Cordova Community Council Press Release

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Rancho Cordova's traditional Fourth of July Parade and Festival have been canceled this year, but for those who cannot get through Independence Day without some high-flying fireworks, a first-time ever "Drive-In Fireworks Show" is on its way.

The Cordova Community Council is putting the finishing touches on a free aerial fireworks show for July 4, though thanks to the corona virus, you will watch from your vehicle.

The show will be launched from a site on Kilgore Road, and surrounding businesses are supporting the show by offering their parking lots from where you can catch the view.

The lots will be accessed from Prospect Park Drive between International Drive and White Rock Road. Lots will open at 7 p.m. and the show will begin at approximately 9:45 p.m. on July 4.

But there will be rules of the road

never before seen at the Rancho Cordova Fourth of July. Like most events in the age of COVID-19, persons age 65 and older, or with underlying health conditions such as heart ailments or diabetes, are advised not to attend.

To discourage gathering behavior, there will be no concessions or other attractions at this event.

In order to abide by COVID-19 safety guidelines, the following rules will apply:

Each vehicle should be occupied by members of the same household who have already been in close contact with each other; Vehicles must be parked six feet apart; Attendees are expected to remain inside their vehicle for the entire time and wear masks if outside; No early birds! No tailgating or BBQs, no alcohol, no pets, no RVs or trailers, no vending; No personal fireworks – leave the pyrotechnics to the pros!

While it is not a perfect solution, organizers said the show will be great, and with especially high-flying fireworks, visible from not only the

reserved parking lots, but various parts of Rancho Cordova.

"We would rather be in Hagan Park as we have been for many years, but COVID-19 restrictions have made that impossible this year," said Shelly Blanchard, Executive Director of the Cordova Community Council, which produces a two-day Fourth of July Celebration each year. "We hope our community will find a way to enjoy what promises to be an extraordinary show, even as we live through this extraordinary time."

Rancho Cordova Fourth of July Parade fans will also get a little treat on July 4.

A video featuring photos of the parade taken over the years has been assembled into a video, which will be emailed to Cordova Community Council email subscribers at 10 a.m. July 4. Featuring a parade soundtrack recorded by the Rancho Cordova River City Concert Band, the 8-minute parade video will also be available at cordovacouncil.org and ranchocordovajuly4th.com. ★

Protecting Sacramento County Seniors

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - COVID-19 has profoundly impacted all of our lives. As we isolate from those closest to us – family, friends, neighbors and colleagues – for older people living in the community or in long-term care settings, the trials are even greater. Social isolation is one of the greatest risk factors for elder abuse.

In California, elder abuse is significantly underreported. For every case of elder or dependent adult abuse known to agencies, 24 are unknown. June is observed as National Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Awareness Month, a statewide effort to increase awareness of elder and dependent adult abuse and to increase reporting of suspected abuse, not only in the month of June but all year long.

There are numerous forms of maltreatment and abuse, such as: physical, sexual, emotional and financial abuse, as well as neglect and abandonment. Elder and dependent adult abuse does not discriminate. Any adult 65 years and older or an adult between the ages of 18 to 65 that requires extra care due to physical or mental limitations can be a victim.

"Social isolation can be difficult for seniors even in the best of times," said Ruth MacKenzie. "We have to help our seniors feel connected especially during COVID-19 and make sure they have access to available local services so they can stay healthy and safe. Staying connected, phoning older adults, checking on an older neighbor, writing a card or letter, can all be positive steps to ensure public safety and social justice."

Seniors are in the highest risk for severe complications from COVID-19, during this challenging time, Sacramento County APS wants to emphasize that there are resources that are available in this time of need and uncertainty.

Sacramento County has a 24-hour hotline for reporting abuse of older adults and disabled adults who may be physically or financially abused, neglected or exploited. The local APS number is (916) 874-9377. To report suspected abuse of an elder in a nursing home, residential care facility for the elderly or assisted living facility, contact the State CRISIS line: 1-800-231-4024. To report abuse in all long-term care facilities, call: Ombudsman Services of Northern California at (916) 376-8910. ★

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - The City of Rancho Cordova, RCPD and Sacramento Metro Fire District encourage residents to be safe when using

fireworks this Fourth of July season.

