The event features live music, access to a variety of display aircraft, yard games, food trucks and more. Blues & Brews takes place on Friday, October 4 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at Mather Airport's Mather Jet Center Hangar 1. Admission to

is free and open to the public. Food is available for purchase from Sacto MoFo food trucks. Wristbands for beer and spirits can be purchased for \$40 per person.

## CA Trucking Association Issues New Statement on the Governor's Signing of AB 5

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Shawn Yadon, CEO of the California Trucking Association (CTA), issued the following statement in response to the decision by Governor Gavin Newsom to sign Assembly Bill 5 into law:

"In the wake of Governor Newsom signing AB 5, the California Trucking Association is exploring its options to ensure California's more than 70,000 independent owner-operators do not lose the tens of thousands of dollars spent in purchasing and updating their trucks, and other assets they have invested in order to build their own businesses.

"In its current form, AB 5 denies a significant segment of the trucking industry the ability to continue operating as independent owner-operators, forcing them to abandon investments they've made in their trucks as well as taking away their flexibility to set their own schedule and determine their destiny regarding their businesses, which many have operated for more than three decades.

"We look forward to working with the Legislature and the Administration to develop a more workable solution to AB 5 that protects employees from misclassification without eliminating the independent owner-operator business model."

Since 1934, the California Trucking Association has been serving the commercial motor carrier industry in California and the companies that provide products and services to the trucking industry. A critical and vital component of California's economy, nearly 80 percent of California communities depend solely on trucks to deliver their goods. # County Board Approves Revised FY 2019-20 Budget

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors voted to revise the Approved Budget for the 2019-20 fiscal year.

The Approved Budget in June totaled \$4.4 billion. With the completion of the County's FY 2018-19 year-end financial closing activities and updated information, an increase of \$138 million was proposed, bringing the Budget Recommended for Adoption to \$4.5 billion in appropriations. Most of this increase involved re-budgeting funds for capital projects due to shifts in timing for those projects.

In June, to close a general shortfall of \$55 million, Sacramento County made \$43 million in reductions in General Fund Departments and reduced \$12 million in General Fund reserves to bridge the gap.

General Fund departments identified a number of targeted program and position reductions. The reductions included the elimination of 181.3 FTE positions that were either vacant or, in a few cases, filled by employees who were shifted to other positions in the same class. No layoffs were necessary.

The June Approved Budget also

included budget increases in a number of areas, including:

- \$21.7 million to make improvements to the County's jails as part of continuing efforts to resolve conditions of confinement concerns identified in a recent lawsuit;

- \$2.3 million in state and federal revenue to add 25 FTE positions in Child Support Services;

- \$1.2 million in 2011 Realignment Local Innovation funds to add seven positions in Probation to establish a Pre-Trial Assessment and Monitoring Pilot Program;

- \$1 million set aside for costs related to the Hardesty/Schneider lawsuit against the County;

- \$3.5 million to add 29 FTE positions in Airports Department to handle the impact of increasing passenger and freight volume; and

- \$668,000 to cover the cost of postcards and postage for the March 2020 Primary Election, as required by state law.

The Board formally adopted the Budget Recommended for Adoption on Sep. 24.

# Registering and Updating Voter Reg at the DMV

**SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG)** - With the 2020 March Presidential Primary closer than you think, registering to vote and updating your registration and party information is more important than ever. It is also easier than ever – you can register and update your information online, in person or even at the DMV. However, if you go to the DMV, understand that ALL eligible individuals completing driver license or ID card applications or change of address transactions will be registered to vote in the county of their residence unless they choose to opt-out of automatic voter registration.

Our voter registration staff has been hard at work reconciling voter files with information coming from the DMV. They are finding that many residents are unintentionally registering to vote, or mistakenly changing their contact information or party preference.

If you are completing a driver license/ID application or renewal or changing your address, the touch screen will prompt you with options to 1-Register to Vote, 2-Update Registration or 3- Do Not Change Registration. These options have been confusing to many voters and have led to errors in their voter registration file.

