Kitty-Palooza Returns for Thirteenth Year

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - On August 3 and 4, everyone wins at the Bradshaw Animal Shelter's annual Kitty-Palooza, including the many cats and kittens, who are ready for their loving "forever" homes and the adopters, who will get a greatly reduced adoption fee, free pet supplies and, most importantly, a new, furry best friend to love for the rest of their lives.

More than 200 cats and kittens will be available at the thirteenth annual Kitty-Palooza, noon-4 p.m., Saturday and Sunday, Aug. 3-4. Adoption fees are slashed for the two-day kitty adopt-a-thon: \$15 for one cat/kitten or \$20 for two. Included in every adoption is a spay/neuter surgery, vaccinations, microchip, ID tag and collar, a one-year license for County adopters and a free vet exam voucher; about a \$200 value.

"Summer is when we tend to have a larger population of cats and especially kittens," said Dave Dickinson, director of the Sacramento County Bradshaw Animal Shelter. "Many of the kittens have been raised by foster care providers and have been socialized with children and other animals. This event is a wonderful way to match up adoptable kittens and cats with new families and to reduce the number of felines housed at the shelter."

Volunteers and Bradshaw Animal Shelter staff will be available both days to assist potential adopters with finding the perfect cat or kitten for their lifestyle. Adopters will also receive "Kitty Starter Kits," while supplies last; pet care information and prize drawings.

unconscionable theft from Sacramento Stand Down Association, they knew that they needed to step in to help," said SAFE Community and Advocacy Engagement Manager Amanda Merz. "Assisting veterans is one of our main pillars of philanthropy at SAFE and we consider it a privilege to help those who have served us."

SAFE will match donations made to Sacramento Stand Down Association now through Aug. 10, up to \$10,000.

Northwest Student Exchange Seeks Host Families for School Year

- Responsible parents looking for ways to supplement the educational and personal growth opportunities for their children or themselves should consider hosting a teenage exchange student for an academic semester or year. Children and adults alike, by interacting daily with a new, international family member, broaden their perspective on the world and discover new facts and ideas.

NorthWest Student Exchange places international high school students with adults and families all over the country, including here in our community. Exchange students add a dimension to the family dynamic that cannot be achieved in any other way. The benefits to the exchange student are obvious: honing their English language skills; learning about the educational system in this country; understanding U.S. social, political, and cultural values; and establishing international friendships. Benefits to the hosts are similar: Not only can hosts learn about another culture and its values; they can view the U.S. through another's eyes, and thereby gain a broader understanding of our own country.

Adults do not need to have children at home to host! Many childless couples, empty nesters, and single-parent families have enjoyed exchange students. NWSE places students from dozens of countries who have varied interests. I will do my best to match a student to your family's lifestyle and interests.

Those unable to host, can earn up to \$175 for every

student placed with people you refer to me, who do host. While hosts cannot be compensated for hosting, tax deductions may be available. Check with your tax preparer.

NWSE exchange students are closely screened for appropriate motivation, academic and language skills; our students have solid emotional and practical support from NWSE professional partners abroad, and from the students' natural parents in their own countries. Our students come with their own spending money, health and accident insurance. Hosts are not expected to be tour guides. Students are here to go to school to improve their English, not be tourists. NWSE local Academic Coordinators, like me, recruit, screen and orient local hosts and provide close support throughout the program.

My family has personally hosted students from France and China and we keep in touch with every student even years later! While they stayed with us, they shared games, they play at home with us, cooked their favorite meals and tried to teach us their language and share their culture. We also have been invited to stay at their family's homes

when we visit their country. One of our French students even calls me his "American Mom."

There are flexible hosting terms available. You may host for as little as a month as a Welcome Host, or, if you're unsure if hosting is right for you, you may host on a trial basis. If everything works out, you may continue for a longer term. In other words, if you're unable to continue hosting for any reason, you're not "stuck" with hosting the student.

Governor Newsom Needs to Return Funds Intended for Disadvantaged Families

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Senate Republican Leader Shannon Grove (R-Bakersfield) issued the following statement after the California Supreme Court recently upheld a ruling by the Third District Court of Appeal which had ordered California to use funds collected during a 2012 Mortgage Settlement lawsuit to help struggling homeowners. The settlement agreement collected \$331 million to help financially-distressed homeowners victimized by unfair lending practices and was intended to provide legal aid, foreclosure hotlines, consumer education and efforts to combat financial fraud.

