Sunrise foot bridge. Events like the California Capital Air Show at Mather, carnivals, and the REMAX hot air balloon are highlighted.

Bicycles roam the trail, a nod to the many cyclists who ride for fun and those who will participate in this year's AMGEN Tour of California, which will begin Stage 2 in Rancho Cordova on May 13. The Golden Poppy, *Eschscholtzia californica*, California's state flower,

throughout the mural are what he calls creative blocks. The closer people look, the more they see, including how Washington integrated signage and hardware into the mural because they could not be moved, unlike the mural which moves with each person who walks down the hallway.

"It is an opportunity to engage families and kids who come here every day," said FCCP Executive Director Robert Sanger, referring to the myriad programs and services the agency provides to families, parents, and children.

The mural is being praised by everyone from children and families, who in addition to touching and photographing it, said that it is really fun to look at, to Rancho Cordova's mayor.

"A Day in Rancho Cordova" mural does a remarkable job of showing the history of our City from Mather AFB to Hagan Park and more. We are proud to support local art in Rancho Cordova, and I'd like to thank everyone involved who made this piece of artwork truly come to life," wrote Mayor McGarvey.



Mead is a wine that uses honey as a fermentable sugar. Strad Meadery uses Sacramento wildflower honey with several crisp flavors and concoctions, including traditional nectar mead, apricot, pomegranate, cherry, cranberry and strawberry nectar meads. And did we mention that it's gluten-free!?

Mead, or as the ancients call it, "Nectar of the Gods," is now available at Strad Meadery, and has been produced by mead maker Dan Slort since 2011.

"Rancho Cordova has been awesome! No one else offered to help us as much as Rancho Cordova. The City was thrilled to have a meadery, and they made the process as pain-free as can be," said Dan Slort. "I can't say enough good things about how the City has been."

The Mayor's Corner

It never hurts to help people when you can

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - I visited Robert J. McGarvey Elementary School on March 1, 2019 and read Dr. Seuss books to first, third and fourth grade classes in celebration of Read Across America Day and Dr. Seuss' Birthday. It is a wonderful way and a wonderful day to celebrate reading. When I asked the first graders if they were reading Dr. Seuss, they all raised their hands. Almost all of the third graders did too, and the fourth graders were about half and half for Dr. Seuss and Harry Potter. It was a great way to learn that the kids are moving forward in their reading. Whether our students are reading Dr. Seuss, Harry Potter or other choices that are offered to them at school, I am glad to know they enjoy reading. Other City Council members visited other schools in Rancho Cordova, and some of our Rancho Cordova Police Officers also participated in Read Across America Day.

The current exhibit at the Mills Station Arts and Culture Center (The MACC), which is located adjacent to the Mather Field/Mills light rail station, started on February 28 and will continue through March 9. It is called Carriage Return: The Art of Typography. There are some truly

antique typewriters featured in the exhibit, and there are a few set up so people can see and feel what a difference there is typing on typewriters versus the typing that is done today using computers. Everything that is on display was truly interesting, but the one thing that really caught my attention were the pictures (art) that were done just using a typewriter. The information next to the pictures and the typewriter tells the story of how patient the gentleman had to be as he typed one key at a time to complete the pictures, and so forth. If you are able to visit The MACC before the exhibit closes, please go. I remember seeing some of the typewriters that were used when I was in high school. I usually looked at them because I didn't take a typing class. So my method when I tried was the biblical method of "seek, and ye shall find."

The Veterans Success Center at the Folsom Lake College Main Campus is a place where veterans can go to have questions answered when someone is there, and veterans can also use the computers available. It hasn't been open very long, and both the volunteer and manager are not there all the time. The college is trying to find some revenue, around \$60,000, so they can hire someone on a permanent basis. We just had our first meeting at Folsom Lake College to learn what the goals of the Veterans Success Center are, and what and who is there. The college's main

goal is to be able to hire someone on a full-time basis. There are eight full-time employees at the Veterans Center at Sacramento Community College, so I imagine it will take some time for Folsom Lake College to reach numbers like that. However, just having one full-time employee will be a big leap forward for them. Our committee will be reaching out to those who don't mind putting in some time and effort so the Veterans Center at Folsom Lake College will be able to help veterans who need a question answered, or who will need many questions answered. It never hurts to help people when you can. "Be kinder than necessary, for everyone you meet is fighting some kind of battle." - Author unknown

Matt Roush: I was startled to see *Counterpart* axed so abruptly on the eve of its second-season finale. It may have been a cult hit at best, but a network like Starz could use a few more of those. But as with many outlets in this turbulent

industry, Starz is undergoing some corporate and executive changes, and marginal series tend to become casualties. It's always possible that the producing studio could shop it to a new home—and streaming a show this addictive and dense makes the most sense—but even with J.K. 