What does each option mean?

I want to register to vote: This is your option if you are currently eligible, but not registered to vote and would like to register.

I want to update my registration: You must update your registration if you have moved, changed your name or want to change your political party status. Updating due to these changes is important to ensure you receive your ballot at the correct location with the correct information come next election.

I do not want to register to vote or update my registration: This option means you are already registered to vote and you have no changes to your file. Your information is still correct and up to date.

What changes have been made to the voting process now that Sacramento County is administering elections under the Voter's Choice Act?

Every registered voter will receive a postage-paid, Vote by Mail ballot

All voters can drop off their ballot at one of 57 Ballot Drop Box location up to 29 days before Election Day

All voters can drop off their ballot, register to vote and vote in person at any Vote Center in the county up to 10 days before Election Day

All Vote Centers (84 total) will be open at least four days before Election Day

Eligible, but unregistered voters can register online or in-person at a Vote Center, before and through Election Day.

How can I check my registration status online?

Visit the "Check my status" webpage. It will prompt you to enter your name, driver license/ID number, last four numbers of your social security number and your date of birth.

How can I register to vote online?

Visit the Register to Vote website and fill out the online voter registration form.

Why does it matter if I update my registration information?

If you have moved, changed your name or political party since the last election and did not update your voter registration record, your registration is out of date. To receive the correct ballot for the district you live in, with your correct name and political party preference you must provide up to date information. Your signature validation is based on your latest signature and name on file, so it is critical they match.

What do I need to know about the presidential primary and party preference?

The Primary Presidential Election has moved to March 3, 2020. Primary Presidential Elections are party specific. The party you are registered with is the ballot type you will receive (Ex: If you are a registered Democrat, you will only see declared Democratic Presidential candidates on your ballot). Before the upcoming election check your status to see what party you are registered with. WASHINGTON, DC (MPG) - Rep. Ami Bera, M.D. (CA-07) released the following statement on impeachment.

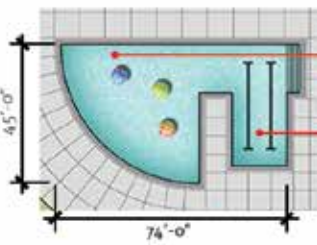

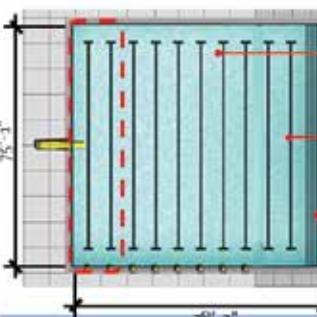

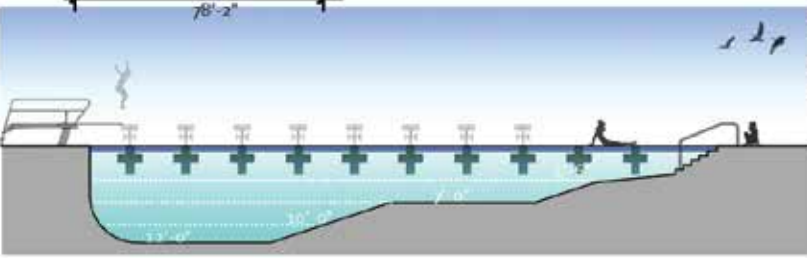

Lap Pool

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - For close to six years, summertime visitors of Hagan Community Park have been making do without a community pool for swimming and splashing recreation. Patrick Larkin, General Manager of Cordova Recreational Park District, updated the Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce on September 20, on the new Cordova Community Pool Replacement Project.

The aging facility, which opened in 1962, had a number of concerning issues including bathrooms without roofs, a leaking main pool, a difficult

to find entrance and ADA obstacles. These problems, together with new Measure J funding, led the City Council and Cordova Recreational Park District to finally decide on a more current design.