Instead Governor Brown spent the money on other programs. Since then, two separate court rulings have ordered

California to return the funds to their intended purposes. Governor Newsom filed an appeal to one of the court rulings and just recently, the California Supreme Court weighed in.

"Legislative Republicans have been fighting this issue to help distressed homeowners since 2015. With the recent decision from the state's highest court, this is a victory for those homeowners and validates what legislative Republicans have been advocating all along. I urge the governor to return the settlement funds to help struggling homeowners and fulfill the original intent," said Senate Republican Leader Shannon Grove.

Democrats Impose Another Tax Increase

SACRAMENTO, CA (MPG) - Even with a \$22 billion surplus, California Democrats passed Assembly Bill 91 which will raise \$1.9 billion in new taxes on small businesses.

Senate Republican Leader Shannon Grove (R-Bakersfield) issued the following statement: "On one hand, Democrats say they are providing a \$220 million savings for small businesses, yet on the other, they are

increasing taxes on small businesses by \$1.9 billion dollars. The last thing Californians need is another tax increase especially when we have a \$22 billion surplus. 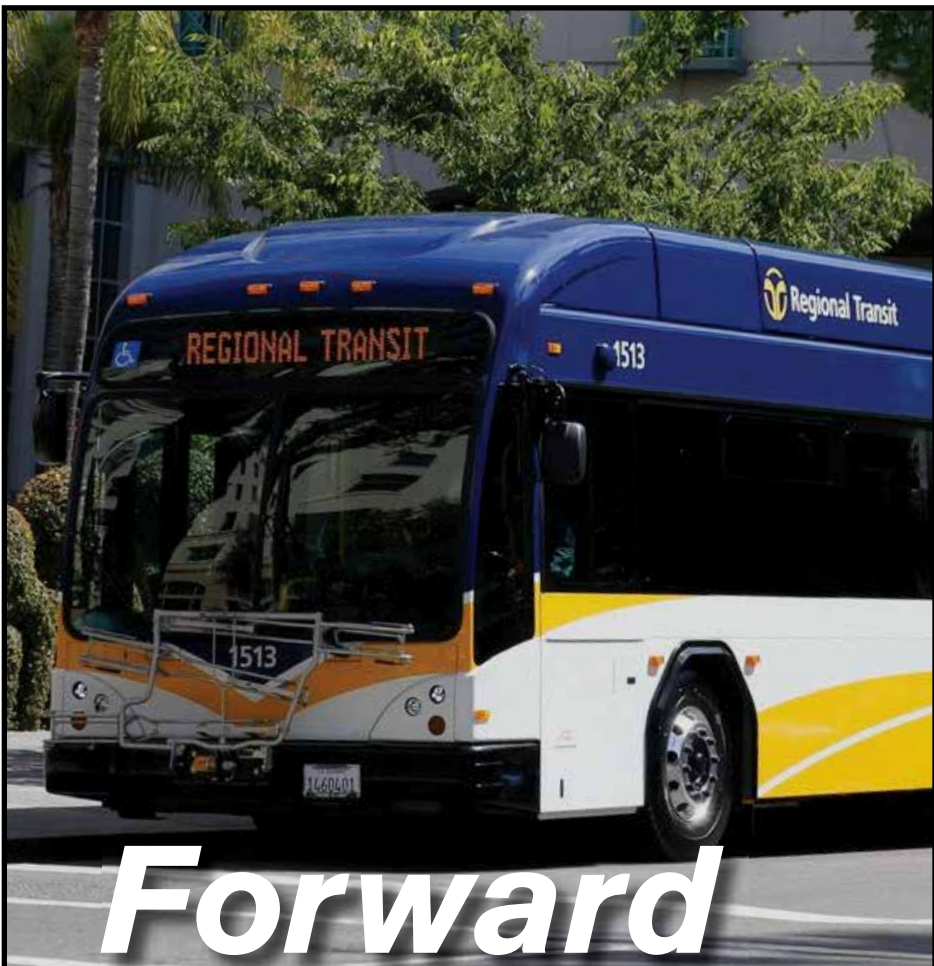

Unsecured Property Taxes Are Due August 31

Sac County Press Release

SACRAMENTO COUNTY, CA (MPG) - Annual bills for Sacramento County unsecured personal property taxes for fiscal year 2019-2020 were mailed on July 12, 2019, and are payable without delinquent penalties through Aug. 31, 2019.