The unsafe use of fireworks can cause severe burns, amputations, blinding and even death. Damaging fires occur when children use fireworks, and

parents are responsible for any damage or injuries caused if their children use fireworks.

Follow these tips to ensure your Fourth of July celebration is safe for everyone:

All legal fireworks in California are called Safe and Sane Fireworks and must bear the State Fire Marshal's seal; Safe and Sane Fireworks may be sold only from noon on

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Northern California's three major fireworks distributors - TNT, Phantom and Discount Fireworks Superstore - are going big this season in hopes to release the inner Uncle Sam and Lady Liberty from within a population feeling blue over a topsy-turvy world dealing with a pandemic and pandemonium.

Believing that the joy of fireworks will help shake the blues by adding red and white in honor of America's 244th birthday, these

companies are rolling out a record 24 new fireworks in the Golden State this season - nearly double the previous mark. The 2020 freshman class also includes one new limited-edition assortment, and never has there been more buy one get one free and mix and match deals to woo buyers.

That's a lot of shapes, sizes, colors and prices among the rookie lineup, and while variety usually bodes well for fundraising non-profits running the stands, perplexed consumers will ponder the obvious questions: What's new? What's loud? What's unique?

How long does it last? What gives me the most bang for my buck?

Help has arrived. Our annual and unbiased fireworks buyers guide has reviews of the new items and the very best of the returning rest. For the 19th year, new fireworks are graded on a 5-star scale, judged on performance, duration, distinctiveness and value.

Promotions are noted where applicable. Every Phantom firework this season is a buy one get one; the freebie can be the same item or any firework of like or lesser price. TNT is countering with its own mix and match deals

plus limited-edition items in commemoration of the company's centennial anniversary of selling fireworks. DFS, which TNT took over in California last year, save for a handful of locations up in the Redwood Coast, tends to have lower prices overall and a wider range of brands.

A star-spangled shoutout to the Sacramento Fire Department for cooperation with this season's test. Special thanks to Fire Marshal Jason Lee and Capt. Keith Wade.

Let the sparks fly!

NEW FOR 2020



CENTENNIAL FOUNTAIN XL (TNT), \$60 - Burn time is shorter than most 500-gram finales at this price point, but this special-edition fountain proves that duration is sometimes overrated. Wows with a mesmerizing mélange of effects and medley of transitions - droplets to fish to crackle to birthday cake to a shock-and-awe eruption. Here for this season only. 80 seconds. ★★★★★

COLORAMA (DFS), \$52.99 - Pretty droplets of gold, orange, green and red, and a strong crackling finish aren't enough to compensate for slow tube-to-tube transitions and an uneven performance. 110 seconds. ★★★

CAPTAIN NUCLEAR FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$49.99 FOR TWO - Decent crackling sparks mixed with pearls, chrysanthemums, multi-colored glitter and flowers build to a less than satisfying climax. 80 seconds. ★★★

LIVING THE DREAM (TNT), \$49.99 - Like ordering TNT's exquisitely named Wild Side (see Best of the Rest) and saying, "make it a double." 500 grams get you two awesome minutes of super-charged crackles, though at a dear price. 120 seconds. ★★★★★

FIERY MEADOW FLOWER FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$49.99 FOR TWO - Proving that hybrid fireworks often make for big crowd pleasers is this combo fountain-wheel featuring titanium crackles and spinning finale. On a smooth surface, the centrifugal force makes this unique rookie rotate. 68 seconds. ★★★★★

FLOWER PATCH KIDS (TNT), \$40 FOR TWO - The first few seconds are absolutely gorgeous with deep red droplets that produce the prettiest start of any California firework. The rest of the flowers in this patch aren't nearly as beautiful. 77 seconds. ★★

TAKE A HIT (TNT), \$40 FOR TWO - Love the rarely seen lavender droplets and nice palms, but this batter got two bases on a bloop single and error. 75 seconds. ★★