The LPA designed pool complex at this point in the timeline, according to Larkin, "will feature a new frontal entry, fully enclosed restrooms and locker rooms, a single level deck, support buildings, shaded areas and a two pool layout."

In 2018, the Rancho Cordova City Council approved \$3.4 million for the approximately \$9 million project (as of 2019), and the approved bidder will

be awarded and set to begin construction in early to mid 2020. Larkin stated that the pool will be under construction for about 15-18 months, opening to the public and swimming teams such as the Cordova Blue Marlins and the Cordettes in the summer of 2021.

"This is the first time we're tackling how to replace the community pool since it was closed about 5-6 years ago," said Larkin, "and because this is a really budget driven project, we will be activating a sponsorship program to bring additional funding."

On occasion, you find that someone has offered a new way of expressing something that feels good inside. Albert Camus who was a French philosopher, author and journalist said, "Autumn is a second spring when every leaf is a flower." The fences were placed there to protect the new trees that were planted to replace the trees that were taken out when the new water release was put in on the Folsom Dam. Why they decided to place the trees so far away from the Folsom Dam I don't know, but they didn't finish the job. There are still pieces of plastic in the fields that were left when the trees they planted "grew up" and didn't need the protection anymore. I will find out who is responsible, and I'll let you know when I find out.

I was fortunate the morning of September 24 to be able to attend the "United We Stand" Breakfast honoring RCPD Officer Mark Stasyuk that was held at the House of Bread Church in Orangevale. Officer Stasyuk's family were among the immigrants who came from the many countries that were part of the former U.S.S.R., or the United Soviet Socialist Republic. The first waves of immigrants were leaving religious persecution, and over the years from the early 1990s, they have been able to see what is afforded

to them from the United States. The guest speaker was Sheriff Scott Jones, host speaker was Pastor Eduard Kislyaka, and the keynote speaker was Senior Chaplain Mindi Russell from the Law Enforcement Chaplaincy Sacramento.

The program also recognized Slavic law enforcement officers from different law enforcement agencies who were at the breakfast. They are the new members of the immigrant families who didn't grow up with the threats from police in the communist countries. They have learned what living in a country that loves and protects its citizens can be like.

At his Gettysburg Address, President Lincoln said, "...from these honored dead we take increased devotion to that cause for which they gave the last full measure of devotion." of Transportation rules say you're entitled to as much as \$1300 in cash, depending on your ticket price and how long you are delayed. 3) **SEARCH FOR ONLY ONE TICKET AT A TIME.** If you search for, say, four tickets, and the airline has only three at the lowest rate, all four are bumped to the higher-price bracket. 4) **YOU'RE NOT IMAGINING IT.** In the new aircrafts, especially those used for long-haul international flights, airlines recently shrank the seats by one inch so they could fit an extra seat in each row. 5) **IF YOUR FLIGHT IS CANCELED, GET IN LINE AT THE TICKET COUNTER.** BUT, also get on the phone. You'll probably reach an airline phone agent before you get to the frazzled agent behind the counter. 6) **DON'T EVER WALK AROUND BAREFOOT ON THE AIRPLANE.** That carpet? Everything you can imagine has been spilled on it. This includes vomit, milk, babypee, and blood. Also wipe down those table trays. Don't want to tell you what could be on those. 7) **AIRLINES RELEASE BARGAIN TICKETS BY MISTAKE.** Every so often, airlines release dirt

cheap tickets. They're not doing it as a favor. It's an accident. Once these tickets are released, there's no going back. That's from Jamie Campbell, travel blogger and creator of the Gaijin Crew. The best way to catch these slip-ups and make the most of them is to sign up for mailing lists from sites such as Airfarewatchdog, which scans the internet for cheap fares. Another site that specializes in helping travelers find mistake fares is Secret Flying. 8) **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS.** The more you know about your rights as an airline passenger, the better. "Airlines don't want customers to know much about their passenger rights, which is not all that surprising when they could owe up to \$700 for each passenger if their flight to or from Europe is delayed or canceled," said Thomas Busson of ClaimCompass. Airlines flying to and from Europe are subject to EU passenger laws. "While U.S. regulations only cover passengers facing cases of overbooking and luggage problems, European regulation goes further." # School Vaccination Requirements Proposed Referendum Enters Circulation

Office of Secretary of State Alex Padilla

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Secretary of State Alex Padilla announced the proponents of a new referendum were cleared to begin collecting petition signatures.