Sac County Extended Foster Care Program Offers More

By Andrea Hansen, Sacramento County

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Each year in Sacramento County, approximately 170 youths turn 18 years old while in foster care - which for many can mean they will be without a family and often without supportive adults in their lives as they age out of the system. But, most 18-year-olds still need financial help, emotional support and other assistance as they enter adulthood and begin to plan for the future.

The Extended Foster Care program - provided through Sacramento County Department of Child, Family and Adult Services - allows 18 to 21-year-olds to stay in foster care with the intent of providing them with supportive housing while also teaching independent living skills to help them achieve self-sufficiency.

The program began in Sacramento County in January 2012, and social workers assist the young adults in maintaining a safety net of support while offering the experience of independent living in a secure and supervised environment. As of December 2018, approximately 360 youth are actively participating in the program.

To qualify, youth must meet one of five conditions: Be in the process of completing high school or an equivalent program (GED); Be enrolled in a university, vocational school or community college at least half-time; Be employed at least 80 hours a month; Participate in a

program designed to promote employment or remove barriers to employment; Be unable to meet the above requirements due to a medical condition.

County social workers work closely with the youth to determine which housing program will best suit their needs. Housing options include: Supervised Independent Living Placement (SILP); Least restrictive and most popular placement; Allows youth to select their own housing and live independently; Must participate in a readiness assessment that determines the youth's level of preparedness for independence including identifying strengths in areas such as budgeting, daily living skills and safety; Receive a monthly stipend; Meet monthly with a County social worker.

Transitional Housing Placement Plus Foster Care (THP+FC) assists with costs associated with rent, and provides a monthly stipend for utilities, furnishings, food and other necessities. You are required to meet weekly with a THP+FC

social worker/case manager and meet monthly with a County social worker. It offers links to experts in the community to help in the navigation of jobs, resumes, applications, higher education and financial aid.

The Independent Living Program (ILP) provides financial assistance and services to current and former foster/probation youth, 16-20 years of age and offers assistance with vital documents, life skills classes, support groups, transportation and tutoring.

"Youth who agree to participate in the Extended Foster Care Program demonstrate more positive outcomes in areas such as employment, education and housing stability than their peers who do not," said Stephanie Sandmeier, Human Services Program Planner. "This program is vital to help our young adults move forward and make the right decisions for their future."

Extended Foster Care is proud to partner with iFoster, a national non-profit which has developed a jobs program specifically

for eligible foster youth between the ages of 17 and 24. iFoster helps prepare foster youth for the workforce by providing a curriculum focused on job skills, soft skills and life skills. The non-profit also partners with major employers like Raley's, Starbucks and CVS. When young people are ready for a job, they can be matched with a potential employer. iFoster matches youth with employers offering permanent employment, guaranteed hours, decent wages, opportunities for advancement and scholarship programs.

Now '23,222 Prohibited Persons' Have Guns. This is Progress?



From the Office of Senator Nielsen

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Attorney General Xavier Becerra issued the annual report on the Armed Prohibited Persons System (APPS), a program designed to remove guns from convicted felons and dangerous individuals. A proponent of the APPS program and former Chairman of the Board of Prison Terms, Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama) issued the following statement:

"Known dangerous criminals must not be in possession of guns. The Attorney General and his agents are making an effort toward that goal.

"I appreciate that Attorney General Becerra is now focused on removing guns from dangerous individuals.

"The program, however, has failed to reduce the number of guns belonging to known criminals and potentially

dangerous people. "The AG identified obstacles and problems, but pointing the finger at the courts, district attorneys and local law enforcements for the delay is not acceptable.

"In 2013, there were 20,721 names on this list. Now, there are 23,222.

"Over the years, I have asked the AG, privately and publicly, to develop a strategy to remove guns from known criminals and potentially dangerous people and keep Californians safe. I appreciate that he has come forward with a plan.

"I would like to see in the AG's plan a delegation of local law enforcement agencies to assist.

"We cannot afford to wait a year to assess this program's progress. Too much is at stake. The Legislature should receive an update in the budget hearings."