JUNGLE FLOWER (TNT), \$39.99 - The intense crackle and vivid colors are pleasing. Just wished it had a more exciting overall and longer performance for the price. 49 seconds. ★★

PINK ICE (TNT), \$30 FOR TWO - Nice to see pink, but blink and you miss it. And what's with the 10-second delay between tubes? 26 seconds. ★

REVOLUTION (TNT), \$30 FOR TWO - You say you want a revolution? Not sure even Paul and Ringo would want this disappointingly short newcomer despite loud three whistles and crackling pink and blue sparks. 34 seconds. ★★

WAR FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$29.99 FOR TWO - Colors change with each stage of fiery crackles. Great duration and intensity. 82 seconds. ★★★★★

FLOWER POT FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$29.99 FOR TWO - Low-noise fountain enralls with multicolored droplets against a near-constant shower of silver glitter. Use of blob-producing nitrocellulose reduces burn time. Worth it. 52 seconds. ★★★★★



TNT TORCH (TNT), \$24.99 - Judge this mundane-looking firework by its cover and you'll miss out on beautiful - no, *beguiling* - shimmering golden stars reminiscent of cones from the early '70s. This pyro's pyrotechnic earns "Best New Firework" honors. 72 seconds. ★★★★★

COSMIC VELOCITY FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$21.99 FOR TWO - Intense crackling fountain with pretty reds and greens, but needs BOGO promo to offset fleeting duration. 52 seconds. ★★

GALACTIC RADIANCE FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$21.99 FOR TWO - Sub-minute burn time isn't cool, but rest of this colorful crackle-crazy fountain is. 46 seconds. ★★

ELECTRIC MANIPULATION FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$21.99 FOR TWO - What's dubbed as a "silky blue explosion" in the second half makes up for an unimpressive opening of standard crackles and colors. 53 seconds. ★★

SAVAGE FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$21.99 FOR TWO - While there's titanium crackle fountains more savage than this, newcomer satisfies with various spark types of red, white, gold, silver and green. 70 seconds. ★★★★★

SPARKLE BERRY (TNT), \$19.99 - Cavalcade of color changes to crackling frenzy after a piercing whistle at the 40-second mark. 65 seconds. ★★

FLARING STARS FOUNTAIN (PHANTOM), \$15.99 FOR TWO - Virtually noiseless beauty featuring swarming fish effect in red, gold and green. Shorter version of Phantom's late great Flying Stars. 54 seconds. ★★★★★

OLD GLORY (DFS), \$15.38 FOR TWO - Veteran TNT fountain debuts in California rebranded as a Freedom item. Colorful and crackly, but there's better out there. 49 seconds. ★★

TOXIC BARREL (TNT), \$12.99 - Green toxic sludge blobs and loud crackles make this a freaky rookie sensation even with the fleeting duration. It's your "Best New Firework" runner-up. 45 seconds. ★★★★★

CENTENNIAL FOUNTAIN (TNT), \$12 - Good height, crackle, color and burn time for the price. Bummer it's only here for TNT's 100th anniversary of fireworks sales. 77 seconds. ★★★★★

KOOL KAT (TNT), \$9 FOR TWO - Billed as a new firework, it's actually a rewrap of Cool Breeze that debuted last season and is being sold at closeout prices. 43 seconds. ★

TORNADO GROUND SPINNER (PHANTOM), \$3.99 FOR TWO PACKAGES OF 6 - Spinning novelty sounds like fun, but if using the Enhanced Fujita Scale for tornadoes, this cyclone gets a rating of EF0. Buy a pack of ground bloom flowers instead. 3 seconds. ★

ALSO NEW FOR 2020 ... CENTENNIAL ASSORTMENT (TNT), \$110.99 - The only state-approved assortment this season features 15 respectable fountains named after oldies but goodies and clad in retro labels. Limited-time item commemorates the 100th year of fireworks sold by the Alabama-based company that would become TNT. Best in the box: Big Bomb, Freedom, Red Devil and Ace fountains. ★★★★★

Once Again the Budget Prolongs State's Financial Problems

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Legislature passed its version of the state budget, a framework that increases taxes and relies on subsidies from the federal government. Senator Jim Nielsen (R-Tehama), Vice Chairman of the Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee, issued the following statement:

"This budget does not solve the state's financial problems." It prolongs

the crisis, thereby, delaying and deepening the economic pain for Californians, especially those in need of state services."