The Attorney General prepares the circulating title and summary that is required to appear on referendum petitions. Once completed, the Attorney General forwards the title and summary to the proponents and to the Secretary of State, and the referendum may be circulated for signatures. The Secretary of State provides calendar deadlines to the proponents and to county elections officials. The Attorney General's official title and summary for the measure is as follows:

Referendum Challenging 2019 Law Regarding State Oversight of Medical Exemptions to School Vaccination Requirements. If this petition is signed by the required number of registered voters and timely filed, a referendum will be placed on the next statewide ballot requiring a majority of voters to approve a 2019 state law before it can take effect. The 2019 law amends related statute increasing state oversight of medical exemptions

from school vaccination requirements, as follows: (1) exemptions obtained before 2020 remain effective until child starts next grade span (i.e., kindergarten; 7th grade); (2) doctors need not certify exemptions under penalty of perjury. (19-0015.)

The Secretary of State's tracking number for this measure is 1869 and the Attorney General's tracking number is 19-0015.

The proponents of the measure, Tara Thornton, Denise Aguilar, and Heidi Muñoz Gleisner must collect signatures of 623,212 registered voters (five percent of the total votes cast for Governor in the November 2018 general election) in order to qualify it for the ballot. The proponent has 90 days from the enactment of the legislation to circulate petitions for the measure, meaning the signatures must be submitted to county elections officials no later than December 9, 2019\*. ## Cordova High School Football Struggles Continue in 61-7 Loss to Ponderosa

**RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG)** - In what has been a rough start to their season, the Cordova Lancers' varsity football program has suffered five consecutive lopsided losses in their first five games. Yet despite another frustrating 61-7 loss at home against visiting Ponderosa last Friday at Cordova High School, team morale remains high with Greater Sacramento League play right around the corner.

Against the Bruins (3-2 overall), the tone of the contest was set early after Lancers' senior quarterback Joey Estrada fumbled the

snap on Cordova's second play from scrimmage, resulting in a Ponderosa touchdown after Bruins' senior tailback/linebacker Colin Taylor would recover the ball for a 35-yard scoop and score. That play was a microcosm of the game, as Cordova would fumble five times, three of which would be recovered by Ponderosa. For the Bruins, Taylor would contribute the initial touchdown on the fumble recovery defensively, and carry his team offensively as he tallied 11 rushing attempts for 120 yards and two more scores.

Miscues by the Lancers resulted in a 47-0 halftime deficit that they would be unable to overcome.

The scoreboard was not indicative of the effort on the part of Cordova, however. With the game well in hand in the fourth quarter, Lancers' senior all-purpose threat Brandon Gray would sprint for a 57-yard touchdown that would excite his teammates along with his coach, Jason Bumbaca. Gray would finish the game with 10 carries for 81 yards as the bright spot for Cordova.

"He's a receiver by trait and it's taken him a little bit of time to get adjusted to taking it between the tackles," Bumbaca said. "But he's done a great job and done everything this coaching staff has asked."

Bumbaca also referenced a recent

player-led meeting that the team held earlier in the week, praising his team's accountability and the leadership in the locker room. He also mentioned that his team sees the bigger picture, and knows that their difficult pre-season schedule should pay huge dividends once league play starts.

"We're essentially trying to look at the light at the end of the tunnel with league coming up," Bumbaca said.

The Lancers travel to Oakmont this Friday, September 27, in their final non-league contest. Greater Sacramento League play will begin for the Lancers on Friday, October 4, when they host Johnson. ★

## Lady Lancers Volleyball Making Huge Strides