Unsecured property tax bills are mailed to all owners of unsecured property in July of each year. If you owned unsecured property in Sacramento County, such as a boat or aircraft, or if you leased or owned fixtures and equipment related to a business on Jan. 1, 2019, and do not receive a tax bill by Aug. 7, 2019, please contact the Sacramento County Tax Collector's Unsecured Property Tax Unit at (916) 874-7833, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding holidays.

Nonreceipt of a tax bill does not excuse delinquency or allow the tax

collector to cancel penalties or collection costs.

Tax bills become delinquent if not paid in the Tax Collector's Office by 5:00 p.m. on Aug. 31, 2019, or received by mail bearing a postmark of Aug. 31, 2019.

If the tax bill is not paid by the delinquency date, a 10% penalty and collection cost will be added. DMV registration may be withheld on boats if unsecured property taxes are reported delinquent. If a tax bill remains unpaid after Oct. 31, 2019, additional collection costs and monthly penalties at the rate of 1.5% will be added to the base tax.

Payments may be made by mail or in person at the County Tax Collector's Office located at 700 "H" Street, Room 1710, Sacramento, CA 95814, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excluded. For credit/debit or eCheck payments please visit the Sacramento County Property Tax Bill Information System website. ★

Ilhan Omar Holds America in Contempt

Beto O'Rourke, the losing Texas senator candidate who bootstrapped his way into becoming a losing presidential candidate, had a message for refugees who had come to America: Your new country is a hellhole.

The former congressman told a roundtable of refugees and immigrants in Nashville, Tennessee: "This country was founded on white supremacy. And every single institution and structure that we have in this country still reflects the legacy of slavery and segregation and Jim Crow and suppression."

Just in case the newcomers were inclined to believe that they had escaped to the greatest country on Earth, an open, dynamic, generous society that, whatever their struggles now, will afford them opportunities unimaginable back home -- Beto was there to tell them of all its sins.

He had made himself into an instrument of woke assimilation.

This is the backdrop of the controversy over Ilhan Omar,

the Somali-born left-wing member of Congress whom Donald Trump urged, in particularly noxious tweets, to return to her native country and fix it before presuming to tell us what to do.

It's a mistake, though, to think that Omar is anything other than on her way to total assimilation, only on the terms set out by Beto O'Rourke.

American has two assimilation problems. One is immigrants feeling only a tenuous connection to America, and getting isolated in ethnic enclaves. The other is immigrants like Omar -- and some of her second-generation colleagues -- assimilating into the America of identity politics and grievance.

They have learned to speak not just English, but the language of oppression. They understand our system (at least no less than the average office-holder), but hold it in low regard. They know our history, as taught by an instructor cribbing from Howard Zinn.

They may be citizens, but they are certainly outraged victims.

According to a profile in The Washington Post, Omar felt betrayal immediately upon getting to America.

"I arrived at the age of 12 and learned that I was the extreme other," she explained to The Post, noting bullying when she was in school in Arlington, Virginia, an affluent

Washington, D.C. suburb. "I was black. I was Muslim. I also learned I was extremely poor and that the classless America that my father talked about didn't exist."

Somehow, despite all the depredations, she gained a seat in Congress. Omar doesn't represent a majority-minority district. She started her elected career, as The Post puts it, by getting to know "older peace-and-justice hippies." She attended Black Lives Matter protests, and established relationships with all the left-wing groups in Minneapolis.

Omar's default is to blame America first. She explained that local Somali-Americans attempted to join the Islamic State as a function of "systemic alienation." She contends that she has met American veterans "who say the most horrendous things, who have complete disregard for life." And she accuses her congressional colleagues of singling her out for demonization.

Anyone who thinks these attitudes are alien to America has never been to a college campus or watched MSNBC. In short, whatever foolhardy things Trump may tweet, Ilhan Omar is not suited to return and fix Somalia, rather to join a segment of the American elite.