"We need to cut spending now. It is irresponsible to give schools and recipients of state programs false hope that the federal government (i.e. federal taxpayers) will bail out the State of California.

"Employers - especially small businesses - have had to bear the brunt of this pandemic. Businesses are finally re-opening, many at

limited capacity. Under this budget, there is another \$4 billion in taxes heaped upon them for next year. How can they afford to stay open?"

Elected to the State Senate in January 2013, Senator Nielsen represents the Fourth Senate District, which includes the counties of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba. June 28, 2020 through 10 PM on July 4, 2020; In Rancho Cordova, use of fireworks is allowed between noon on June 28, 2020 through 10 PM on July 4, 2020, and only between 8 AM and 10 PM daily during this period; It is illegal for anyone under 18 years of age to use fireworks; It is illegal to sell, give or deliver fireworks to anyone under 18 years of age; It is illegal to point or throw a firework into a crowd or at people; Fireworks that explode or leave the ground are illegal in California and prohibited by law, punishable by up to a year in county jail and up to a \$1,000 fine; The sale or transfer of Safe and Sane Fireworks may only occur at a fixed place of business, which is licensed and permitted to sell Safe and Sane Fireworks; Fireworks are not allowed in any public park. Always have a bucket of water to dispose of fireworks; Always have a hose connected to water available in case of fire; Do not use fireworks near dry grass or other flammable materials. Cut your yard more frequently to reduce fire hazards; Do not use fireworks while under a

canopy, covered balcony, covered patio or under a tree or bushes; Never attempt to relight or "fix" fireworks; Pets can become frightened by the loud sounds and unfamiliar sights during festivities. Keep your pets safely indoors, or if you must take your dog with you outdoors, keep him or her leashed and under your direct control at all times; Help stop the spread of coronavirus by practicing social distancing of six feet or more. Wear a cloth face covering in public places where social distancing is not possible. Learn more: CityofRanchoCordova.org/coronavirus

RCPD will double the number of patrol officers who are proactively patrolling and responding to illegal fireworks calls on the night of July 4th. If you suspect the use of illegal fireworks, report incidents to RCPD with a location of the activity by dialing 916.362.5115. In order to cite or arrest an individual for illegal fireworks, the crime has to happen in the officer's presence for RCPD to take any type of enforcement action. And Another Thing Groundbreaking for the new pool/pools

Like many Cordovans who have been residents for quite a while, we know how popular that pool was for years. And unfortunately, like most things, the pool ended up wearing out and was closed. There were many kids who missed the pool, especially during the hot times of the summer. The Cordova Blue Marlins are very excited that the building of the pool is finally underway and that they will be able to go back to having practice and competition in their own Cordova pool. I know they have been using the Rosemont High School's pool and had to have smaller home meets or hold them at the competition's pool.

As I said earlier, I was glad to go to the groundbreaking for the new pool/

pools. For those who haven't heard about the new pool, there will actually be two pools: a larger pool and then a smaller pool for the small children. The groundbreaking was different than others in the past because the council members came to the groundbreaking at different times to shovel dirt and wore attire that included a face covering, gloves, shoes or boots, etc., which made it easier to push the shovel into the ground. I am looking forward to the pools being open again.

And another thing, representing the city on the board of the Sacramento-Yolo Mosquito & Vector Control District is very interesting and sometimes very surprising because of the amount of money that this special district has to handle. Gary Goodman, executive of the district, said, "I will go over the board story at the Board meeting. (That was on June 16, 2020.) Of particular note is some estimates

that we used for future years. We based these estimates on the economic downturn during the housing bubble that started in 2007. We have modified some of the revenue projections with a similar timeframe to what we saw during that time. These are estimates only. We can update them based on better information that we receive."