Elected to the State Senate in January 2013, Senator Nielsen represents the Fourth Senate District, which includes the counties of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba. Defendants Sentenced for Multiple Armed Robberies

DATE: February 22, 2019
CASE: Ceariaco Cabrellis & Frank Moppins (Case #16FE002475)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Scott Schweibish, Career Criminal Prosecution Unit

The Honorable Allen Sumner sentenced Frank Moppins to 25 years in prison. An allegation that Moppins has a prior strike conviction for first-degree burglary was found true at the sentencing hearing. Ceariaco Cabrellis was previously sentenced to 27 years, 8 months in prison.

On September 26, 2018, a jury convicted Ceariaco Cabrellis and Frank Moppins of four counts of robbery with the allegation Cabrellis and Moppins personally used a firearm during the robberies. Cabrellis was also found to have caused great bodily injury to one of the victims.

On February 4, 2016, Ceariaco Cabrellis and Frank Moppins were at a park smoking marijuana. When they saw the four victims arrive at the park, the defendants asked them if they had any marijuana to sell or to smoke. The victims replied they did not have any marijuana and left. The defendants followed the victims, approached them and asked again if they had any marijuana. Cabrellis and Moppins then pulled out a gun and ordered the victims to get on the ground face down. When one of the victims refused, Cabrellis pistol whipped him causing a broken orbital socket and broken nose. The defendants proceeded to rob the victims of items they had in their possession before fleeing the scene.

Cabrellis had two pending felony cases against him at the time of this offense.

Defendant Convicted of Hotel Room Murder

DATE: February 14, 2019
CASE: Mario Michael Mayorga (Case #16FE022652)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Caroline Park, Homicide Unit
 Mario Michael Mayorga was convicted by a jury of the first-degree

murder of Tina Morales. The jury also found true that Mayorga used a deadly weapon during the murder.

Mario Michael Mayorga and the victim were in a dating relationship. On November 24, 2016, Thanksgiving Day, the victim checked into a motel near Stockton Boulevard and Mack Road. The victim had Thanksgiving dinner with Mayorga and the two then walked to a friend's house. Another friend drove the two back to the victim's motel room at 1:30 a.m. At 11:30 a.m. that day, motel employees found the victim with multiple stab and puncture wounds.

Allegations that Mayorga suffered two prior strike convictions for assault with a firearm and assault with a deadly weapon will be determined at the sentencing hearing.

Mayorga faces a maximum sentence of 75 years to life in prison. Sentencing is set for March 15, 2019, at 10:30 a.m. in Department 10 before the Honorable Eugene Balonon.

Defendant Sentenced for Murder, Attempted Murder for shooting at Cinco de Mayo Party

DATE: February 11, 2019
CASE: Kejhonne Henderson (Case #17FE008447)

PROSECUTOR: Deputy District Attorney Caroline Park, Homicide Unit

The Honorable Stacy Boulware Eurie sentenced Kejhonne Henderson to 72 years to life in prison. On November 16, 2018, a jury convicted Henderson of the second-degree murder of Jordan Pannell and attempted murder. The jury also found true firearm allegations on both counts.

On May 5, 2017, Kejhonne Henderson was at a Cinco de Mayo house party in North Highlands. When Henderson got upset about the Mozy music being played, Jordan Pannell intervened. Henderson and Pannell walked outside, where Henderson shot Pannell nine times, killing him. As Henderson tried to flee, he was tackled by the second victim and the two struggled over the gun. Henderson shot that victim in the thigh. The second shooting victim survived his wounds. ★

Lancers Struggle Against McClatchy

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Some days, it's just not your day.

It didn't take long for the Cordova Lancers' varsity baseball team to find out it wasn't their day during their contest last Friday at McClatchy, with the game only lasting five innings as the Lions ran away with an 11-0 victory.

The Lancers (0-2 overall) stumbled out the gate defensively, surrendering three runs in the first inning to begin what was a difficult outing for the club. It would continue to snowball for the Lancers in the second inning as Cordova

freshman first baseman/#3 pitcher Matthew Jernigan was given his first varsity start and struggled early, giving up eight runs on six hits in one and one-third innings, including four costly errors. Junior Dylan Murphy entered the game in the second inning in relief of Jernigan but did not fare much better, giving up three runs on three hits in two-thirds of an inning.

