MATHER, CA (MPG) - On Thursday, Feb. 7, Cordova Recreation & Park District (CRPD) hosted hundreds of

community members in the Mather Sports Center gymnasium to unveil a completely refinished, Sacramento Kings-branded gymnasium floor sponsored by the Sacramento Kings,

Kaiser Permanente, the Good Tidings Foundation and Sacramento County. As part of the celebration, community members were invited to be a part of the ribbon-cutting and 100 local youth attended the free Jr. Kings basketball clinic hosted by the Sacramento Kings, Jr. Kings organization.

One of CRPD's three main community centers, Mather Sports Complex was built in 1967 but not deemed to the District until 1994. Located at the front door of a major transportation corridor (Highway 50) and the entrance to a main commerce center, Mather Sports Complex has been an easily accessible location for the past 52 years. However, it was not until CRPD's forward-thinking Board of

Directors and management team took over and saw potential in the complex, investing in additions like the Skate Park and synthetic turf fields, that made Mather Sports Complex the regional sports destination it is today. Now, as of February 2019, the Mather Sports Center has received all new lighting courtesy of SMUD, exterior and interior work, including painting, the refinished floor, bleacher upgrades and new basketball hoops.

Sacramento County Board of Supervisors', Don Nottoli (District 5) played an instrumental role in bringing this project to life. "Mather Sports Complex was an ideal choice for the Kings' first indoor court for many reasons, but mainly because it is a great host

Sac Area Beer Guild to Launch Craft Brewers Cup

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - The Sacramento Area Brewers Guild has announced it will be organizing the debut of the California Craft Brewers Cup in the fall of this year, in a partnership with the California Craft Brewers Association and five California-based Brewers Guilds.

Based on a projected 2,000 entries, the CCBC will be the third-largest craft beer competition in the world, and will highlight the best beer from independently owned and operated craft breweries in California. The judging will take place in August, with awards given out at the Annual California Craft Beer Summit in Long Beach on September 12th.

"The California Craft Brewers Association is thrilled to be involved in the first competition of this kind - hosted by the entire craft brewing industry to celebrate the innovation and creativity of the beer culture that was born here in the Golden State," said Tom McCormick, executive director of the CCBA. "Hosting the California Brewers Cup ceremony at the annual and statewide gathering of the craft brewing family, the California Craft Beer Summit, adds a wonderful community element to this event. The Summit also gives beer lovers a chance to taste award winning beers from the competition at the Summit Beer Festival."

With over a decade of competition management under its belt, the Sacramento Area Brewers Guild is collaborating with four other Craft Beer Guilds in California - Bay Area, Los Angeles, Orange County, San Diego - to field entries. Awards will be given out in over 60 categories, all of which will be evaluated by a field of 140 judges. The California Craft Beer Summit is an annual event that provides two full days of education, networking and exposure for brewers, retailers, distributors, craft beer lovers, and homebrewers.

Tony Award Winner Roger Bart Coming to CHS Performing Arts Center

Keiwa Gakuen College Jazz Quest to Visit Sacramento

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Almost forty years ago, Cultural Homestay International (CHI) arranged for students from Japan's Keiwa Gakuen High School to participate in a homestay program with host families in Roseville and Orangevale. While here, the students learned American English and learned about American culture, said Randy Chafin, who worked with the non-profit organization in the 1990s.

Students were accompanied by teachers, including Hideo Tsujimoto from Keiwa Gakuen High School who brought students seven times and became friends with Chafin and his family. Tsujimoto is retiring this year and is bringing some of his former students, who now attend Keiwa College, to the Sacramento region for a whirlwind jazz tour and to reunite with friends and host families.

Sixteen musicians will accompany him and American Mark Marin, an English teacher at a Niigata junior college. Niigata is the capital city of Niigata Prefecture, located about 200 miles from Tokyo on Japan's west coast. It is known for its rice, sake, natural beauty, and cultural events. Twelve college students, one high school student, and two Keiwa graduates will make the trip.

Na'Vaughn Martin, who carries the moniker of Mr. Sax and studies music at Howard University, will perform with the band at several locations throughout Sacramento. Martin had participated in a

cultural exchange program between Howard University and Keiwa College and Tsujimoto said it is his pleasure to play with Martin in America.