Just one figure, and that is the total revenue for 2019-2020 is \$15,576,249.00. Being a special district can and does bring much more money than you may think. But if you think of some of the special districts like the fire districts, school districts and park districts, and what their budgets come up to, then the Mosquito & Vector Control District gets more than people think. Oh well. We don't have to worry about that much money at home. Right?

District Attorney Announces Crime Lab Youth Shadow Days

24, 2020 ~ 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

WHERE: Virtually – broadcasted live from the District Attorney's Crime Lab

The program is open to current Sacramento County high school students. Priority will be given to senior high school students.

Students will need to submit completed registration forms and a signed permission slip, which can be downloaded at www.sacda.org.

The deadline to apply is July 10, 2020. Space is limited to 60 students each day and on a first come, first served basis. Please register early.

DA Anne Marie Schubert states, "Our goal with all of our youth programs is to engage and educate our youth as well as inspire them to pursue a career in the criminal justice field, including forensic science which is a critical factor in most criminal cases. I am pleased we are able to continue this program virtually – keeping students, our staff and their families healthy and safe in this time of social distancing."

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE CORDOVA RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT
RESOLUTION OF THE INTENTION TO LEVY ASSESSMENTS FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2020/21 PRELIMINARILY APPROVING ENGINEER'S REPORT
AND PROVIDING NOTICE OF HEARING FOR
THE PARK MAINTENANCE AND RECREATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT



WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District, acting as the legislative body of the Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District, has previously ordered through Resolution 06/07-1 the formation of an assessment district pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, known as the Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District, for the purpose of financing certain park and recreational improvements, and for the purpose of funding maintenance operations of the District; and

WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code sections 22622, 22623 and 22661 authorize the preparation of an Engineer's Report on an annual basis which shall describe any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, set forth an estimate of the costs of any improvements and/or annual maintenance costs for the park and recreational improvements specified in the Engineer's Report, specify a diagram for the assessment district and specify the amount to be assessed upon various types of assessable lands within the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, an Engineer's Report for Fiscal Year 2020/21 as authorized by the Board of Directors has been presented to the Board of Directors for its consideration and approval, which Engineer's Report generally describes the general nature, location, and extent of the new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, provides an estimate of the costs of any proposed new improvements or substantial changes in existing improvements and refurbishments, specifies the costs of maintenance of park and recreational improvements within the district, and sets forth a diagram for the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has adopted a Resolution approving and filing an Engineer's Report for Fiscal Year 2020/21 as required by Streets and Highways Code Section 22623, which Engineer's Report sets forth plans and specifications for the improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, an estimate of the costs of these improvements, an estimate of the cost of maintenance with respect to such improvements, a diagram of the assessment district, and a description of the net amount to be assessed upon assessable lands within the assessment district which Engineer's Report is incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22624 as follows:

- a. The Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District, acting as the Board of Directors of the Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District, hereby adopts the Preliminary Engineer's Report dated June 17, 2020, and files said Engineer's Report with the Clerk of this Board as approved pursuant to the requirements of California Streets and Highways Code section 22623.
- b. Said assessments will be levied and collected within the boundaries of the Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District, the boundaries of which are specifically described in the Engineer's Report. A full and detailed description of the boundaries of the Assessment District and the parcels of land within the district is contained within the approved Engineer's Report.
- c. The Board of Directors declares its intent to levy and collect assessments for the Fiscal Year 2020/21 within said district at an assessment rate of \$28.47 per year per single family residential unit, as set forth in the Engineer's Report. These assessments are based on the same formula as those levied in Fiscal Years 2006/07 through 2019/20. The total number of parcels to be assessed and an estimate of total annual assessment revenue are contained within the Engineer's Report.
- d. Ongoing maintenance, improvements and/or refurbishments within said assessment district to be funded by said assessments are detailed within the Engineer's Report which is incorporated herein by this reference.
- e. Reference is hereby made to the Engineer's Report which is on file with the Clerk of the Board for a complete description of the proposed improvements and maintenance to be undertaken in Fiscal Year 2020/21 and the cost thereof, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the proposed assessment district.
- f. The Board hereby declares that this Resolution of Intention constitutes a Notice of Hearing regarding its intent to levy and collect assessments within the Park Maintenance and Recreation Improvement District for Fiscal Year 2020/21. This Public Hearing shall be held at a Regular meeting of the Board of Directors on July 15, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. (via the Zoom Meetings platform) and at Rancho Cordova City Hall, 2729 Prospect Park Drive, Rancho Cordova, California 95670. The Clerk is hereby directed to publish this notice as a Notice of Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 6061.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to the conclusion of the Public Hearing, any interested person may file a written protest with the Clerk of the Board, or, having previously filed a protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. YEAR 2020/21 PRELIMINARILY APPROVING ENGINEER'S REPORT AND