Before they could blink, Cordova found themselves down by double digits. The Lancers didn't fare any better offensively as they did not record a single hit in the contest, with McClatchy senior pitcher Theo Dopkins recording a no-hitter, including 11

strikeouts in four innings of work. Offensively for the Lions, eight different players recorded hits.

The game was called after five innings due to the 10-run mercy rule coming into effect.

"We made two errors early in the game that cost us five runs right off the bat," Lancers head coach Doug Hughes said afterward. "Four errors in the game cost us nine unearned runs. That's the story of our first two games."

Hughes expected some growing pains this season as he brings along a young club, and despite the lopsided defeat, he isn't worried about his team's 0-2 start.

"I'm not concerned because we really haven't been on the field much because of the weather," Hughes said. "We're way behind the eight-ball here. I'm not worried about pre-season games. I'm worried about league. That's all I care about."

Although league wins are a long term goal, Hughes also recognizes that his team needs to get their offense on track in the short term, having scored just two runs in their first two games this season. He made no bones about it when asked what his team will be doing at practice going forward.

"We'll be in the cage, I'll tell you that." ★

The Art of TYPINGOGRAPHY

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Before keyboarding class in high school and college, there was typing class where students diligently learned the QWERTY keyboard, practiced timed writings of one, three, and five minutes, learned how to correct errors, and participated in production typing. There was no paper clip to help with questions, no autocorrect feature to correct one mistake and create another, and there was no ten-key pad off to the right. The numbers were located above the letters.

The newest exhibit at Mills Art and Culture Center (MACC) features typewriters owned by Kae Sable, editor of Dime Show Review. They are electric and manual. One folds for better portability. Some are colorful. Some have rust. Some include cases, and one huge unit was used by accountants. Each machine has a sign with the name, date, and country of origin. And she brought some electric typewriters for gallery visitors to try.

Sable and Cheryl Gleason met about a year ago during an exhibit at the MACC, and the idea began to form once

Gleason learned of Sable's collection. Gleason put a call out for art featuring letters, numbers, fonts, and received entries from near and far. Thirty four artists had work juried into the exhibit, which opened February 28 to more than 100 visitors.

From Nikki Thompson's "Collapse" art book to Ron Hall's Ouija board and eyechart constructed from wood to works in encaustic, mixed media, and created with the use of stencils,

newspapers, ink, watercolor, and painted, glued, and built up, there was something for all fans of the written or printed word.

Katherine Kunz-Davies' two mid-century modern pieces, "Snacks" and "Peace," were stationed across from snacks and were reminiscent of signs from drive-in or single screen movie theaters. She found her inspiration while creating Christmas cards and kept, she said, running across mid-century signage. The letters are all found pieces and she said, smiling, that she wanted to create a sign reading "Friends" but could not find the letters so she created "Peace."

Throughout the gallery, artists talked, answered questions about their art, and supporters read poems, eye charts, word searches, and leaned in for closer looks at pieces like Amy and Joann Solov's collage, "1964 Typing Text," and other pieces that required greater inspection to see that the letters were formed from smaller letters, from hand-drawn illustrations, or from newspapers.

Sable briefly spoke about her collection, the history of the QWERTY keyboard, and some of the typewriters to Rancho Cordova Arts members and taught a pamphlet stitch book making workshop on March 2.

"The pamphlet stitch make n' take workshop was filled to capacity," wrote Sable. "Everyone left with a simple, but very useful structure that can evolve into other projects."

Sable began collecting typewriters three years ago and currently owns more than 70. A Smith-Corona Coronet Electric she purchased for \$20 at a thrift store was her first.

"I thought I'd never have a printing press, so - the typewriter became my personal printing press," she wrote in an email.

Two years ago, Sable was given a Vandercook Universal III printing press. She is the third owner of a press that began its life at The Washington Post where it was used during the tumultuous years from 1960 through 1972 and undoubtedly holds many secrets.

She collects, cleans, restores, and researches them. And she uses them. She drafts most of her writing on the typewriter because it offers her "freedom from distraction" and temptations of the computer. She cites sound as an important component to the experience of typing and calls typing an accomplishment at the end of the day when she has a stack of pages to show for her work and not simply a computer file.





About the exhibit, she wrote "Cheryl Gleason is AMAZING! Her vision for the show is pure genius. I am completely impressed by her capability to pull threads together for a cohesive event. The art in the show is dynamic and varies and some of it is very clever. The entire show is simply marvelous - something for everyone."

The exhibit closes March 9 with another book making workshop at noon.