"We want to show our gratitude to America because Americans created jazz, which we adore, and because America was the home of Duke Ellington, whom we respect," wrote Tsujimoto, Jazz Quest band director.

Tsujimoto adds that jazz has enriched their lives and still loved in America, a century after its creation, and is loved by people in Niigata.

Duke Ellington has a connection to Niigata, the capital city of Niigata Prefecture, located 200 miles from Tokyo on Japan's west coast, that dates back 55 years. In 1964, an earthquake destroyed much of the city including more than 23,000 homes, wrote Tsujimoto.

Ellington came to Tokyo after the earthquake, cancelled his Hawaii tour, and played a benefit concert in Tokyo. In 1966, the city bestowed Ellington with honorary citizenship, and continues to remember the great jazz musician with an annual festival called Niigata Jazz Street, Duke Ellington Memorial each summer. The city held its 33rd annual winter Niigata Jazz Street in January.

Ellington, born in 1899, was a songwriter, pianist, conductor, and one of the earliest

big-band jazz leaders. During his 50 year career, he composed songs for the stage, film, and the contemporary songbook. His unique sound produced hits like It Don't Mean a Thing if It Ain't Got that Swing, Satin Doll, Ko-Ko, among many others.

Jazz Quest, said Tsujimoto, remains true to Ellington's style, respecting the music and his love of it. "We feel that it is our mission to hand down his music to future generations and follow his example of charity."

In 2018, the high school won a national high school big band jazz concert, and the Niigata college students performed at a national college big band jazz contest for the first time. The bands performed Ellington's music.

Jazz Quest will perform on February 20 at Old Sacramento's Laughs Unlimited, on February 21 at Folsom High School for the Folsom High School jazz band. On February 23, the band travels to Fresno to perform at the San Joaquin Jazz Festival, returning to perform on February 24 at Sacramento's Buddhist Church before spending time with host families and friends and returning to Japan.

Volunteers of America Opens Transitional Housing Program for Homeless Veterans

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Volunteers of America Northern California and Northern Nevada (VOA) has launched a 40-bed transitional housing and employment services program for veterans experiencing homelessness in Sacramento County.

The program provides furnished temporary housing in individual studio apartments, meals, life skills and financial management classes, pre-employment and vocational training, employment placement assistance, substance abuse support, housing location and transportation services to single male and female veterans. This program is funded through a grant awarded to VOA from the Veterans Administration and is the only "Service Intensive Transitional Housing" program for Veterans in Sacramento County.

"We are very excited to add this invaluable program to Volunteers of America's existing services for veterans in Sacramento County at Mather Community Campus," says VOA Division Director, Sherman Haggerty. "This program will allow a unique group of veterans the extra time and help needed to meet their goal of achieving independent living."

This program offers the first new transitional housing beds for homeless veterans in Sacramento County, in over three years. The housing units are conveniently located at VOA's Mather Community

Campus adjacent to VOA's Supportive Services for Veteran Families, Homeless Veteran Reintegration Program and the Veteran Service Center all located on the same campus. These housing units are also conveniently located near Sacramento's Veterans Hospital Administration Hospital. Additional housing units are currently under construction at the Mather campus which will increase local housing inventory.

Volunteers of America Northern California and Northern Nevada provides specialized programs for homeless and at-risk veterans and their families in the Greater Sacramento area. Services include rapid rehousing, case-management and homelessness prevention. A large focus is heavily placed on increasing veteran men's and women's employment

possibilities through life and job skills classes.

Founded locally in 1911, the Northern California & Northern Nevada office of Volunteers of America is one of the largest providers of social services in the region. The professional paid staff operates more than 50 programs in categories that include: crisis housing, supportive housing, employment and training services, and corrections. In fact, Volunteers of America provides shelter or housing to nearly 1,800 men, women and children every night in Northern California. Nationally, Volunteers of America helps more than 2.5 million people annually in more than 400 communities. WARNING! Rain and High River Flows

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Due to projected rains, the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation will increase water releases from Folsom Lake, which will cause the American River to run higher and also faster than normal. Discovery Park, which is designed to flood during these conditions, and Howe Avenue and Watt Avenue River Access to the American River

Parkway will be closed from Wednesday, Feb. 13 and will remain closed until further notice.