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District, acting as the legislative body of the Independence at Mather Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District, has previously ordered through Resolution 00-8 the formation of an assessment district pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, known as the Independence at Mather Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District, for the purpose of financing certain park and recreational improvements, and for the purpose of funding maintenance operations of the District; and

WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code sections 22622, 22623 and 22661 authorize the preparation of an Engineer's Report on an annual basis which shall describe any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, set forth an estimate of the costs of any improvements and/or annual maintenance costs for the park and recreational improvements specified in the Engineer's Report, specify a diagram for the assessment district and specify the amount to be assessed upon various types of assessable lands within the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, an Engineer's Report for Fiscal Year 2020/21 as authorized by the Board of Directors has been presented to the Board of Directors for its consideration and approval, which Engineer's Report generally describes the general nature, location, and extent of the new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, provides an estimate of the costs of any proposed new improvements or substantial changes in existing improvements and refurbishments, specifies the costs of maintenance of park and recreational improvements within the district, and sets forth a diagram for the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has adopted a Resolution approving and filing an Engineer's Report for Fiscal Year 2020/21 as required by Streets and Highways Code section 22623, which Engineer's Report sets forth plans and specifications for the improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements, an estimate of the costs of these improvements, an estimate of the cost of maintenance with respect to such improvements, a diagram of the assessment district, and a description of the net amount to be assessed upon assessable lands within the assessment district which Engineer's Report is incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 22624 as follows:

- a. The Board of Directors of the Cordova Recreation and Park District, acting as the Board of Directors of the Independence at Mather Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District, hereby adopts the Preliminary Engineer's Report dated June 17, 2020, and files said Engineer's Report with the Clerk of this Board as approved pursuant to the requirements of California Streets and Highways Code section 22623.
- b. Said assessments will be levied and collected within the boundaries of the Independence at Mather Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District, the boundaries of which are specifically described in the Engineer's Report. A full and detailed description of the boundaries of the Assessment District and the parcels of land within the district is contained within the approved Engineer's Report.
- c. The Board of Directors declares its intent to levy and collect assessments for the Fiscal Year 2020/21 within said district at an assessment rate of \$178.86 per year per single family residential parcel as set forth in the Engineer's Report. These assessments are based on the same formula as those levied in fiscal years 2000/01 through 2019/20. The total number of parcels to be assessed and an estimate of total annual assessment revenue are contained within the Engineer's Report.
- d. Ongoing maintenance, improvements and/or refurbishments within said assessment district to be funded by said assessments are detailed within the Engineer's Report which is incorporated herein by this reference.
- e. Reference is hereby made to the Engineer's Report which is on file with the Clerk of the Board for a complete description of the proposed improvements and maintenance to be undertaken in Fiscal Year 2020/21 and the cost thereof, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the proposed assessment district.
- f. The Board hereby declares that this Resolution of Intention constitutes a Notice of Hearing regarding its intent to levy and collect assessments within the Independence at Mather Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District for Fiscal Year 2020/21. This Public Hearing shall be held at a Regular meeting of the Board of Directors on July 15, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. (via the Zoom Meetings platform) and at Rancho Cordova City Hall, 2729 Prospect Park Drive, Rancho Cordova, California 95670. The Clerk is hereby directed to publish this notice as a Notice of Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 6061.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to the conclusion of the Public Hearing, any interested person may file a written protest with the Clerk of the Board, or, having previously filed a protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. A written protest shall state all grounds of objection. A protest by a property owner shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owned by such owner.