Question: In your recent wish list for Emmy nominations, you repeatedly stated that deserving network shows and performers were likely to be shut out by cable/streaming competitors. So explain again why there isn't a need for two separate awards shows: one for broadcast, and one for cable shows/streaming services. — Maurice

Matt Roush: Sorry, not budging. (And I'm pretty sure this is becoming an annual argument.) What would you call the awards show for broadcast shows only: The Also-Rans? The Consolation Emmys? Why don't they deserve to compete with the very best on other platforms? To me, it makes a statement when the precious few shows and stars (and writers, directors, designers, etc.) from broadcast shows make the cut

that somehow they've bucked the odds to get the attention of the TV Academy. I agree that it isn't fair that some very good work on network TV is getting overlooked, but in the bigger picture, the solution to this paradox is for the networks to tell bolder, riskier stories. Even then, it might not matter to an industry whose members seem to gravitate toward premium cable and streaming. But a show like *This Is Us* is evidence that if a network series touches a chord in the culture, breaking through the insane clutter that is now the TV landscape, Emmy nominations (and even a win) may follow.

World Series of Poker Player Ends His Suffering With Medical Aid-in-Dying Law

RANCHO CORDOVA, CA (MPG) - Kevin "Racks" Roster, Jr., a terminally ill, 36-year-old native New Yorker, who moved from his long-time home in New Jersey to California, so he could access its medical aid-in-dying law to peacefully end his suffering from sarcoma, died on Friday, July 26. He died peacefully in his sleep shortly after taking the aid-in-dying medication, surrounded by his wife, caretaker and best friend, at his apartment in Rancho Cordova.

Sarcoma often is misdiagnosed until it is too late to cure and nearly 6,000 people die each year from sarcoma, according to the Sarcoma Foundation of America. After his diagnosis, Kevin dedicated much of his remaining life to raising awareness about sarcoma and medical aid in dying via a blog, Twitter account, YouTube videos and playing semi-professional poker wearing sarcoma education gear.

Last month, Kevin partnered with Compassion & Choices to urge lawmakers in his native state of New York and nationwide to authorize medical aid in dying as an option for mentally capable, terminally ill adults to peacefully end intolerable suffering. Kevin originally planned to use the new New Jersey medical aid-in-dying law that takes effect on Aug. 1, but his doctors told him in May that he probably wouldn't live long enough to use it.

Kevin's story generated news coverage by California, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and national media outlets, reaching millions of people, including ESPN's World Series of Poker, ESPN's Outside the Lines, Poker Life Podcast, Pokernews.com, Pokercentral.com, Joey Ingram's Poker Life podcast, Datpoker podcast hosted by six-time World Series of Poker bracelet winner Daniel Negreanu and Adam Schwarz, USA Today, USA Today oped, Sacramento ABC-10TV affiliate, Sacramento Bee, and Philadelphia NPR affiliate WHYY.

Thanks to this publicity, 2012 World Series of Poker (WSOP) Champion Greg Merson put up the \$10,000 entry fee, so Kevin could fulfill his last wish by playing in the WSOP Main Event in early July, while wearing sarcoma education gear. Unfortunately, he "busted the tournament" (ran out of poker chips) in the final level of day 2.

However, after returning home to Rancho Cordova because of rapidly declining health, he still managed to win the 2nd largest cash game pot in the history of the StonesLivePoker stream/stones gambling hall in Sacramento, more than \$12,700.

"I have chosen to peacefully end my fight with sarcoma from a position of strength via the use of medical aid in dying," Kevin said in a statement he posted Thursday night with a YouTube video directed to his poker community (statement and video are posted at: <https://mysarcomacancerstory.com/140-2/> and video also is posted on YouTube at: www.youtube.com/watch?v=2Fmxppw441g).

"At this point, the disease is holding me hostage, and I am taking back control, as I have tried to at every crucial step of my journey. I currently suffer from an almost constant need to be on oxygen, fatigue which keeps me in bed 13-14 hours a day, coughing fits, delirium, tumor pain in my back lungs and groin requiring morphine liquid, and about 40 pills daily, shortness of breath and difficulty eating amongst many, many others."

"The most special thanks are reserved for my wife and best friend, Jennifer, and my son, Lucas, for their support and understanding and also for my caregiver, who wishes to remain anonymous. Without them and their support, none of this would have ever been possible," Kevin concluded. "I do ask that any media outlets understand our need for privacy at this time. My family will not

accommodate any requests for interviews or comments at this time."

