Free COVID Testing

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Sacramento County Public Health wants to remind the public that COVID-19 testing is free and more appointments are available at 11 locations in Sacramento County.

Starting Sept. 14, these locations are now open longer to schedule testing appointments for anyone (2 years old and older) in the County. The public is encouraged to get tested regularly, especially in the event that physical distancing measures could not be maintained.

"If you have spent time with people outside of your household and you weren't able to physically distance, you should consider getting tested because you may have been exposed unknowingly to the COVID virus," said, Sacramento County Health Officer, Dr. Olivia Kasirye. "It is also important to remember that if you test negative once, that does not mean you will not get sick with COVID-19. The test result only means that you did not have COVID-19 at the time you were tested."

The number of new COVID-19 cases in Sacramento County is steadily reducing on the Dashboard.

However, the public needs to continue to not gather, follow physical distancing measures, wear face coverings in public, wash our hands and get tested regularly in order to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our community.

View the new schedule with extended hours to make your appointment today for free COVID-19 testing.

The Sacramento County COVID-19 website also has information for what to do for those who test positive for COVID-19.

Shelter Dogs Get a Break

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Sacramento County's Bradshaw Animal Shelter is offering a new Dog Day Out Program to the public that allows applicants to check out a dog for a day. The program was created and is being implemented by Sacramento Shelter Pets Alive (SSPA) – an organization that works within the shelter to offer daily enrichment and behavior training, adoption counseling and promotions, as well as outdoor playgroups for the shelter's large breed dog population. The Dog Day Out Program gives shelter dogs a break from the stresses of shelter life which can be loud, unfamiliar and sometimes scary.

Many shelter dogs have already benefited from program activities like: Hiking; Walking along the river; Picnicking at the park; Grabbing a 'puppuccino'; Cuddling on the couch.

While we continue to face many uncertainties this year, "this program is helping to lift spirits in our community," said Sacramento Shelter Pets Alive Director, Delyse Gannaway. "It's about improving quality of life for our community and our animals."

Individuals 18 years of age and older can apply by filling out an online application with SSPA. The organization then matches applicants with an available shelter dog and a curbside checkout is scheduled.

The Dog Day Out Program is not the only new shelter service available to the public during COVID-19 modified operations. Those interested in adopting a shelter pet can view a list of available pets online then call the new adoption appointment line a 916-875-2287 between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. daily (except holidays). Those interested in fostering can now apply online.

Walk-in licensing services are also available between noon and 4:30 p.m. Tuesday – Sunday, at 3839 Bradshaw Road, Sacramento CA, 95827 and online via the Bradshaw Animal Shelter's website. Along with these new services, the monthly Rabies and Vaccinations Clinic at the shelter resumes with modified outdoor operations on Oct. 15 from 3 – 5 p.m.

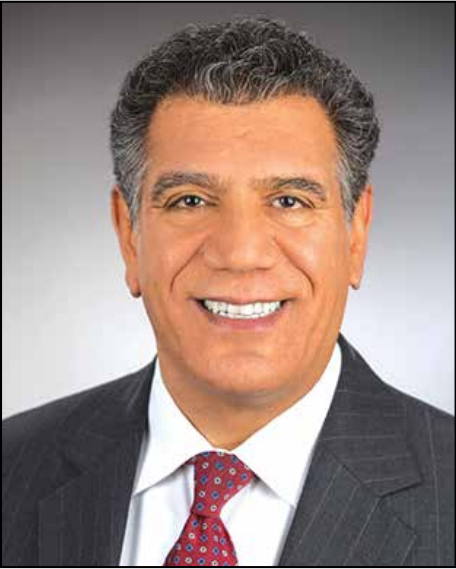

A Message about the Upcoming Election

Dear Rancho Cordova Resident,

In response to recent events and the community’s feedback, the Rancho Cordova City Council has placed Measure R, a local recovery and relief ½ cent sales tax, on the November ballot for voter consideration. If enacted, Measure R will provide an estimated \$8 million each year to fund community priorities identified by Rancho Cordova residents, including:

Keeping public areas healthy, safe and clean; Repairing city streets and potholes; Ensuring the city is prepared for any natural disaster or health emergency; Supporting programs to attract new businesses and jobs to Rancho Cordova; Helping address homelessness issues; Removing blight and revitalizing vacant buildings along commercial corridors.