While unrelated to the Folsom Lake water releases, the Dry Creek Parkway will also be closed at this time due to flooding.

Sacramento County Regional Parks staff will be monitoring the river elevations throughout the weekend, and closure notices will be updated as necessary.

Rangers and maintenance

teams have begun to notify people in the Discovery Park area of the anticipated high flows.

Bicycle commuters and park visitors should use caution as conditions will change throughout the next few days as the storm passes through the valley and surrounding mountains.

In-Ground Graves and Niches Now Available at Historic Matthew Kilgore Cemetery

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - It was with immense pride that the City of Rancho Cordova acquired the historic Matthew Kilgore Cemetery located on Kilgore Road between Trade Center Drive and Sun Center Drive. The City is now offering in-ground graves and niche wall graves for purchase at the cemetery.

It is rare to find such a rich, historical feature in the heart of a city. The cemetery was established in 1874 and

incorporated in 1888. Along with the extended Kilgore family, there are many other pioneer founding family plots with names such as Deterding, Studarus and Yost among the more than 150 people resting there. At the City Council Meeting on September 6, 2005, with several descendants of these pioneers in attendance, the County Historical Cemetery Association designated Matthew Kilgore Cemetery as a historical cemetery and presented a plaque to the City Council for placement at the property.

The City of Rancho Cordova

has taken extensive steps to restore the historic cemetery. Its rededication in 2007 was a source of pride for the community and won several awards for creativity. Today, it is a beautiful resting place and a comfort for loved ones.

Both parties should be able to unite for a great rebuilding of America's crumbling infrastructure.

But Willard, along with a lot of other people, started looking at how they could continue the race while respecting the prerogative of Eppie Johnson's family. I'm very glad they were able to work together and will continue the race that Eppie Johnson started. Whenever you are able to save a tradition like that, the people who were looking forward to it are happy, the family of the man who began the race is happy, and the people I talked about earlier have a great feeling because they were able to save that tradition.

Linda Budge and I were able to talk to the 2019 Youth @ City Council students, a program of PRO Youth and Families, last Monday evening about the background and history of Rancho Cordova. This is the fourth year the City has supported that program through the Community Enhancement Fund. The City has contributed approximately \$300,000 to build civically involved young people who become stakeholders in the City's success, support the healthy development of young people in the City, and improve public safety through youth-led projects in schools and the community.

Railroad Museum Debuts New Exhibit Titled "Farm-to-Fork: A Public History" Created & Designed by Sac State Students

The California State Railroad Museum & Foundation are proud to announce an all-new exhibit titled "Farm-to-Fork: A Public History" which is the creation of graduate students of the Capital Campus Public History Program at California State University, Sacramento. The team of dedicated history students conducted the bulk of the research, image search, and approved the design concepts under the direction of California State Railroad Museum Director and Professor, Dr. Ty O. Smith, and Interpretation & Education Manager, Kimberly Whitfield. The curriculum put into action the philosophy that the Museum's highest calling is to be a laboratory of learning.

The focus of the new exhibit is to relate the multi-faceted story about the critical role the railroad played in transporting the Central Valley's agricultural bounty to the surrounding region, state and nation. In short, the railroad helped to create the very foundation for the global success known today as farm-to-fork. This new exhibit provides Railroad Museum visitors

with the opportunity to gain a more complete understanding about the production and delivery of goods, appreciate the deep history of the people and lives behind the foods we purchase, and learn how railroads played an integral role in that history.

As background, not long after California's Gold Rush in the 1850s and the completion of the Transcontinental Railroad in 1869, many early Californians turned to farming the fertile Delta. The bounty of high-quality fruit and produce grown locally was loaded into ice-cooled railroad cars. Locomotives then pulled the refrigerated freight cars through the Sierra to eager buyers farther east and beyond. This agricultural success was made possible by opportunity, new technology and hard-working people coming together at the right place at the right time in history.

Available now for public viewing, the "Farm-to-Fork: A Public History" exhibit is located in the Museum's Roundhouse inside and surrounding the popular "reefer" car (also known as the refrigerator car) and will remain on display permanently. Viewing the exhibit is included in Museum admission: \$12 for adults; \$6 for youths ages 6-17; free for children ages 5