California is one of nine states — including Colorado, Hawaii, Maine, Montana, New Jersey, Oregon, Vermont, and Washington — as well as the District of Columbia, that have authorized medical aid in dying. Collectively, these 10 jurisdictions represent more than one out of five U.S. residents (22%) and have 40 years of combined experience using this end-of-life care option.

"Kevin died much too young, but he made the most of the last weeks of his life by educating millions of young sports fans about the deadly health threat of sarcoma and the end-of-life care option of medical aid in dying that many of them probably were unfamiliar with," said Kim Callinan, CEO of Compassion & Choices. "We are eternally grateful to Kevin for his work to advance medical aid-in-dying legislation in New York and other states, which allow terminally ill adults to peacefully end their suffering if it becomes intolerable."

Kevin Roster was born on March 9, 1983 in Queens, New York and raised there. He is survived by his wife, Jennifer, and their 10-year-old son, Lucas, who live in Staten Island, New York.

Girl Scouts Take STEM on the Road

SACRAMENTO REGION, CA (MPG) - Far too many girls in this country are unable to see themselves working in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) fields, but Girl Scouts is working to change that. "There's been a big investment nationally in STEM," explained Beth Peters, Girl Scouts Heart of Central California (GSHCC) STEM initiatives manager. "The national CEO [Sylvia Acevedo] is a rocket scientist, so she's very invested in computer science. She got into science because of Girl Scouts, so she wants other girls to have that opportunity."

The GSHCC council successfully opened two STEM Centers + MakerSpaces, one in Sacramento and another in Modesto. Peters said the Sacramento space served 1,400 girls in the first year and 2,400 girls so far this year. "It's growing rapidly," said Peters, "and it's not just limited to STEM centers. Girls are doing projects with their troops, with their troop leaders, doing it on their own, they're taking more classes... girls are getting more involved, for sure, which is really exciting."

GSHCC has 18,000 girls in their council, which serves 18 counties. Everywhere "between Yuba City down to Merced, from Tracy to Truckee, so it's a very big section of the Central Valley," said

Peters. "It's just not feasible for people to be able to get to the MakerSpaces on a regular basis." To expand on the success of the STEM Centers and reach more girls, GSHCC just launched a Mobile STEM Center + MakerSpace. "We decided to take everything good about these spaces and put it on wheels so we can take it to them," said Peters. Medha Aiyah, a Gold Award girl scout, was part of the GIRL (Go-getter,

Innovator, Risk taker, and Leader) Task Force, and she helped design and implement the STEM Center + MakerSpace. Aiyah just finished her freshman year at the University of Texas at Dallas where she is majoring in computer science. "I love coming back," said Aiyah, "especially seeing the growth of what Girl Scouts here have done promoting girls in STEM. It's amazing, and the Mobile STEM MakerSpace is so cool

because you can take STEM on the road and bring it to so many girls."

Aiyah said, "When I took my first computer science classes in high school, there weren't as many girls as I expected. I thought, 'We have the same mind and the same capability to do what guys can do, why are there less girls in this field?' So it's really important to encourage girls, to tell

them, 'You have power, and you can shine bright in these fields.'"

The Mobile STEM Center will travel to troops and Title I schools throughout the region to reach underserved girl scouts, especially those living in outlying areas. GSHCC will rotate the curriculum to offer a

variety of options including engineering, robotics, programming, virtual reality, energy and space science, cyber security, agricultural science, and forensics.

Peters said that GSHCC also works with local partners in the region to help connect girls to STEM resources that already exist in their communities, and they "hope that the Mobile STEM Center will be a magnet for that."

At a launch party for the Mobile STEM Center on June 18, attendees commended the initiative. Powerhouse Science Center deputy engineer Rita Hoffstadt and executive board of directors' member Judith Kielstrom admired the MakersSpace and said they look forward to partnering with GSHCC. Kielstrom said, "It takes a village to raise a young scientist."

Sacramento Mayor Darrell Steinberg supports GSHCC's STEM initiative, noting the importance of creating pathways for young girls into these fields as the area increases its technological impact: "Sacramento is booming.... We're building a modern economy." Mayor Steinberg wants Sacramento to be a national leader in ensuring young women's involvement in STEM, and he offered this advice to young women: "Live your dreams. Don't let anyone tell you that you can't do something."