Funds generated by Measure R would only be used in the City of Rancho Cordova, and Measure R would require annual audits and citizen oversight. During these challenging times, Measure R would ensure funds for infrastructure projects, including repairing streets and potholes. Also, this Measure would allow the city to support existing businesses, as well as attract more retail, restaurants and recreation opportunities, to continue making our city a place where all generations want to live and put down roots, even after the crisis is over. Also on Rancho Cordova’s November 3rd Municipal ballot, residents will have the opportunity to vote for three City Council Members. The Rancho Cordova City Council is comprised of five Council Members, who serve four-year terms. These terms are staggered, and so are the elections of the Council Members. This year, residents will vote for three City Council Members. In the next general election, residents will vote for two City Council Members. 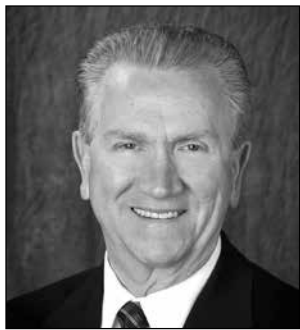

Department of Health Services has partnered with UC Davis Health, StemExpress and local community agencies to provide Community-Based Testing Sites for free COVID-19 testing by appointment for Sacramento County residents.

These testing sites are NOT for: travel clearance; surgery clearance (Contact your health care provider); people with severe fever, cough, or other symptoms. (Contact your health care provider); or, people that have tested positive for COVID-19 within 10 days of the testing date.

Testing appointments are available regardless of U.S. citizenship or legal residency status for anyone 2 years and older (minors must be accompanied by a parent/guardian). For your scheduled appointment, bring any form of identification with your date of birth to check-in. Face masks/coverings must be worn at all testing sites, some masks will be available. Maintain physical distancing while in testing sites. Results will be available within three days of testing. You will receive notification of results from StemExpress via text or e-mail. ★

Ask Toni

What is the Medicaid Estate Recovery Program?

Toni,

I am a financial planner with a client who just received a bill for her mother's Medicaid Long Term Care that was cared for at her mother's house instead of a nursing home. Sue is now stuck with a \$67,500 bill that Medicaid says must be paid in full. Her mother died at least 8 months ago.

She recently received a document from MERP (Medicaid Estate Recovery Program) saying that Medicaid wants all the Medicaid money used for her mother's care returned or the state is placing a lien on the house that Sue's mother owned when she finally passed.

What is MERP? I have never been asked about this situation and do not know what to tell my client. ~ Thanks, Chuck

Hello Chuck:

What a great question!! After researching MERP (Medicaid Estate Recovery Program), I found it to be very eye opening!

America needs to be aware that nothing comes without a cost!! And it a real surprise when a Medicare beneficiary receives Medicaid Long Term Care and later the Medicaid recipient's estate receives notification from the state of Texas for a "Notice of Intent to File a Claim against the Estate. Medicaid can recover ANY and I repeat ANY medical expenses, not just nursing facility services or home and community based services, but also includes related hospital services, prescription drugs and even Medicare cost sharing expenses which are... Medicare premiums (Part A - hospital insurance, Part B - medical insurance), deductibles and coinsurance amounts. Some of these services may be part of the \$67K your client has to pay back to Medicaid.

You asked if the state could take her mother's house. Yes! All claims against

an estate, including MERP claims, must be paid before the property can be distributed as specified in a will. The state does not, however, require an heir to sell the deceased recipient's homestead (house) if the claim can be paid by other funds. But if not, then you may have to sell the house, or the state will file a lien against the house.

The state does not process its own paperwork and has an outside Texas Medicaid Estate Recovery Contractor who handles the complete process. In the letter sent to the recipient's estate it states...the amount received will not exceed the value of the estate's assets, if any. If there is no money in the estate, then there is nothing to recover.

My advice would be to explore all of your options and maybe a family can work out a schedule to take care of your loved one or ask the church to find a volunteer or two to assist in the process. This way you can protect all that your loved ones have worked, so hard to accumulate.

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE CORDOVA RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT LEVYING SPECIAL TAX

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted proceedings under and pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, Chapter 2.5 of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5 (commencing with Section 53311) of the California Government Code (the "Act"), to form Cordova Recreation and Park District Community Facilities District No. 04-01 (Sunridge) (the "CFD") and to authorize the levy of a special tax (the "Special Tax") upon the land within the CFD to finance certain public services and facilities, all as described in those proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the rate and method of apportionment of special tax for the CFD (the "Rate and Method") is attached to Resolution No. 04-01 of the Board entitled "Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District Forming the Cordova Recreation and Park District Community Facilities District No. 04-01 (Sunridge) and Confirming the Results of an Election Regarding the Levy of a Special Tax therein to Finance Certain Public Services in and for such Community Facilities District" (the "Resolution of Formation"); and

WHEREAS, following an election of the qualified electors in the territory proposed for annexation into the CFD (the "Annexation Territory") held on August 19, 2020, the Board adopted its resolution entitled "Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District Declaring Results of Special Annexation Election, Determining Validity of Prior Proceedings, and Directing Recording of Amended Notice of Special Tax Lien, Community Facilities District No. 04-01 (Sunridge) Annexation No. 3 (Center Property APN 067-0030-002)";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CORDOVA RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT as follows:

1. By the passage of this Ordinance, and pursuant to the Act, the Board hereby authorizes and levies the Special Tax within the CFD pursuant to the Act, in accordance with the Rate and Method, which is by this reference incorporated herein. The Special Tax is hereby levied in the CFD and all territory annexed into the CFD to date, including the Annexation Territory, commencing in fiscal year 2020-21 and in each fiscal year thereafter to pay for the authorized services and facilities for the CFD and all costs of administering the CFD.

By the passage of this Ordinance, the Board also hereby ratifies the levy of Special Taxes within the CFD pursuant to the Act in fiscal years 2004-05 through 2019-20.

2. The District Administrator or designee, or an employee or consultant of the District, is hereby authorized and directed each fiscal year to determine the specific Special Tax to be levied for the next ensuing fiscal year for each parcel of real property within the CFD, in the manner and as provided in the Rate and Method.

3. Exemptions from the levy of the Special Tax shall be as provided in the Resolution of Formation, the Rate and Method and the applicable provisions of the Act. In no event shall the Special Tax be levied on any parcel within the CFD in excess of the maximum Special Tax specified in the Rate and Method.

4. All of the collections of the Special Tax shall be used as provided in the Act and in the Resolution of Formation, including, but not limited to, the payment of costs of the services and facilities, the payment of the costs of the District in administering the CFD, and the costs of collecting and administering the Special Tax.

5. The Special Tax shall be collected in the same manner as ordinary ad valorem taxes are collected and shall have the same lien priority, and be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in cases of delinquency as provided for ad valorem taxes; provided, however, that the Board may provide for other appropriate methods of collection by resolution(s) of the Board. The District Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to provide all necessary information to the auditor/tax collector of the County of Sacramento in order to effect proper billing and collection of the Special Tax, so that the Special Tax shall be included on the secured property tax roll of the County of Sacramento for fiscal year 2020-21 and for each fiscal year thereafter until no longer required to pay for the services or facilities or until otherwise terminated by the District.

6. If for any reason any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid, or if the Special Tax is found inapplicable to any particular parcel within the CFD, including the Annexation Territory, by a court of competent jurisdiction, the balance of this Ordinance and the application of the Special Tax to the remaining parcels within the CFD shall not be affected.

7. The Chairperson shall sign this Ordinance and the Secretary shall cause the same to be published immediately after its passage at least once in a newspaper of general circulation circulated in the District.

8. This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days from the date of final passage.

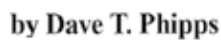

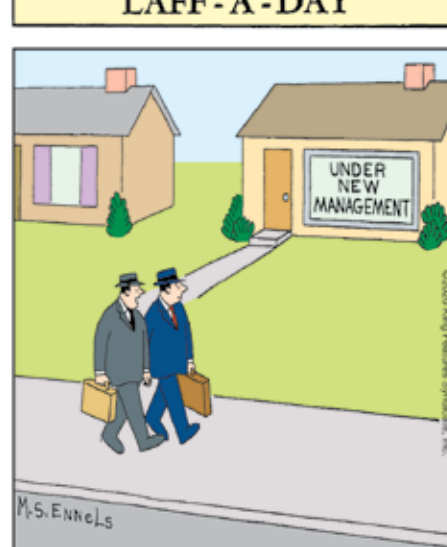

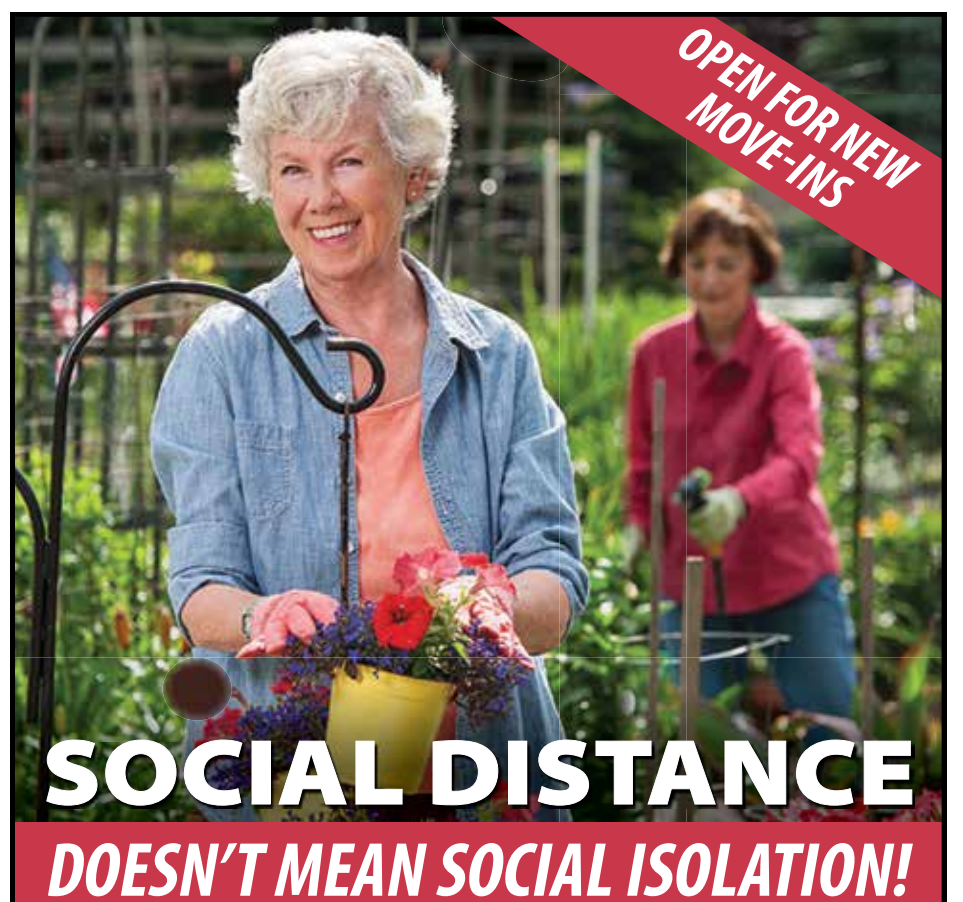
